For those who have been eagerly awaiting the return of the Four Winds Casinos in New Buffalo, Hartford,

Dowagiac and South Bend, the **Pokagon Gaming Authority** has laid out plans for how it will all work when they reopen for business next Monday, June 15th at noon.

Each Four Winds Casino location has implemented changes to their amenities and services to help protect the health and safety of guests and employees, and will continue to provide an enjoyable entertainment experience. Frank Freedman, Chief Operating Officer of Four Winds Casinos, says, "With the approval of our reopening plan by the Pokagon Gaming Authority and Pokagon Gaming Commission which includes the implementation of several additional health, sanitization and social distancing measures approved by the Pokagon Health Task Force, we are pleased to confirm that we will welcome guests back to all of our Four Winds Casinos locations on Monday, June 15 at Noon Eastern Time." He adds, "As the health and safety of our guests and employees, has been and continues to remain our top priority, we will be opening with some changes to our amenities and services. With these changes, we will continue to exceed expectations and provide excellent customer service that the Four Winds Casinos are known for." Matthew Wesaw, Tribal Council Chairman and CEO of the Pokagon Gaming Authority, says, "The reopening of our casinos comes at a critical time for our Tribe and our employees that are in need of economic relief," and adds, "Unlike state and local governments which predominately use tax dollars to operate, the Pokagon Band is a Sovereign Native American Government which relies on revenue from its business ventures to fund critical services and programs for our citizens including healthcare, housing, education, family services, financial support, elder care, police, courts and more. Although our closure was voluntary due to our sovereignty and to protect everyone's health and safety, great care was taken by our Gaming Authority, Gaming Commission, Health Task Force and casino management team on how to reopen with the proper health and safety measures in place." Upon entering each casino through designated entrances, guests will be required wear a mask and be screened using touchless temperature check technology. The age of

Certainty is essential to recovery.

This week, I'd like to take a quick snapshot of where we are in the re-opening process and give voice to some of the frustrations still felt by thousands of small business owners across the state.

Southwest Michigan is in Phase 4 of the MI Safe Start Plan and the statewide stay-at-home order has been lifted. Retailers are now fully open, and restaurants can offer dine-in with lim-

ited capacity. Starting Monday, June 15, personal services including hair, massages, and nails will reopen statewide.

On the healthcare front, the number of new coronavirus cases has dropped significantly from the peak in early April. The number of deaths has consistently decreased and there are

far fewer COVID related hospitalizations. What's more, the shortage of personal protective equipment around the state has been alleviated and access to coronavirus testing has greatly increased.

In fact, Berrien County has done more coronavirus testing per-capita than any other county in Michigan. The Berrien County Health Department, InterCare Community Health Network, and Spectrum Health Lakeland have worked tirelessly to achieve this feat and deserve our community's thanks and apprecia-

If the current trajectory of coronavirus cases continues, Governor Whitmer said the whole state will be able to enter Phase 5 "in a few

While encouraging, "in a few weeks" is not a timeline that businesses can realistically use to plan their operations on. Unfortunately, this lack of clarity has been a constant since the start of the pandemic, vexing citizens and business owners

Look no further than Michigan's MI Safe Start Plan, where eight regions of the state independently progress across six phases of recovery. The plan notably omits specific details on how those progressions are met and instead uses vague terminology such as when cases and deaths decline "more sharply."

Illinois' plan also calls for a gradual reopening of individual regions across multiple phases. Unlike Michigan, it lays out far more detail on how those regions move forward. For example, in order to move into the next phase of recovery, an Illinois region must record a positive testing rate at or below 20%, experience two weeks of new cases increasing by under 10%, no increase in hospital admissions for 28 days and have surge capacity of 14% for ICU beds, medical beds, and ventilators.

There are five stages to Indiana's Back on Track recovery plan, each with benchmarks and dates with which business owners could plan to move from one phase to the next. The dates are moved up if conditions are met ahead of sched-

In contrast, when asked to clarify Michigan's timeline at her June 5 press conference, Governor Whitmer had this to say: "Going the next step into fully resuming into Phase 5 will take days, maybe weeks, maybe a little bit longer after that. But this will look a lot more like normal when we get past the 15th.'

The one thing that kills business and markets is uncertainty. While it may be difficult to set standards during these times, the more conflicting messages that are sent, the worse the economy will get and the longer it will take to come back.

And there are quite a few businesses that are very much at risk of not coming back.

If you'll recall, on March 16, 2020, Governor Whitmer signed Executive Order 2020-9 which 'temporarily' closed movie theaters, gyms, casinos, and more. Thirteen weeks and over 110 executive orders later, movie theaters, gyms, and casinos remain closed across most of Michigan. Not only that, they haven't even been given a date with which to plan for re-opening. These businesses are in desperate need of customers, cash, and certainty. Those three C's are the only true path to solvency and long-term stability.

Nobody denies the coronavirus is still a threat, but data has been moving in the right direction for some time. Neighboring states have proven decisions can be based on clearly communicated benchmarks. The longer Michigan remains an outlier, the higher likelihood we will face a one-state recession. The road to recovery will be difficult enough, it's time we got out of our own way.



Dave Says

Many benefits to budgeting

Dear Dave,

Some friends

recently introduced me to your ideas for handling money. I've got to admit a lot of it makes sense, but I'm not sure why you're so adamant about budgeting. Can't you get a good idea of your finances by checking your accounts and balances online regularly?

Parker Dear Parker,

This is a great topic, especially for those who are new to the idea of getting serious about their finances and gaining control of their money. A lot of folks wonder why I'm so intense about budgeting on paper, on purpose, every month. Part of the reason is they don't understand all the benefits—financial and otherwise—that come with giving every dollar a name.

The financial benefit is a no-brainer, so it's the perfect place to start. I've been teaching people to live on a budget for many years. The reason? It never fails. People who make, and live by, a zero-based budget every month are much more likely to win with money over time. It's not always easy when you're first getting started, but it's worth it.

There's also an emotional benefit to consider. I can't think of many things more stressful than running out of money before the end of the month. If you don't keep a detailed accounting of every dollar that comes in, and where it goes, you're inviting an incredible amount of fear and uncertainty into your life.

Another benefit is where relationships are concerned. Money problems and fights over money are the leading causes of divorce in America. I've seen how proper budgeting principles can bring a sense of healing, hope, and restoration to families. During budget meetings, couples learn to talk to each other like never before. They open up, share their dreams and fears, learn how to draw boundaries, and plan for the future. And this benefit isn't just for the married crowd. Folks who are single can develop more personal discipline, and find accountability, that has an impact on their relationships, too.

It's tempting to think the idea of "on paper, on purpose" is nothing but a catchphrase. But it's so much more. Budgeting is absolutely the key to gaining control of your finances!

The Veterans Voice – Agent Orange Claims Part 2



(A/O) claims are one of the most frequently filed claims that we process in Veterans Services. If you want a comprehensive list of all the places the U.S. Government

has acknowledged A/O was used, visit www. publichealth.va.gov/exposures/agentorange/ locations/tests-storage/index.asp. The first veteran to receive a successful claim for A/O exposure stateside occurred in 2009 by U.S. Army Veteran James Cripps, who was stationed at Fort Gordon. Georgia while working as a Game Warden in 1967. See http://agentorangezone.blogspot.com/2009/11/ local-veteran-wins-fight-for-medical.html?m=1 for more information. It took a five year fight and a Board of Veterans Appeals hearing for Mr. Cripps to prevail on his A/O claim with the VA. Another area where A/O was used and buried underground is in Okinawa, Japan. There is an excellent A/O documentary on YouTube you can view at www. youtube.com/watch?v=5tRkP2b3dsM that shows the usage and ground water contamination that the U.S. Government is slow in acknowledging to date. Some veterans have already prevailed with A/O claims that served at various military bases in Okinawa who were stationed there from the late 1960's to date. You can Google Agent Orange in Okinawa for more additional information. In fact, Stars and Stripes had an article titled, "Two vets win Agent Orange exposure cases from Okinawa" vou can view at www.stripes.com/ news/2-vets-win-agent-orange-exposure-casesfrom-okinawa-1.457227 that discusses the issue in detail. Also, any Air Force Veterans who flew on C-123's from 1969 - 1986 (see https://benefits. va.gov/BENEFITS/factsheets/serviceconnected/ AO_C123.pdf for additional information) may also be eligible to file a claim for A/O exposure. There

Orange are Air Force Bases in Thailand during Vietnam, if you also had perimeter duty or duties that took you alongside the perimeter (see www.publichealth. va.gov/exposures/agentorange/locations/thailand. asp for additional information), that can qualify you for an A/O claim. Veterans who served in a unit in or near the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) anytime between April 1, 1968 and August 1, 1971 are also presumed to have been exposed to A/O herbicides. The presumption dates were extended to September 1. 1967 to August 31, 1971 beginning on January 1, 2020. You can visit www.publichealth.va.gov/ exposures/ agentorange/locations/korea.asp for additional information. Usually, anything outside of Vietnam or more than 12 nautical miles off the coast of Vietnam or Cambodia in Navy or Coast Guard ships between January 9, 1962 and May 7, 1975 will receive some denial pushback from VA (C-123's and DMZ being the exceptions) and more likely than not have to go to the Board of Veterans Appeals (a very lengthy process) where the BVA will consider approval of these A/O claims on a case-by-case basis. Again, in addition to being presumptively exposed to A/O, you also need to have one of the 14 current conditions or diseases on the VA's list (see www.publichealth.va.gov/exposures/agentorange/ conditions/index. asp). In general, claims are won on both evidence and arguments, a carefully strategic mix of the two, but the former usually prevails. If a veteran believes their health problems are a result of A/O exposure, please contact our office for assistance in filing a claim.



guests will be restricted to those 21 and older as some non-gaming amenities will be closed. The number of active slot machines has been reduced and in some cases chairs and machines have been moved while very popular games have plexiglass dividers to help ensure social distancing guidelines. There will also be reduced seating at table games. Additional cleaning teams have been added in every area of the casinos with a focus on frequent cleaning of high touch surfaces. All Four Winds team members will also be washing and sanitizing their hands more frequently, for at least 20 seconds and practicing respiratory etiquette. Dining venues will be limited with seating and hours of operation. Touchless menus will be available at each restaurant using a scanned QR code and a disposable menu will be provided upon request. You will notice more spacing in between tables and party sizes will be limited. Self-service beverage stations will now be equipped with a team member for assistance.

Additional procedures and service modifications to protect the health and safety of guests and employees include: Masks will be worn by all employees... Additional signage containing COVID-19 prevention and social distancing reminders with be posted throughout each casino location...Rescheduled entertainment will be announced as dates are confirmed...Valet and group shuttle service will not be offered and the Buffets will remain closed Freedman says, "We are in this new journey together and excited to welcome guests back," and adds, "Hopefully we can return to our full complement of gaming, dining, entertainment, and event options soon. Please visit, www.fourwindscasino.com for a full list of details, safety protocols and guidelines. Also follow our social media pages for periodic updates." Previously, the Pokagon Gaming Authority announced the closure of its Four Winds Casinos on Tuesday, March 17th, and an indefinite extension of the closure period on March 27th. The reopening

plan was approved by the Pokagon Gaming Authority and Pokagon Gaming Commission was approved during a hearing on Monday June 8th.

Over the past 35 years Mary and Andy Sloan crafted a true family restaurant along M-139 in Benton Harbor. Not only did they labor side by side for those three and a half decades at their Country Kitchen Restaurant, their son and daughter joined the team over the course of the years and they seemingly knew everyone's name who came to dine. Now, after briefly converting to curbside service during the pandemic like many other local restaurants across the land, the Sloans, who have been a part of the Benton Harbor community dating back to 1978, have posted on the menu board of their roadside pylon sign, "Closed, Thanks for 35 Good Years." They have owned and operated the restaurant at 2487 M-139 across from Carpet Mart since 1985. Five years ago in 2015 they were the first Country Kitchen Restaurant in the nation to convert to the concept called Cafe by Country Kitchen, which as Mary said, "Allowed us to still focus on what we were already great at — breakfast all day — but with a fresh twist." At that time the restaurant changed operations to a 7-day a week schedule, from 6am until 2:30pm, discontinuing their dinner service completely. It was a concept that helped keep the restaurant alive and thriving, with positive Trip Advisor reviews keeping them rated at 4.5-stars or higher the entire time they were in business. The Sloans were very generous to the community over the years, donating pancakes to the Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast fundraiser twice a year for many years. Now, though, the run is over, and if you call the restaurant you get a recorded message that says that they are officially closed for good...headed into retirement. A well-earned rest is in the books for the Sloan family, but one of the hot breakfast spots is now gone from the menu in Michigan's Great Southwest.

Restaurants in Benton Harbor and Fennville are among the more than 100 small business enterprises around the state who are employing the Michigan Economic Development Corporation's Crowdfunding Program this month in recovery efforts from the coronavirus pandemic. Houndstooth Restaurant in downtown Benton Harbor and Root for Fennville both have \$5,000 campaign goals in the effort alongside businesses from one end of the state to the other. All in all, more than 100 small businesses around the state will utilize the MI Local Biz crowdfunding program throughout the month of June, according to word from the MEDC. Officials at the MEDC will provide a total of \$500,000 in matching grants to help the businesses as they work to recover from the negative economic impacts of the COVID-19 crisis. MEDC CEO Mark A. Burton says, "Michigan's small businesses and traditional downtowns are a vital part of the state's economy, and this program offers innovative access to capital for those businesses currently experiencing a loss in revenue directly related to the COVID-19 crisis," and adds, "Helping our local businesses to successfully reopen lays a path for economic recovery in communities across the state, while offering patrons an opportunity to support businesses in a time of need." Houndstooth is a New American restaurant that opened in September of 2019 in the Arts District of Benton Harbor. Owner Cheyenne Galbraith says, "Six months later we made the difficult decision to close temporarily due to COVID 19. Though we tried to stay open for carryout, it was not sustainable for our business and we laid off our employees and closed." Regarding the crowdfunding campaign, she says, "We are asking for help now, as the next few months will present many uncertainties and this money will help us stay 'above water'. We would like to slowly bring back our amazing staff, though we are only able to function at half-capacity." She adds, "We would like to be able to continue to be able to use the local farmers



By having these funds we will be able to support not only our staff, but local businesses and agriculture, which gives our food the quality we strive for." Galbraith, and her brother James operate the restaurant, and James says, "Our restaurant, though still very new, provided consistent employment and visibility to an area of Benton Harbor that invites all, and that is Houndstooth. We will continue to reach out to our community and evolve with what our community's needs are. With this money, we can create a safe home for our employees and safely serve our community." You can help at the link below. Launched in May, the MI Local Biz program builds on the MEDC's successful Public Spaces Community Places program, in which residents can use crowdfunding to be part of the development of strategic projects in their communities and be backed with a matching grant from MEDC MI Local Biz allows for a small business to utilize donation-based crowdfunding through Michigan-based Patronicity's existing platform and to receive a 1:1 matching grant from MEDC of up to \$5,000. Funds must be used by the businesses for working capital needs in order to maintain ongoing operations during and through the COVID-19 crisis. Currently, there are businesses in 42 counties participating in the MI Local Biz program - in communities ranging from Houghton in the Upper Peninsula, to Benton Harbor in Southwest Michigan, to Spring Lake in West Michigan, to the Lake Michigan port city of Manistee, to Port Huron at the easternmost point of the state. Campaigns are continuing to go live and will be added to the page on a regular basis. Examples of the types of businesses that are participating include restaurants/bars/coffee shops, cafes, salons/day spas, yoga studios, historic theaters, retail shops, art galleries, recreation businesses, and many other

Ben says, "We still offer Frozen Yogurt and Edible Cookie Dough, but with the addition of Gourmet Popcorn last fall we felt a name more encompassing was needed." Ben adds, "We offer Caramel and Cheddar Cheese each day. which of course can be mixed just like in Chicago to create our Big City Mix, along with another savory flavor that rotates in and out of the system." He notes, "We also have an assortment of candied corn that comes in a wide range of fruit flavors and colors." State Street Treats also offers an array of decorative tins including many local college and professional team logos which the Iliff's suggest as great gift ideas. They also offer local schools, recreational leagues and the like fundraising opportunities, while also selling popcorn in bulk. The shop is currently open every day for to go and call ahead opportunities at 408-8625. When Ben and Amy took over the shop at YoBubbs in the city's central business district in the spring of 2018, the excitement level was high. Teachers by trade they knew that young people wanted a place for fun as well as an opportunity to gain life experiences by working in the shop. They are popping fresh popcorn at State Street Treats every day that they are open for business throughout the year. The shop, located at 319

State Street in downtown St. Joseph, next to White Pine Winery, was first established in May of 2013, and now they mark their seventh season in operation. Ben and Amy are both seasoned Watervliet Public Schools teachers.
