





PIEDMONT PETS

My guess is that most shelter directors would say the same thing I am about to say: When a pet is missing, the first thing that should be done is to file a lost report with any and all shelters in a wide radius. Shelters, and especially public shelters, would be the logical place to receive a stray. After shelters have been notified, then call veterinary clinics and post a picture on any available social media site.

A few weeks ago, we received a wonderful chocolate Lab as a stray. He did not have a collar or tag, nor was he microchipped. We were sure an owner would come to claim him since he was such a friendly, exuberant dog. Under Virginia law, he became our property after being here for five days, not including the day he came in, and we transferred him shortly after that to one of our adoption partners in Northern Virginia. We transferred all property rights over to that group and they became the legal owner.

Just a day after he left us, an owner came forward. She said that whenever he would get loose from his chain (he was not constantly chained), he would always come back. It did not occur to her to call us. I called the group who received him; however, they had already found him another home and did not want to return him to us. That was their right.

It was my sad duty to give the owner the news that there was no way to get her dog back. She understood, but regretted not calling us.

About 25 years ago, the law in Virginia changed to give shelters and other groups (referred to as "releasing agencies") clear property rights once an animal had

fulfilled a very specific stray time. That protected the shelters, releasing agencies, adopters, and transfer partners from having to become involved in making decisions about forcing adopters to return animals to the first owner. After all, who would want to adopt a stray animal from a shelter if there was even a remote possibility a previous owner would come forward and demand the animal's return?

In order to protect owners, we encourage them to make sure all dogs and cats are microchipped (with registration kept current), with dogs always wearing a collar with current city or county tags.

In addition, if you find a stray, by law you must inform the public animal shelter in the locality the animal was found. An owner may be looking for that animal and you cannot deny that owner the rights to their pet ownership.

Social media is a wonderful tool; however, it does not and cannot take the place of the safety net provided by public animal shelters!



"Science has always been one of my favorite subjects in school, along with math," said Hernandez. "I love being able to find an explanation for why the world functions the way it does, and even if we don't have the answers now, we can work towards them."

One of the most meaningful experiences I had in high school was volunteering with Mrs. Spencer the summer after my junior year. I knew that she taught the same chemistry class over the summer at DCC since she had mentioned it in class. She agreed to allow me to set up the labs and answer any questions the students had in class."

Spencer feels similarly about Hernandez's enthusiasm for chemistry and was thrilled when she learned that she would have a lab assistant for the summer.

"Frida is one of those students who makes teaching so rewarding," said Spencer. "It's exciting to be able to instill my love of chemistry in one of my students. When she asked if she could help with my chemistry labs last summer, I was super excited for her to experience another aspect of chemistry. I was also surprised that a high school student would want to drive over an hour each day during summer vacation to prep chemistry labs. She was a tremendous help, not only to me, but also with my students. She willingly jumped right in and helped answer their questions. I am so excited for the experiences Frida has ahead of her!"

Her experience at DCC inspired Hernandez to continue her pursuit of academic excellence and, ultimately a career, in Chemistry.

"Volunteering at DCC has had a huge impact on my career path," said Hernandez. "While I had been considering majoring in Forensic Chemistry, after working in a lab for most of the summer, I decided that I always wanted to be surrounded by chemistry. I loved being in a lab and immersing myself in a subject that I loved. After taking Dual Enrollment Chemistry through DCC, I have come to realize my passion for the subject, and I will forever be grateful for the opportunity to work there over the summer."

Hernandez plans on majoring in chemistry at Amherst College in the fall and ultimately hopes to pursue a graduate degree in chemical engineering.





INSTRUCTIONS

Fill a large stockpot with water and bring to a boil over HIGH heat. Salt the water with about a tablespoon of salt. Add pasta and cook until just al dente (according to package instructions).

Drain pasta and toss with a light drizzle of olive oil. Set aside to cool slightly.

While pasta is cooling, chop tomatoes, cucumber, and red onion. Set aside in a large mixing bowl and add capers to the bowl.

Add dressing ingredients, except for olive oil, to a bowl and whisk to combine. While whisking, slowly pour in the olive oil, and continue whisking until completely combined. Taste and adjust salt and pepper accordingly.


Add the cooked pasta and crumbled feta cheese to the large bowl with the vegetables. Pour dressing over the top and toss to combine.

Cover bowl with plastic wrap and refrigerate for several hours, up to 2 days.

Serve cold or at room temperature, and enjoy!
