

her in a nursing home. I now help her with bathing and sometimes toileting. My own health is poor but I feel naturally obligated to her. My family is worried about me but what else can I do? Dr. Robert Webk

A

Although there are several issues here, perhaps the biggest one for you is, how to deal with the guilt imposed by a parent's unrealistic expectation?

Caregivers must look after themselves because studies show they develop more health problems due to the stress related to care-giving. Parents can impose an unbearable burden by insisting on a promise which may not only be unrealistic, but may lead to significant problems for them <u>both</u>.

You need to have a 'heart-to-heart' with her (if she is still able ) and ask her [and yourself] these four questions [from Dr. Gwande's book, "Being Mortal"]:

1) What is her understanding of her current condition? [does she realize she has a <u>terminal</u> disease – Alzheimer's]

2) What are her goals when her health gets worse? [it will worsen - so is the goal be 'comfortable' or 'suffer more'

3) What frightens her most about her health situation? [is it loss of memory, not being able to look after herself, uncontrolled pain, or what?]

4) What is she willing to trade-off, to give up, just to stay alive? [would she want you to get sick trying to care for her?].

These are not easy discussions but are necessary [and are applicable in any serious illness!]. When her dementia starts to require 24-hour care, you will need assistance. Whether or not she gives you permission, in the end, placing her in a nursing home may be in everyone's best interests.





our troops for missions around the world. the local 911 agency. When you call 911, your location can also be determined within 300 feet through various methods such as cell tower triangulation, GPS and (coming soon) elevation data so that emergency personnel can determine approximately what floor of a high-rise building you are on. The FCC has instituted rules that will require that location data soon be accurate to within 50 feet.

With more and more of us dropping our landlines and moving to cellular service, it becomes more and more imperative that we find ways to communicate if and when Obama kills our phones again. For example, Facebook Messenger allows you to make "phone calls" to anyone on your friend list. signed a note at the bank for my nephew, her grandson, to buy a truck. I do not think my nephew has made a single payment yet he drives this \$30,000 pickup without making a payment on it. My mother is not in good health and I want to know if her estate would be responsible for the debt. She is only a co-signer on the note.

My mother

People often don't understand the role of a co-signer for a loan. It seems that it is generally misunderstood to be a second place responsibility.

I want to be very clear in explaining that a co-signer is equally responsible for the debt. If they have more money and assets, they are going to be primarily responsible for the debt. I think that the intent, more often than not is that the person getting the loan will make the payments. Everyone involved in the transaction knows that the person getting the loan does not have sufficiently good credit to qualify for the loan by themselves. There is always a reason for that lack of good credit.

Sometimes those reasons are a new job. no credit history or a recent bankruptcy. Other reasons are a past history of late payments or non-payments. Given the

right circumstances perhaps after a divorce or bankruptcy and based on the character of the person needing to borrow someone else's credit, co-signing a loan can be a positive help for a person who is in need. The cases that I hear about are obviously the ones that don't work out, and I have heard many of those.

Specifically, in answer to your question, first the nephew would be responsible after the co-signer passed away. Secondly, the truck is security for the debt and it would be repossessed and sold and whatever it sold for would be applied to the debt. Any balance left owing (known as a deficiency or a deficiency judgment) would be a debt of the estate. If your mother doesn't have much of an estate or has done some estate planning such as deeding any property to her children while reserving a life estate and taking title to her own vehicles with a co-owner as an "or" such as "Jane Johnson OR Bill Johnson" then there would be little need to even file an estate. A creditor has the right to file an estate to establish their right to collect; it is also the true that the decision to do so is a straight forward monetary analysis. A bank will not spend the money to hire a lawyer if it is not worth their while. Buckle up and drive safely.

### Schools Need Fresh Produce

### Editor:

Farm to school programs offer children better, fresher, more nutritious, and more local food choices that empower children and their families learn more about the food on their plates and make better food choices. These programs also help strengthen rural and small town economies by creating economic opportunities for local farmers and ranchers as well as local food processors.

As part of the upcoming Child Nutrition Act Reauthorization, Congress needs to build on the success of farm to school by strengthening and expanding the program's scope and by providing additional mandatory funding. Earlier year, Representative this Jeff Fortenberry (R-NE) and Representative Marcia Fudge (D-OH) took a huge step in that direction when they introduced the Farm to School Act to expand and strengthen the U.S Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm to School Grant programs. Senator Thad Cochran (R-MS) and Senator Patrick Leahy (D-VT) introduced a companion bill in the Senate.

As Rep. Fortenberry explained at the time, schools throughout Nebraska and across the U.S. are eagerly embracing local foods from local farms, with more than 10,000 schools participating in Farm to School programs nationally. The Farm to School Act will also expand existing USDA Farm to School Grant programs to include preschools and summer and after school programs. The Center for Rural Affairs applauds Rep. Fortenberry, Rep. Fudge, Senator Cochran, and Senator Leahy for their effort to promote the use of fresh, locally produced food in even more schools and educational programs.




Schlarp by her teammates. was a natural in the sport, even in her earlier high school days.



## Lift Them Up

*I truly wanted to tell a story* in in this column, but in my day job I listened to a 13 year- old and a third-grader admit that they had foully cussed each other during an argument. The 13 year-old repeated the vulgar language that he had used in front of four adults. He didn't flinch.

I can't get him off my mind. It's disturbing how bad language, like everything else now belongs to the very young. They use it boldly on Facebook and loudly use it in public places. They don't see the harm in it. They think it's just a word. Really – is this where we want our young people to be? Where will it get them? Disrespecting themselves and those around them. Maybe we can cut it off at the source. They weren't born cussing.

Below is a column that I wrote in 2002. It was originally addressed to moms and dads only, but now since youngsters can easily pick up this bad habiť from anywhere, I would like to address:

Mom, dad, families and friends of the young,

Do you cuss or curse (which ever you call it depending where you are from)? You know what I mean. Do you use expletives that I would have to use symbols like this \*#!x!#@\*+!!!, if I were to print them here? Why do you use bad language? Let me list a few reasons.

1. You want kids to think that you are tougher than any guy on the block.

2. You want to make everyone around you to feel as comfortable as you can.

3. You use bad language because it describes what you are thinking better break when no one can see

than any other words in the English language. 4. You think that there

is no such thing as filthy language, so you say what you want and you'll teach kids to use ugly language while they are little to get

what they want. Have I gotten it right so far? I hope not. You started cursing for the same reason these kids will. You were around someone who cussed and you got into the same habit. First, you practiced their bad words in your head – thinking silently during bad situations. Occasionally you would mouth the situations. words. Finally, you got bold enough to say them around your friends. Then it didn't matter to whom you said them. (You still hesitate around the religious people in your life.) Curse words may be such a part of your life that you don't even notice anymore. [But the children notice.]

A while back, a man called me a bad word when he was telling me that I had left my bag of charcoal under the cart as I unloaded groceries into my car. I totally missed out on his kindness because of his foul mouth! I just wanted to chase him down and tell him my name for future reference. Mom, dad, family and friends, is cursing a big part of your everyday life? Then you can count on the fact that it is a big part of your kids' lives too. They are practicing in their heads. They are using bad language when they are with their friends. They want to cuss their teachers and pretty soon they will cuss you out too.

A habit is hardest to

or hear it. Cussing in your head is one of the worst. It makes you negative. It pulls you down. Help your kid to stop his habit. Stop yours. Write a replacement word list. Use words that make no sense like - "Oh, potato chips!" Or count to ten. Or bite your tongue. Tell your friends to slack up on the words, and then be a good example. You will gain respect. You will better your kids. Start now. We'll all benefit. Sincerely, Cat
