EDMONT PET

This year is our 45th anniversary! In 1975, a small group of area citizens decided to combine individual efforts into an organization that could make a difference in the lives of the animals. The Danville-Pittsylvania County Humane Society was formed and incorporated.

The small group operated as a foster home organization that provided very small spay/neuter assistance, as well as assisting the animal control officers return dogs to owners and finding potential adoptive homes for shelter animals.

In 1983, the newly-named Danville Area Humane Society contracted with the City of Danville to operate and maintain the animal shelter. The shelter at this time consisted of a small office area and nine dog runs. At its own cost, the Humane Society renovated the dog runs, and built 28 small/medium dog runs, as well as a small cat area. On June 1, 1984, DAHS began operating the shelter. On that first day, over 100 animals were released to the shelter by their owners, and by the end of the first week, 300 dogs and cats had been released.

In 1989, DAHS renegotiated the contract with the City. The State Veterinarian at this time also gave notice that the shelter needed to be expanded in order to handle the large number of animals being received. A new contract with the City was signed, giving DAHS more funds with which to operate the shelter.

At that time, the City also paid \$89,000 to build the cat room, treatment room, and isolation areas.

In 1993, we received notice that DAHS has been named as one of the nine beneficiaries of an estate worth \$29 million. The E. Stuart James Grant Charitable Trust was established by American National Bank, and through disbursements from this foundation, we have been able to

expand our work. The spay/neuter and adoption subsidy program is funded through this foundation. In addition, many shelter and equipment upgrades have been possible.

In August of 2007, an expansion to the dog area was completed, giving the shelter an additional 28 dog runs.

In April of 2012, we opened the E. Stuart James Grant Adoption Center. This expansion provided two cat colony rooms, a conference center, a lobby, additional office space, additional dog runs, a kitchen, a grooming room, and rooms for small companion animals.

In January 2019, completed a renovation of the oldest part of the shelter. The double-decker dog run area we built in 1983 was gutted and turned into a huge, updated cat room. The cat room was turned into a walk-through area, and a cat isolation area was built.

ΔII of these shelter renovations and expansions have helped us lengthen the time we hold animals, as well as lessening the spread of disease and increasing the comfort of the animals. Volunteers help us by enriching their lives with attention and walks outside (for the dogs).

Uncle Sam Doorstop

Iron doorstops became a hot collectible with rising prices about 1990. A 1985 book picturing doorstops and several auctions, which included rare doorstops, sent collectors searching for examples of the 1930s and '40s collectible. They became so popular that thousands of copies were made, many from the original molds. Bright new paint identifies many recent doorstops, but some, with artificial wear and tear, are good enough to fool collectors today. It is almost impossible to break an iron figure, so many iron doorstops still are available with little damage. Top prices are paid for doorstops in great condition with almost all of the original

paint. And, of course, rarity adds value. This original Uncle Sam doorstop has the words "For the Open Door" on the base. The words "For the Open Door" had a political meaning, and it was not just a statement about how the doorstop was used. A complicated "Open Door" policy was promoted by the U.S. in 1899. It suggested that all countries should allow China and other countries to trade with no tariffs, no special harbor charges, and with no interference or attempts to divide China. There was another Open Door political discussion in 1922, and this discussion probably is the one mentioned on the doorstop. China opened special investment zones in 1928. There were more international discussions and changes in 1978 concerned with China's industry, trade and foreign investment.

The Uncle Sam doorstop is rare and desirable, and this one, with great paint, sold several years ago at a Bertoia Auction for \$21,240. The 1985 value was \$250.

A • The Couroc Co. was founded in • Monterey, California, by Guthrie Courvoisier in 1948. The name is derived from the first four letters of his last name, "Cour," with "oc" added to make it sound like "rock." Most Couroc items were made of black resin and embedded with coins, wood, metal or objects from nature. Courvoisier died in 1963 and the company closed in the 1990s. The value of your tray is about \$30.



This Uncle Sam doorstop sold for \$21,240 in a New Jersey auction. It was listed as worth \$250 in 1985. Vintage doorstops have all gone up in value, especially those with the original paint.




HOLLYWOOD — Just imagine a meeting, a month or so ago, when HBO Max executives were trying to figure out how to launch their new streaming service to compete with Netflix, Disney+, Amazon Prime, etc. How do we get noticed? Let's pull the

greatest film of all time, "Gone With the Wind," from our service because of the objections of Oscar-winning screenwriter John Ridley (whose screenplay for the remake of "Ben-Hur" tanked and was the biggest disappointment of 2016). A Harris poll a few years back found "Gone With the Wind" is still America's favorite film, and it's been seen by more people than any other film in motion picture history.

Why should we care if HBO Max doesn't show it? It can be seen often on Turner Classic Movies (TCM), TBS and TNT. Should we start burning copies of the book or never watch this classic film again? Should it be shunned like "Birth of a Nation," the 1915 D.W. Griffith classic silent film that causes outcries every time it's revived? No doubt by the time you read this, "Gone

With the Wind" will have been restored to HBO Max (yawn).

When I dined with Butterfly McQueen in 1970, she told me, "Mr. Selznick hired me to play Prissy a year before he went into production. I was the first person signed and was paid to wait for production to start. No detail was too big or too small." HBO Max, why don't you try pulling "The Wizard of Oz," there must be people in Salem against witches and riding tornadoes? Just asking.

"Evil Dead" fans are going to get "Evil Dead Now," another sequel of the classic 1981 horror film. Bruce Campbell, who starred in the previous sequels, will only be a producer on this one. One reason may be because he's now an ordained minister in Jacksonville, Oregon, who often performs weddings. Say, "I Do!"



Taking Care of Your Child's Health and **Wellness during COVID-19**

Like many aspects of daily life, the COVID-19 pandemic has changed how we think about and access healthcare these days. For families, that includes pediatric care for children. We asked Aubrey McBryde, a certified pediatric nurse practitioner at Sovah Pediatrics Danville, to talk about the importance of continuing to seek proper care for your child and answer some frequently asked questions regarding children's health during this time.

Q: Can I still contact my child's pediatrician to talk about a health issue?

A. Absolutely. It is always important and okay for you to contact your child's pediatrician about any health or wellness issues your child may be experi-



Depending on your child's issue and symptoms, your pediatrician may want you to come in for a visit or - if deemed appropriate - schedule you for a virtual telehealth visit.

Q: Is it okay to schedule an appointment for my child's annual well visit?

A. Yes. Well visits are an essential part of keeping your child on the road to good health. They provide the opportunity for your child's pediatric provider to conduct a comprehensive evaluation, monitor your child's growth and developmental milestones, ensure that they are up-to-date on immunizations and answer any questions you may have about your child's health.

Now might even be a particularly good time to schedule your child's annual physical. Pediatric offices are taking extra precautions to protect the health and safety of patients and their families, such as scheduling well child exams in the beginning of the day and sick visits later. Your pediatric health care provider may even have a few more openings for these types of visits than usual. Additionally, scheduling an annual physical will help your child be ready for the return of school sports and other activities that require an annual physical and immunization

Q: Should my child wear a mask or cloth face covering?

A: Children do not need to wear a mask or cloth face covering if they are at home and not exposed to someone with COVID-19. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that everyone two years and older wear a cloth face covering that covers their nose and mouth when out in the community. Cloth face coverings can help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and should be worn in addition to other measures like social distancing, frequent hand-cleaning and other preventive measures. It is important to remember that cloth face coverings are not intended to protect the person wearing the covering. Rather, they help prevent the spread of illness to others and is especially helpful if the wearer is asymptomatic and unaware that they could be passing illness on to others.

Based on these recommendations, you may want to consider a mask or cloth face covering for your child if you are taking them into a public place where it can be difficult to maintain safe social distances, like grocery stores and other public places. Additionally, if you are visiting your child's pediatrician, they may ask that your child be masked when they enter the office for their safety and the safety of

Children under two should not wear a mask due to the potential for suffocation. Those who have trouble breathing, are incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove their face covering without help are also exempted from this recommendation. If your child has special health needs and cannot wear a traditional mask or cloth face covering, you should talk to your pediatrician about other safety options.

Q: How can I help my child cope with what is happening right now?

A: Our current events can be a scary and unsettling time for children, but there are some things you can do to help them, including open discussions about what may be bothering them; answering their questions with simple but honest lan-

Patrons should not visit the market if they are ill and maintain six feet of space between other shoppers. Staff are asking that families only send one person per house inside the building to shop at a time.

There will only be one entrance and one exit, staff members will direct traffic flow and monitor the number of customers in the building at a time. Patrons are asked to not linger and socialize inside the building during their shopping experience.


