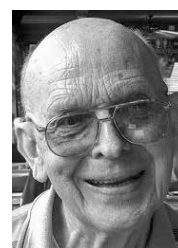

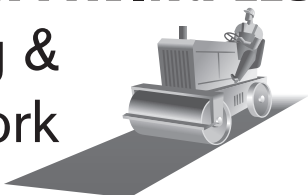

- **Speak to vendors** to find out if cancellations can occur with no penalties. Many hotels and other travel services are waiving fees for cancellations, or allowing bookings to be rescheduled at no additional cost.

- **Try to think of some alternative dates** for events like weddings and graduation parties as soon as possible. There is no way to accurately predict the path that COVID-19 will take, nor put a firm date regular life can resume, but discussing alternative dates with vendors with whom you're already under contract may put you at the top of the list when gatherings are once again allowed.

- **Reach out to guests** to explain that your plans are fluid. Expect that a good portion of guests, even those who already committed to attend, may not be able to make rescheduled events. Speak with vendors about fluctuating headcounts in the wake of COVID-19.

- **Be patient** and keep an open minded about events. These are unprecedented times and many people are learning as they go. Rescheduling events when the threat has subsided may cause a bottleneck effect with service providers. Flexibility and patience can help make reschedule less stressful.

### 10 things you can do to manage your COVID-19 symptoms at home

If you have possible or confirmed COVID-19:

1. **Stay home** from work and school. And stay away from other public places. If you must go out, avoid using any kind of public transportation, ridesharing, or taxis. 
2. **Monitor your symptoms** carefully. If your symptoms get worse, call your healthcare provider immediately. 
3. **Get rest and stay hydrated.** 
4. If you have a medical appointment, **call the healthcare provider** ahead of time and tell them that you have or may have COVID-19. 
5. For medical emergencies, call 911 and **notify the dispatch personnel** that you have or may have COVID-19. 
6. **Cover your cough and sneezes.** 
7. **Wash your hands often** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. 
8. As much as possible, **stay** in a specific room and **away from other people** in your home. Also, you should use a separate bathroom, if available. If you need to be around other people in or outside of the home, wear a facemask. 
9. **Avoid sharing personal items** with other people in your household, like dishes, towels, and bedding. 
10. **Clean all surfaces** that are touched often, like counters, tabletops, and doorknobs. Use household cleaning sprays or wipes according to the label instructions.

## SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

**1** Ask the person to **SMILE**.

**2** Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.

**3** Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.

**4** Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

## OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking, dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

## Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

**CHEST DISCOMFORT.** Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

**DISCOMFORT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE UPPER BODY.** Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.

**SHORTNESS OF BREATH** with or without chest discomfort.

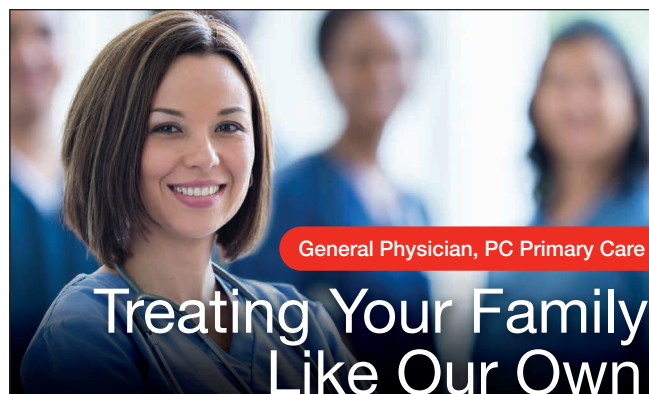

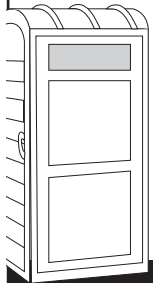

The role of a speech teacher or speech-language pathologist plays an integral part in the day-to- day education of students with autism, emotional disorders, cerebral palsy, Down Syndrome and who are multiply disabled. They are in charge of providing therapy to anyone receiving speech services.

Speech-language pathologist Lorrina Kostuk-Madonia says that she and her fellow speech specialists, that are employed by Orleans/Niagara BOCES at various school sites, work with a different student every half hour during a school day. "We provide them an individual pullout session into our room for one-on-one intensive therapy. We also can see them in a push-in setting in their classroom and help them to carry over their goals in the classroom with various strategies. We also see children in a group setting where we take three to four kids and work on their speech and language goals together." The speech team prides themselves on being flexible with their teaching methods and have even given therapy on fieldtrips and at the side of a pool during gym classes. It also helps them to see how the child does in a community setting and if they understand the directions they are given.

"We are always coming up with different therapy techniques," Kostuk-Madonia says. "The students function at a variety of levels and some are primarily non-verbal and we want to give them a functional way to communicate. We use many strategies like visuals and it helps them to bridge the verbal output of their language. For some that means picture books and for those who are more advanced there are apps that we can download onto an assisted technology device or an iPad that they can use to communicate their needs. We are doing our best to give kids a variety of tools." Some students are higher functioning and more verbal, but have trouble for social-emotional reasons. "We work with them on how to start a conversation. How to take turns with their friends in conversation. What are appropriate or good things to say. There is nothing we can't work on as far as understanding and expressing language and we are proud of that."

The speech therapists work very closely with the classroom teachers, teacher aides, counselors, occupational therapists and physical therapists, who also work with the students, to help carry over strategies that facilitate the students' understanding and use of language. The Speech Department also documents and evaluates the students to continue to make sure a child is qualified for the level of therapy they have been receiving and if they are meeting their speech and language goals in their IEP's (Individualized Education Program). "We use that information and come up with a comprehensive report to provide their parents, the CSE (Committee on Special Education) chairperson and their classroom teachers," explains Kostuk-Madonia. "We all work together as a team because we are the glue that helps to keep it all together for the student."

One of the reasons for the constant monitoring is that if a child regresses with their therapy, they can come up with a plan to correct that. "This is why extended school year is so important," says Kostuk-Madonia. "Having six weeks off in the summer would cause many of them to regress. It is so important to keep them on target."

The speech team is constantly getting professional development through webinars and meetings their supervisor Cassandra Barnes sets up for them. They also attend conferences yearly. Speech-language pathologists have to have 36 hours of continuing education every three years to maintain ASHA ( American Speech-Language Hearing Association) certification and acquire 100 hours every five years to maintain professional teacher's certification. "We all share with the rest of our team what we learn and what we have success with," says Kostuk-Madonia. "That is priceless to me to have that type of rapport with the team. We are very involved and are always looking to learn more to help our students. We also have to educate ourselves about what is going on with the Medicaid rules, since we take care of the billing. It is very important to be diligent with that."

Although their job can be challenging, the reward outweighs that. "Once you do this kind of work, you just love it," Kostuk-Madonia explains. "I like working with the most challenging children. Sometimes they have their good days and their bad days, sometimes they have a hard time realizing how they are feeling and can't verbalize it. The challenge for us is that we are working with a different diagnosis every 30 minutes and we have to change our plan within moments to accommodate them. I live for that, I like feeling needed." She gets very emotional when she talks about the breakthroughs that she sees. "For some kids it takes a long time and that lightbulb going off for them, no matter how small, means so much to all of us at the school and to their families. It is why we do what we do."
