### Scouting for Food Campaign

In America, there continues to be families that struggle to make ends meet and provide food for their families. That problem happens right here in Dickinson County too. Families that struggle can receive supplies to help them out, at the Upper Des Moines Food Pantry. The only problem is that once the food pantry hands out a large amount of supplies, they need to get the shelves filled back up to continue to provide to those in need. This is where the Local Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts like to help with this ongoing problem. The Boy Scouts of America does a once a year “Scouting for Food” Campaign. Next Saturday, May 9, you will see the Cub Scouts from Pack 67 in Milford going door to door hanging a tag that lets the public know they are requesting food donations for the food pantry. Then on Saturday, May 16, The Milford Boy Scout Troop 170 will be coming around the town of Milford picking up those bagged donations.

The Food Pantry came up with a list of items that they are really low on, but will take donations of any non-perishable food items or paper products. Some items they are requesting are: canned pineapple, applesauce, baked beans, canned potatoes, tuna and chicken helper box meals, boxed au gratin potatoes, plain oatmeal, banned chicken or tuna, Spaghetti O’s, peas or mixed veggies, rice, spaghetti sauce, apple sauce, saltine crackers, assorted snack crackers, cereal, canned fruits, canned beef stew, vegetable beef soup, cream of any kind of soups, toilet paper, Kleenex, hand soap, pancake syrup, salad dressing. So you can join the efforts of the Boy Scouts and help families that are in need. In Boy Scouts, one of the points of the scout law is. “A Scout is Helpful”. Thank you for your support.

### Pioneer Days Canceled

The 52nd edition of Pioneer Days in Milford, Iowa, will have to wait another year.

The Milford Commercial Club’s Executive Board voted 5-0 Wednesday night, April 29, to not host the town’s annual celebration July 24-26 because of the COVID-19 situation.

“There is just too much uncertainty now. Our main concern is the safety of the persons who attend all of our events and our own business members who largely fund the three day celebration,” said Pioneer Days Co-Chair, Susan Reiser.

The group did say that if things calm down in the next two months, they are not ruling out the chance of a parade or a noon barbecue luncheon.

“There are some events that we can easily and quickly organize. We just need to be flexible in what we can do as the situation allows. I guess if we are making an error in canceling this event, then we are making it on the side of caution.” Reiser added.

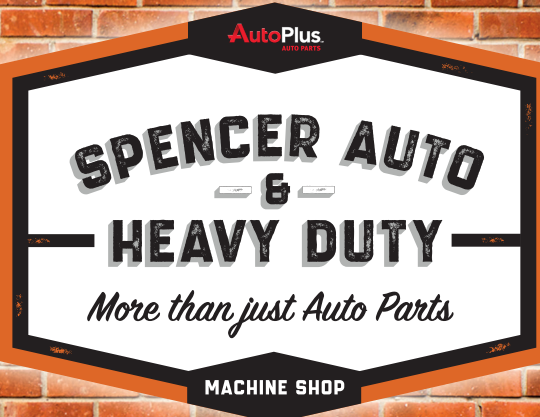

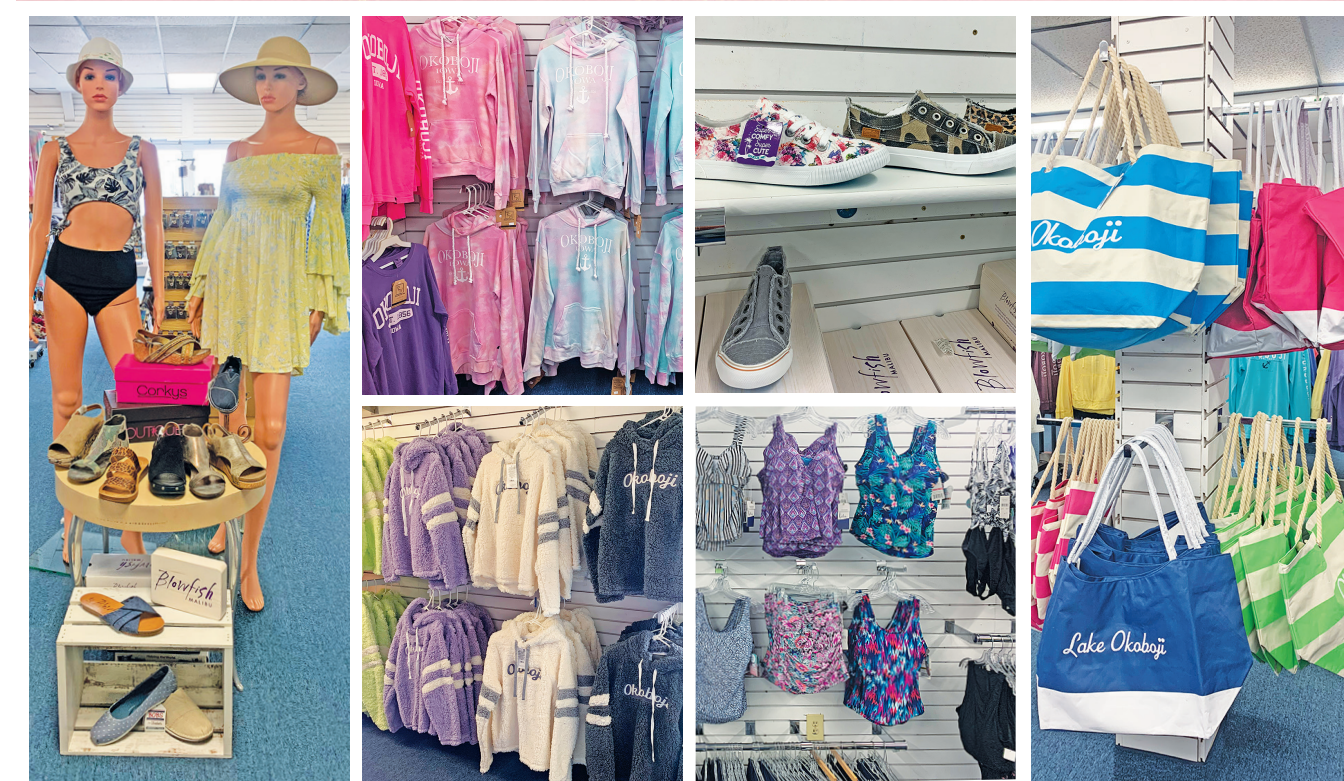

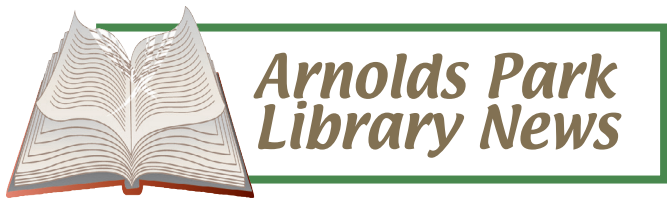

With the library being closed to the public the staff has been keeping busy with curb side checkouts, cleaning, organizing shelves, and planning future programming. Additionally, the Library Director and Library Board have been working on a phased re-opening plan. This plan was designed to keep our staff and patrons safe while still being able to enjoy the library.

The Governor lifted its mandated closing of libraries effective May 1. While we respect the Governors decision the Arnolds Park library staff and board do not feel that we can safely re-open at this time. We are planning on doing a phased re-opening beginning on Monday, May 18, 2020.

On Monday, May 18, the library will start Phase 1 and be open to the public on a limited basis. The library will be open to the public Monday-Friday from 10:00am-3:00pm. This allows staff time to sanitize incoming books before opening to the public, as well as additional time to clean and disinfect surfaces after being open. Based on our square footage and the ability to allow patrons and staff to safely social distance themselves we can allow five patrons plus any staff working in the library at one time. The library will be open for patrons to browse our materials and check outs. All other services (programming, computers, toys, etc.) will not be available during this phase. Phase one will run from May 18 to May 31. \*\*Subject to change based on current COVID-19 restrictions\*\*

We want to remind patrons that we offer "Books to Go" at the library on Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 1-4pm. Patrons can reserve books online or call the library to have their books picked out. We will continue to offer this service during our first phase of re-opening for patrons who wish to pick up their materials outside the library.

The library staff wants to thank our patrons for their loyalty and understanding during this uncertain time. We love our patrons and want to keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible. ### 2020 Census - Be Counted!

The 2020 Census will provide a snapshot of our nation-who we are, where we live, and so much more. The results of this once-a-decade count determine the number of seats each state has in the House of Representatives. They are also used to draw congressional and state legislative districts.

Over the next decade, lawmakers, business owners, and many others will use 2020 Census data to make critical decisions. The results will show where communities need new schools, new clinics, new roads, and more services for families, older adults, and children. The results of the 2020 Census will inform decisions about allocating hundreds of billions of dollars in federal funding to communities across the country-for hospitals, fire departments, school lunch programs, and other critical programs and services.

### Spring Clean-Up Day

The annual Arnolds Park City Wide Clean-Up is scheduled for **Monday, June 1, 2020**. This is offered to all residents of Arnolds Park as a discounted way to dispose of items that are not collected during regular garbage pick-up. Please place small items in boxes or bags. White goods (appliances) and brown goods (electronics) will be disposed of for \$10 each; flat-screen TVs are \$15 each and older model box-style televisions are \$25 each. All of these items require a tag that can be purchased at City Hall prior to June 1. **Items must have a tag on them in order to be picked up.** Also, no lawn waste or recycling will be collected. If you need to dispose of building structures or other large objects that two men cannot easily handle, please call City Hall at (712)-332-2341 to make special arrangements and we will try to accommodate you.

The City will not pick up any hazardous items such as oil, paint, pesticides, weed control products, etc. Empty paint cans will be picked up if the can is dry and the top is off.

Please refrain from placing items curbside prior to the Saturday before the clean-up day. All debris, however, needs to be curbside and ready for pick up by **7:00 a.m. June 1**.

Please be courteous if you are going through bags or boxes, put the items back that you do not want. Be respectful of residents' yards and the workers who have to clean it up.



### Campground

Governor Reynolds has mandated that all recreational camping is prohibited at this time. Once the restriction is lifted, overnight camping at the Minnewashta Campground, located at 7 Bascom Street, will be available on a first come first serve basis. The rates are \$35 a night with electricity and \$25 a night without, rates

### Police Department

The Police Department would like to take this time to remind all pet owners that they must have their pets, especially dogs, contained on their property at all times. When walking animals, please be courteous and use a leash; dogs should not be running at large. All animals must be in a secure location away from electric, gas, and waters meters. This will assure your meters are read properly.

If you are going to be using ATV's or golf carts this summer please make sure you are aware of all the rules and regulations. Copies of the ordinances are available in City Hall or you may contact the Police Department with questions.

season for our area businesses. We are always striving to enhance police protection for our citizens and tourists to make Arnolds Park as safe as possible.

### Renting of Residential Property

The City has seen an increased number of residential properties listed on AirBnB and other vacation rental sites. Please be aware that the minimum rental period differs depending upon what Zoning district property is located in. Property located in the (R-1) Single Family Residential, (R-2) Medium Density Residential, and (MH) Mobile Home & Manufactured Housing districts have a minimum rental period of thirty-one (31) days or one calendar month. Rentals by the week, weekend, or night are only allowed in the (R-3) Cottage Residential, (C-1) Downtown Commercial, (C-2) General Commercial – Mixed Use, (C-3) Highway Commercial, and (C-4) Resort Commercial districts. Regardless of location, all owners must provide enough off-street parking for their tenants. A 180-square foot parking space is required for every three (3) persons of occupancy, or one (1) space for each bedroom. Failure to comply with the City Ordinance can result in a Municipal Infraction charge and fine for each day that the violation occurs. Please check with City Hall before listing your property for rent.



### Projects

The City relies on hotel/motel income to fund a number of capital improvement projects each year. Due the current health crisis and uncertainty about the financial impact on tourism, the City will be postponing some of the upcoming 2020 Capital Improvement projects.

These projects include the pickle ball courts and additional parking at Sawmill Park, parking and sidewalk improvements on West Broadway Street, storm sewer and public access improvements on 232nd Avenue, and the mill and overlay of Prairie Lane, Miriam Lane, Monument Drive, and Pillsbury Point Park Road. Over the course of the summer, re-evaluation will take place and some of these projects may be completed yet this fall with the others pushed back to 2021.

Approximately 300-feet of the water main on Minnewashta Beach Road was replaced last fall. All that remains for that project is the repair of the street. Approximately 482 feet of water main beginning on Elm Drive north of the Abbie Gardner Cabin and extending down Prairie Lane remains scheduled to be replaced this spring. This project will continue as it needs to be completed before the mill and overlay of Prairie Lane can take place. ABC Services out of Estherville, IA is the contractor on both the Minnewashta Beach Road and the Elm Drive water main projects.



### Wildcat Stadium

Residents driving by 74 Bascom Street will notice an addition to the former Arnolds Park high school baseball diamond, now owned by the City of Arnolds Park. New this year is a play area to the north of the ball field and concession stand.



### Yard Waste & Open Burning

The City has proper disposal methods for yard waste and we ask that it never be blown into or placed on the streets, public roads, or neighboring lots.

If you wish to have your yard waste picked up it must be placed in City bags, tied shut, and placed at the curbside by

**7:00 a.m. on Tuesdays.** The bags must not weigh more than 75 pounds. Cut branches in 4-foot lengths and bundle with a City bag attached. Yard Waste is picked up April through October (dependent on the weather.) City bags are available for purchase at City Hall and Casey's in Arnolds Park. If you need to dispose of yard waste outside of this time frame you will need to drop off your bags at the Dickinson County Recycling Center located at 2260 220th Street (A34), Milford, IA. Charges may apply.

If you choose to burn your yard waste, please be courteous to neighbors and use good judgment based on weather conditions. All fires must be attended by a person 18 years of age or older at all times. Any yard waste you burn on your property, must originate on your property. **The burning of garbage, rubber, or anything of a toxic matter is strictly prohibited. Yard waste cannot be burned on City property.**



### Garbage Collection

Beginning Memorial Day and continuing through Labor Day, garbage will be picked up on Mondays and Fridays. **Collection begins at 7:00 a.m.** If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated collection day.

Paint, lawn waste, or recyclables are not to be placed into the cart. Also, remember to place your carts at least five feet away from any structure (i.e. mailboxes, trees, cars.)



### Recycling

Curbside recycling days are the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. **Please contact City Hall if you would like to receive a recycling container at no charge.** Recycling must be placed in the correct container in order to be picked up, Town & Country will not pick up recycling in any other container or if it is mixed in with garbage. Please have containers out by 7:00 a.m. on pick-up day. If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated pick-up day. There are recycling bins located at 700 240th Avenue. If you should miss the curbside collection.

Accepted recyclables include: cans (steel, tin, aluminum), plastic containers (bottles, tubs, jugs), flattened cardboard, paper (newspapers, office paper, junk mail, magazines, phone books). Shredded paper and plastic bags need to be bagged separately in clear plastic bags.

**Do not recycle the following items:** Glass (bottles, jars), Styrofoam, ceramics, porcelain, baking glass, toys, clothes, shoes, rubber, waste & food, hazardous materials (paint, lead, glue, oil), electronics (TVs, keyboards, batteries, bulbs), furnace filters.



### Appliances & Electronics

Appliances and electronics are picked up curbside year-round. You must purchase a tag for these items at City Hall. Dickinson County has a recycling facility located at 2260 220th Street in Milford where you can dispose of all of the above items yourself. Please contact (712) 338-2549 with any questions.



### Severe Weather

Sirens located at City Hall, Dam Road, & Benit Drive will be sounded. Tests for these sirens are held every Wednesday at noon.

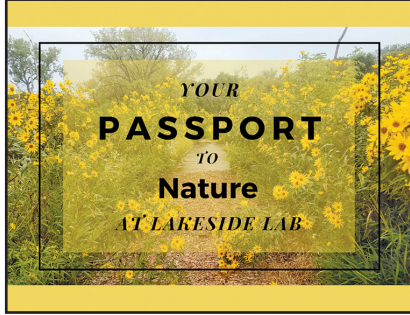

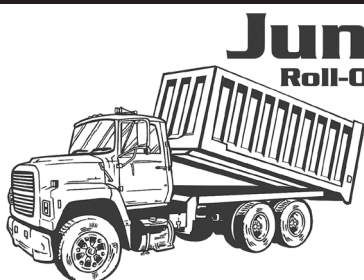

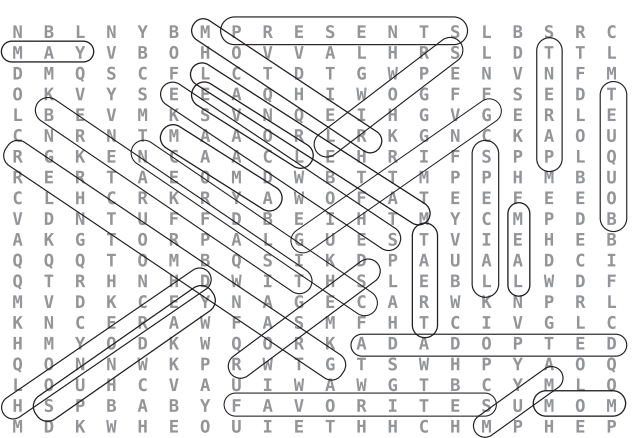

Without going into details, Middleton noted in an email, "I have really enjoyed my time here at Okoboji!"

Sam Cordes, 2019

Do you remember actor and bicyclist Sam Cordes? He was very much a part of the 2019 season at the Okoboji Summer Theatre. In an email from Kansas City, Missouri, where he is 'summering' at his parents' home, Sam expressed his disappointment about the OST's 2020 season being canceled. "Sad to hear that the Okoboji Summer Theatre will be yet another theatre to fall victim to the pandemic. It's a hard time for us theatre folk. I'm sure things will be looking different in Okoboji this summer." While he was off on a cross-country bike trip when he left the campus of the Uofo last summer, Sam explained Sunday that he taught through the academic year at Hastings College, in not-too-distant Nebraska! "I planned on going back to teach there for another year in August; but we'll see how this all turns out."

"I was supposed to be playing the role of Ferdinand in the Heart of America Shakespeare Festival's production of The Tempest, here in Kansas City; but like most things, that, too, was canceled. I had even planned to do RAGBRAI for the first time. So, the summer has turned out to be a total bust with COVID-19."

Sam also noted that he had earlier contacted the OST's artistic director, Stephen Brotebeck, to be considered for the season. "I will miss being in Okoboji."

Research director RD isn't going to miss much this week, which for her starts on Wednesday, with No Diet Day - the day we can eat anything, and everything, we like! Perhaps strangely, RD has selected Lasagna, a song from Weird Al Yankovic's 1993 release, The Food Album, which was his first and only LP to be certified gold by the RIAA - to date. The wacky cut is a parody of Ritchie Valens' 1958 Top Forty hit, La Bamba, which has since been covered by many artists, including Trini Lopez, The Ventures, and even Ray Conniff...

Thursday's full moon is nicknamed The Full Flower Supermoon - the last of three to occur this year. For the record, according to EarthSky.Org, a Full Flower Supermoon is a full moon closely coinciding with perigee - the moon's closest point to earth in its monthly orbit. In the late 1950s, songwriters Al Hoffman and Dick Manning's lunar studies inspired them to pen two songs about the moon - Allegheny Moon, which was Patti Page's big hit in 1956; and Moon Talk, recorded by Perry Como, in 1958...

And, RD adds that it was also May 7, 1941, that The World Famous Glenn Miller Orchestra recorded Chattanooga Choo Choo, which was part of the Sun Valley Serenade musical motion picture. While RCA Victor painted a copy of the record with gold paint in 1942, the RIAA awarded its first official Gold Record to Perry Como, in 1958, for his smash-hit single Catch A Falling Star...

Sunday, of course, is Mother's Day - when no collect calls are allowed! And it is also Stay Up All Night Night! - which can be celebrated with the song, In the Wee Small Hours of the Morning, written by David Mann and Bob Hilliard, in 1955 - no doubt during a post midnight session. That same year, the song was introduced as the title track of a Frank Sinatra album. More recent versions include those by Carly Simon, (1990), trumpeter Chris Botti (1999), and Kurt Elling, in a medley on his 2007 release Nightmoves.

May 10th is also the day (in 1899) that Fred Astaire was born in Omaha. Astaire was the dancer, singer, actor and choreographer, who introduced the George and Ira Gershwin composition, They Can't Take That Away From Me, in the 1937 movie musical, Shall We Dance.

The following year, They Can't... was nominated for an Academy Award as the Best Original Song -- after George Gershwin had passed away. The Second Hand Songs website boasts nearly 500 recordings of the song by as many artists!

Property Tax Has a New Deadline

"On April 27, 2020, Governor Reynolds issued another extension to the 3/17/2020 Emergency Healthcare Proclamation, that waives late penalty on property tax payments through May 27, 2020, to help give some assistance to Iowans dealing with the impact of COVID-19's arrival in our state," says Dickinson County Treasurer Kris Rowley. "Payments must be postmarked by May 27, 2020, paid online at www.IowaTaxAndTags.org by May 27, 2020, or dropped off in the Dickinson County Treasurer drop box outside the Courthouse by May 27th to avoid a late penalty. Payments can also be called in to the office."

The county offices at the Dickinson County Courthouse closed to the public at noon on 3/17/2020, due to concerns over COVID-19 in Iowa and surrounding states. "Sadly the Coronavirus has changed how we live our lives and conduct our business," says Rowley. "My staff are still here at the office handling our workflow and answering questions by phone and email. Many of the driver's license and motor vehicle deadlines have been extended through a State of Public Health Emergency Proclamation made by Governor Reynolds on 3/17/2020 back-dated to 3/16/2020."

If your driver's license has an expiration date of January 16, 2020 or later, you do not have to renew your license at this time. It will remain valid to drive in the state of Iowa until the declared disaster is lifted. You may also be able to renew your driver's license or Iowa-issued ID online at https://mymvd.iowadot.gov/Account/Login.

With regards to air flights, The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) will accept state driver's licenses or identification (ID) cards that have expired on or after March 1, 2020, if you were unable to renew at your state driver's license agency. Check with TSA to make sure you can fly if yours is expired.

If your vehicle registration expired January 31, 2020, or later, it will be considered valid to drive in the state of Iowa until the declared disaster has ended.

If you purchase or transfer a vehicle on or after February 16, you will not be required to obtain a title and registration within 30 days. This will remain in effect until the declared disaster is over. Carry your purchase documents/bill of sale in your car when driving until it is transferred into your name and plated. The bill of sale is also needed at the treasurer's office to complete the transfer.

If you purchase a vehicle from a dealer on or after February 1, 2020, you will not be required to obtain license plates within 45 days. This will remain in effect until the declared disaster is over. Carry your purchase documents in your car when driving until it is transferred into your name and plated.

On non-interstate roads only, trucks hauling food, medical supplies, cleaning products or other household goods may exceed the weights listed in Iowa Code 321.463 by 12.5% without a permit, so long as they don't exceed 20,000 pounds on an individual axle and their total weight does not exceed 90,000 pounds. Trucks are still required to obey posted bridge restrictions.

Rowley says, "The website for Dickinson County is https://dickinsoncountyiowa.org. Many of the motor vehicle forms are available on this website. There are also links to the Iowa Tax and Tags website, www.IowaTaxAndTags.org, for making property tax and motor vehicle renewal payments.

Bumgarner added: "The safety of its patients and healthcare team is the hospital's priority during this public health emergency. Spencer Hospital will communicate significant updates about elective surgeries and other services to keep the public informed."


