ASK THE **ATTORNEY**



I read two different summaries of all of the civil cases decided by the Alabama Supreme Court and the Court of Civil Appeals every week. I do this in an effort to stay current on the law and hopefully, be the best lawyer for my clients.

Last week I read a case that surprised me and I want to tell you about this decision and the law that it contains as I was not aware of this.

In Kowalski v. Upchurch, decided 7/17/15, the court reaffirmed the proposition that if a spouse is named on an insurance policy as the beneficiary and the parties later divorce, even if the divorce contains the following language: "All items of personal or real property in the

insured's name or belonging to the her, including, without limitation . . . retirement plans, IRA, business interests, partnerships insurance policies, shall be her sole property and the [former] husband is divested of any interest therein. The former spouse still collects the money.

What this means is that if you have named your husband or wife as the beneficiary of your insurance policy and you later get a divorce and don't change the beneficiary on the policy, when you die your ex will get your life insurance proceeds.

In some cases where there is still a relationship because of children and the former spouse is trustworthy enough to make sure the money goes to the kids that may be fine. In other cases the very thought of the ex spending that insurance money on their new spouse could make someone turn over in their grave at a considerable RPM.

What surprises me about this case is that the language of the divorce specifically addresses the life insurance policies and states that they are the property of the spouse who took out the policy and not the former spouse and you would think that language that specific would accomplish that goal. It does not.

This case notes that divorce by itself does not affect the spouse's right as the named beneficiary of the other spouse's insurance policy unless a clause in the policy conditions those rights upon the continuance of the marriage. That rule stems from the fact that a beneficiary's rights to proceeds from an insurance policy arises from a contractual obligation, not a marital one.

Buckle up and drive safely.

Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate.' (Matthew 19:4-6). God did not define marriage by using two men or two women in a relationship. He rather defined marriage at the beginning of time by using Adam and Eve or one man and one woman.

People who remain homosexuals will not inherhit the kingdom of God. God said "Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. 

she argued that marriage licenses should provide couples with the right to only a common household, but not parenthood. In fact, couples should have to obtain a permit to become parents.

Sam Mitchell's Legacy

Coffee High School has produced numerous football All-State and All-American players in their long and storied history. One of the greatest players in the 1950's was the late Sam Mitchell. Mitchell as an All-American halfback at Coffee in 1957 and excelled not only in athletics, but also in academics and student leadership. Mitchell was recruited

out of high school by many Division I colleges, but decided to sign with Auburn University to play under legendary Coach Shug Jordan. Mitchell was also a standout academic student, graduating with a Bachelor's Degree and later earning two Master's Degrees including a MBA.

graduating Ăfter from Auburn, Mitchell launched a very successful coaching career. He served as head football coach at Columbus High School in Columbus, Georgia where his teams advanced to the state championship game twice, losing once in the final second of the game. He remains the youngest coach in Georgia high school history to take teams to a state championship game.

He was offered a chance to coach on the college level and accepted a job at Auburn under Shug Jordan coaching the secondary and special He became teams. endeared to Auburn fans when his secondary, known as Mitchell's midgets, were the ones who blocked two punts that were returned for touchdowns in Auburn's 17-16 win over Alabama in the 1972 Iron Bowl.



Auburn players awarded Mitchell the game ball in that win. In 1973, Mitchell was hired as assistant head football coach and defensive coordinator under Paul Dietzel at the University of South Carolina. He finished his coaching and

Vince Dooley at the University of Georgia for four years.

Mitchell was very civic minded, serving on several clubs including the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. In 1981, he entered private business as a financial planner and stock broker and founded Mitchell Investments, where he worked until retiring in 2013. Mitchell capped off his remarkable career when he was inducted into the Lauderdale County Sports Hall of Fame, sealing a legacy that won't soon be

Putting The Cart Before The Horse

Have you ever found yourself in the midst of an important situation in life and realized that you might have done things in the wrong order? Sometimes it's almost impossible to predict the correct order of things, and other times you just find yourself in a situation and have to wing it from there.
