

One More Coat

Ladybird Act Slowly Eliminating Historic Barns, Nostalgic Signage

LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN, GA. - Sign painters recently completed a three-day project to repaint a barn maintained by See Rock City, Inc. (SRC) on Highway 68 near Crossville, TN. This is part of an ongoing SRC initiative to do several barn repaints yearly, continuing this historic legacy.

"We are in a preservation mode of trying to keep as many barns as possible for nostalgic purposes as southern icons, as well as for advertising," said Roy Davis, manager of SRC's R&R Hospitality. "Unfortunately, we can only maintain the paint on the barn and not the structure itself. If the barn becomes in total disarray or is taken out by a storm, then we lose it and cannot replace it due to highway laws."
The "Ladybird Act," as the billboard-banning legislation was nicknamed, meant that many of Rock City's rooftop messages had to be removed beginning in the 1960's.

With only 79 SRC barns still maintained from

My mother died in June, 2014, before she passed away she had put my younger sister on her savings and checking accounts. My mother also left a will leaving me as executor and my other sister as co-executor. The sister who was the co-executor had seen an attorney in Athens, Alabama about the funds our mother left in the bank, this attorney told her that these funds belonged to the sister who mother put on these accounts. He stated these funds were hers and she could do what she wished, she could keep the money or divide them with the other heirs, the choice was hers. The co-executor sister hired a second attorney and she told us that the funds in those accounts had to be put in an escrow account until after the will was probated, after these funds were put into an escrow account

this attorney will drop us. Which attorney is right about who these funds belong to?

Phillip, Killen, AL

The answer to your question is contained within the contract that the depositors signed with the bank that held the funds.

Experience dictates that the funds in the bank will belong to the person who is the survivor of the two people who were on the account. All banks require that an agreement be signed and every one that I have seen in the last twenty years just simply by default has a "joint tenants with rights of survivorship" clause. This means that the person who survives the other gets the money.

This is exactly the same type of clause that is in most deeds between married couple where a home is owned jointly during the marriage, it will go to the survivor by the terms contained in the deed. Most homes bought and owned during a marriage are bought as "joint tenants with rights of survivorship".

I am certain that it is possible to reach another agreement with a bank that says that funds held jointly or payable to an estate or a different beneficiary or some other arrangement, but I have never seen anything other than held jointly and then owned by the survivor.

This keeps the bank out of the estate process and also out of any litigation because there is an agreement in place that protects them from having to make a decision or make an appearance in Court. Therefore, the lawyer that said that the sister gets the funds is quite probably correct but it wouldn't do any harm to ask to see the agreement signed when the account was originally set up. Subpoenas certainly can be issued by the attorney handling the estate for a copy of that agreement.

WATERING **TIPS FOR** HEALTHIER **LAWNS**

ummer is a season for landscaping, and you're watering. worry that their lawns won't make it through the dog days of summer. But lawns don't have to succumb to the sizzling summer sun. Oftentimes, the right watering strategies can help homeowners nurse their lawns through the hottest months of the year, so they'll

Reconsider when Come homeowners who live summertime, homeowners in regions that get especially may want a glass of hot in the summertime often water at high noon, when temperatures seem to be at their hottest. But you and your lawn are different, so the best time to satiate your thirst is not necessarily the best time to water your lawn. Watering in the middle of the day is often ineffective, as water tends to evaporate quickly in the afternoons remain as green as they did when temperatures are back at the height of spring. When temperatures are peaking. Nighttime watering



can contribute to the growth of fungus, which can create an entirely new set of headaches for homeowners. Morning watering sessions tend to be most effective during the summertime, as temperatures tend to be cooler in the morning, leading to less evaporation. Less evaporation means all that watering isn't going to waste.

Reconsider your sprinkler. If you can't afford an in-ground irrigation system, which many landscaping professionals feel is the most effective and efficient way to water a lawn, then you likely will rely on a sprinkler to keep your lawn looking lush through the summer months. When choosing a sprinkler, look for one that shoots water out horizontally as opposed to vertically. A vertical sprinkler system is more vulnerable to wind and evaporation than one that shoots water out horizontally, so make sure your sprinkler system is sending water into your lawn and not into summer breezes.

 Avoid overwatering. How much water your lawn needs in the summertime depends on a host of factors, including where you live and how often rain falls in that region. Overwatering can promote the growth of fungus and adversely affect your lawn's root system, making it difficult for roots to grow deep. Speak with a local landscaping professional to determine how often you should water your lawn each week.

• Strategically position your sprinklers. When choosing where to put down your sprinklers, hook them up to your hose, turn them on and then watch to see where the water is going. Areas that exposed to sun are most in need of water, so make sure the bulk of your water isn't going to shaded areas beneath trees. In addition, make sure you aren't wasting water on sidewalks, patios and driveways. Sprinklers should be positioned so none of the water they're shooting out is landing on surfaces that don't need water. It sounds simple, but too often homeowners drop their sprinklers down, turn them on and then walk away without waiting to see where the water is landing. Position sprinklers or adjust sprinkler heads so all the water is landing on your lawn.

Keeping a lawn lush and green at the height of summer requires homeowners to adopt effective strategies. Such a strategies can make the difference between a lush landscape and one that succumbs to summer heat.
