With that in mind, the Shoals Community Clinic, in partnership with the UNA College of Nursing and Allied Health, Tri-State Center for Breast Health at ECM East will host the annual Catherine Barnes Women's Health Fair on April 6 and 8 from 9am-2pm at the clinic at 309-B Handy Homes in Florence.

The fair will offer free cervical and breast exams and free mammograms, with some restrictions, for women age 40-64 who do not have health insurance or a primary health care provider. This is a part of the clinic's Well Woman Project, and is supported by the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program. This program has saved hundreds of women's lives in Alabama.

The Fair is named after one the clinic's founding officers and first directors, **Catherine** Semmes Barnes, an inspiration to women fighting this disease.



# One of Bruins Best

The Bradshaw Bruins was a fitting tribute to one 1976 under the late Hall of Fame coach Eddie Frost. But, two years prior to and that, the Bruins baseball team won the 4A State Baseball Championship. One of the key leaders from that 1974 squad was Darryl Cantrell. Cantrell was a natural from the very beginning of his career.

As a matter of fact, Cantrell hit a couple of doubles and a homerun in his very first game in 1972. That team went on to finish third in the state in Class 4A. Cantrell played in the annual Lions' Club East-West All-Star game. When the Bruins won the state title in 1974, Cantrell led the team in batting with a .356 average while hitting nine homeruns.

He also led the team in RBIs and stolen Through last five games of the championship march, Cantrell showed his pitching prowess by starting or relieving in every game. In the last game of the playoff finals, he pitched a one-hitter to defeat Prattville.

Cantrell became the first-ever player to receive a full baseball scholarship to the University of While North Alabama. at UNA, he set the record for career strikeouts and led the NCAA Division II in average strikeouts per game with 12. He was named to the All-Eastern Conference team in 1978.



# Ask Dr. Webb

Our cousin is a nurse and says mom has started into her 'downward spiral' and she won't be with us much longer. What is this 'downward spiral' and how can she

The 'downward spiral' refers to the time period leading up to someone's expected death.

Experienced nurses and physicians can see this and when asked, will say, "I'd be surprised if she were still alive in 6-12

The following are seen in the 'spiral'; the more of them you have, the more likely a person is in the 'spiral'.

- 1.) Increasing dependence on others. One of the best predictors of approaching EOL [end-of-life] is needing increasing help with ADL's [Activities of Daily Living]: dressing, bathing, toileting, food preparation, walking.
- 2.) A new incurable and terminal disease [such as metastatic cancer] develops.
- 3.) They eat less; and steadily lose weight; and sleep more
- 4.) Saying frequently they "won't be here this time next year"; that they are "tired and ready to go"; wanting to see deceased relatives!
- 5.) Suddenly making funeral arrangements; buy a gravesite, complete a will, make a list of who gets what after they die.
- 6.) An increase in doctor visits and hospitalizations.
- 7.) Losing interest in activities/readings/TV/family.

It's important to make sure they don't have an easily treatable problem or that they aren't primarily depressed (where taking an anti-depressant might reverse their decline). If not, and they have many of the above behaviors, then help them focus on living 'comfortably'.

And, as the wise 'Maxine' says: "try to stay away from





### MAKE IT UP IN MARCH,

(OR WHAT HAPPENS I F YOU FORGET TO SHOW UP IN COURT)

During the month of March, the Lauderdale County District Attorney's office is running a program called "Make It Up In March." This program is for people who either didn't remember to show up in court or haven't paid their fines as they were ordered. During March the District Attorney's Office has an offer to work with these people and probably waive a failure to appear charge and set up a payment program to get these outstanding

fines and court costs paid. You can call the Lauderdale County District Attorney's Office at 256-764-6351 and speak with either Carolyn or Krystal. I have known both of these ladies for many years and I have always been impressed at how hard they work to help people solve their problems and stay out of the court system. They are outstanding.

Some years ago, I helped set up the municipal court in Lexington and served as the judge for four years. I really did not enjoy being a judge. I don't like finding people guilty or putting people in jail, although on occasion it was quite satisfying.

The problem that people have if they forget to show up for court is that the judge really has no choice other than to issue a warrant for their arrest on a charge of "failure to appear." The problem is now two-fold. First, this is a new charge with new court costs and a new fine so it costs more money and it's not cheap. Secondly, and more interestingly, it is a "non-bondable" offense. That means if you are pulled over in Florence and they run a check and there is a failure to appear charge in Decatur, they have to take you to jail where you will wait until Decatur sends someone to pick you. Then you will be put in jail in Decatur where you will not be allowed to make bond because you have already proven that you will not show up for court. They will not let you out until you have seen a judge and made some arrangement to pay the outstanding fine, plus, answer for the new charge of failure to appear.

The solution that I have always offered my clients in that situation is for me to take them to the next available court date where they missed court and often the court will dismiss the failure to appear and accept a suitable arrangement for payment of the fines. If they are pulled over before then or have some contact with a police officer who runs their license, they will be held until the failure to appear charge is resolved.

Anyway, the Lauderdale County District Attorney's Office during the month of March is sincerely trying to help people who may have missed payments or court dates. Buckle up and drive safely.







Gary had the heart surgery at UAB Hospital in 1973 after the state took him and his six siblings from their alcoholic, abusive father, and put them in foster homes. Doctors discovered that a hole in Gary's heart that was supposed to have healed had not. He was ten vears old at the time.

"She was so sweet to me at a time in my life when I really needed someone to show me that there were good people out there that cared and wanted to help," Gary told AL.com.

Kathy said she was in her early twenties at the time. She was six months from graduating, working part time as a nurse's aide to put herself through school.

She made a huge impact on Gary in his recovery, but she says she absolutely had no idea at the time.

"I wish I would have known," she said. "I wish that I would have known more. I wish I could have done more."

"She went way beyond the duty of a nurse with her smile," Gary said. "I looked forward to it every day. Like I said before, I cried when they took me off her floor. I tried to go back down to her floor to see her, but they wouldn't let me."

The fact that anybody would go to the depth's that he did to try to locate



me, to thank me, it was just incredible," Kathy said. "I just can't imagine.

Kathy is still a nurse and works in the cardiac unit at East Alabama Medical Center in Opelika. feels Gary was giving her too much credit. Nursing, she said, is "a lot of compassion."

"It's a lot of medicine, but it's a lot of compassion," she said. "If you don't have that part of it, then I think something has to be missing."

Kathy found out Gary was looking to tell her thank you when a story about Gary's search for his nurse went up on AL.com on Thursday. He had only a possible first name, date, location, and the photo, but that was enough. Kathy's college roommate, Gwen Harlan, saw the photo and alerted Kathy. Kathy's daughters helped organize the March 15 reunion.

Had it not been for them, Kathy might have never known, especially since she gave up Facebook for Lent.

She was stunned to find out that the story of Gary's search had become very popular on Facebook and on AL.com. "I had no clue," she said.

"We're both very excited that it has touched so many people," said Gary, who now runs a turtle farm in Killen, and bills himself as the Alabama Turtle Farmer.

"That really is the amazing thing," Kathy said. "I read some of the comments -

that this story has brought tears to people's eyes - and I that blew me away. I totally







# **Medication Safety Tips** for Children and Adults

rescription over-the-counter medications can save lives and help people of all ages manage certain conditions. When used correctly and under the guidance of a physician, medications are largely safe. It's when medicines are used off-label, shared or taken in error that reactions and injury can occur.

The American Academy of Pediatrics and their Healthy Children Organization warns that more than children hospital emergency rooms every year for problems to medication errors. Children are not the only ones in danger. Adults can make mistakes with their medications as well. For example, seniors who may be managing several different types of medications inadvertently cause dangerous drug interactions by mixing the wrong pills.

Pharmacists work diligently to help prevent medication errors. However, the general public can also do their part. The American Society of Health-System Pharmacists and National Association of Boards of Pharmacy offer these medication safety tips.




· When a new medication is prescribed, ask the doctor to explain more about it, including its intended purpose and any common side effects to be expected.

· Make sure your doctor knows about all the medications you are taking, including non-prescription products, herbal remedies, dietary supplements, and vitamins. Some medications do not mix with seemingly innocent ingredients. Keep a running list of any medicines you take so you can easily and accurately share this information with your physician.

· Question anything that you do not understand. Check the prescription for dosing information. For refills, make sure the refill information conforms to the original prescription strength.

· Fill all prescriptions at the same pharmacy and develop a rapport with the pharmacist so that potential drug interactions will be flagged. Pharmacists are well versed in medications and may be able to inform you as to the safety or risk involved in taking an over-the-counter product at the same time that you are on a prescription.



· Use the right dosing tools. A spoon from the kitchen is not accurate for measuring out a teaspoon of medication.

If you take multiple medications, use a pillbox to keep pills organized. The box makes it easier to manage medications and serves as a reminder if you have or have not taken a medication on a given day.

Store medications as instructed on the label. The bathroom medicine cabinet may not be an ideal place to store medications, as bathrooms get damp, and that can compromise

· Many pills look the same. the integrity of the pills. If you are confused Also, bathroom cabinets are readily accessible by all, including kids. It's better to store drugs out of sight and reach of children. Keep dangerous medications locked away.

> · Routinely discard expired or unneeded medications. Medicine take-back programs for disposal are a good way to remove medicines from the home and reduce the chance that others may accidentally take the medicine.

Consult with a doctor before beginning or ending medication.

Medicines play important roles in personal health. When used correctly, medications are assets, but caution should always be taken to ensure safe usage and storage of any medications.




