

Information and Safety Tips from Sheffield Utilities for Public Awareness Program (Alabama Act 94-487 and Office of Pipeline **Safety Part 192.616)**

What is Natural Gas?

Natural gas is made up of hydrocarbon gases, primarily methane, naturally occurring in rock formations deep below the earth's surface. The natural gas is withdrawn and transported to homes and businesses through an underground system of pipes.

Why use Natural Gas?

Natural gas is a fuel of choice because it is:

- 2. Clean-burning (emits few pollutants)
- 3. Plentiful
- 4. Safe

Who uses Natural Gas?

- Residential users use natural gas in their homes to fuel furnaces, pool/ spa heaters, gas lights, stoves, generators and space heaters.
- Commercial users use natural gas in businesses such as restaurants, hotels, and hospitals.
- Industrial users use natural gas for heating processes and as a fuel for the generation of steam.
- Electric utilities use natural gas to generate electricity.
- Natural gas pipeline companies use natural gas as a fuel to run compressor units.

Natural Gas Safety Precautions

Natural gas is colorless, odorless, lighter than air, and non-toxic. Breathing natural gas is not harmful as long as there is an adequate supply of fresh air to breathe along with it. Natural gas by itself will not burn, but with the proper mixture of gas and air combined with an ignition source, combustion can occur.

An odorant that smells like rotten eggs is added to natural gas so that it can be detected. The odor is a warning that natural gas may be present and, if ignited, could result in personal injury or property damage. If the smell of gas is present inside your home or business (no matter how faint or strong),

Do Not:

- 1. Smoke or strike a match.
- 2. Operate an electric switch or appliance control.
- 3. Pull any plugs from outlets.
- 4. Use a flashlight or lighter.
- 5. Use a telephone or cell phone in the building.

If you SMELL A FAINT ODOR of natural gas INSIDE YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS, check to see if any appliances have been left on accidentally or if a pilot light has been extinguished, which would cause the odor (rotten eggs). If the odor persists, TAKE NO CHANCES, get out of the house immediately, and then call us from a nearby phone or neighbor. If a STRONG OR PERSISTENT ODOR OF GAS is present IN YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS, OR IF YOU HEAR A HISSING SOUND of escaping natural gas, follow this procedure:

- 1. Get everyone out of the building immediately.
- 2. Leave the door open.
- 3. Use a neighbor's phone or cellular phone outside the building to call us.
- 4. If you SMELL OR DETECT NATURAL GAS OUTSIDE, call us.

Leaks from natural gas pipelines are extremely rare, however it is important that you know how to recognize the signs of a leak if one were to occur in your area. A strong odor, hissing sound, or dirt blowing up from a hole are signs of a leak. Move away from and upwind of the suspected leak before calling us. Do not light matches, smoke, use a cell phone or attempt to start any motor vehicles in the area of a possible gas leak.

Call Before You Dig

Whether you are building a home, installing a sprinkler system, or just planting a tree, we want you to be safe. No matter the size of the project, before you dig, grade, or excavate, the law requires you to call for all underground utilities to be located. Please contact the One-Call Center for more information on this free service. (Alabama One Call 811) If you are digging and expose a gas pipeline, call us. Proper attention to pipe that has been exposed can prevent problems later.



Alzheimer's, and has repeated urinary tract infections (UTI) treated with antibiotics whenever she becomes more confused. We're now told these likely weren't infections and the antibiotics should be avoided. How will we know if she has an infection and when it should be treated?

To improve quality of care, doctors initiated the *Choosing Wisely* campaign in 2013, which publicizes

tests and procedures found to be more often harmful, and helps seniors avoid these.

The American Geriatrics Society (AGS) and the American Medical Directors Association (AMDA), recommend that when considering if a senior has a UTI, Don't use antibiotics just because bacteria are found in the urine, unless specific urinary symptoms are also present.

Studies confirm that for seniors to have a treatable UTI, they must have urine-related symptoms, such as burning when passing urine, going more often with new incontinence, a fever, low abdominal pains. Without these symptoms, no harm is done if they do not receive antibiotics just because their urine has bacteria.

Dementia patients have been assumed to have a UTI when there's an increase in confusion. We now know most seniors in nursing homes always have bacteria in their urine (they are 'carriers'); assuming there was an infection stopped us looking for other causes of their new confusion.

In addition, the AGS and AMDA recommend the only way to test urine for this is to use a catheter: "clean-catch' specimens [peeing into a cup] are always contaminated and can

Thus, the evidence is clear: do only tests/procedures shown to be beneficial, and avoid unnecessary drugs. If your mom is more confused but has no fever, no urine-specific symptoms, then don't do a urine test; rather, look for other possible causes of confusion [drugs, irritating people/relatives!].





ONE OF MY FAVORITE authors, Isaac Asimov, wrote a book called "Runaround" in 1941. In the book, he first described the Three Laws of Robotics. Each law kind of feeds on itself creating a logic loop that is designed to keep

both robots and humans safe. The three laws are: 1. A robot may not injure a human being or, through inaction, allow a human being to come to harm. 2. A

robot must obey the orders given it by human beings except where such orders would conflict with the First Law. 3. A robot must protect its own existence as long as such protection does not conflict with

the First or Second Laws. These laws set the foundation for tons of other books exploring what happens when robot morality conflicts with human morality.

Ironically, the setting of the original book is the year 2015 and, whaddayaknow, the evil scientists at Google (and other manufacturers) have been busily testing robots that will cart us around town. After well over a million miles of testing these driverless cars on public streets, their safety record is impeccable. Eventually, this technology promises to reduce traffic injuries by 90%.

The cars are slated to be released to the general public as soon as 2017 and will necessarily have to have some programming that is analogous to Asimov's Three Laws and that's where it gets interesting.

Let's says you and your driverless car are driving along a mountain road when a sudden gust of wind sends your car careening towards a bus stop filled with children. Shall the car be programmed to run off the side of the mountain or plow into the group of kids? The most logical answer is to save the most number of

human lives by sending you off the mountain. But is that the choice you would make under the same circumstances? Maybe. Maybe not.

Let's say I put a large hole in my head and need to get myself to a hospital quickly? Can I push a button that makes the car drive aggressively? If Donald Trump needed to borrow my car the next time he visits us, will I be allowed to program it to be a little less careful?

Up to 90% of all traffic accidents are caused by human error. Driverless car technology has already been proven to drastically reduce that number. Still, what idiot would dare buy a car that promises to sacrifice it's driver if it comes to a conflict in the laws? Well, this idiot!

Alas, when the rubber meets the road, it's actually extremely rare that any driver is forced into these kinds of moral dilemmas but these dilemmas are going to have to be addressed somehow. This is the kind of weird stuff I ponder while I'm supposed to be concentrating on driving. So y'all steer clear until I buy my own robot car.





PERSONAL VS. BUSINESS







SPORTS RELATED INJURIES

As a personal injury firm we get a lot of questions about sports related injuries to minor children. Often these injuries occur at a school or during a school sponsored event. Occasionally, we will see a child or teenage athlete injured pretty badly and often as the result of a flagrant foul committed by an opposing player. Outraged parents want to sue someone and ask us about lawsuits arising out of sports injuries.

Schools, school officials, teachers, coaches and school boards are all protected by the

concept of sovereign immunity. Sovereign immunity is a concept that comes to us from English common law when the kings and queens of England were thought to have been anointed by God. They were deemed immune from the courts of justice here on earth as they were beyond its earthly influence. Governments still retain sovereign immunity especially as it protects the governmental pocketbook.

Generally speaking, governmental immunity or sovereign immunity applies to employees of a governmental agency in and about the performance of their duties. Obviously if they are not at work, but are merely citizens violating traffic regulations and injuring someone, they are not immune.

An intentional injury by an opposing player could be the basis of both a criminal and civil penalty. This does occasionally occur. The problem with a civil lawsuit against a minor for injuring someone in a sporting event is that minors have no money and you cannot insure against an intentional act. If you intend to hurt someone and do, there is no insurance coverage to protect you.

The only cases that have been truly successful are those unfortunate cases where there is a failure of equipment such as a football helmet that is designed to protect against injury and injury occurs. Those cases have been successfully litigated as product liability cases.


