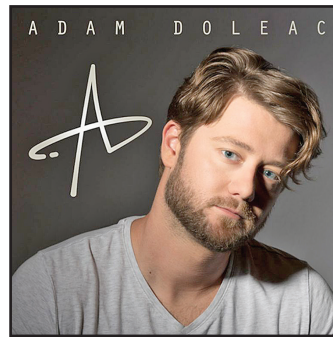



The Itty Bitty Boji Band's scheduled Sunday “Veteran's Ball” at the Spirit Senior Activity Center has apparently been added to the scratch list — though you might want to call just to check if there's been a change of heart there...

The good news is the Little Swan Lake Winery has three stage shows this weekend, starting not on Thursday, but Friday night, with Kayla Brown's performance, from 5:30-7:30, on the stage in the barn...

The LSLW will also see *The South 71 Trio* on the same stage, Saturday night, from 6-8:00. And Sunday afternoon, *Beyond Blue*, will entertain from 4:00-6:00pm...

Research director RD starts with another pop quiz this week — What three things do the pop hits *Wah-Watusi*, *Don't Hang Up*, and *South Street*, have in common? The first answer is obvious. In the early 1960s each of the songs sold over a million copies, earning gold record status. And, all were written by Dave Appell and Kal Mann; and released by the R&B group, *The Orlons*, whose lead singer, Rosetta Hightower was born on this day in 1944...

Thursday will be Beatles Day. Known also as *The Fab Four*, the group starred in the 1964 music comedy film, *A Hard Day's Night*. The film was released at the height of ‘Beatlemania.’ As a financial and critical success, it depicted a day in the life of *The Beatles*. The soundtrack includes a list of songs written expressly for the motion picture, such as *I Fell*, *And I Love Her*, and *I Should Have Known Better*, — as well as the movie's theme...

Thursday is also the day — in 1955 — that the Broadway production of *Can Can* closed after 892 performances. The production featured music written by Cole Porter, with the song, *I Love Paris*. With over 250 versions listed on the *Second Hand Songs* website, some of the most popular might be those by Ella Fitzgerald (1956), Dean Martin (1962) and Frank Sinatra, from *Live in Paris*, which was recorded in 1962, but not released until 12 years later...

New York composer Richard Rodgers was born on June 28, 1902, and known mainly for his work in his city's musical theater. The song, *It's Easy to Remember (and so hard to forget)*, which was co-written with Lorenz Hart, debuted in the 1935 movie, *Mississippi*, starring Bing Crosby. While Bing was the first to sing it more than eight decades ago, the lyrics were more recently revisited by Stacey Kent, on her 2002 tribute, *In Love Again, The Music of Richard Rodgers*; and also by the multi-talented Seth MacFarlane, on his 2011 CD, *Music is Better Than Words*, which also contains, *Something Good*, the love ballad from *The Sound of Music*, for which Rodgers wrote the music and the lyrics!

Every now and then, the Old Professor gets to surprise RD in her section of *RAMBOLing*. Today is that one day of the year we get to wish her “Happy Birthday!” This year, today is the day. Even though RD is many years younger than the Old Professor, we are smart enough to not reveal what birthday — ‘cause we hope RD will continue to email her research for us all each week for many birthdays ahead...



Every grant distributed went to nonprofits seeking funding for both new and current needs, that have arisen as a direct response to COVID-19. Our grant review committee has vetted the requests to ensure vulnerable populations are receiving services.

The Okoboji Foundation established the Disaster Recovery Fund to provide leadership and collaborative funding to support those who face the greatest need.

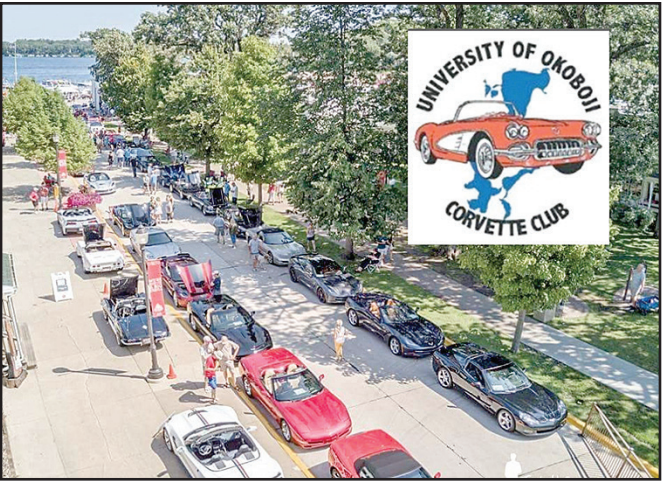

Beef Quality Assurance Trainings Gradually Resume

While COVID-19 has changed a lot of things, major packers still require a current Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) certificate from feedlot producers selling market-ready cattle. Beth Doran, beef specialist for Iowa State University Extension and Outreach, said that's why a set of certification workshops has been planned for northwest Iowa producers starting in early July.

"Five workshops will be offered in northwest Iowa to help producers renew an expiring certificate or acquire a new certificate," Doran said. "We want to be sure opportunities are available for producers to be certified."

The workshops are a collaborative effort of Iowa State University Extension and Outreach, the Iowa Beef Center and the Iowa Beef Industry Council, and are scheduled for the following dates and locations.

Sheet Pan Chicken Thighs & Loaded Cauliflower ~ Serves 4 at 570 calories/person

1 small head cauliflower, cut into florets
3 tablespoon butter, melted
4 slices reduced-sodium bacon
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1/4 cup sour cream
1 green onion, sliced
4 skin-on, bone-in chicken thighs (about 5 ounces each)
2 tablespoons olive oil
1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
1/2 teaspoon Kosher salt
1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Preheat oven to 450°F. Place chicken thighs, skin side up, on one side of a large sheet pan. Rub with olive oil, then season with thyme, salt and pepper.
Place cauliflower florets on the other side of the pan, drizzle with melted butter and stir to coat. Spread into an even layer.
Place bacon along the edge of the pan, directly touching the pan. Bake for 35-40 minutes, until bacon and chicken skin are crisp and cauliflower is tender. Crumble the bacon. Top cauliflower with shredded cheese, bacon, sour cream and green onion.

COVID-19 Test Iowa Site Opening In Spirit Lake On June 22

The number of Dickinson County residents infected with COVID-19 has increased dramatically in the past month. As people from out of town visit the area, increased community spread in the Iowa Great Lakes is likely to continue. For this reason, the Office of Governor Kim Reynolds, Lakes Regional Healthcare, and Dickinson County Emergency Management have worked together to open a drive-through Test Iowa clinic in Spirit Lake.

The clinic will open at noon on Monday, June 22 and then be open from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm every weekday beginning Tuesday, June 23. Any Iowa resident will be able to receive a COVID-19 test for free, regardless of symptoms or potential exposure to the virus. Those with COVID-19 symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, fever, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell, headache, muscle aches) are encouraged to call Lakes Regional Healthcare's Respiratory Clinic at 712-336-6696 for guidance on whether it is best to receive a test at the Respiratory Clinic at Lakes Regional Healthcare or the Test Iowa clinic.

In order to get a COVID-19 test through the Test Iowa clinic:

1. Complete the online assessment at www.testiowa.com.
2. After completing the online assessment, you will receive an email from TestIowa.com that includes a bar code. Print the bar code or take a screenshot of it.
3. Go to the drive-through Test Iowa clinic in Spirit Lake, located on the Dickinson County Fairgrounds just west of the Expo Building and behind the show barns. Enter the fairgrounds at their west entrance off of 15th Street and follow the signs. No appointment is needed. Please wear a mask and bring your bar code and personal identification, such as a driver's license, with you. Please be aware that healthcare staff will be dressed in appropriate personal protective equipment including a gown, gloves, mask, and face shield. This is for your protection as well as their own.

Test results will be emailed to you within 48 to 72 hours. You can also go to Test Iowa's Patient Portal, and enter your personal identifier/bar code number to check your results. If your test results are positive, further instruction will be provided to self-quarantine and seek medical attention.

Mobile Food Bank in Estherville

The Food Bank is every month now because of the increase in need. At the June Food Bank, 514 people (206 families) received 8,760 pounds of food.

Because of COVID-19, food will be brought out to people in their vehicles when they drive up. Do not arrive before 3:00pm. Remain in your vehicle. Do not line up at the door. Registration will take place at your vehicle. Building will remain closed. Bring bags, laundry baskets, or boxes to carry your food.

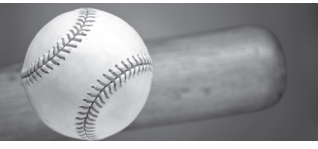

Iowa Lakes Trustees Discuss Plan For 2020-2021 School Year

The Iowa Lakes Community College Board of Trustees met Tuesday afternoon at the SERT Facility on the Estherville Campus.

During Tuesday's meeting, Iowa Lakes Community College President, Valerie Newhouse presented a thorough plan for review of the anticipated 2020-2021 school year.

During her presentation, she shared, "The Administration at Iowa Lakes Community College continues to plan for the upcoming school year by evaluating various aspects of the college experience. Areas of focus include the college calendar and campus activities, campus housing, course instruction, continuing education offerings, and workforce training."

Iowa Lakes plans for classes to resume on Tuesday, August 25.

"We plan to move forward with classes as previously scheduled, with a modified move-in plan for students residing in our dorms. Additionally, we will conduct pre-move-in health screenings that will include temperature checks and a questionnaire," shared President Newhouse.

Iowa Lakes will implement new methods of instruction in addition to offering online and traditional classroom experiences.

According to President Newhouse, "This fall, Iowa Lakes will implement two new course offerings for Iowa Lakes' students. These offerings are LAKER LIVE and LAKER NOW."

LAKER LIVE courses allow students and faculty to participate in a face-to-face, virtual classroom through a video conferencing platform.

LAKER NOW courses offer students the same opportunity to participate live, or the flexibility to view and participate at a time convenient to their schedule.

"Additionally, Iowa Lakes will offer online courses and traditional classroom instruction. Any traditional classroom instruction or labs will be held in smaller groups to maintain social distancing standards. Our Career and Technical programs will be held with modifications to allow for social distancing," said President Newhouse.

President Newhouse noted, "There are many caveats to our plan. We can make changes as needed depending on the coronavirus status within the Iowa Lakes District. We will monitor and assess the recommendations or guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) for higher education institutions."

Jolene Rogers, Executive Director of Community and Business Relations, received approval to accept a donation to the Carrington Baker Scholarship.

The Carrington Baker Scholarship has been awarded annually since 2015. Carrington was a Laker – and member of the Laker Life club, which significantly impacted his life. Cary was a strong leader in the Laker Life campus ministry at Iowa Lakes and a Youth Leader at Grandview Baptist Church. He made everyone feel welcome and valued. This scholarship will help keep the tradition Cary started in encouraging that environment of family. With this donation, the scholarship will be a permanent testimony to those values of inclusion and community.

"The Iowa Lakes Foundation has awarded more than \$484,000 in scholarships to over 300 Iowa Lakes' students for the 2020-21 academic year," said Rogers.

There are still a few committees that need to make their final selections. Recipients are notified through their scholarship application.

Rogers shared a video with the Iowa Lakes Board of Trustees that highlighted work completed by the first group of students for the new Professional Dog Grooming program offered on the Emmetsburg Campus.

Jeff Soper, Chief Financial Officer, provided the board with an update on the Iowa Lakes Aviation & Airport Management program. "Over the past 12 months, the Iowa Lakes Aviation & Airport Management program has seen a significant increase in enrollment, having doubled the number of students enrolled from the previous year. With the increase in enrollment and to support the industry's needs, Iowa Lakes has made adjustments in our airplane fleet. We have purchased three Cessna 172 aircrafts and have sold other models," said Soper.
