## SOUTHERN OKRA \& TOMATO Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 2 (16 ounce) cans whole tomatoes, cut up
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 (10 ounce) package frozen cut okra
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 2 teaspoons dried basil
- $1 / 2$ teaspoon hot pepper sauce
- salt and pepper
- 2 tablespoons butter, cut up
- 1 cup cornbread stuffing mix
- $3 / 4$ cup shredded cheddar cheese


## Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
In a small bowl, stir together the cornstarch and 2
tablespoons of the juice from the
tomatoes; set aside.
In a large saucepan, cook and stir the onion and garlic in the 1 tablespoon of butter until
tender. Carefully stir in the undrained tomatoes, the okra, sugar, basil, hot pepper sauce,
and salt and pepper.
Stir the cornstarch mixture, then add it to the vegetable mixture. Cook and stur until the mixture is thickened and bubbly. Remove from heat.
Pour the vegetable mixture into a 2 -quart rectangular baking dish. Dot with the 2
tablespoons butter. Cover and bake in the oven for 20 minutes.
Remove the casserole from the oven. Sprinkle with the stuffing mix and the cheese.
Return to the oven; bake about 5 minutes more or until stuffing mix and cheese are

## BAKED BEET CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

4 tablespoons butter, melted 4 tablespoons cornstarch 1 cup water
4 tablespoons brown sugar $1 / 4$ teaspoon salt


3 tablespoons horseradish
4 cups cooked beets
$1 / 3$ cup dry breadcrumbs

## 3 tablespoons butter, cold

## Directions

Blend butter and cornstarch adding water gradually and cook until mixture starts to thicken, stirring constantly.
Add sugar, salt, horseradish and beets.
Pour into greased baking dish and top with dry bread crumbs and dot with butter.
Bake about 20 minutes at 350 degrees or until crumbs are browned.

## KALE \& CAULIFLOWER CASSEROLE Ingredients

- $11 / 2$ pounds red potatoes, scrubbed well and quartered
- $1 / 2$ head medium cauliflower, cored and cut into florets into florets
- Kosher salt
- 1 large leek, pale green and white parts only, chopped
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Freshly ground black
 pepper
- 1 bunch kale, stems removed and chopped (6 ounce bunch)
- $3 / 4$ cup whole milk
- $1 / 3$ cup sour cream
- 1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan
- 2 tablespoons butter, cut into pats


## Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees $F$.
Add the potatoes and cauliflower to a large pot and cover with cold water.
Season with a big pinch of salt and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat to a simmer and cook until tender, 15 to 20 minutes. Drain the potatoes and cauliflower in a colander.
Add the chopped leek to a small bowl and cover with water. Let sit and soak for a few minutes to remove all the grit. Drain well and pat dry with paper towels.
Heat the olive oil in a large skillet. Add the leeks and saute until tender, 3 to 4 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.
Add the kale and saute until wilted down and softened, about 5 minutes longer.
Sorry I had to cancel at the last minute, but it took me forever to think of an excuse I've never used before.

Add the milk to the skillet and bring up to a simmer.
Stir in the drained potatoes and cauliflower and mash all together.
Stir in the sour cream and Parmesan for some extra flavor. Taste and adjust the flavor as needed. Add the whole shebang to a 2 -quart baking dish and dot with the butter.
Bake until golden brown on top, about 35 minutes.

## GREEN TOMATO CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

- 6 green tomatoes, cut into 1 -inch cubes
- 3 stalks celery, cut into $1 / 2$-inch pieces
- 16 green onions (white and pale green parts only), chopped
- 1 bunch cilantro, chopped
- 5 tablespoons soy sauce
- $1 / 4$ cup olive oil
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar

- $1 / 2$ teaspoon ground black pepper
- $1 / 2$ teaspoon salt
- $1 / 2$ teaspoon red pepper flakes


## DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees $f(175$ degrees $c$ ).
2. Mix green tomatoes, celery, green onions, and cilantro together in a 2-quart casserole dish. Whisk soy sauce, olive oil, brown sugar, vinegar, black pepper,
3. Salt, and red pepper flakes together in a bowl; pour over vegetable mixture. Toss to coat.
4. Bake in the preheated oven until vegetables are tender, about 45 minutes; stir about 20 minutes into cooking to redistribute sauce.

## ASPARAGUS ONION CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

- 1 pound fresh asparagus, cut into 1 -inch pieces or 2 packages ( 10 ounces each) asparagus cuts, thawed
- 2 medium onions, sliced
- 5 tablespoons butter, divided
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1 cup $2 \%$ milk
- 3 ounces cream cheese, cubed
- 1 teaspoon salt

- $1 / 8$ teaspoon pepper
- $1 / 2$ cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup soft bread crumbs


## Directions

1. In a large skillet, saute asparagus and onions in 1 tablespoon of butter until crisp-tender, about 8 minutes. Transfer to an ungreased 1-1/2-qt.
baking dish.
2. In a large saucepan, melt 2 tablespoons butter. Stir in flour until smooth; gradually add milk. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened.
3. Reduce heat. Add the cream cheese, salt and pepper; stir until cheese is melted. Pour over vegetables. Sprinkle with cheddar cheese. Melt remaining butter; toss with bread crumbs. Sprinkle over casserole.
4. Bake, uncovered, at $350^{\circ}$ for $35-40$ minutes or until heated through.

## CARROT COIN CASSEROLE

## Ingredients

- 12 medium carrots, sliced
- 1 large onion, cut into $1 / 4$-inch slices
- 2 cups frozen peas
- $1-1 / 2$ cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 4 tablespoons butter, softened, divided
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- $1 / 4$ teaspoon ground nutmeg

- 2-1/2 cups whole milk
- 1 cup crushed butter-flavored crackers (about 25 crackers)


## Directions

1. Place carrots and small amount of water in a saucepan; cover and cook over medium heat until crisp-tender, about 6 minutes. Add onion; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 4-6 minutes or until onion is crisp-tender. Drain. Add peas and toss.
2. Place 4 cups in a greased shallow 3 -qt. baking dish; sprinkle with cheese. Top with remaining vegetables. In a saucepan over medium heat, melt 1 tablespoon butter. Stir in flour, salt, pepper and nutmeg until smooth. Gradually add milk, stirring constantly. bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Pour over the vegetables.
3. In a small saucepan or skillet, combine cracker crumbs and remaining butter; cook and stir over medium heat until toasted. Sprinkle over casserole.
4. Bake, uncovered, at $350^{\circ}$ for 30-40 minutes or until bubbly.
