





BBQ Chicken Nachos

~ Serves 4 at 700 calories/person

6 ounces tortilla chips 1 pound chicken breasts, cooked & shredded

42 cup BBQ sauce + additional for serving

1 1/2 cups frozen corn, thawed 1 cup frozen broccoli, thawed & cut into bite-sized florets 3/4 cup light canned peaches,

chopped 42 cup shredded mozzarella cheese

42 cup shredded cheddar cheese 1 avocado, diced

Preheat oven to 400°F. Grease a large sheet pan, then spread tortilla chips over the pan. In a small bowl mix chicken and BBQ sauce. Sprinkle

over the chips. Place frozen corn and broccoli in a colander and run under cool water until thawed. If the broccoli is large, cut into small, bitesized florets. Pat vegetables very dry with a towel, then



spread over the chicken and chips. Drain canned peaches and dab dry with a towel. Chop, then spread over the chips. Sprinkle shredded cheeses over top, then bake for 15 minutes, until vegetables are hot and cheese is melted. Top with diced avocado and additional BBQ sauce, then serve.




YMCA Announces Organizational | Farm Bureau Plants Trees in Restructure in Response to **COVID-19 Financial Constraints**

The YMCA of Okobojis announced a plan to shift organizational resources in light of current economic conditions. Chang-

the

es include permanent closure of the Healthy Living Program Center located in downtown Spirit Lake, along with a restructure of debt and a revised staffing model.

Regarding the closure of the downtown location, CEO Andrew Fisher says the Board's decision was not made as a direct



The Y's Healthy Living Program Center opened in 2014 as the YMCA began researching the possibility of building a facility partnership and expansion of health and wellness opportunities in the Iowa Great Lakes region. Members will still have access to the flagship Bedell Family YMCA location, as well as the Healthy Living Program Center located in Milford. The Jiu Jitsu Okoboji program, which conducted self-defense training classes at the Spirit Lake HLPC site, will be relocated to the Bedell Family YMCA as soon as COVID-19 related restrictions are lifted. Additional adjustments will be made to the physical layout of the Bedell Family YMCA to accommodate the Spirit Lake HLPC's wellness equipment.

In order to weather this storm and ensure sustainability for the future, the YMCA will also restructure debt and revise its staffing model. One of the top three priorities in the YMCA's Strategic Plan is to Optimize Resources to build the organizational capacity necessary to effectively fulfill the Y's mission in our community. This involves prioritizing how the YMCA allocates financial, facility, and human resources. The YMCA will proceed with projects currently underway at the Bedell Family YMCA and Camp Foster to increase capacities and improve member and camper experiences.

Dickinson County Farm Bureau planted four 10-foot seedless Honey Locust trees on the Dickinson County Fairgrounds north

of the horse barn. The trees are in memory of four former members of the Dickinson County Farm Bureau

Board of Directors. Atree was planted in memory of Donald Nielsen. He was first elected to the board in 1994 as Westport Township Director. In 1996 he was elected vice-president and served two terms as president starting in 1999. Don was a very successful Membership Campaign Manager from 2006-2009 and received state recognition for an



outstanding membership drive. Don quit the board in 2011 due to health reasons and passed away in March of 2013.

A second tree was planted for Phyllis Nielsen. She was elected as a director on the board for county Area 2 in 2000. She was also appointed Ag in the Classroom (AITC) Coordinator and was co-chair of the Women's Committee. In 2002 she was appointed vice-president to fill a vacancy, then elected president in September of 2002. Phyllis became a fulltime AITC Coordinator in 2004 and was instrumental in establishing five Teacher Academies in the county from 2005 to 2009, drawing an average of 26 teachers to each academy. She was also the force behind three Farm Festivals in Dickinson County during the same time period. Phyllis passed away this March 2020.

Athird tree was planted in memory of Brian Peck. Brian joined the Farm Bureau Board in 2000. From July 2001 to July 2004, he and Kristi served on the Iowa Farm Bureau Federation Young Farmer Advisory Board. He became the county's Membership Campaign Manager in 2002 with a successful campaign with 809 members. He was also elected vice-president that year and served as Dickinson County Farm Bureau President from 2004 to 2010. Brian passed away in October 2018 while still serving on the board.

The fourth tree was planted in memory of Duane Van Kleek. His term on the board was from 2012 to 2015 and though brief. left an impact. He was very passionate about food being available for those in need, taking land out of production and the DNR's land use. Duane passed away in November 2015 while still serving on the board.





Arnolds Park opening with several cautions







Spencer Hospital Reintroduces Additional Services

Spencer Hospital will reintroduce some health services that were suspended two months ago as a precaution during the initial stages of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

"The hospital will carefully reintroduce additional services on June 1 after suspending certain non-essential services out of an abundance of caution," said Spencer Hospital president Bill Bumgarner. "Service expansion plans have been advanced in consultation with hospital's medical staff and are consistent with generally accepted public health guidelines. While risk of exposure still exists, healthcare providers have learned more about COVID-19 and how to incorporate mitigation practices over the past two months."

Essential services have continued at Spencer Hospital throughout the COVID-19 public health emergency although many elective services were suspended. Service expansion plans entail reintroducing a range of elective services to include outpatient diagnostic, rehabilitative and screening services based on a patient's needs and risk factors. Surgical services will be further expanded to include inpatient procedures. Limited outpatient elective surgeries were restarted in measured process two weeks ago.

"Our planning calls for an incremental increase in service access, to be followed by monitoring to ensure there's not a significant increase in COVID-19 infection in the community, before considering expanding additional services," said Bumgarner. "Non-essential services could be restricted or suspended again if there is a concern about the level of community spread."

Services which will be reopened or expanded effective June 1 include the following:

· Cardiac and pulmonary rehab services will be offered in-person with number of attendees limited and safety restrictions in place.

· Diagnostic imaging and laboratory services will be increased based on patient needs, identified by ordering physicians.

· Physical, occupational and speech therapy, and respiratory services will be expanded, based on patient needs.

· Home health and wound care services will be offered on a limited basis, based on patient risk considerations and priorities.

· Diabetic education will permit individual in-person sessions but will continue to encourage telemedicine appointments. Nutrition counseling will continue to be restricted to phone or online appointments.

Patients and authorized visitors will have their temperature checked and be asked screening questions at the entrance of the hospital. Masks will be required for anyone to enter the hospital. The use of waiting areas will be limited and directed by hospital staff. The cafeteria and coffee shop will be available for take-out food items only.

"Spencer Hospital continues to seek the appropriate balance to provide needed services while also being mindful of patient, visitor, employee and community safety," Bumgarner said. "It's important to remember the threat of COVID-19 remains very real. We should all continue to use recommended precautions in our work and personal lives. Doing so will make a difference."





Treasurer's Office Updates

The county treasurer's office will open up along with the rest of the Dickinson County Courthouse by appointment only. The expected opening date is Wednesday, June 3rd.

Dickinson County Treasurer Kris Rowley says, "Governor Reynolds extended the Proclamation of Public Health Disaster Emergency to June 25, 2020. If the proclamation is not further extended, here's deadlines to be aware of."

1. Property taxes: Pay by June 25, 2020 to avoid delinquent interest charges. No appointments will be available for property tax payments. Pay online at www.IowaTaxAndTags.org, by mail at Dickinson County Treasurer; PO Box AD; Spirit Lake, IA 51360; by phone at 712-336-1205; or use the Dickinson County Treasurer drop box on the west side of the Courthouse, outside the front door.

2. Motor Vehicle Transactions: If your vehicle registration expired January 31, 2020 or later, it will be considered valid to drive in the state of Iowa until June 25, 2020 without penalty. You can pay these online or by mail to remain current. The 30-day deadline to transfer a vehicle purchased on or after February 13, 2020 was suspended until the proclamation expires, currently June 25, 2020. The 45-day deadline for driving with temp plates on vehicles purchased on or after January 31, 2020 was suspended until the proclamation expires as well. Contact the treasurer's office for more information at 712-336-1205.

3. Driver's License Transactions: If your driver's license expired on or after January 16, 2020, until the COVID-19 disaster is lifted by Iowa Governor Reynolds, currently June 25, 2020, your license/ID will remain valid to drive in the state of Iowa. You may be able to renew online or qualify for a 6-month extension on your current license. Contact us at 712-336-6277 for more information.

We Must Do Better

This has been a tough year for our country and things got even worse this past week with the killing of African American George Floyd by white Minneapolis Police Officer Derek Chauvin while three other officers watched and did nothing. Over the weekend we saw many peaceful protests around the nation, but unfortunately saw several of these protests turn violent with destruction of property, injuries and looting of stores. With the killing of Floyd and murder of another African American, Ahmaud Arbery in Georgia in February that finally saw an arrest in May, racial tensions have escalated to a boiling point and things are not getting any better unless we all take a stand against racism.

She deals with hearing the N-word thrown around like it's nothing, and she sadly deals with people treating her different just because her skin is darker than mine. We can't understand that as white Americans, but where we need to get to is that we must empathize with this, and admit that this is the world that we live in. When I walk into a room, the first thing someone may notice about me is that I'm fairly tall or that my goatee is starting to turn gray, not that I'm a white male. I am not judged by the color of my skin, and no one should be, but we must deal with the fact that we live in a world where people are still judged by the color of their skin and that is not right. Racism is a learned behavior, we are born to love each other but somewhere along the lines, many people are taught to hate those who look different. We are all created equal, but we must realize that we are not all treated equal. As parents we need to realize that the comments we make during these troubled times are being heard by our children; we need to realize that our children watch how we react to racist comments, stereotypes or jokes, and if we say or do nothing they will grow to think that this behavior is acceptable.

I don't have the answer for how to end racism, but I do know that we can all do our part, even in our mostly white part of the world. Peaceful protests are a good first step, but we can't have these protest turn into destruction of property and even worse, more violence. We need empathy and compassion for our fellow man; we need to listen to each other, and most importantly, we need to CARE about each other, even those who we may disagree with (this also goes for our current divisive political system). When trying to figure out how to get through troubled times, I find it best to turn to the Lord and my faith; Romans 12:21 is a great verse to live by, especially in today's world, "Don't be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good." We can, and we must make this world a better place to live for ALL by not allowing evil to win and by doing a little good every single day; it may not seem like much but it will make a difference, and our fellow humans of ALL colors and races deserve it!

Farmers and Ranchers in Iowa Can Now Apply for Financial Assistance through USDA's Coronavirus Food Assistance Program

Online Tools and Toll-Free Number Available to Assist Producers

Agricultural producers can now apply for USDA's Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP), which provides direct payments to offset impacts from the coronavirus pandemic. The application and a payment calculator are now available online, and USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) staff members are available via phone, fax and online tools to help producers complete applications. The agency set up a call center in order to simplify how they serve new customers across the nation.

"We know Iowa producers are facing a tough time now, and we are making every effort to provide much needed support as quickly as possible," said Amanda De Jong, state executive director for FSA in Iowa. "FSA is available over the phone and virtually to walk you through the application process, whether it's the first time you've worked with FSA, or if you know us quite well."

Applications will be accepted through August 28, 2020. Through CFAP, USDA is making available \$16 billion for vital financial assistance to producers of agricultural commodities who have suffered a five-percent-or-greater price decline due to COVID-19 and face additional significant marketing costs as a result of lower demand, surplus production, and disruptions to shipping patterns and the orderly marketing of commodities.

"We also want to remind producers that the program is structured to ensure the availability of funding for all eligible

producers who apply," Amanda De Jong

In order to do this, producers will receive 80 percent of their maximum total payment upon approval of the application. The remaining portion of the payment, not to exceed the payment limit, will be paid at a later date nationwide, as funds remain available.

Producers can download the CFAP application and other eligibility forms from farmers.gov/cfap.Also, on that webpage, producers can find a payment calculator to help identify sales and inventory records needed to apply and calculate potential payments.

Additionally, producers in search of one-on-one support with the CFAP application process can call 877-508-8364 to speak directly with a USDA employee ready to offer assistance. This is a good first step before a producer engages the team at the FSA county office at their local USDA Service Center.

Applying for Assistance

Producers of all eligible commodities will apply through their local FSA office. Those who use the online calculator tool will be able to print off a pre-filled CFAP application, sign, and submit to your local FSA office either electronically or via hand delivery. Please contact your local office to determine the preferred method. Find contact information for your local office at farmers.gov/cfap.

Documentation to support the producer's application and certification may be requested after the application is filed. FSA has streamlined the signup process to not require an acreage report at the time of application and a USDA farm number may not be immediately needed.

Additional Commodities

USDA is also establishing a process for the public to identify additional commodities for potential inclusion in CFAP. Specifically, USDA is looking for data on agricultural commodities, that are not currently eligible for CFAP, that the public believes to have either:

- 1. Suffered a five percent-or-greater price decline between mid-January and mid-April as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic,
- Shipped but subsequently spoiled due to loss of marketing channel,
- Not left the farm or remained unharvested as mature crops. More information about this process

is available on farmers.gov/cfap. To find the latest information on CFAP,

visit farmers.gov/cfap or call 877-508-8364. USDA Service Centers are open for business by phone appointment only, and field work will continue with appropriate social distancing. While program delivery staff will continue to come into the office, they will be working with producers by phone and using online tools whenever possible. All Service Center visitors wishing to conduct business with the FSA, Natural Resources Conservation Service, or any other Service Center agency are required to call their Service Center to schedule a phone appointment.
