


Qunday Morning Positive Perks from your Sassy Small Town Missus







federal government to do Covid-19 testing. It is part of \$16,790,380 in federal funding to help health centers in Upstate New York respond to and contain the spread of the COVID-19 outbreak, U.S. Minority Leader Charles E. Schumer and U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand announced.
