

"I left again for another career that didn't pan out, so I came back into the



Lifeline Service Offering



The Public Service Commission of Alabama designated TEC the "Eligible Telecommunications Carrier" for its service area for universal service purposes. The goal of universal service is to provide all citizens access to essential telecommunications services. As part of its service offerings, TEC offers a program (Lifeline) to assist qualifying low income individuals with the charges for their telephone service. Lifeline is part of the federal Universal Service Fund program instituted by the Federal Communications Commission and overseen by the Universal Service Administrative Company.

Lifeline Assistance enables eligible subscribers to pay reduced charges for all residential service plans that provide voice telephony service, including bundled service packages combining voice and broadband, or packages containing optional calling features. TEC Residential flat rate voice service includes unlimited incoming and outgoing local calling per the subscriber tariff filed with the Public Service Commission of Alabama and found on the web at www.tec.com. Toll limitation is free for qualifying Lifeline customers. The current FCC mandated discount provided under the Company's Lifeline service is \$9.25 per month for each month that the customer qualifies. To receive these discounts, an individual must meet certain eligibility criteria such as participating in one of the following federal assistance programs: "Medicaid; Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as Food Stamps; Supplemental Security Income (SSI); Federal Public Housing Assistance; Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP); Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or National School Lunch Program's Free Lunch program (NFLP)." Alternatively, an individual would be eligible if the household gross monthly income does not exceed 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. [47 C.F.R. \$54.409(b)] Only eligible customers may enroll in Lifeline. Federal regulations allow only one Lifeline discount per household. An individual may not transfer his or her Lifeline discount to someone else, even if he or she is eligible. Other terms and conditions apply. For example, customers must apply for Lifeline and provide the required qualification

documentation and the Company is required to verify the continuing accuracy of the qualifying information annually provided by those individuals. In addition, as long as a qualified individual agrees to toll limitation, that individual is not required to pay a deposit prior to the service being offered. A complete set of terms and conditions for this program is available at TEC's local business office at 955 Second Street, Cherokee, AL.







hardware store in Bessemer, Alabama. Owner, William J. Long, became interested in the 'horseless carriages' in early 1911 when he purchased his first Model T. Although a train destroyed Long's Ford after it stalled on a railroad track, he was convinced that the 'automobile' was the transportation of the future. There were no automobile franchises in those days, so Mr. Long purchased as many Fords as he could from Ford to resell at the hardware store that same year.

began Henry Ford granting Ford franchises to dealers in 1915 with one of the first being granted to the Long-Lewis Hardware Company. The assemblyline Fords were shipped in boxcars and the train stopped in Birmingham to unfoad the new automobiles. The wheels were put on at the railhead, and they were then driven to the hardware store in Bessemer. A twostory addition was added to the hardware building in 1921 to house the Ford Division of Long-Lewis Hardware.

In 1965 the Ford Division moved from the hardware store to a separate location on the Bessemer Super Highway. Vaughn Burrell, the long-time general manager, became the sole owner in 1986 of Long-Lewis Ford in Bessemer and Long-Lewis Hardware in Birmingham. Burrell moved the dealership in 1999 from Bessemer to its new facility





My wife was in a car accident and the other driver was working for a business and was working at the time of the accident. The accident report indicates that the driver had insurance but we have since found out it has been canceled. I think that the business should be responsible for my wife's car and her hospital bill.

Charles, Moulton,

If the driver was at work for the business at the time of the

accident, the business will be probably be liable (responsible) for both the property damage and the personal injury to your wife.

This presumes that the other driver was at fault in the accident. Before the business is liable, the driver has to have been negligent in some way that caused the accident such as a rear end collision or failing to yield the right of way. If he was not at fault, then his employer is not responsible.

We are talking about an area of law called "agency" and we think about a relationship where the employee was performing duties incident to their job, but the law also will find an employer responsible if the employer supplied the vehicle or the employee was acting in furtherance of the employer's interest.

The law does not require that the employee was specifically authorized to engage in that particular activity but that those activities were generally within the employee's authority. In other words, if it is customary for the driver to eat lunch while doing their job while on the job and the driver was going to lunch, the employer should be responsible.

The idea behind the law imposing liability on the employer is that the employer is generally in the best position to insure that their work is performed in a safe manner. Therefore, the negligent acts of an employee while in the line and scope of their employment are both the responsibility of the negligent employee and the company they were working for at the time of the accident. If the other driver was at work when this accident happened, the company that he worked for should have to pay for the harm that he





Gerrymandering is Finally Addressed

ne could easily question the reasoning behind the reconfigured legislative maps for Alabama house and senate seats in 2012. Looking at Alabama state senate District One for example that now winds across portions of Lauderdale, Limestone, and Madison counties, it would seem that simply

reapportioning the population for the respective districts could be much cleaner.

The Supreme Court of the United States in a 5-4 vote last week directed the federal appeals court to take a closer look at the potential reasoning behind the make-up the district lines created in 2012 based on the 2010 census.

The Court did not rule in Alabama Legislative Black Caucus v. Alabama that the map was right or wrong. Instead it said state did not ask the correct questions when arranging districts.

Who is to say whether the districts were gerrymandered based on race alone in 2012? Who is to definitively say why they were often redrawn in a similar manner when democrats were in control of both houses? What CAN be said is that some of the new district lines are completely nonsensical.

-- The word 'gerrymander' (originally written Gerry-mander) was first used in March of 1812 in response to a bill redrawing the Massachusetts state senate election districts and signed by Governor Elbridge Gerry. The redistricting benefited Gerry's Democratic-

I.D. Laws Separate

Political opportunists are also trying to tie this action in with voter I.D. laws as just another method to suppress the black vote or limit black representation. The two are completely separate issues.

In another ruling last week the Supreme Court declined to hear the challenge to Wisconsin's voter ID laws brought by the ACLU. Voters there have an election next week, but voter ID regulations will be implemented for the

following election cycle.
Critics say the Wisconsin laws are among the strictest in the country, requiring that voters show a current or recently expired driver's license, a military ID, a tribal ID, or some other form of identification. Liberals argue that such requirements keep minorities from casting a ballot. All the clichés are referenced - bigoted, unfair, racist, Jim Crow, etc.

I'd like to know how only Hispanic and black voters inconvenienced by

some perceived preferential accessibility. Such claims simply lack substance.

pieces in an electric kiln and glazes them after they have cooled. The next day he puts them in an outdoor gas kiln for up to thirty minutes and then places them in a steel tub

filled with cedar and wet newspapers. A reduction or carbonization process begins once the red hot pots ignite the combustible materials. The result is that any unglazed areas on the pots will absorb and turn black from the smoke. During this extreme temperature change of cooling down, crazing or cracking occurs on many of the glazed areas on the pots. After cleaning the soot off the pieces they are ready to show





GOING AFTER GRUBS

andscaping is a rewarding hobby for homeowners. Men and women with green thumbs often take pride in their lush lawns and gardens.

But even the most wellmaintained lawns are not immune to problems that can compromise all the hard work men and women put into their lawns. One such problem is a grub infestation.

Grubs are a type of pest that can cause considerable damage to lawns, and while many homeowners have no doubt heard of grubs, they might want to learn more about these pesky pests so they know what to do should grubs ever appear in their yards.

• What are grubs?

Grubs are insects that live in the soil, where they feed on grass and roots. Many grubs are the larva of Japanese beetles, and those beetles typically lay their eggs in sun-drenched areas of lawns in midsummer.

• What are signs of grub damage?

Grubs not only damage lawns on their own, but they serve as food sources for local wildlife as well, attracting wildlife, which can do its own damage to

Lawns can turn brown for a variety of reasons, and grubs are just one of many potential culprits behind the browning of once-luscious landscapes. Grubs feed on roots, so homeowners who suspect their lawns have fallen victim to grub infestations can pull up the areas where grass has turned brown to see if there are any grubs, which look like worms.

Landscapes that have suddenly become popular among local wildlife that is digging up lawns may also be infested with grubs. Skunks and raccoons feed

a on grubs, and may dig up for lawns where grubs are present.

Damage resulting from grub infestation is most visible from late summer to early fall.

• Can grub damage be prevented?

Preventing infestation typically requires homeowners to keep watchful eyes on their lawns. Pay particular attention to areas that begin to brown, especially areas that are turning brown in spite of adequate watering. An early indicator of a grub infestation is small grubs around the roots of grass. In such instances, applying insecticide may be enough to prevent a small grub problem from spreading. Insecticides also can be

an effective preventative measure for homeowners grub with looking to avoid infestations. Speak landscaping local professional recommendations about which insecticide to apply and how best to apply it.

 What can I do about grub damage?

Attempting to treat rubs in the spring may be ineffective, as grubs are large and no longer feeding in spring. So homeowners infestations should address the situation before the situation before they retire their green thumbs for the winter. Remove debris from grub infestations with a rake before watering the affected areas. Watering can help some damaged roots recover, but areas that have been especially damaged may need to be reseeded.



solidified his career path as of good people who work under me every day. When you have good people, it makes your job easier," Willis said.

Willis has witnessed many drastic changes in the business since 1961.

"I guess one of the major changes is that the grocery business is more technical now," he said. "It was more hands-on in the early years. Back then business wasn't conducted via email or fax. You had more personal contact with people.

Willis said that the implementation of new technologies has made doing business in the retail world much easier.

"If you had a truckload of groceries to unload, we would unload it by hand. Now we have forklifts and pallet jacks and things to make the job easier and more efficient. That's just one example.

"When I started out in the grocery business there were no scanners at the check-out. Everything was punched in on a keyboard on a cash register. At the first job I had, we didn't even have a cash register. We had an adding machine and a cash drawer. All items were added up on a crank adding machine," he said.

According to Willis, stores priced each item on the shelf individually, as opposed to our current barcodescanning technology.

"The difference now from what it was when I started out is amazing," he added. According to Willis, the

heart of the matter remains the same despite the changes that the years bring.
"The grocery business is

still providing a service and selling a product. How we do it in the grocery business is up to the people who are in charge of it."

Willis feels it is important for everyone to take pride in their work as they enter and progress through their careers.

"No matter what you do, whether you're selling groceries or building a Caterpillar, you have to dedicate yourself to it and you've got to like it. Remember to put forth all the effort you can in whatever you are doing, and try to gain all the knowledge you can while you're doing

Willis' advice for anyone entering retail is very simple. You have to like people and understand people to be in the retail business. You have to like dealing with people."

As Willis' grocery career draws to a close, he looks forward to his future plans to rest and work in his garden, a place that he refers to as his passion.

"Everybody kids me about my garden, but I love it. Dad always had a big garden. We grew a lot of what we ate. I just love to see things grow," Willis said.

"Between the garden and the yard work and the honey-dos, I'll stay busy, I'm sure. I just won't have a telephone or email to answer to. I'll just have to answer to my wife."




