Mueske Family Foundation To Match All YMCA Donations up to \$100,000 Through August 1

The Mueske Family Foundation is leading the way to help alleviate the financial strain the YMCA of the Okobojis is experiencing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The foundation announced today a \$100,000 match for all donations received by the YMCA until August 1, 2020.

"We recognize the pandemic has severely impacted the YMCA's ability to generate income and we wanted to help," said Duane Mueske of the Mueske Family Foundation.

Like many other non-profits around the United States and the world, the YMCA of the Okobojis had to make difficult decisions the past few months to adhere to the guidelines and mandates set by local authorities.

The Bedell Family YMCA has since been unable to offer their full breadth of programming, and Camp Foster had to make the difficult decision to suspend the 2020 overnight camp season. This loss of camp, program, and membership fees has created a projected financial loss of nearly \$1,000,000 for the Y as a whole.

To curb the impact, the YMCA has announced several recent changes, including permanent closure of the Spirit Lake HLPC, staffing reductions, and restructuring of debt. Additionally, a fundraising event is planned to be held at Camp Foster on July 31 in place of the Strong Kids event that was postponed this spring.

"We'd like to thank the Mueske Family Foundation and all the dedicated donors who have given to the Y's Annual Strong Kids Campaign this year," said Andrew Fisher, CEO of the YMCA of the Okobojis. "If you're someone who hasn't and would like to make a donation, I'd encourage you to make that donation before August 1 to take advantage of the donation match and help make those dollars work even harder for the Y. We can't thank the Mueske Family Foundation enough for stepping up and helping the Y during this difficult time. It's refreshing to know there are people out there like Duane and Willia who recognize the importance the Y plays in the community and are willing to help in a time of need."

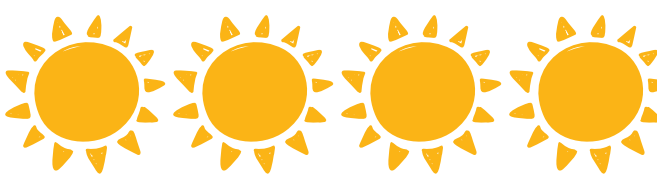

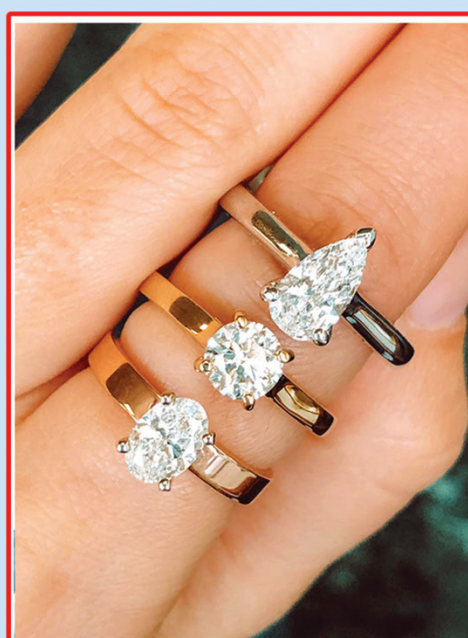

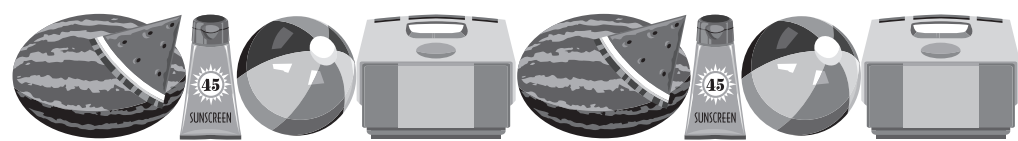

IRRMA postpones inductions 'til 2021

While we can't say the announcement that the Iowa Rock 'n' Roll Music Association's Labor Day weekend Hall of Fame Induction would be delayed until Memorial Day weekend in 2021 was a surprise, it is just one more example of the toll COVID 19 has taken not just on the health scene, but in the lives of those who work and play — innocently and healthily — in the Iowa Great Lakes Region. As executive director Clay Norris noted in his statement, "Safety for our inductees, our staff and volunteers, and our patrons, is and always has been our top priority." So be it.

The good news here, is that IF things go as now planned, IRRMA will quite properly bookend the summer of 2021 on the campus of the UofO...

Another event we missed this year was hearing *The Northwest Iowa Jazz Band* perform at Estherville's annual 4th of July Flight Breakfast, which was also a COVID casualty. The air show and pancake feed is an annual fund raiser for the projects of the Estherville service clubs. And the band has always kept things lively...

A bigger fun event was going to be Estherville's Sweet Corn Days, which would have spanned the last weekend in July — had it not also been cancelled. That will leave 500 dozen ears of sweet corn (6,000 ears!) looking for new shelf space in the marketplace. We are told that provider Jason Wirth, of Jake's Sweet Corn, in Thompson, says he'll have no problem selling that much extra sweet corn, as it is only a small percentage of the 420,000 ears his crews grow, pick, and sell each year...

A note of sadness sounded over the weekend with the passing of Freddy Cole, who performed at the Pearson Lakes Art Center at least twice, if not three times over the years.

Freddy was the last of a Chicago dynasty best-known for brother Nat 'King' Cole, and two less-recognized brothers, Eddie and Ike, who also had good music careers.

Freddy's style was best exemplified with his choice of easy-going songs that made his baritone voice and deft touch on the ivories a true trademark.

One of the songs Freddy performed at the PLAC, *The Best Man*, came with a twist on his 1990 CD, *I'm Not My Brother, I'm Me*. You can listen to it and many others, on *You-Tube*. See if you get to Freddy's punch line before he sings it!

After a relative dearth on the entertainment scene since March, there will be at least two live shows to celebrate with on Bastille Day, Tuesday, July 14th. Neil Dover, who has twice performed at The Barn in Okoboji, will be returning to campus to perform at The Okoboji Store restaurant, from 7-9:00; as a part of his tour from the Gulf Shores and Florida panhandle area. While up north he'll be making stops in Wisconsin, Michigan, Minnesota, and Nebraska, too — though The Okoboji Store will be his only Iowa stop.

Just up the road a piece, the Pearson Lakes Art Center will be hosting *Farewell Angelina* in its outdoor amphitheatre that same evening. While there will be some seating available, this is a BYOC (chair) party. Just so you know, *Farewell...* is an all-female group of vocalists and multi-instrumentalists. We're betting reservations are in order for both these shows...

The Little Swan Lake Winery will accept reservations; but they're not generally required. And this week will see Dave Rowley on the stage in the barn, Thursday night, from 6-8:00; the old favorite *TBA** on the same stage; Saturday, also from 6-8:00; and *Coelmo*, Sunday, from 4-6:00.

(*Little Ol' Winemaker Scott Benjamin promises he will have a band other than *TBA* booked for Saturday — even if he has to take the stage with his kazoo and didgeridoo!)

Looking ahead more than a week, the Okoboji Summer Theatre Association will hold its annual summer meeting on Thursday, July 16th, in the rehearsal room in the new Weaver Commons building.

The meeting of the Theatre's volunteers will include some information on the postponed 2020 season with limited plans for 2021, along with election of officers. Those interested in being a part of the organization are invited to attend the 5:30 session which should last about an hour. For more information, call John Barrow, at 612-845-6963.

Recent highs with humidity to match have made research director RD even dizzier than usual, as the song she has come up with on this first July 2020 edition of *RAMBOLing* is *Sleigh Ride in July* — written by Jimmy Van Heusen and Johnny Burke, and recorded by Julie London for her 1956 *Calendar Girl* LP; then in 1959 by Benny Carter for *Aspects*, his album of monthly salutes. Alumni of *Class 105* were used to celebrating Carter's song of the month on the first Sunday of every month...

The first Tuesday in July (today) is also Strawberry Sundae Day, which RD says calls for some low-calorie *Incense* and *Peppermints* in the song of the same name by the Los Angeles-based rock group *Strawberry Alarm Clock*. *Incense...* was written by members of the group, and clocked in at Number One on the pop charts for one week in the fall of 1967. SAC's other claim to fame came on January 22, 1968, when they appeared on the premiere of NBC's sketch comedy TV series, *Rowan and Martin's Laugh In...*

One possibly good thing to come out of the COVID pandemic is the number of both guys and gals who are taking to baking a variety of breads and other delicious goodies. Everyone enjoying a sandwich owes Otto Frederick Rohwedder a "Thank You," for his efforts in the development of the first automatic bread-slicing machine. RD notes this as Rohwedder was born 140 years ago today, in Davenport.

After graduating from the Illinois College of Optometry, Rohwedder opted to become a jeweler. So it was his third career choice as an inventor that gave us the bread-slicing machine that made him famous. And it's another novelty number, *(I Like) Bread and Butter*, that fits RD's bill for the related song. A pop vocal trio, *The Newbeats*, had the hit with it in 1964. The song has since been used in commercials for SPAM, Doritos, and Quaker Rice Cakes...

Boston-born composer Jimmy McHugh was born on July 10, 1894, and is still considered one of the most prolific songwriters from the 1920s to the 1950s, with more than 500 songs to his credit. One of McHugh's well-known efforts, *It's a Most Unusual Day*, (written in collaboration with Songwriters Hall of Fame lyricist Harold Adamson), is from the 1948 motion picture *A Date With Judy*, which quickly became the signature song of the movie's star, Jane Powell. It has since been covered by a variety of artists like June Christy, with *The Stan Kenton Orchestra* (1960), Andre Previn (1964), and Michael Feinstein on his 1989 release, *The M.G.M. album...*

2020 Clay County Fair Postponed until 2021

The Clay County Fair Association announced today that the 2020 edition of "The World's Greatest County Fair" will not be held and will be postponed to September 11-19, 2021.

The decision, announced following a vote by the Fair Executive Committee, was made amid concerns over the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. After weeks of exploring various options, it became clear that the Fair could not protect the health and safety of fairgoers, staff, volunteers, 4-H/FFA youth, exhibitors, vendors, sponsors, and entertainers during the nine-day event.

"The decision to postpone the Fair came with emotion and somewhat disbelief that it was really happening," said Fair Association Board Chairman Charlie Elser. "But with lots of input from our partners and work by our staff, the decision was the right one. It's time to move forward and think about 2021."

Despite the postponement of the Fair, 4-H/FFA livestock competitions will be held this fall. Details will be available soon from Iowa State University Extension Clay County.

Below is a full statement from Fair CEO/Manager Jeremy Parsons:

"For the past several weeks, we have gathered information, talked with public health authorities, and dialogued with our partners all in an attempt to fulfill the Fair's mission of providing a "safe family atmosphere" in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. After exploring all options, the answer is clear. We simply cannot. The Clay County Fair will not be held in 2020.

The absolute minimum to keep our entire Fair family safe would be following the current public health recommendations of social distancing and increased sanitation. Unfortunately, we discovered that implementing these measures would have eliminated some of our greatest Fair traditions and made other traditions unrecognizable. We couldn't imagine limiting the standing-room-only crowds at the draft horse show or the 4-H beef show. Fifty percent capacity at our free entertainment tents? No way. We didn't want partially empty exhibit buildings so we could properly socially distance our vendors. For those who had already purchased reserved Grandstand tickets, we would have been forced to move or refund your seats to keep everyone separate. We didn't like the thought of making your family wait in socially distanced lines to enjoy Grandpa's Barn or the Depot.

No matter how hard we tried, we couldn't find a way to give you the entire "World's Greatest County Fair" experience that you have come to love, expect, and deserve.

While we cannot give you the Fair this year, we are working hard to find safe ways that you can still create blue ribbon memories. Opportunities for our local 4-H/FFA youth and local non-profits are at the forefront of that attempt, and details will be released in the coming weeks.

Our Fair is just like your home. A strong foundation is essential for it to be secure. For the Fair, our foundation is you – our Board, staff, volunteers, 4-H/FFA youth, exhibitors, vendors, sponsors, entertainers, and fairgoers. This year, however, our foundation is shaky at best. The Fair and many of our non-profit partners need large groups of volunteers and employees to make the Fair a success. In a normal year, it is difficult to find the help; this year, it would be nearly impossible. Many people are not comfortable being around crowds for nine consecutive days, and the effect of a possible outbreak that could occur in the middle of the Fair is a risk we are not willing to take.

Also just like your home, the Fair cannot be built in a day. Our decision must be made now. While it would be nice to see into the future and know what September would be like in this unprecedented time, we don't have that luxury. We must make educated decisions based on what we know today. Waiting any longer could have damaging effects to our many Fair partners and the Fair itself. Preparing for the Fair requires financial commitment for many, including us, and we can't wind up anything that can't be unwound.

For more than a century, your unwavering support has made us "The World's Greatest County Fair" and we cannot thank you enough. Just like you, we are disappointed that we won't be together this September. More than that, we are heartbroken because we know this decision will impact each of you directly, and our community as a whole. However, while this was a tough decision, it is also the most responsible decision to ensure the safety of our entire Fair family, the community, and the long-term stability of the Fair itself.

When this is all over, we know that Clay County, northwest Iowa and the entire region will need our Fair more than ever. And, just as we have done for 103 years, we will be ready."

This marks the fifth time in the 103-year history of "The World's Greatest County Fair" that the Fair will not be held. From 1942-1945, the Fair was suspended due to World War II. The 2021 Clay County Fair will be September 11-19.

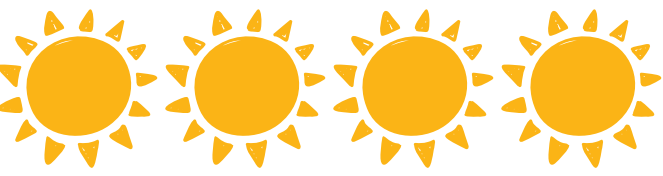

Drew Baldrige to Perform at Captains Entertainment Complex

Location Change For Spirit Lake's COVID-19 Test Iowa Clinic

Dickinson County's COVID-19 Test Iowa Clinic is moving to a new location. Beginning Monday, July 6, the clinic will be located at the Lakes Area Hockey Association Rink at 3800 Sunner Avenue in Spirit Lake. It will continue to be a drive-through clinic.

In order to set up the clinic, the hours for Monday, July 6 will be 9:00am until 5:00pm. On Tuesday, July 7, and thereafter, the clinic will be open from 7:00am until 5:00pm every weekday. At this point the clinic will be available through July 17. At that point, it will be determined whether to keep it open or not based on need.

The local Test Iowa Clinic has been open since June 22. Since then, 1,576 COVID-19 tests have been completed and 73 people have been positive, which is about 4.6 percent of the tests. Any Iowa resident is able to get tested for free, so it is not known how many of the 73 positive cases are residents of Dickinson County.

Dickinson County's first positive case was on March 26 and since then, the total number of positive COVID-19 cases in Dickinson County has increased to nearly 300. Six Dickinson County residents have been hospitalized and two have passed away.

Lakes Regional Healthcare strongly encourages residents and visitors in the area to practice safe social distancing and wear face masks. Spirit Of Harmony Chorus Celebrates 40 Years

The Spirit of Harmony Chorus, which has grown from a chorus of new-to-barbershop singers to a chorus who has competed internationally 4 times, is celebrating its 40th anniversary this year.

Spirit of Harmony began meeting at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Spirit Lake in October 1979 with 31 women present. The group was chartered with the Sweet Adelines International organization in May 1980 under the direction of Ken VanderSloot. Their first regional competition was in March 1981 in Iowa City. The next year they competed in Ames and won the Most Improved Chorus award winning 8th place. Judy Weipert was their director from 1982 to 1984. In 1984 Jane Ford served as director until 1999. Judy again took over the director spot in 1999 and still is the director of Spirit of Harmony Chorus.

The chorus never looked back and continued to grow in strength and ability, all while building lasting friendships and just having a great time singing a cappella music with each other. From 1988 to 2019 Spirit of Harmony has won First Place Small Chorus 25 times; Second Place Overall Chorus 6 times; Third Place Overall Chorus 8 times; Most Improved Chorus 3 times with a total of 49 winning medals at the regional level.

Harmony Classic is an International competition for small and medium size choruses. The small choruses have 30 members or less and medium choruses, 31 to 59 members. To be chosen to compete at the international Harmony Classic, a chorus must have one of the 5th highest scores in the world, in their division, from their regional competition. The top five choruses in each division are invited to attend the Harmony Classic. With hundreds of choruses in those 2 divisions around the world, to place in the top 5 is quite an accomplishment. Spirit of Harmony, from the small chorus division, has competed at the international Harmony Classic four times. They placed 5th in Greenville, South Carolina, in 2007; 4th in San Antonio, Texas, in 2009; 3rd in Houston, Texas, in 2011 and 5th in Baltimore, Maryland, in 2014. In 2019 Spirit of Harmony qualified with their highest score ever and was invited to the International Competition in Louisville, Kentucky, this October, but the competition was cancelled due to the COVID-19 virus. They hope to be able to compete in St. Louis, Missouri, in 2021.

Presently the chorus has 33 members. Along with competing, they also enjoy entertaining a variety of groups. They have consistently sung at The Okoboji Summer Theatre prior to theatre performances, performed at the Clay County Fair and at various town celebrations, reunions, business gatherings and many other places. They love to entertain their audiences! Members come from Arnolds Park, Emmetsburg, Estherville, Lake Park, Milford, Spirit Lake, Spencer, Battle Creek, Wallingford and Lakefield and Marshall, Minnesota.

In a normal year the chorus meets on Monday nights at 7:00 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Spirit Lake. Any woman who enjoys singing has been invited to join them at a rehearsal to join in the fun and learning. However, during this time of COVID-19 their rehearsals have taken a different turn. "Rehearsals" are still on Mondays at 7:00, but right now are in the form of ZOOM. This has been a time for members to greet each other, participate in physical and vocal warmups, or perhaps play a musical game. They sing through their current repertoire along with new music by using chorus recordings and learning tracks. They do an old fashioned roll call, (remember grade school?), but this is different. We share something a little different each week. One week may be our favorite piece of jewelry, the next might be the top 40 song the year we graduated. They get to know a little something about members they wouldn't necessarily learn while on the risers. They would love to have you join them at a ZOOM rehearsal. To join the chorus at a rehearsal, just email our ZOOM coordinator at trubis@q.com and she will get the ZOOM login information to you. They are looking forward to the time when they will be back at Immanuel Lutheran Church, on the risers in their regular spot, listening for the pitch from the pitch pipe and watching their director to start them singing again – ALL together.
