


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
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Sarbequeo Ingredients

- 1 fresh pineapple
- ¹/₄ cup rum
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves

DIRECTIONS

Step 1: Peel the pineapple and, leaving it whole, cut out the center core. Slice into 8 rings, and place them in a shallow glass dish or resealable plastic bag. In a small bowl, mix together the rum, brown sugar, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and cloves. Pour marinade over the pineapple, cover, and refrigerate for 1 hour, or overnight.

Step 2: Preheat grill for high heat. Lightly oil grate.

Step 3: Grill pineapple rings 15 minutes, turning once, or until outside is dry and char marked. Serve with remaining marinade.



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
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
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ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION FOR JUNE 23RD PRIMARY

Governor Cuomo's executive order allows for voters to request an absentee ballot for the June 23rd Primary Election. You must check off "temporary illness due to COVID-19" for its reasoning. You can do this by visiting nycabsentee.com on a computer, tablet or smart sending phone, by an e-mail absenteeJune2020@boe.nvc or by calling (888) 868-3692. You may call me at (718) 892-1161 and I will personally help you obtain one. Lastly, please be sure to continue to remind your loved ones and neighbors to complete the US Census immediately. You can do so by visiting mycensus2020.gov on a computer, tablet or smart phone or by dialing (844) 330-2020 for English. For Spanish speakers, please dial (844) 468-2020.

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
