



I do not know how old you are so I can only tell you that you are experiencing a social security off-set. When you reach retirement age for social security purposes, which is a moving target depending on what year you were born, the off-set will cease.

The rule for an off-set is based on the idea that we don't want people who don't work to do better, meaning make more money not working than working. Social Security rules provide that you can only receive 80% of your pre-injury earnings and above that amount your Social Security is decreased to the extent that the Social Security Administration believes to be 80% of your pre-injury earnings. Social Security can and will completely cut off your Social Security payments if necessary.

You are receiving payments from two different sources. Social Security law contains the off-set. Workers compensation in Alabama is based on 2/3 of your average weekly wage capped at approximately \$755.00 per week. Social Security is based on how much you paid in and for how long. You are receiving permanent partial disability benefits from workers compensation. Permanent partial payments are capped by the legislature at \$220.00 a week. When you add both your Social Security and your workers compensation payments together, they may not combine to total more than 80% of your pre-injury wages.

Lawyers who settle workers compensation cases by agreement can include language that can prevent or minimize the Social Security off-set, but a judge has no power to do so. I know that seems odd, but all a judge can do in a worker's compensation case is decide a percentage of disability from 0 to 100% disabled. The amount of money that results from that determination is then paid weekly until paid in full. The Court has no power to prevent an off-set. This can greatly affect the

negotiation strategy for a worker's compensation case.

Oddly enough, the fact that a Social Security judge found you disabled has no real bearing on a Circuit Court State judge finding you disabled. The two systems use different rules and Social Security looks at all of your health issues that affect your ability to work while worker's compensation typically only considers issues caused by an on-the-job injury.

PAYING THE "STUPID

Dear Dave,

My husband broke a few ribs and his collarbone a couple of years ago when he flipped our ATV. He's fine now, but we still have about \$20,000 in medical bills because we were both between jobs and didn't have medical coverage when the accident occurred. We also have two credit cards, one with a \$1,000 balance and the other a \$7,000 balance. We only have \$200 a month we can put toward debt, so where should we start? Sandy

Dear Sandy,

having health insurance at any time of your life is not smart, regardless of being between jobs or not. Ouch, what a mess! You didn't tell me what you guys make, but I can tell you a few things.

Number one, you're probably going to have to get your income up. You may have to take on a couple of part-time jobs or work some overtime. My grandmother used to say, "There's a great place to go when you're broke — to work!" If you only have \$200 a month to put toward your debt, you've got to create some you've got to create some margin, and that may be on the income side of things.

The other thing I've found is this: Most people seem to be able to magically find money when they feel it's

a life or death situation. "Magically" means that you do a budget. You make a written game plan where every dollar has a name before the month begins. When you write down every dollar, and you and your husband sit down and agree on where every dollar is going to go, you're going to have an ah-ha moment that feels like you got a raise. If you're normal, you waste a bunch of money because you don't budget and have a written plan. And normal pretty much sucks!

So, here's the drill. Start living on a written budget, extra work, start working the debt snowball and pay off those debts from smallest to largest and don't even think about a vacation or anything else that's not necessity based until you clean up this mess. When you start living with a scorched earth idea - beans and rice, rice and beans — I'll bet you're going to find a lot more than \$200 in your budget to put toward killing off this debt!

Dear Dave,

Recently, I met a young man who was put out on the street when he turned 18. He lives on food stamps and \$10 a week. My wife and I are on Baby Step 7 of your plan and have a great income, and our whole family feels called to help this kid — maybe even taking him into our home. Do you have any advice?

You guys obviously have loving hearts and are doing great financially. But let's take a look at few important factors in a decision like this.

If you're thinking about actually taking him in under your roof, you need to remember that your first responsibility is to your family. You have to make sure they're safe, and that would include finding out everything there is to know about this guy. Talk to his past teachers, coaches or even family members if you can find them. Spend some time just talking to him, too, and find out more about his background, attitude, habits and goals. Then, if you still feel led to open your home to him, make sure everyone involved signs an agreement with really clear rules and guidelines about what is expected, what will not be tolerated and the rewards

and consequences of each.

Helping him with food and clothing alone would be a generous act, but what you're considering is absolutely amazing. Just make sure, if you go this route, to do it not just with love, but with lots of forethought and wisdom. —Dave





hunting season. By gun responsibility I mean things like never load your gun until you are in the field ready to hunt, never cross a fence with a gun in hand, and for goodness sake, never point a gun anywhere near someone else.

The devious, despicable,

dastardly, cowardly people, from Charles Manson to Jeffrey Weise, to James Holmes, to Adam Lanza, to Tamerian and Dzokhar Tsarnaev and now to Dylan Roof, and anyone else who murders another human being, all share one thing in common. They wanted to hurt and kill others.

ECO-FRIENDLY PEST CONTROL IN THE GARDEN

By Melinda Myers

Spots on tomatoes, holes in hosta leaves and wilting stems mean insects and diseases have moved into the garden. Don't let these intruders reduce the beauty and productivity of your landscape. Work in concert with nature to prevent and control these pests and you will be rewarded with a bountiful harvest and landscape filled with beautiful blooms.

• Monitor. Take regular

- Monitor. Take regular walks through the landscape. Not only is it good exercise, but it will improve your mood and you'll discover problems earlier when they are easier to control. Look for discolored leaves, spots, holes and wilting. Inspect the underside of the leaves and along the stems to uncover the cause of the problem.
- Identify. Once you discover a problem, identify the culprit. Your local extension service, garden center or reliable internet resource can help. Once identified, you can plan the best way to manage the culprit.
- Invite the Good Guys. Toads, lady bugs and birds help control many garden pests. Attract them to the garden by planting herbs and flowers to attract beneficial insects, adding a house for the toads, and birdbath for songbirds. Avoid using pesticides and learn to tolerate a bit of damage. A few aphids or caterpillars will bring in the ladybeetles, lacewings, birds and toads that are looking for a meal.

 Clean up. Many insects
- Clean up. Many insects and diseases can be managed and prevented with a bit of garden cleanup. A strong blast of water from the garden hose will dislodge aphids and mites, reducing their damage to a tolerable level. Or knock leaf-eating beetles and other larger

insects off the plants and into

a can of soapy water.

Pick off discolored leaves, prune off diseased stems and destroy. Be sure to disinfect tools with 70% alcohol or one part bleach to nine parts water solution between cuts. This will reduce the risk of spreading the disease when pruning infected plants.

• Adjust care. Reduce the spread and risk of further problems by adjusting your strategies. maintenance overhead Avoid and nighttime watering that can increase the risk of disease. Use an organic nitrogen fertilizer like Milorganite (milorganite.com) encourages slow steady growth that is less susceptible to insect and disease attacks.

Mulch the soil with shredded leaves, evergreen needles or woodchips. This will keep roots cool and moist during drought, improve the soil as they decompose, and also prevent soil borne diseases from splashing onto and infecting the plants.

• Non-chemical Controls. If the problems continue, try some non-chemical options for insects. A yellow bowl filled with soapy water can attract aphids, a shallow can filled with beer and sunk in the ground will manage slugs, and crumpled paper under a flower pot for earwigs are just a few ways to trap and kill these pests.

to trap and kill these pests.
Or cover the plants with floating row covers. These fabrics allow air, light and water through, but prevent insects like bean beetles and cabbage worms from reaching and damaging the plants.

• Organic products. Organic products like insecticidal soap, Neem, horticulture oil and Bacillus thuringiensis can be used to control specific pests. And even though these are organic, they are designed to kill insects or disease organisms, so be sure to read and follow label directions carefully.

• Take Note. Make notes on the problems and solutions in this season's garden. Refer to these next year to help you do a better job of monitoring and managing garden pests. And when shopping for new

plants, select the right plant for the location and choose resistant varieties whenever possible.

A little eco-friendly gardening can go a long way in creating a beautiful and productive garden.
