

Moore Shoals' First in NADN

FLORENCE-Local attorney **Larry B. Moore** was recently inducted into the Alabama Chapter of the National Academy of Distinguished Neutrals.

Membership in the NADN is by invitation only and limited to professional mediators and arbitrators who are established as trusted neutrals in the legal community. Members are nominated by existing Academy members, they must have served as a mediator at least five years, and mediated over 200 private civil disputes. Additionally, they must have received the endorsement of at least eight attorneys for whom the mediator has mediated civil disputes during the preceding 120 days.

Moore is the first mediator in the Shoals area to be inducted into the NADN. He practices with the law firm of Moore, Berry, and Linville in Florence.

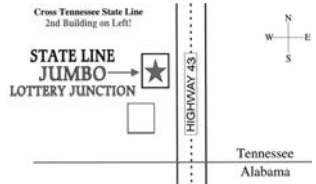

Ian Teaches Aaron

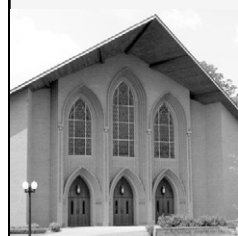
Ian: "You know, without God's grace we are lost."

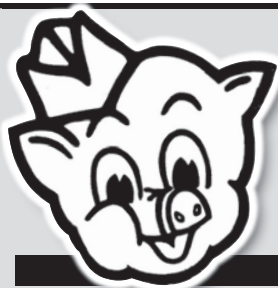

Award ranking and is itself a culinary destination," said Bowser. Including the music-themed Swamper's Bar & Grill and the adjacent convention center, in ten years the Marriott Shoals has served 1.8 million meals.

"As soon as the hotel opened, the Florence area became a major destination for tourists and conventions," said Lee Sentell, director of the Alabama Tourism Department.

RECENT BANKRUPTCY LAW CHANGES

Federal courts in certain cases are required to use the law of the state that applies to a particular case and that is true to a certain extent in bankruptcy cases. In bankruptcy cases different states allow people who file bankruptcy to keep different amounts of equity in their home and personal property and the bankruptcy court in a particular state uses those amounts set by the state that it's

located in. pictures and all books used in the family shall also be exempt from levy and sale under execution or other process for the collection of debts. No wages, salaries, or other compensation shall be exempt except as provided in Section 5-19-15 or Section 6-10-7.

2. The homestead of every resident of the state, with the improvements and appurtenances, not exceeding in value **fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000)** and in area 160 acres, shall be to the extent of any interest he or she may have therein, whether a fee or less estate or whether held in common or in severalty, exempt levy and sale under execution or other process for the collection of debts during his or her life and occupancy and if, he or she leaves surviving him or her a spouse and minority of the child, or children, but the area of the homestead shall not be enlarged by reason of any encumbrance thereon or of the character of the estate or interest owned therein by him or her. When a husband and wife jointly own a homestead each is entitled to claim separately the exemption provided herein, to the same extent and value as an unmarried individual. For purposes of this section and Section 6-10-38 and 6-10-40, a mobile home or similar dwelling if the principal place of residence of the individual claiming the exemption shall be deemed to be a homestead.

located in. For example, Florida has a very high exemption which allows debtors in bankruptcy to keep huge homes and Alabama has one of the lowest exemption amounts in the country.

This keeps a creditor from taking everything a person has. Historically, Alabama allowed \$3,000.00 in personal property, plus clothing and family photos and books. Alabama allowed the debtor to keep the first \$5,000.00 in home equity and if a married couple filed that added together to \$10,000.00 in home equity.

All other property above the exemptions (\$3,000.00 & \$5,000.00) was sold and divided among the creditors or a debtor could file a plan to repay the creditors under bankruptcy Chapter 13.

On June 11, 2015, the Legislature changed the law as follows:

1. "The personal property of such resident, except for wages, salaries, or other compensation, to the extent of the resident's interest, to the amount of **seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500)** in value, to be selected by him or her, and in addition thereto, all necessary and proper wearing apparel for himself or herself and family, all family portraits or





Senseless Action Scars Our Nation

The people of Charleston, South Carolina will feel tainted for generations. Twenty-one year old Dylann Roof was arrested without incident fifteen hours after killing nine people at Emanuel African Methodist Episcopal Church in Charleston - after he sat with them through a Bible study class last Wednesday.

Perhaps the most troublesome aspect is that he doesn't appear to fit the stereotypical image of a calculated killer. He is not the grizzled unkempt, middle-age, unshaven perp we often see on news reports associated with atrocities. He doesn't appear to need a razor yet.

Whether we admit it or not, there is a set of physical characteristics - which transcend age, race, ethnicity, and gender - that will cause us to subconsciously secure the door lock on our car for fear of being mugged, raped, etc. This baby-faced kid with a Dutch-boy haircut doesn't create that reflex in me. Furthermore, he didn't have an axe to grind with any of these people. Walking in off the street and firing away at random would be more understandable. But sitting with the victims for an hour through the class? Could he not see that these were good people who hardly seem to fit the subjects of his brief pre-murder racist rant reminiscent of the 1960's?

There are few actions that can be considered

Deshler's Legendary Receiver

In 1965, Buddy Moore's undefeated Deshler Tigers unleashed one of the most lethal passing combinations in the state of Alabama. Quarterback Tommy Lewey throwing and Jim Underwood receiving put fear into the hearts of opposing football teams. Underwood was practically unstoppable as a receiver. TimesDaily Sports Editor Hap Halbrooks said it best in describing Underwood: "he called him a glue-fingered receiver." "He was catching the ball everywhere it was thrown." The Tigers certainly didn't know the first game against Walker County would be the only blotch on an undefeated season. But they did discover what an impact that season's passing game would become. In a 13-13 deadlock, Underwood caught two touchdowns in a come-from behind battle. Underwood would have a great statistical season that year, catching 48 passes for 785 yards and 10 touchdowns. Two games in particular would be Underwood's signature games. He was named Alabama Player of the Week after catching 5 passes for 105 yards and two touchdowns in Deshler's win over Athens that gave the Tigers the prestigious Tennessee

Valley Conference Championship, Against Decatur, he caught 3 touchdowns, which was a school record at the time. The awards rolled in for Underwood after the season. He was named First-Team All-State end, All-TVC First-Team, the Shoals Area's Most Outstanding Lineman and voted the Tigers' Most Valuable Offensive Player. Underwood continued his heroics in the Alabama High School North-South All-Star game when he caught the winning touchdown pass for the North team. Underwood was also an outstanding baseball pitcher for the Tigers. He played in the 1965-1966 East-West All-Star games. Underwood received the ultimate honor for his athletic achievements this spring when he was inducted into the Colbert County Sports Hall of Fame. That 1965 squad will go down as one of the Shoals Area's all-time great teams. I would have loved to have seen them participate in the playoffs, but that didn't come until two years later. Underwood is currently the president of area Subway stores.

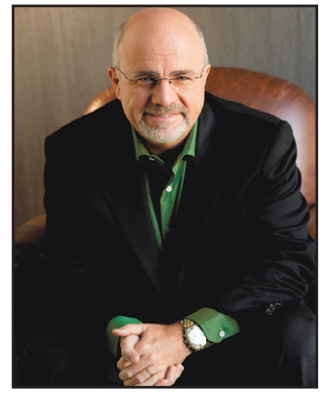

Dear Dave, My wife and I are in our twenties. We have no debt and \$50,000 in the bank. Our income is \$90,000 a year, and we're cautious to live on less than we make. Still, we can't seem to get motivated to make a budget. How can we get inspired to do this?

one, but that would mean taking out a \$30,000 loan. We have \$30,000 in savings, including our emergency fund, and we make \$55,000 a year. What are your thoughts?

Dear Isaac, Two of the biggest motivators we have are pain and pleasure. Financially, you guys don't have any pain. You're killing it! So, we're going to have to figure out something associated with pleasure.

Dear Renee, I think what you're doing with your lives is kind of cool. But I can't advise financing something that will go down in value as quickly as an RV. I wouldn't even do it on the basis that it's going to be your primary residence.

I think you need to look for something bigger than money to push you. You guys need to ask yourselves, "What are we saving for?" On a bigger scale, ask yourselves, "What can we do with this money?"

Let's look at things from a different angle. First of all, I think your emergency fund is a little high. I recommend three to six months of expenses, and on a household income of \$55,000, holding \$20,000 in reserve would be a lot. If you kept \$15,000 in the bank, that would leave you with \$15,000. If you're talking about a \$30,000 upgrade, you'd only need to save up another \$15,000.

It sounds to me like you both realize money can't be the goal. And that's a good thing. You guys are obviously smart, gifted people. I'm sure you have ideas and goals, dreams and desires. Talk about them and write them down. By doing this, you'll be taking the first steps toward making these things reality. When you have something specific that you want money to do, it gives you a reason to make it behave.

See where I'm going with this? With a little patience and planning, you can have your upgrade in the not-too-distant future and still have the peace of mind that goes with knowing you have a reasonable emergency fund sitting in the bank!

God calls us to manage well the resources He gives us, so that we're able to do good things for His kingdom and His people. Broke people can't give, so my advice would be to use your talents and resources for the good of others.

who just graduated from Brooks, is going into computer science and will transfer to Athens State after receiving his Associate's Degree from Shoals. Mary Davis, a 2015 graduate of Deshler, plans to major in education and transfer to UNA upon graduation.

"These students are all motivated," noted Brittany Jones. "They're here because they want to be."

"We also have Scholar Dollar recipients in the tech fields of applied engineering, welding, and auto collision," added Adam Goodman. "We offer 20 - 30 tech fields here, so there's something for every student whether technical or academic."

What draws students to NWSCC and the Scholar Dollar program?

Mary, Ashton, Stokes, and Chloe all agreed this has been the best choice for them and has made a huge difference. "I'm just thankful we have a community that cares enough to do this," Mary added. Chloe nodded. "This gives students a chance to have an education they might not get without it."

"We have students who have to take out loans to pay for books and fees, so without this scholarship program they wouldn't be able to attend at all," Brittany said. "You don't have to be a star athlete or have a 4.0 GPA to go to college without starting off with a huge student debt."

NSWCC and Scholar Dollars are working with seventeen public and private high schools in the two county area. They are enrolling about 150 students per year.

In order to qualify for the program, high school grads must meet these requirements:

- Maintain a C average
 - 95% attendance rate
 - Be a US citizen
 - Have a clean record
- Once admitted, there are several more requirements.
- Maintain a C+ average
 - No disciplinary action
 - Be a full time student
 - Submit to random drug tests

All incoming students are required to submit to a drug test and attend orientation. However, for Scholar Dollar recipients there is a four-week class that is even more in-depth. They're taught such skills as how to study, how to take notes, how to pay attention, time management, how to build a resume, and how to interview and land a job.

Scholar Dollar students meet with their Success Coaches regularly on a one-on-one basis. This enables the coach to see how they are doing in class, arrange for a tutor if necessary, and just generally talk about any questions or problems they might have.

"I really feel supported," Ashton said. "I can meet

with my adviser any time I need to." Stokes and Mary looked on in amazement. These incoming students weren't aware of all the benefits their scholarship included!

"I like starting off in a smaller environment," Stokes added.

Mary likes being able to stay closer to home. "I'm looking forward to getting involved and meeting new people."

Chloe and Ashton are happy to offer suggestions to the new students. "Do well in class," Ashton advised. "Join at least one of the clubs on campus, and get to know your classmates."

"This is a new environment for you," Chloe told Stokes and Mary. "Be friendly, and keep your grades up."

"This is a great program," Brittany Jones added, "This is the best program I've seen in a long time. I had one student say she'd been waiting three years for this!"

The wait is over. The Scholar Dollars scholarship earns an A+ from everyone involved, and will continue to offer quality education to Shoals area high school grads for a long, long time.

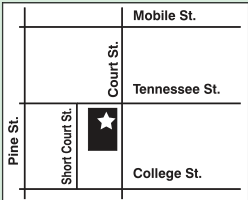

for those who served their country. But as a veteran myself, I sometimes worry that the public is getting an incomplete impression of veterans.

Facing so many demands for charity, the public thinks veterans are a bunch of zeros. The fact is veterans as a rule have been successful in life. When I left the service in 1970 after a stint in Vietnam, I almost immediately entered UNA (then Florence State University) on a very generous G.I. bill. (Thank you, America and UNA!) I remember meeting other ex-G.I.s on campus. In those days, Vietnam vets were called GI's instead of warriors.

The G.I. benefits allowed me to study at UNA unhindered by part-time work, something many non-vets never enjoyed. Nearly four years later, I was still using G.I. payments at the University of Mississippi's graduate school. When I left Oxford, MS, I had an M.A. in my pocket. As far as I remember, I was debt free thanks partly to the benefits. Thousands of veterans traveled a similar route toward their goals. Today, at age 67 and retired, I'm eligible for medical care at the VA's excellent clinics at Sheffield, Huntsville and Birmingham. These services are available to me because of my war-time service as a twenty year old. While I've more or less forgotten my distant Army days, the American people haven't.

As a veteran, I appreciate every thanks I get from a considerate public. I encourage everyone to help those veterans who are in need, but not every veteran has a drug problem, or a homeless problem, or a

mental problem related to his or her military service. In fact, like me most veterans do not. And while veterans certainly deserve a pat on the back, so do the American people for their generosity. After all, we're in this together.

which is often made of plastic and connected to the trap under the kitchen sink. On occasion, this tube can get blocked and prevent the dishwasher from draining effectively. In addition to these cleaning techniques, using a rinse agent may help the dishwasher work better. According to Jet Dry, the maker of a popular rinse agent, rinse agents help your dishwasher rinse away residue that causes spots and film on dishes and glasses. They are designed to lower the surface tension of the water, causing it to sheet off the dishes during the final rinse. This prevents the formation of droplets of water that can remain on the surface of the dishes and form spots and film.

Maintaining a dishwasher with regular cleaning can help it perform better during each and every load.

The dishwasher is an unsung hero of many a kitchen. When a dishwasher is working properly, it can make fast clean-up of scores of dishes, silverware and glasses.

As handy as dishwashers can be, sometimes they seem to lose their cleaning power. While inadequate cleaning may indicate the time has come to replace the dishwasher, many times all the appliance needs is a little maintenance and TLC.

Lenders Harm Rural Areas

Editor:

Payday lenders target low and moderate-income people, advertising a quick, easy loan to help make it until the next payday.

In reality, payday loans begin cycles of chronic indebtedness. According to the Center for Responsible Lending, the average borrower ends up indebted for more than six months with an average of nine payday loan transactions at annual interest rates exceeding 400%.

Twelve million Americans are trapped every year in a cycle of payday loans with an average annual interest rate ranging from 391% to 521% for the typical two-week loan. An average payday loan of \$325 incurs \$468 interest for a total repayment of \$793 after the loan is flipped eight times. Payday borrowers are more likely to have credit card delinquencies, unpaid medical bills, overdraft fees leading to closed checking accounts and, ultimately, bankruptcies.

This is why sixteen states and the District of Columbia have enacted double digit annual interest rate caps for payday loans.

The rates, terms, and reality of payday loans are sickening for everyone, but especially for rural residents. Small towns have a high percentage of self-employed rural people. Entrepreneurs need access to capital, so it's important for consumers to protect their financial health. A poor credit history will limit the number of financial options open to entrepreneurs. Anything that prevents current entrepreneurs from growing or budding dreamers from opening a business harms rural communities, where entrepreneurs are a major economic force.

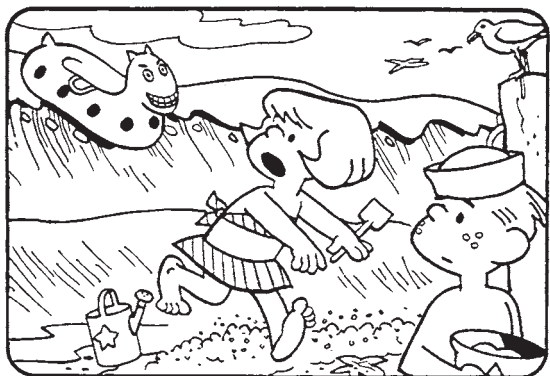

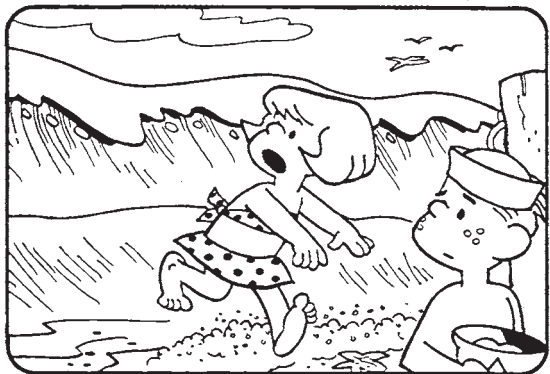

as deplorable as what Dylann Roof did last Wednesday.

Naturally, the gun deaths were politicized. We hear the mantra, "It was too easy for him to get a gun... Gun violence has no borders. It knows no limits." Well, neither does knee-jerk stupidity. The gun didn't commit the crime any more than his car did. He could have just as easily clubbed several of those people with a brick in darkness after the class and they wouldn't be any less dead. We can't outlaw bricks.

Instead of trying to find the bad things in his life, we need figure out what good things were NOT in his life.

The fact that Roof reportedly was allowed to reload and spend his ammunition several times before leaving the scene seems almost inexcusable. Where was someone, anyone, to intervene? Was the entire church made up of older ladies?

And why no expression on this guy. Is he one of the medicated millions who has

just become numb?

The families, surviving church members, law enforcement and government officials, and the citizens of that community need our prayers for strength, patience, and understanding, because all three will be difficult to come by. Roof needs prayers and so do members of his family. They have been hurled into the wrath of the media and public blender. Their lives have also changed forever.

With evidence so convincing, many, including me, would normally advocate for the death penalty in such a deplorable and heartless crime. Not one year after conviction, not ten years and \$2 million in taxpayer legal fees later, but the week after his first appeal fails. That would be the only real deterrent for such antics. However, lawyers need billable hours and the ACLU has insured that 'hanging at sunset' will never happen again in America.

Therefore, give Roof life and put him with the general population in a close or medium security prison. The situation should work itself out appropriately.
