On Sunday, we will celebrate Mother's Day. The very word "mother" brings to mind safety, warmth, care, and love. There are bad mothers, to be sure, but the vast majority offer unconditional love. In fact, all nature values mothers. There is a reason our planet is called Mother Earth. Many of the same traits that are seen in human mothers can also be seen in animal mothers.

Puppies and kittens adjust easily and quickly to shelter life if they come in with their mother. As long as they have her, all is right with their world. It is always heartbreaking to see little kittens and puppies come to the shelter without their mother. When put into a cage with another nursing mother to see if they will be accepted by that mother, they immediately try to nurse, and then quickly cuddle with her. Most animals in nature crave their mother.

Occasionally throughout the years, a mother cat or dog has been brought to the shelter first, and then the babies have been found and brought to us a couple of days later. It is heartwarming to see the joy of that reunion. Sometimes, the babies are captured first, and then the mother. The reunion is just as joyous.

The situation that we hate to see the most is to have a nursing animal put in our drop-off cage; we always worry about where the babies are. If we have been told the general area where the mother has been caught, we have been able, in some cases, to put a leash on the mother dog, take her to that area, and let her lead us to her babies.

People know to exercise caution approaching a mother animal who has her babies with her. Even some very trusting dogs and cats become nervous when a human picks up their young.

In the wild, most fights with a female are caused by a protective mother. Wild animal poachers and collectors know that in order to capture a baby or a young animal, the mother first has to be killed.

There are many documented stories about the care animal mothers give. Cows are very maternal. One witness saw a newborn calf sliding down a slope. Six cows answered the mother's cry for help, and stood in line to keep the calf from sliding. They even stayed to lick the calf clean. Dairy cows become agitated when they hear the bleating of the calves that have been taken from them.

Mother chickens can recognize their chicks' peeps, and sheep and goat mothers make sure their offspring play with others in their own age group.

Even some species of insects are raised by their mothers!

- No food can be consumed on site



Do currently offered vaccines against pneumonia provide seniors any protection against the coronavirus disease? I've always been bad about getting vaccinated, but this coronavirus pandemic is causing me to change my thinking.

Pro-Vax Patty

Dear Patty,

This is a great question. Because the coronavirus (COVID-19) attacks the lungs and respiratory system, many readers have asked whether the pneumonia vaccines, which are administered to millions of patients each year, might protect someone if they contract the coronavirus.

But unfortunately, the answer is no.

Do Pneumonia Vaccines Protect Seniors from Coronavirus?

250,000 Americans and kills about 50,000 each year. It's recommended that all seniors, 65 or older, get two separate vaccines – PCV13 (Prevnar 13) and PPSV23 (Pneumovax 23). Both vaccines, which are administered one year apart, protect against different strains of the bacteria to provide maximum protection. Medicare Part B covers both shots if they are taken at least a year apart.

Shingles vaccine: Caused by the same virus that causes chicken pox, shingles is a painful, blistering skin rash that affects more than 1 million Americans every year. All people over age 50 should get the new Shingrix vaccine, which is given in two doses, two to six months apart. Even if you've already had shingles, you should still get this vaccination because reoccurring cases are possible. The CDC also recommends that anyone

Vaccines against pneumonia, such as pneumococcal vaccine and Haemophilus influenza type B vaccine, do not provide protection against the new coronavirus.

This virus is so new and different that it needs its own vaccine. Researchers are in the process of rapidly developing a vaccine against COVID-19, but it is expected to take at least a year before it's ready.


Having said that, you should also know that there are several other important vaccines the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all seniors should get up to date on after the coronavirus pandemic dies down. Here's a rundown of what they are, when you should get them, and how they're covered by Medicare.

Flu vaccine: While annual flu shots are recommended each fall to everyone, they are very important for older adults to get because seniors have a much greater risk of developing dangerous flu complications. According to the CDC, last year up to 647,000 people were hospitalized and 61,200 died because of the flu – most of whom were age 65 and older.

To improve your chances of escaping the seasonal flu, this September or October consider a vaccine specifically designed for people 65 and older. The Fluzone High Dose or FLUAD are the two options that provide extra protection beyond what a standard flu shot offers. And all flu shots are covered under Medicare Part B.

Pneumococcal vaccine: As previously stated, this vaccine protects against pneumonia, which hospitalizes around

All Medicare Part D prescription drug plans cover shingles vaccinations, but coverage amounts, and reimbursement rules vary depending on where the shot is given. Check your plan.

Tdap vaccine: A one-time dose of the Tdap vaccine, which covers tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (whooping cough) is recommended to all adults. If you've already had a Tdap shot, you should get a tetanus-diphtheria (Td) booster shot every 10 years. All Medicare Part D prescription drug plans cover these vaccinations.

Other Vaccinations

Depending on your health conditions, preferences, age and future travel schedule, the CDC offers a "What Vaccines Do You Need?" quiz at www2. CDC.gov/nip/adultimmsched to help you determine what additional vaccines may be appropriate for you. You should also talk to your doctor during your next visit about which vaccinations you should get.

Cake:

2 cups cake flour*

2 teaspoons baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 cup milk preferably whole or 2%

4 tablespoons unsalted butter cut into pieces

1 tablespoon vanilla extract

- 1/2 teaspoon almond extract optional, but highly
- recommended
- 4 large eggs

12/3 cups granulated sugar

Filling and Topping:

8 ounces cream cheese softened

3/4 cup powdered sugar

- 3/4 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 1/4 cups heavy whipping cream chilled
- 3 cups sliced or diced strawberries divided
- 2 tablespoons strawberry jam

additional fresh strawberries for garnish (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Cake:

Preheat oven to 350°F.

In a large bowl, whisk the flour, baking powder and salt together.

In a small saucepan, bring the milk and butter to a boil. Once boiling, immediately remove from the heat and add the vanilla extract and almond extract.

In a separate bowl, using a hand mixer or stand mixer, beat the eggs and sugar on medium-high speed until pale yellow, fluffy, and doubled in volume. This takes about 5 minutes - do not skip this step, this helps to make the cake fluffy. While still beating, slowly drizzle in the hot milk mixture. Beat in the flour mixture.

Line the bottoms of three 8-inch** round cake pans with a circle of parchment paper, and spray the pans with nonstick spray. Divide the batter between the prepared pans (I use a generous 2 cups of batter per pan**). Bake for 14-18 minutes, or until the edges are light golden, the center springs back when lightly pressed, and a cake tester comes out clean. I recommend rotating the baking pans at least once during cook time. Set the pans on a rack to cool. Run the tip of a sharp knife around the edges of the cakes to loosen them, and turn them out of the pans (the layers will be fairly thin, about 1-inch high).

Filling and topping:

Combine the strawberries and jam and set aside (these will be used for the filling and topping).


Note: I sliced the strawberries for the filling (about 21/2cups), and I diced the strawberries for the top of the cake (about 1/2 cup). Do both, or one or the other your choice. You'll need about 3 cups total.

For the whipped cream frosting: Combine the cream cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla extract in a large mixing bowl or the bowl of a stand mixer. Fit the mixer with the whisk attachment and mix on medium speed until smooth. While the mixture is still whipping, slowly pour in the heavy cream down the side of the bowl. Stop and scrape the bottom and sides of the bowl periodically. Increase the speed and continue whipping until the cream can hold a stiff peak.

Assembly: Place one layer of cake on a platter. Top with whipped cream frosting, then top with about 1 1/4 cups of sliced/diced strawberries. Place another layer of cake on top and repeat. For the third/top of layer of cake, top with whipped cream frosting, then place the remaining diced/sliced strawberries in the center. Decorate the outside with whole strawberries, if desired. I like to store this cake in the fridge to keep the frosting stable.


