

### Adam Doleac, to Perform at Captain's Entertainment Complex

Sony Nashville Recording Artist, Adam Doleac, will be performing Sunday, June 28, at Captain's Entertainment Complex in Arnolds Park, as part

of their NASHLO Summer Concert Series. Adam grew up in Hattiesburg, Mississippi playing both sports and music, learning how to play the drums at a young age. When it came time to attend college, Doleac chose to play baseball at the University of Southern Mississippi, his team won three Southern Mississippi Confer-

ence championships and played in the College World Series in 2009. Adam wrote his first song "That Guy" later that year, and continued playing ball. He found that music was becoming too hard to resist after his second song "Travel On" started to get a ton of hits on YouTube. Doleac traded a promising baseball career for country music and moved to Nashville in 2012 where he began to write professionally and play music with a band named after himself. In 2015, the Adam Doleac Band self-released "Dream Catcher" and soon after he landed a publishing deal with Sony/ATV, placing songs with Kenny Chesney, Darius Rucker and Rascal Flatts. Adam began his solo career in 2017 making a name for himself with the song "Whiskey's Fine" from his independent EP which caught the attention of SiriusXM's "The Highway Channel". 287 Records released a six-song EP that showcased Doleac's easygoing county pop style, which is quickly becoming a favorite on Sirius XM The Highway. In the fall of 2019 Sony Music Nashville signed Doleac to the Arista Nashville imprint. His single "Famous" spent two weeks at No. 1 on Sirius XM "The Highway's" Hot Country Countdown. 





In the early 1960s each of the songs sold over a million copies, earning gold record status. Thursday will be Beatles Day. Known also as The Fab Four, the group starred in the 1964 music comedy film, A Hard Day's Night. The film was released at the height of 'Beatlemania.' As a financial and critical success, it depicted a day in the life of *The Beatles*. The soundtrack includes a list of songs written expressly for the motion picture, such as If I Fell, And I Love Her, and I Should Have Known Better, as well as the movie's theme ...

Thursday is also the day - in 1955 - that the Broadway production of Can *Can* closed after 892 performances. The production featured music written by Cole Porter, with the song, I Love Paris. While Bing was the first to sing it more than eight decades ago, the lyrics were more recently revisited by Stacey Kent, on her 2002 tribute, *In Love Again, The Music of Richard Rodgers;* and also by the multi-talented Seth Macfarlane, on his 2011 CD, Music is Better Than Words, which also contains, Something Good, the love ballad from The Sound of Music, for which Rodgers wrote the music and the lyrics!







# Beef Quality Assurance Trainings Gradually Resume







#### COVID-19 Test Iowa Site Opening In Spirit Lake On June 22

The number of Dickinson County residents infected with COVID-19 has increased dramatically in the past month. As people from out of town visit the area, increased community

spread in the Iowa Great Lakes is likely to continue. For this reason, the Office of Governor Kim Reynolds, Lakes Regional Healthcare, and Dickinson County Emergency Management have worked



together to open a drive-through Test Iowa clinic in Spirit Lake.

The clinic will open at noon on Monday, June 22 and then be open from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm every weekday beginning Tuesday, June 23. Any Iowa resident will be able to receive a COVID-19 test for free, regardless of symptoms or potential exposure to the virus. Those with COVID-19 symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, fever, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell, headache, muscle aches) are encouraged to call Lakes Regional Healthcare's Respiratory Clinic at 712-336-6696 for guidance on whether it is best to receive a test at the Respiratory Clinic at Lakes Regional Healthcare or the Test Iowa clinic.

In order to get a COVID-19 test through the Test Iowa clinic:

1. Complete the online assessment at *www.testiowa.com*. 2. After completing the online assessment, you will receive an email from TestIowa.com that includes a bar code. Print the bar code or take a screenshot of it.

3. Go to the drive-through Test Iowa clinic in Spirit Lake, located on the Dickinson County Fairgrounds just west of the Expo Building and behind the show barns. Enter the fairgrounds at their west entrance off of 15th Street and follow the signs. No appointment is needed. Please wear a mask and bring your bar code and personal identification, such as a driver's license, with you. Please be aware that healthcare staff will be dressed in appropriate personal protective equipment including a gown, gloves, mask, and face shield. This is for your protection as well as their own.

Test results will be emailed to you within 48 to 72 hours. You can also go to Test Iowa's Patient Portal, and enter your personal identifier/bar code number to check your results. If your test results are positive, further instruction will be provided to self-quarantine and seek medical attention.

### Iowa Lakes Trustees Discuss Plan For 2020-2021 School Year

The Iowa Lakes Community College Board of Trustees met Tuesday afternoon at the SERT Facility on the Estherville Campus.

During Tuesday's meeting, Iowa Lakes Community College President, Valerie Newhouse presented a thorough plan for review of the anticipated 2020-2021 school year.

During her presentation, she shared, "The Administration at Iowa Lakes Community College continues to plan for the upcoming school year by evaluating various aspects of the college experience. Areas of focus include the college calendar and campus activities, campus housing, course instruction, continuing education offerings, and workforce training.'

Iowa Lakes plans for classes to resume on Tuesday, August 25.

"We plan to move forward with classes as previously scheduled, with a modified movein plan for students residing in our dorms. Additionally, we will conduct pre-move-in health screenings that will include temperature checks and a questionnaire," shared President Newhouse.

Iowa Lakes will implement new methods of instruction in addition to offering online and traditional classroom experiences.

According to President Newhouse, "This fall, Iowa Lakes will implement two new course offerings for Iowa Lakes' students. These offerings are LAKER LIVE and LAKER NOW.

LAKER LIVE courses allow students and faculty to participate in a face-to-face, virtual classroom through a video conferencing platform.

LAKER NOW courses offer students the same opportunity to participate live, or the flexibility to view and participate at a time convenient to their schedule.

> "Additionally, Iowa Lakes will offer online courses and traditional classroom instruction. Any traditional classroom instruction or labs will be held in smaller groups to maintain social distancing standards. Our Career and Technical programs will be held with modifications to allow for social distancing," said President Newhouse.

> President Newhouse noted, "There are many caveats to our plan. We can make changes as needed depending on the coronavirus status within the Iowa Lakes District. We will monitor and assess the recommendations or guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) for higher education institutions."

> Jolene Rogers, Executive Director of Community and Business Relations, received approval to accept a donation to the Carrington Baker Scholarship.

The Carrington Baker Scholarship has been awarded annually since 2015. Carrington was a Laker - and member of the Laker Life club, which significantly impacted his life. Cary was a strong leader in the Laker Life campus ministry at Iowa Lakes and a Youth Leader at Grandview Baptist Church. He made everyone feel welcome and valued. We have purchased three Cessna 172 aircrafts and have sold other models," said Soper.
