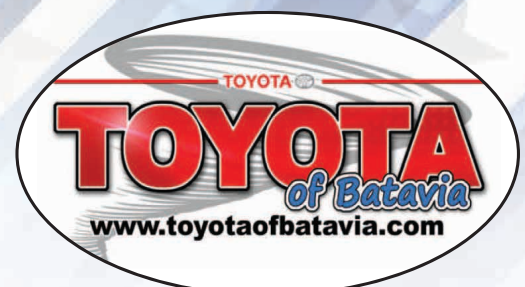

BLACKMAIL INVESTIGATIONS

Blackmail is a criminal offense. However, there is often a lot of gray area involved in prosecuting the crime, which may make it difficult for police to set up an investigation of the incident. In some states, it is up to the victim to prove to law enforcement that they are being blackmailed before the police can do anything, while in other cases, merely reporting a crime will result in some form of police investigation. In other states, proof is not required if the threat being made is considered an independent crime. Civil lawsuits against a blackmailer are not permitted in some states, leaving only the criminal case to provide justice for the victim.

Most states treat blackmail as a type of extortion, which involves threats of violence or other harm in order to compel a person to do something. SIGNS OF A STROKE

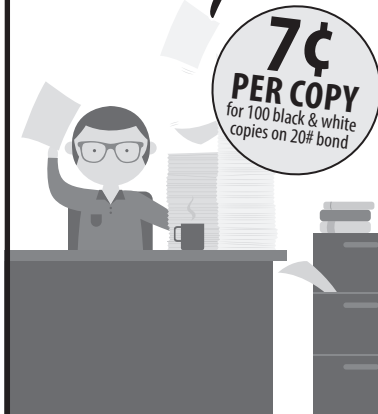

- Proposition 2 – Bus Purchase Reserve (\$525,000)
- Proposition 3 – Hoag Library (\$713,000)
- Board of Education Trustees - Choose and/or write-in up to three (3) candidates

Place the completed ballot in the Official Absentee Ballot envelope, sign and date the back of the envelope, complete the front of the envelope and seal it. Place it in the larger return envelope addressed to the District Clerk and return it to the Albion Central School District.

We must receive Official Absentee Ballots by **June 9, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.** We cannot accept any Official Absentee Ballots after that time.

A budget hearing will be held remotely at **7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 28, 2020**. The presentation may be viewed live or replayed at the link available on the District's budget vote webpage. Go to www.albionk12.org/district/budget-vote for details on the budget.
