
HOLLYWOOD — Are you ready for a musical about Steven Spielberg's classic 1975 film "Jaws"? The Papermill Playhouse in New Jersey, often used to develop Broadway-bound shows, has booked an impressive season from now until 2021. It has planned productions of the classic board game and comedy film "Clue," "The Sound of Music" and the Elton John/Tim Rice musical "Aida," before ending the season with "Bruce" (June 9-July 21, 2021). Bruce was the name of the uncooperative mechanical shark that gave Spielberg and his team endless problems. Mark your calendars.

Meanwhile, another Bruce, Bruce Willis, has been more than cooperative with his busy film schedule. "10 Minutes Gone," with **Michael** Chiklis, was released last September; "Trauma Center," with Nicky Whelan, debuted Dec. 6; and "Survive the Night," with CW star Chad Michael Murray, went straight to video.

Willis also has a slate of films that don't yet have release dates. The sci-fi action thriller "Breach," about an interstellar ark, is due in the fall. "Midnight in the Switchgrass" has a great cast with Oscar-nominee Emile Hirsch, sexy Megan Fox, Lucas Haas and Sistine Rose Stallone (21-year-old daughter of Sylvester), but shooting is on hold due to the coronavirus. He's also got "McClane," an offshoot based on Willis' character from the "Die Hard" franchise, along with the alien invasion movie "Cosmic Sin," with Luke Wilson and Frank Grillo.

Wilson just completed the sports film "12 Mighty Orphans," set during the Great Depression, with Martin Sheen, Robert Duvall, "Seinfeld's" Wayne Knight and Treat Williams. Frank Grillo has completed "The Hitman's Wife's Bodyguard," with Ryan Reynolds, Morgan Freeman, Samuel L. Jackson, Salma Hayek, Antonio Banderas and Richard E. **Grant**, for an Aug. 28 release.

coronavirus, Baz Luhrmann's film, shooting in Australia, about Elvis Presley, in which Hanks plays Presley's manager Colonial Parker to Austin Butler's Elvis, has been shut down until Hanks has recovered. Maggie Gyllenhaal plays Elvis' mother.

Their first hit was "Ruby Don't Take Your Love to Town.'

Luckily, for many years I was able to spend time with Kenny and hang out at his house from time to time with Mickey Dolenz. Kenny was just as nice and down to earth as you were led to believe he was. His music stays with us now that he's joined the "Islands In the Stream"!

If you are like I am, you are on overload from coronavirus news. Things we were told at the beginning of the pandemic may or may not be true. No matter the news, the availability of essential supplies, and the disruption of what we considered normal, we are all united by one thing: We are all waiting for bad news to turn into good news.

As you may know from previous columns, I believe in preparing for emergencies and disasters before they occur. This pandemic, though, has taught me some lessons.

I am reminded of something I have learned from companion animals and vacuum cleaners. Dusty Cat and Katey Dog have been in heaven for many years now, but they were the first ones who taught me the Vacuum Cleaner Principle.

They were terrified of vacuum cleaners. Whenever I approached the storage closet, they were on high alert. When I took the cleaner out of the closet, they ran. The problem is, they did not run into another room, nor did they run out of the path of the vacuum. They ran in front of it. In fact, they ran in front of it throughout the house. They were always ahead by several feet, but they could have just been so much better off if they had gone into another room or just veered away from the vacuum's path.

Such has been portions of my emergency planning for my dog, cat, and birds. I had a good supply of food, but not the three-month supply that is recommended. I always had in the back of my mind that I could buy more before the hurricane or blizzard struck. After all, I would have several days warning.

I always stored just one step ahead of the supplies running out. Who could ever have guessed that a pandemic could lead to such shortages? My animals are very particular about the food they like, and I always expected the shelves to be full

One step ahead is no longer acceptable in this world gone topsyturvy. During a pandemic, we do not evacuate; we shelter in place. Some parts of the emergency preparedness remain the same; however, some do

We suggest that all human guardians/pet owners do the following so they do not have to just stay one step ahead:

1. Work to store at least a three month supply of food for each animal.

2. Keep all routine vaccinations upto-date. Keep your dog's required tags current. Know where the rabies certificates are kept.

3. Maintain a positive relationship with your veterinary clinic. Pet illnesses do not stop during a pandemic.

4. Have a plan in place just in case you have to be hospitalized. Make sure a trusted family member or friend will take care of your pets.

5. When possible, keep a three month supply of heartworm prevention, flea and tick prevention, and other medications.

Eventually, the shelter in place quarantine will end. Here's hoping the lessons learned do not!




