## **REAL OPEN MEETINGS? Onus on Legislators**

MONTGOMERY-The 2015 regular session of the Alabama Legislature is underway. The challenges they face regarding budgets, healthcare, essential services, social services, and prison overcrowding are daunting.

One proposal should come before the body that will

restore the intent of the Alabama Open Meetings Act which was passed in 2005 and compromised by recent Alabama Supreme Court rulings.



I recently served as a juror in an automobile accident case. During the trial, the jurors were never told if the driver who caused the accident had insurance. When we started deliberations, we asked the judge if the driver who caused the accident had insurance and we were told that he could not tell us. I wanted to find for the lady who had been injured

in the accident but was concerned about making the other driver pay for her damages out of his own pocket if he didn't have insurance. Why couldn't the jurors have been told whether or not the driver had insurance?

Denise, Athens, AL

Without hesitation, I can assure you that the driver who caused the accident had liability insurance. How can I be so sure? The reasons are

First, attorneys such as Tom and I who practice personal injury law represent our clients on a contingency fee basis. This means that if we do not recover money for our clients, we do not get paid. Practicing law is an honorable profession but it is also a business. Employees must be paid, the light bill comes, copier paper must be purchased, the phone bill has to be paid and so on and so on. Although Tom and I do handle some cases for free, we have a business to run. If any attorney

is trying an injury case to a jury, you better believe the other side has insurance coverage.

Secondly, if the other party is represented by an attorney, you can bet that they have insurance. With the average hourly cost of defense attorneys in the range of \$200.00 per hour and the fact that it takes approximately a year to two years to get a case set for trial, it is not hard to imagine the fees generated by the defense attorney. For example, let's say that it takes 2 years to get an automobile accident to trial. That is 104 weeks (52 weeks + 52 weeks = 104 weeks). Say the defense attorney works 5 hours a week on that file; that is 520 billable hours (104 weeks x 5 hours = 520 hours). Multiply 520 billable hours times the rate per hour, \$200.00, and the total charge is \$104,000.00.

As a juror, you are led to believe that you receive complete disclosure of all the facts necessary to properly and fairly reach a decision. A juror, however, is provided only that evidence that the law allows the trial attorneys to present. The law in Alabama does not allow the attorneys or judge to tell the jury whether the at-fault party has liability insurance. The fear is that if the jury learns that there is insurance coverage for the accident, they may be more willing to compensate an injured party because it is the insurance company who is spending the money and not the person who caused the accident.

The next time you sit down in a jury box in a civil injury case, just remember it's the insurance company sitting at the defense table and it's the insurance company's money on the line!





amount of a toxic substance can be big trouble," says Dr. John Hammons, president of the ALVMA.

Below is a list of some of the top poisons pets are most susceptible to. Some are obvious, but others may surprise you. Please be sure you are familiar with all of them. They are as follows:

 Foods (chocolate, xylitol and grapes/raisins)

- Insecticides (sprays, bait, and spot-on flea/tick treatments)
- Mouse and rat poison (rodenticides)
- Human and pet medications
- Household cleaners (sprays, detergents, polishes)
- Fertilizers (bone meal, blood meal and iron based products)

Other poisons that are dangerous extremely include antifreeze and acetaminophen. Veterinarians have also seen numerous cases of xylitol poisoning (xylitol is found in many sugarless gums, candies and mints), human medications such non-steroidal antiinflammatory medications, antidepressants and flowers. Symptoms can range from digestive upset and neurological signs, to liver and/or kidney failure.

If you think your pet has come in to confact with a poison, call your veterinarian immediately. Sometimes induction of vomiting is indicated, while in other cases IV fluid therapy and oral charcoal therapy may be indicated. Poisons are fast-acting and can be fatal. Do not hesitate to contact your veterinarian if you see any indications of poisoning such as vomiting, diarrhea, drooling/hypersalivating, inappetance, nausea, coughing or vomiting blood, weakness, lethargy or collapse.

The ALVMA encourages pet owners to take preventive measures to avoid poisoning accidents. This is the perfect time of vear to do some spring cleaning and remove any items that could be hazardous to your pets from within their reach. Listed below are some useful preventive tips for pet owners:

bottles within reach of pets (dogs can quickly

- chew through a pill bottle) Create a pet poison first aid kit
- Know the signs of poisoning in your pet
- As spring approaches, be aware of all of the harmful plants and gardening items that could cause your pet harm
- Last, but not least always keep the number for your veterinarian in a handy location

House Bill 195 by Rep. Randy Davis (R) from Daphne would ensure the meetings of our state, county, and local governing bodies are open in sunshine, not in secret.

Every Alabama citizen should be concerned that the current status of the law essentially allows for serial or secret meetings. That's where groups of less than a quorum can meet to discuss issues and decide how to vote without ever having a discussion in public. Then when a quorum is gathered, since the discussions have all taken place, the public only witnesses a vote.

The Open Meetings Act was passed overwhelmingly by both houses in 2005 and states, "It is the policy of this state that the deliberative process of governmental bodies shall be open to the public during meetings as defined in Section 36-25A-2(6)." That is the solid bedrock for the remainder of the law.

There are times when closed meetings are necessary expressed nine exceptions. Some of the more familiar exceptions include attorney-client privilege, security issues, discussion of general reputation of an employee or candidate for employment, and the preliminary negotiations of trade and commerce.

During the normal course of business, discussions of government business should be conducted in public. Our legislators should all agree that tax-payer deserves nothing less.



understanding and clarity negotiations Signatures nuclear progress." followed.

But does this letter constitute treason as the newspaper claimed and leading Democrats inferred?

As with every issue first consideration should be, "What does the Constitution say?" The word treason appears in Article III, Section 3, and follows: "Treason against the United States, shall consist only in levying War against them, or in adhering to their enemies giving them Aid and Comfort." Did this letter, reminding a dictatorial government, where the voice of one dominates, of our constitutional procedures requiring the voice of many, consist of levying war against the United States? No! Did it adhere to the interests of our enemies, which Iran is or we would not have sanctions imposed against it? No again. The Constitution continues, "No Persons shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two Witnesses to the same overt Act, or on Confession in open Court." Clearly the Senate Republican letter cannot be attached to any of the properties of treason in the

Constitution. The New York Daily News and Democrats making the charge has convicted nearly half of the U.S. Senate as traitors without constitutional basis.

However, to the charge that they are interfering with negotiations by reminding the Iranians of our constitutional procedures, the Constitution clearly prescribes such in Article II, Section 2, Clause 2. The President "shall have Power, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate to make Treaties, provided two thirds of the Senators present concur." The advice function is performed during the creation of a treaty and the consent function is thereafter, once an agreement is presented to them. Many presidents have not sought the advice of the Senate when they created treaties. Obama has shown no tendency to do so either, preferring to prepare a treaty without any advice from Congress.

Obviously a letter to a foreign government reminding it that no branch of government operates independently of another in the United States, does not constitute giving advice to the President. But in a distorted way, it does. It reminds the President of constitutional procedure as well and places him on notice that he can expect resistance should he circumvent the constitutional treaty-making

process. So why did the Senate not wait for the finished treaty? Because they were afraid. This Congress has experienced the most encroaching president on legislating and treaty-making powers since Franklin D. Roosevelt and they were not certain that he would even present the finished treaty to them for ratification. Remember, this is the same president who by executive order by-passed Congress on executive amnesty thereby making his own law and independently changed parts of the National Health Care Bill at least 14 times with a stroke of the pen with no constitutional authority.

My question to the seven Republicans who did not sign and to all the Democrats in the U.S. Senate is this. Why did you not sign as well? Why is there not bipartisan support of the Constitution? Can't you see your authority being eroded? If a Republican did the same thing increasingly, executive order or , undermining the constitutional separation of powers leaving your body weaker than before, you would be all over him. Íronically, Republicans would be supporting their president. Neither party sees its own as dangerous.

#### ROTOTILLER

Augers can be heavy and cumbersome, and many do-it-yourselfers will find that one-person augers are more than adequate for their projects.

Augers dig deep holes, so it is always smart to have the property surveyed prior to use. This way pipes, gas lines, buried electrical lines, and any other obstructions are clearly identified prior to drilling.

#### **CULTIVATOR**

Cultivators are similar to tillers in that they loosen soil. Cultivators are effective during the growth period of plants, when they can be used to aerate the soil and remove weeds. Cultivators come in hand-held versions and push models, and some are even motorized. Cultivators get close to plants to remove weeds without disturbing the plant. They also are used to stir in compost or fertilizer.

While many people think cultivators and tillers are the same, that is not the case. The former is less powerful and will mix the soil or stir up the top layer, while the latter can break up moderately hard ground and loosen firm soil.

When using any tools around the garden, wear the proper protection. This includes devices to protect hearing when power tools are in use as well as gloves and safety goggles. Tillers, augers and cultivators have the potential to toss soil and rocks into the air, so make sure others keep their distance while work is in progress.

# ITTAKES AN ARMY

## Veterinarians train to save America's community cats

hey live on our streets, in fields and barns, behind shopping centers and in our neighborhoods. They eat on back porches and in city parks, fed by dedicated cat lovers. They're the felines now called "community cats," and while many of them are feral, some are strays or abandoned former pets who have adapted to life outdoors.

Some estimates suggest there are as many unowned as owned felines in the U.S., most of them unvaccinated and never spayed or neutered. Left free to reproduce, they'll create the next generation of community cats, and the next,

Operation Catnip aims to change that, says founder Dr. Julie Levy, director of the shelter medicine program at the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine. The trap-neuter-return (TNR) organization has been running free high-quality, high-volume spay/neuter clinics for community cats in Gainesville, Florida, since 1998. In 2014 alone, they helped 2,693 cats and prevented the births of an estimated 6,142 kittens just in the first year following surgery.

Now, thanks to a grant from PetSmart Charities, they're throwing open their operational model and training program to veterinarians, veterinary students and veterinary technicians from all over the country.

"Our vision is to train an army of veterinarians to spay and neuter America's community cats," said Levy. "This approach, along with vaccination, will allow us to reduce cat population, control infectious diseases and improve the lives of the cats."

Operation Catnip clinics are run MASH-style, with each cat tended by volunteer veterinarians, technicians and veterinary students. Each cat receives a medical examination and, if healthy, is spayed or neutered, treated for fleas and other parasites, and returned to the same place she or he was trapped.

It's easy to tell if a cat has been treated at the clinic, because of the distinctive "ear tip" each one receives during their

surgery. This means those cats can easily be identified as having already been sterilized, so they won't be trapped again, putting them through unnecessary stress and taking the place

of cats who still need care. One graduate of the program, Dr. Amy Karls, was so inspired by her training with the Operation Catnip program that she now volunteers her services with four different community cat organizations near her North Grafton, Massachusetts, home — all that on top of her full-time career as a veterinarian.

"I wasn't taught the high-volume, high-quality surgical techniques now commonly used in TNR programs while I was in veterinary school," she said. "We learned new surgical skills, colony management and trapping techniques, and feline medical and behavioral pearls."

America is a nation of cat lovers. One 2007 study found that 81 percent of us would prefer to see cats left where they are rather than killed, if those were the only two choices. Programs like Operation Catnip, which saves community cats, offer something better than either: reduced population over time, vaccination to help prevent infectious disease, and a chance for healthy feral cats to return to their homes in our communities without adding to the feline population.

It also offers a chance for veterinarians to become better surgeons, and for all veterinary professionals to learn innovative strategies for managing community cats in their hometowns.

"I was able to bring everything I learned back to our local rescue and TNR groups," said Karls. "It was truly wonderful to see so many people united for the common goal of improving the lives of the homeless cat population."



### Principle-Based **Negotiations**

There was once a story about two chefs who were fighting over the last orange in the kitchen. They both needed an orange for their recipe. After bickering over it they decided to split the orange 50/50, and each take half.

One chef squeezed the juice from his half of the orange into his special sauce and threw the peel in the garbage. The other chef carefully grated the peel of his half into his cake mix and discarded the rest. Neither chef had quite enough of what they needed but would have to make it work.

Negotiating on position or "digging in" to one side can be detrimental to the outcome of what you're trying to achieve. Instead of negotiating on the "what," ask questions and find out the "why." Focus on principle, not position.

This is the main point of the book I'm currently reading: Getting to Yes: Negotiating Agreement Without Giving In, by Roger Fisher, William Ury, and Bruce Patton from the Harvard Negotiation

Think of the two chefs mentioned above. What if they had discussed what it was that they needed from the orange? One needed only the juice, and the other chef needed only the peel. They both could have benefitted from the entire orange instead of only half.

Negotiation is a major part of a real estate transaction. First, you negotiate price. Then, who pays closing costs, possession dates, etc? Next, there will likely be negotiations on repairs once the home has been inspected. It will always help to ask questions when negotiating these terms. This will allow you to find out what is really important to each party.

Too many times a negotiation will fail to come to an agreement because someone thinks they have to "win."

If a buyer is not willing to meet your price, ask why. It could be that they are concerned about the age of your central unit. In this case, you might offer to pay for a two-year home warranty, which will give them piece of mind for the first couple of years.

Asking the right questions may allow you to benefit from the whole orange instead of only half. On the flip side, not asking "why" may leave you holding on to that house until the next offer comes along, which will most likely be less than the offer you have right now. -mr


