Questions from the Heart

My doctor told me that I have a problem with the blood supply to my heart and that I need a coronary angiogram. He said he is going to stick me in the groin, but I'm really uncomfortable with this. I'll have to lie down for six hours afterwards, but I have frequent back pain. I also heard that there can be a lot of complications with this procedure. Are there any alternatives? If so, what are they?

You're correct in that you have to lie down for about six hours after a traditional coronary angiogram. Coronary angiograms require that cardiologists introduce a **catheter** – a thin tube inserted in your artery and guided near your heart – to determine blockages near the heart, typically using the **femoral artery** in your groin. This

is called a **transfemoral catheterization.**However, there are many complications that can arise from inserting a catheter through your femoral artery. For instance, you could develop AV fistula, aneurysms, or a hematoma with the transfemoral approach. Also, because the transfemoral artery is a large artery, there is even a *risk of death* from exsanguination, or blood loss. Elderly and obese patients are at an especially increased risk of bleeding complications from transfemoral catheterization.

So are there alternatives to this method? The simple answer to your question is yes.

By inserting a catheter through the radial artery in your wrist, a coronary angiogram can be a **minimally invasive** procedure. Using the radial artery to insert a catheter is called **transradial catheterization**.

Most people you know have probably had a coronary angiogram via a femoral artery catheterization. In 2008, when I first started practicing in Florence, less than 3% of angiograms in the United States were done via the radial artery. According to a study from 2015, now almost 30% of angiograms in the United States are done this way. All over the world, 70% of these angiograms are performed via the radial artery, and in some countries, this percentage is more than 90%.

Why? Well, there are actually many benefits to using the radial artery instead of the femoral artery. Studies show that using the radial artery means fewer chances of complications occurring. Because the radial artery is smaller than the femoral artery, there is less risk of bleeding, AV fistula, aneurysms, or a hematoma. Also, the risk of death from exsanguination is virtually eliminated with a radial artery catheterization. In fact, studies report that the recovery is quicker when using the radial artery. You are able to walk immediately after the procedure - as opposed to the femoral artery catheterization which requires you to lie down afterwards. This is especially good news for patients with back pain, and this ultimately leads to a much shorter hospital stay, a lower cost to the patient, and less discomfort

The YMCA Board of Directors last week proudly announced that the borrowed funds funds connected to this endeavor have been successfully repaid five years ahead of schedule. At a gathering of Y supporters, community leaders, and past and present board members, acqueline Broder, current Board Chair, thanked the Shoals community for the support and confidence it has shown the YMCA of the Shoals throughout the expansion.

Featured board members Doug Tallman, Dr. Gil Griggs, Charles Crow, John Lehrter, and Tom Frith each average over 25 years of service to the Y. They gave a moving look back, telling their stories of the Y's history from humble beginnings at the corner of Walnut and Tuscaloosa Streets in Florence. Tallman literally gave a 'Rocky' shout-out to Mr. E. Stanley Robbins with a fist pump, "Yo, Mr. Robbins - We did

Robbins, for whom the facility is named, insisted that we would persevere, and he provided startup capital for the Y's current location on Helton Drive.

Crow then shared that at one point "They had a director, an administrative assistant, and one donated bike for the exercise room." But, still the Y did grow. The '80s and the '90s were successful and the community supported the programs. the Y had By 2000 outgrown initial Helton space its and expansion seemed necessary. Unfortunately, the economy was weak and YUSA advised against any addition. Still, the local visionaries forged ahead. In 2001 business offices, a state-of-the-art fitness center, an aquatic facility unique to our area complete with a lap pool, leisure pool, hot tub, steam

room, and sauna became a reality.

With the community's support the Y proved the naysayers wrong. One board member ` noted. "While everything we see today is the result of very foolish decisions, the Shoals has gained the benefits." Presently, the Y has more members than at any time in its history. As Dr. Griggs stated, "The Yhas wonderful programs and sound management. financial And when you go there you will see people from all socioeconomic levels, all shapes, all sizes, and all races getting healthy together." He expressed He expressed the thoughts of former Executive Director and Board Member, Jim Noles, stating, "Wouldn't it be nice if the rest of the world could be more like the Y and we could somehow take that diversity outside the Y?'

A ceremonial absolving of the debt took place by stamping the original bank note PAID IN FULL by Broder and Tallman. Board Vice-Chair, Parke Cochran, charged everyone to keep moving forward. He said that all the past accomplishments had been a leap of faith. Cochran encouraged all by saying, "Do not be afraid of future challenges as the future is bright indeed!"



My mother was married to my father for nearly 20 years and he died 4 years ago. My mother is disabled and draws a small amount of social security but has been told that she could draw widow's benefits. She is not receiving widow's benefits, how can she draw widow's benefits?

In order to qualify for widow's benefits under the Social Security Administration Rules the first requirement is that the Ask the Attorney marriage have been for 10 or more years and the deceased spouse having worked and paid in to social security (what you see deducted

> those 10 or more years. Secondly, the widow (or widower) must be 50 or older and the deceased spouse must have died within 7 years of the claim for benefits.

What you are really looking at is a comparison between two earnings records to see who would draw the largest amount per month of social security benefits. The more money you earn the more money you pay into social security and the more money you pay into social security the more money you get back every month up to a maximum amount that changes typically every year. People that make over \$118,500.00 a year do not have to contribute to social security on earnings above that amount. Those people get a raise every year at the point where they have paid their FICA taxes on the first \$118,500.00 they made and do not have to pay any more

If your father's earnings were higher than your mother's and your mother is disabled and 50, an application for widow's benefits should be filed and it should be granted giving your mother the benefit of your dad's payments into

the social security system.

One thing that my law firm does that is a little different than what some other law firms do that handle social security disability claims is we file initial application for our clients. Atlanta, got a job in the Emory University library, and was part of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee. She was arrested in Albany, Georgia on December 10, 1961 during the last Freedom

West Virginia Institute
of Technology hired her
on a one-year contract in 1969 and thus she found her home among the hills. She has been an advocate for public libraries, public education, rural health clinics, senior citizens, and abused women and children. West Virginia honored her with the Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday Commission's highest award, the "Living the Dream" recognition. West Virginia University awarded her the Martin Luther King Achievement Award. She was the West Virginia Business and Professional Women's first Business Woman of the

At the age of 19, Howard University student, Dion Diamond, was a seasoned veteran of the nonviolent direct action movement that began with sit-ins at public restaurants in 1960. On May 24, 1961, three weeks after the first Freedom Riders set out to take down the "white" and "colored" signs in public transportation, Diamond had a crash introduction to nonviolent civil disobedience taught by the Rev. James Lawson. He then boarded a Greyhound bus in Montgomery, headed to Jackson, Mississippi and perhaps on to New Orleans.

The National Guard barely kept the jeering mob of 2,000 white supremacists from attacking the fifteen Freedom Riders. The Freedom Riders knew that they might be murdered anywhere along the way. National Guardsmen with drawn weapons rode on the bus escorted by Alabama state police cars. Meanwhile, a National Guard helicopter hovered over the bus. After being arrested at the Greyhound bus station in Jackson, Diamond spent the next several months incarcerated in Parchman prison. After being released from Parchman, Diamond became a staff member of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee and was arrested dozens of times. Diamond grew up in Petersburg, Virginia and made his home in the District of Columbia. He has had a long career as a civil servant and consultant specializing in housing, social services, employment issues.

Reginald M. Green grew up in the District of Columbia. When he was a student at Virginia Union University, he was first arrested in the 1960 Richmond, Virginia sit-ins. On June 7, 1961, he and five other Freedom Riders boarded a Trailways bus in Nashville, Tennessee, which made its way to

ow long do dogs live? I think we can all agree that it's not nearly long enough. Canine lifespans vary from as short as 6 to 8 years for certain giant breeds to an astounding 20-plus years for some tiny dogs. Owners of small and medium-size dogs can generally expect their companions to live 10 to 15 years.

Diet, good care and genetics all play a role in the length of a dog's life, but two researchers at the University of Washington in Seattle are hoping to learn more about how dogs age, as well as whether the aging process can be delayed and the lifespan lengthened. The Dog Aging Project (DAP), headed by Daniel Promislow, Ph.D., and Matt Kaeberlein, Ph.D., plans to track 10,000 dogs in homes around the United States to get a sense of how genetic and environmental factors affect aging in dogs.

As dogs — and humans and other animals — age. organs and tissues break down, increasing the risk of age-related diseases such as cancer, cardiovascular disease, kidney disease, Alzheimer's disease and more. Age is a greater risk factor for these diseases than diet, weight and exercise.

is to understand the aging process so we can delay the onset and progression of all these diseases," Dr. Kaeberlein says. "It's sort of a fundamental shift from the traditional medical approach, which is to wait until dogs - or people - are sick, and then try to treat the disease.

The dogs in this observational study will include many different breeds in different environments: short-lived dogs, long-lived dogs, dogs in wealthy households and dogs in more modest households. The researchers will look at not just how long the dogs live, but also at how environmental factors affect them as they age.

Included in the DAP will be a smaller study, with up to 36 pet dogs in the Seattle area. It will look at whether a drug called Rapamycin – used to prevent organ transplant rejection in humans – can slow aging, extend canine lifespans and improve quality of life. The drug has been shown to increase lifespan in many different organisms, Dr. Kaeberlein says, as well as improve cognitive, cardiac and immune function in animals such as mice.

"There's been accumulating evidence over the past several years that not only do they live longer, but that the aging process itself is slowed down," he says.

interest in enrolling them in the Rapamycin study, only 26 dogs so far have met the criteria to be included: at least 6 years old, weighing at least 40 pounds and with no pre-existing conditions. Among them are golden retrievers, a greyhound, Labrador retrievers, German shepherds and mixed breeds.

In both studies, dogs are good subjects because their shorter lifespan allows scientists to see results in a decade or less.

"If we had a large enough sample size, we could know in three years – certainly in five years – the extent to which Rapamycin improved healthy aging in dogs," Dr. Promislow says. "And for a longitudinal study of age, where we want to follow dogs throughout life and understand the genetic or environmental factors that affect aging and disease in dogs, you can do that in a decade. That's not possible in that timeframe in people.

The eventual results could have implications for humans, but the dog-loving scientists say their research is about more than that.

We're both determined to find ways to improve the quality of life for dogs," Dr. Kaeberlein says. "This is not just about finding something that will help people. It might be good for dogs and their owners."

Pet dental care good for health

- Does your dog or cat have pearly white teeth or grungy brown ones? In either case, if he has bad breath, he needs to see the veterinarian for a professional cleaning. Bad breath and tartar – the hard brown stuff on your pet's teeth - are signs of periodontal disease, which is bad news for tooth structure. It can lead to tooth loss, receding gums and even bone infection. February is National Pet Dental Health Month, which means there's a good chance your veterinarian is offering a discount on professional cleanings, which aren't just cosmetic, but get below the gumline, where bacteria lurk.
- Going skiing? You might want to see if the ski area has an avalanche rescue dog on staff. The dogs, who are trained snow, can search an avalanche site the size of a football field in as little as five or 10 minutes, reports AP's Sue Manning. "The fastest thing is a dog – faster than a beacon or echo," says Craig Noble, ski patrol and dog supervisor at Squaw Valley Alpine Meadows Resort in Olympic Valley, California. The dog and handler teams have specialized training and are recertified annually.
- Zero to 60 in 1/100th of a second? We're not talking time trials for the latest Lamborghini, but the speed of a chameleon's tongue. Yes, you read that right. The small but mighty lizards can flick their tongues toward a cricket at up to 264 times the force of gravity, according to a study published in the journal Scientific Reports. The anatomy of the tongue gives it spring-loaded power, allowing chameleons to capture more prey, and its speed beats out that of any other reptile, bird or mammal.



Why didn't the riverine boats communicate their problems to their commanding officer who should have been monitoring their transit from Kuwait to Bahrain? If they did communicate their situation, what were the instructions they received from higher command?

It appears to me the personnel on the riverine boats and the command hierarchy viewed the movement of the boats as a routine operation. They were caught off guard by the problems encountered and were unprepared to conduct contingency operations. It reminds me of the capture of the USS Pueblo off of North Korea many years ago.

This incident could embolden the Iranians and other unfriendly countries to test our military prowess.







Don't Believe the Lie

It seems one of the biggest lies that satan has ever told is that you do not have to be baptized to be saved. How is it that something that is so plainly commanded in Scripture and obeyed in numerous Biblical examples has become such an unnecessary thing? How has the act of obedience in baptism become something to be ignored and eagerly explained away? Is it because countless people are afraid of water? No, I don't think that is it. 
