Muscle Shoals Music Foundation board member, Rodney Hall, spearheaded the foundation's purchase of 3614 Jackson Highway from a private owner so that







'The foundation was able to purchase the building through the generosity of private investors, like Gene Hamby who investors, understand the importance of preserving the legacy of Muscle Shoals Music.

The studio was founded in 1969 by Swampers Jimmy Johnson, Roger Hawkins, David Hood, and Barry Beckett. It became one of the most influential recording studios in the world, ` attracting artists such as the Rolling Stones, Paul Simon, Bob Seger, Linda Ronstadt, Cher, Bob Dylan, Joe Cocker, Rod Stewart, the Staples Singers, Art Garfunkel, Traffic, Cat Stevens, Lynyrd Skynyrd and many more. Since the 2013 release of the criticallyacclaimed documentary Muscle Shoals, more than 24,000 music enthusiasts from throughout the world have made pilgrimages to the iconic studio.

"We are grateful to Beats for supporting our community's efforts," said MSMF chair, Judy Hood. "Iimmy lovine, Dr. Dre, and Beats understand that the Muscle Shoals Sound Studio is magic. We are now protecting and preserving that distinct and authentic sound. The studio will be open to the public as well as to musicians for sessions. We expect both hit records as well as selfies of visitors from all of the world to come out of the Muscle Shoals Sound Studio." The foundation has also purchased land behind the studio for later development.

"Everyone who loves Muscle Shoals music owes an enormous debt to filmmakers Stephen Badger and Freddy Camalier for their documentary Muscle

ATTORNEY

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama.

I was sitting in traffic and left a gap between my car and the car in front of me. A car turned left in front of me and between the two cars and was immediately hit in the side by a car that was going to turn right from the turn lane beside me. The driver of the car that got hit claims that I was at fault for leaving a place for him to turn. He says I waved him through which I did not. Can he sue me for this?

He can sue you but not successfully. This is what we call a "courtesy wreck." They happen all the time. The law is that the driver of an automobile is not to proceed until they personally make sure that it is safe to proceed. A driver may not rely on the perceptions (or

misperceptions) of others.

A person who proceeds through a gap in traffic crossing a lane of traffic which has the right of way does so at their own peril. If there is a wreck they are responsible for failing to keep a proper lookout and for failing to yield the right of way.

The law is clear on this point and I think that any suit filed would be unsuccessful. Nonetheless, don't make a statement and don't talk to other people about this experience without talking to your insurance company or your lawyer first. If you were my client, I would insist that you not make a statement and not talk to anyone about the incident including mothers, brothers, friends and Facebook.

The person who was traveling in the lane beside you has the right to sue the person who turned in front of them. They had the right of way and they should win their case. Don't signal other drivers' intentions and don't wave other drivers through.

Buckle up and drive safely.

Plastic Gloves Are Not the Cure All

he laws differ from state to state, but restaurant patrons in the Shoals will see virtually all employees in the food preparation business wearing gloves. The law is intended to curb foodborne illnesses.

Intended is the operative term. Whether it is a traditional family dining establishment or a fast food prep line, many of the employees I've seen are far too casual in their preparation process.

Years ago it was about constant hand washing. Many of us were comfortable with that because workers seemed more conscientious and greater effort was made to prepare food with tongs and other utensils. The use of gloves has become health law, and that has become a detriment to precaution.

Watch where those gloves go sometimes... One sandwich business requires the handling of bread, meat, and vegetables along with an array of door handles and levers. Handling processed meat and vegetables means water and oil-based moisture getting handles wet over and over again. Food is handled with the same hands that grab the handles, sweep off the food prep surface, pick up and discard fallen cucumbers, wrap and bag up the food, etc.

A salad bar stocker at a nice chain restaurant came out wearing gloves and carrying several containers, each with a different variety of lettuce



The Liberals' Tenets

Editor:

I created a detailed version of the Tenets of Liberalism/Socialism in March/2002. Those tenets still hold true. Presented here is an abridged version to allow for publication.

or vegetables. She sat some down and started pouring the lettuce into an existing container sweeping, pulling it, and patting into place with her hand. She paused to move several serving tonks to the side, then resumed sweeping the lettuce out of the bowl and emptied other bowls in a similar manner.

A front counter employee at yet another fast food restaurant had a problem getting a transaction to process on her register. She called the shift manager to the front who happened to be preparing sandwiches in open view only a few feet behind the counter area. He came to the front, listened to the concern, and hit several register keys to solve the problem. Then he was right back preparing the food without changing his gloves.

Now that plastic gloves workers are required, wash their hands less, don't change gloves often enough, and don't seem to understand contamination.

Believe it or not, the York State Health Department does not require workers to change gloves after handling money because, according to its website, food outbreak investigations have identified the handling of money as a cause of illness. What idiot decided that?

Signs being required to remind food prep workers in the restrooms are troubling. That should be common sense... and a firing offense for noncompliance. However, some people are just not raised properly to wash hands, trim fingernails, and avoid contamination. In addition, many workers from other cultures simply do not observe the same hygiene ideals and food preparation precautions that most of us expect in the United States. That is another huge topic

unto itself.

I am still amazed at how many people born and raised in the U.S. use the restroom and don't wash their hands before walking back out into the restaurant. It has to be laziness, apathy, or ignorance.

In addition, the warm, moist environment created by trapped body heat inside every plastic glove is an ideal place for bacterium proliferation. Some gloves are also more susceptible to rips, pinch creases, pin holes, or other breaches. Bacteria can travel though the tiniest places. Long fingernails or rings which harbor more harmful bacteria than bare hands can also compromise disposable gloves.

Studies in the United Kingdom have concluded that gloved hands can contribute as much if not more bacteria to foods and food-preparation surfaces than bare hands. Gloves can be a cause of crosscontamination in food service if not changed often and if multi-step processes are not constantly adhered

California Governor Jerry Brown signed a bill that became law January 1, 2014 requiring all food prep workers to wear gloves in every instance. There was an instant backlash against the bare-hand ban. Within six months, the state assembly repealed the law and the California Senate voted 32-0 for repeal, reverting instead to the prior law that required food employees to minimize hand confact with ready-to-eat foods.

I think I would rather see hair nets then the current version of our glove laws. People are way too comfortable handling food with a gloved hand that has been in contact with too many surfaces. They are also less likely to take the most

Pastime enjoyed by people of all ages. While many people trek into the woods to see their favorite birds, homeowners can take steps to entice these fascinating and feathered friends right to their backvards.

Homeowners who want to attract birds to their properties can do so by providing the birds food, shelter and places to wash up or cool off. Installing a bird feeder and a bird bath in your yard is one way to attract a bevy of winged creatures that can provide hours of enjoyment.

Establishing a birdfriendly

may seem as simple as hanging a feeder on a pole or tree and erecting a bird bath nearby. But certain level maintenance is needed to birds healthy and happy. According

to the experts at the Bird Watcher's

Digest, recent indicates feeders can sometimes be a source of disease for the birds visiting them. The Audubon Society echoes that warning, saying that bird feeders and baths can serve as transmission stations for diseases such as aspergillosis, avian pox and salmonellosis.

Such warnings are not meant to deter budding hobbyists. birding Organizations like Audobon Society hope that such warnings send the message that disinfection maintenance necessary to maintain sanitary environments for birds. Doing so is relatively easy and well worth the time for birding enthusiasts.

• The Humane Society of the United States advises cleaning hanging feeders once every two weeks or more often if they're

feeding designs should be cleaned every two days. Feeders can be immersed in a very-diluted solution of bleach to water (nine parts water to one part bleach). Let soak for a few minutes, and then scrub with a stiff brush or scouring pad before rinsing. Allow the feeder to dry completely before refilling it with seed.Bird baths should

Frequently research collect discarded seed hulls and clean bird droppings from beneath feeders. If the area around the feeder become has especially soiled, relocate the feeder elsewhere and clean its initial location.

Follow instructions with regard to seed and other bird food. Reduce the amount of suet offered in hot weather. Heat can cause suet to spoil, and sticky suet can become stuck in birds' feathers and make it hard for them to keep clean.

• Do not situate feeders and bird baths under perches where they can be soiled by droppings.

• If you notice birds look sick or are not acting strangely, halt feeding and bathing to prevent healthy birds from becoming ill. Wait a week before resuming feeding and notify wildlife officials if you find dead or sick birds around your property.

• Locate feeders and baths at least 30 feet away healthy as possible.



Maine-ly For Dogs

Many national parks limit the presence of dogs, but Acadia is a beautiful exception

There were dogs everywhere: on trails, on top of Cadillac Mountain, kayaking on a lake and enjoying lunch with their people at Jordan Pond House. Where were we? Acadia National Park, on Maine's rugged coastline.

Last year, I wrote about taking pets to national parks. It can be done, but for the most part, pets are limited in where they can go. They are usually banned from all but paved trails, as well as lodges and visitor centers (although they can walk around outside them).

An exception is dog-friendly Acadia. The 74-square-mile park encompasses much of Mount Desert Island, and its features include ocean shoreline, lakes, forests and Cadillac Mountain, the highest point on the north Atlantic coast. Dogs must be on a leash for their safety and that of wildlife, but that said, they have access to 100 miles of hiking trails and 45 miles of crushed-rock carriage roads, which are shared by hikers, bicyclists and horse-drawn vehicles. Dogs are allowed on carriage roads and on most trails; exceptions include difficult trails such as Precipice and Beehive, which require climbing iron ladders or rungs or crossing narrow ridges along cliff edges. The east side of Jordan Pond trail isn't recommended for dogs, either; as we discovered, it requires quite a bit of scrambling over boulders.

While we saw a pair of Brittany spaniels kayaking with their people, neither dogs

nor people are allowed to swim in most of the lakes because they are public water supplies. Echo Lake and Sand Beach restrict pets during summer. Other restricted areas include the Wild Gardens of Acadia and public buildings.

Dog-friendly excursions include horse-drawn tours of the carriage roads, a windjammer cruise on the Margaret Todd, a trip on a lobster boat and a nature cruise of Frenchman Bay. Leashed dogs may also ride the Island Explorer Buses that go to, from and through the park.

Pets are permitted at Seawall and Blackwoods campgrounds. If that's a little too rustic for you, the town of Bar Harbor and surrounding areas have several petfriendly accommodations, including cottages through Ryan Estate Rentals, Balance Rock Inn (which has a steep pet fee) and chains such as Holiday Inn and Quality Inn.

Dawn Celapino of San Diego and her cairn terrier Jack visited Acadia on a recent 10-week road trip to promote fitness for people and dogs (Jack's Journey USA). When they weren't driving through the park or hiking in the rain, they parked their RV at Hadley's Point Campground, a few miles west of Acadia. Amenities included a laundry facility and Wi-Fi.

An alternative suggested by Marie C. Taylor in her book "Doggy Walks and Destinations: Acadia National Park and Vicinity" is to board your dog at a kennel with in/out privileges so you can take him



him to stay if you go somewhere he can't. Boarding him also increases your choice of lodgings.

Ironically, our dogs didn't accompany us on this trip. Flying one of them crosscountry, let alone three, just wasn't in the cards, but if we go back, we'll definitely hope to bring them along.

New scoop on poop: **DNA ID**

complex in Brooklyn, New York, are facing an inescapable poop patrol: they must now have their dogs' DNA tested and registered. Owners can no longer get away with not cleaning up their dogs' feces, urine and vomit. Using forensic science in the form of a product called Poo Prints, building management can identify scofflaws and levy \$250 fines per incident. Overall, the program has proven to be a significant deterrent, reports The New York Times. Since enforcement began in May, seven matches have been made.

· You probably haven't given your pet's microchip much thought since it was implanted. Out of sight, out of mind, right? But it's a good idea to check the status of your pet's chip annually during his veterinary exam. You may need to update your address or phone number, for instance. Without accurate information in the registration database, your pet may not be returned to you if he's ever lost. And if your pet isn't already 'chipped, that's something to schedule at his next visit. In combination with a collar and tag, it's the best way to ensure his safe return.

• The spotted Egyptian mau may well descend from the cats worshipped by ancient Egyptians. Who wouldn't worship a cat depicted on a 3,400-year-old tomb as retrieving a duck? The present-day mau loves to fetch toys and is a highly competent hunter of live prey if given the chance. Reserved toward strangers, he is fiercely loyal to his family and chortles to them in a guiet, melodious voice. The mau's medium-length coat has silky, fine fur in silver, bronze, smoke and black, plus blue versions of those colors. His light-colored eyes are described as gooseberry green.

Smith's first book, Carolina Dreams: The Musical Legacy of Upstate SC, was published in 1997. It featuring a history of the Marshall Tucker Band and all the other great music that came from the region. Smith began writing for various regional and national publications including Rolling Stone, Mojo, Relix, The Atlanta Journal Constitution, Y'all, and many others. When CMT needed a southern rock authority, they enlisted Smith.

Great Expectations

Last week some good friends of ours had the pleasure of having their heating and air conditioning system replaced, ducts and all. It was just what they wanted to spend a lot of money on right now! They were dancing in the yard while the installers worked! Okay, I may

be exaggerating.
I'm sure you've all been in a similar situation before.
