Solutions, Navistar, North American Lighting, Shoals Hospital, and Tasus. Current job titles of these students include industrial engineering technicians, equipment engineering technicians, assembly technicians, patient care technicians, and welders. Students typically work four to five days per week during the semester, earn a paycheck, and receive a high school credit for their efforts. Lyons HR provides liability insurance for these students.

In April a second group of students will begin interviewing for the internship placements for the 2015-16 school year. Expanded internship opportunities in other career fields such as computer information systems and automotive technology will be added at that time. The vision is for the program to spread throughout our region and the state.

Business and industry may say that our young people are not wellprepared for careers, but this task is too big for our schools to do alone," claims

Dr. Gary Dan Williams, principal at Muscle Shoals Career Academy. "Our students are earning college credits through our dualent partnership Northwest-Shoals enrollment Community College. They are earning employability certifications and developing technical skills. Yet, we cannot fully simulate real-world work settings. This is what we have always needed: business and industry taking an active role in helping to educate our students though workbased learning. Companies previously have been hesitant to employ high school students because of liability concerns and a lack of confidence in young people. Because of Pathfinder Alabama, potential employers can be more confident about liability issues. Due to rigorous skills training in the high school setting, their concerns about young people's workplace abilities are alleviated.'



income school," Carpenter wrote in her project description. "We have very little technology or resources that students can interact with such as iPads, chromebooks or whiteboards. We all do our best to engage students in our lessons, and an whiteboard interactive would be a dream come true for my classroom. Most of our students come from homes that do not have computers or any type of technology, so this would truly be a great experience for my second graders."

Carpenter went on to

doesn't want anything 'artificial' to prolong keeping him alive. What is really considered Artificial Life Support? There's no doubt Alzheimer's can be a miserable disease for both

patient and family; and some patients have written in their Advance Directive (Living Will) that they do not want anything 'artificial' which might prolong their suffering. However, what's artificial depends on who

These five are usually accepted as artificial: CPR (Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation); feeding tubes; ventilator support; IV fluids; kidney

If we define artificial as anything other than 'food' or 'natural', would the following 'minor' items also be artificial: insulin; antibiotics; surgery of any kind; blood pressure pills; etc?

Obviously, there's room for debate. So to help make decisions, an important question is "what's his goal"? Realizing he has an incurable, terminal disease, he seems to be asking only to be kept comfortable, to live without suffering or being a burden (from his perspective)? Could he be worried his family would keep him kept alive in spite of suffering?

He does need to know that occasionally some of these minor artificial treatments can actually help him stay comfortable. With a goal of "comfort only", he needs to look at each available treatment for a particular symptom and consider trying it.

Unfortunately, due to modern medicine's focus on fixing individual organs or health problems, rather than looking at what's best for the whole person, we may unintentionally cause suffering. For example, treating pneumonia with only comfort-focused narcotics and breathing treatments, and avoiding antibiotics, may allow pneumonia (or any infection) to be his "best friend": because dementia usually worsens with every major illness, dying from pneumonia may be his escape from what will eventually progress to a state of bed-bound agitation.

By not interfering in a natural process and focusing only on comfort, we leave it to a greater power to determine what's best. Our obligation is to relieve and prevent suffering. You need to support him in his right

Thank you for considering us to represent your son but Joel and I do not practice criminal law. Part of the confusion is that lawyers are not allowed to advertise that they are a specialist in a particular area of the law. The only exceptions are tax attorneys and patent attorneys.

The reality is that no lawyer

is going to be really good at everything. Lawyers do develop areas of practice and some lawyers

develop extremely narrow specialized areas of practice. They are truly specialists.

Joel and I practice personal injury law which includes automobile accidents, workers compensation claims and commercial vehicle accidents.

In automobile accident cases, the attorney must know what the rules of the road are and what makes another driver responsible for damages. In Alabama, we have a mix of English common law where a jury determines whether or not a person acted as a "reasonable" person would have acted under the same or similar circumstances or whether their actions were "unreasonable" in a manner that foreseeably caused harm. The other type of law that we have is statutory rules which dictate when you must yield the right of way or how far behind another vehicle you must be at any given speed.

Once you understand the rules of liability then you look at what damages are recoverable under Alabama state law. Recoverable damages are typically lost wages, medical bills, property damage, loss of enjoyment of life, pain and suffering as well as compensation for a permanent injury.

An attorney has to obtain competent medical testimony and be familiar with the rules of evidence as well as rules that apply to liens and subrogation interests. Hospitals that treat a person for an accident or injury have a statutorily created lien that gives them the right to be paid first. Other types of insurance such as Medicare and Medicaid have legally created obligations for repayment and if you have health insurance with a private insurer such as Blue Cross Blue Shield, they also have a right of

If you reach an agreement to settle with the person that caused the accident and you don't notify your own insurance company of the settlement before you accept it, you may give up certain rights to other money benefits that may have been otherwise available to you.

Buckle up and drive safely.



WHERE'S THE SAFETY **FACTOR?**

Dear Dave,

I'm 30 and debt-free. Do you think I should stop making contributions to my 401(k) account for a year in order to save up an emergency fund?

Dear Beth,

Yes, I do. But it shouldn't take you a year to set aside an emergency fund if you're debt-free and making decent money at your job.
Just make it part of your
monthly budget plan, grit
your teeth and do it!

I recommend that people put off or stop investing until they are debt-free, except for their home, and have an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses in place. In some cases, depending on how much debt they have, it could take three or four years to do all this. I know it seems like a long time, but it's really not in the grand

scheme of things.

Here's the way I look at it. If you have no emergency fund, but you're contributing to your 401(k), there's a good chance you'll end up cashing out your 401(k) if a large, unexpected expense comes along. When you cash out a 401(k) early, you get hit with a penalty plus your tax rate. That's not a good plan!

That's just one of the reasons I tell people to have an emergency fund in place before they start investing!





during his presidency. His administration is riddled with Muslims. The following is a quote from Page 261 of Obama's book, "Dreams From My Father,







theaters felt sitting by their neighbors or almost innocent boyfriends watching Christian Grey -"Christian"?

Dr. Miriam Grossman, M.D., in "A Psychiatrist's Letter to Young People about 'Fifty Shades of Grey'", starts by saying, "There's nothing gray about 'Fifty Shades of Grey'. It's all black." She later adds, "Abuse is not glamorous or cool. It is never OK – under no circumstances." A friend of mine hit that nail on the head when she said, "Which one of us ever dreamed about our pretty little daughters and handcuffs at the same time?'

I recommend that you Google Dr. Grossman's letter. She makes so many meaningful points. One point that she makes about Anastasia's choices really enhanced a point that I have made here before about marital sex. Email

experience - soon after meeting him. Neuroscience suggests their intimacy could jump start her feelings of attachment and trust, before she's certain that he deserves them. Sex is a powerful experience – particularly the first time." Sex is supposed to complete the marriage relationship – consummate. This level of intimacy is to cause attachment – solidarity – oneness forever. Society has brought us to think that sex just says – "Hello" or "Hey, I really do like you" – that it is to start or affirm the relationship. We tell ourselves this, but our brains, our hearts know better. Quite often it is easy to tell if a young dating couple has had sex, because they can't let each other go even when they should. Why do women stay in abusive relationships? Lots of reasons – but one of the reasons is that they have given themselves away. As the doctor said, "Sex is ... powerful..."

When I was young, my sister hid the *True Romance* magazines under her bed. But, now you don't even have to sneak a peek. It's on the big screen. Marital love, self-respect and intimacy are being dragged down. A psychologically/spiritually dangerous relationship - why would we want to have anything to do with that? Let's not leave our young people at risk. Let's talk boldly about love that's not just about fulfilling our own feelings and desires. Let's demonstrate love that is about acting in the best interest of another person – love that has genuine care and is true forever - no shades, just consummate devotion. Now, that's intimacy. That's love. That is marriage.





