

Several years later, more contributions allowed the site to be nicely landscaped.

Honorariums ĥave also been placed at the site in honor of children adopted. "We realized the Hope sculpture would be a comfort to someone who has walked through the journey of adoption as well--either on the placement OR receiving side of the experience," Grisham added. "While adoption is a wonderful option that we share with all of our clients, it is chosen by very few. We understand that for the birth mother, there is a grieving process that she will likely experience as she walks through the adoption journey. We encourage her to look beyond her needs to the best interests of the child she is carrying and to consider whether she can offer her child the care, love, and stability it will need to thrive in life. Our goal is to help her see that adoption may be the BEST way for her to show her child love. And on the other side of the equation awaits a family who will receive the gift of life through her selfless act."

Ask Dr. Webb

A study published July this year in JAMA Oncology found that patients with any end-stage cancer who

received chemotherapy, hoping to improve their quality of life and survival, actually were made to feel worse and didn't live any longer!

661 patients with stage 4 [metastatic] cancer were followed: half received at least one dose of chemotherapy, and the other half were the 'control' group, meaning they received only comfort care to control symptoms (pain, shortness of breath, nausea). All the patients entered the study feeling 'well' and without any significant symptoms.

The accompanying editorial stated, "It is disturbing that this trial demonstrated no benefits of chemotherapy... and... that oncologists still recommend and use systemic therapy so close to patient death." The authors speculate that chemotherapy was given to patients already functioning well and without symptoms in an attempt to just reduce the cancer's spread.

Based on this study, it unfortunately appears that once you have metastatic cancer, your chances of living longer and better by taking chemotherapy is not very good. A person may be better served by informing themselves and making a choice that is right for them—which could still be a trial of chemotherapy; or could be, eat and drink what you like, enjoying your family without the nausea and other problems that frequently accompany cancer treatment.

Try not to give in to others' false hopes. Know that usually a comfort- focused approach helps you to live more comfortably and longer-which means, ask your doctor if hospice might be a better choice!

Wilson, was clearly doing hisjob and defending himself against Michael Brown, and he still had his life ruined. We eagerly watched as tens of millions in damage was done by looting punks and rioters over the course of the following week that further hurt the local economy. Now, the same community requires taxpayer assistance for its recovery.

Several weeks ago racial tensions increased at the University of Missouri when the student body president, Peyton Head, lamented about there being a KKK chapter on the campus. The story festered as did tensions. Head was named homecoming king this year at UM which served to quell some tensions.

That may have been orchestrated. It turns out that Head recently did an internship with Obama's former Chief of Staff and current Chicago mayor, Rahm Emanual. He also had a recent 'meet and greet' photo taken with the President. Incidently, there is not KKK chapter on the Missouri campus. The media never questioned Head about his claims. Sounds like a top-flight community organizer in the making.

making. Now we have the case of more alleged inaction against racism and social injustices by the UM president. There has been one isolated accusation of a racial epithet - hurled by a drunk in an old pick-up truck - and an as-yet unsubstantiated claim of a swastika drawn with feces on a wall.

Jonathan Butler took up the cause at the university and was a central figure in the protests at UM last week. He was claiming to represent those fighting against racism, inequality, and social injustice with his two-day hunger strike that garnered the sympathy of millions and added to the pressure on the university officials.

The UM football team joined in the protest as over 30 black players claimed they would not play in another game unless the university's less-thanresponsive president was fired or resigned. UM is mediocre at best this year. Had they been 9-0 entering the week, many players admitted they would not have become involved. All this caused the president's resignation and the chancellor's reassignment.

What went underreported is that Butler is now in this eighth-year doing post graduate work at Missouri and his father is a longtime railroad executive who earned over \$8 million last year. And Butler is fighting for social justice and inequality? It sounds like the drunk really needs the justice and equality.

justice and equality. Butler's initial outrage may also have been centered on the fact that he lost his health insurance benefits when he became a graduate student. He was mad at the university, its president, the chancellor, trustees, any establishment whites that he could blame. He never considered it was Obamacare that threw him into his racially retaliatory hunger strike.

Why do we concern ourselves AT ALL when someone goes on a hunger strike? That is as juvenile as someone holding his breath in protest. Let him starve or asphyxiate to his heart's content.

One would never imagine that UM is supposed to have one of the nation's premier journalism programs. Then again, if reliability, and modern-day corroboration methods are considered, maybe that makes perfect sense.

The real injustice is that taxpayers fund this modernday charade of higher ed.







If on the other hand, the driver simply was not paying attention and was not speeding, then your daughter doesn't have a case.

Secondly, if your daughter or your daughter's boyfriend paid the driver to take them to the movies or, for example, gave the driver gas money, then the driver is considered a "driver for hire" and the "guest passenger" statute does not apply. In this situation, your daughter could file suit against the driver.

Recently, I settled a client's case where my client, who was a passenger, was injured on his way to work when the driver fell asleep at the wheel and crashed. I successfully argued that my client and the driver did not fall under the guest passenger statute because they took turns driving to work and therefore their relationship was a business relationship and for their mutual benefit.

Editor:

A National Women's Business Council analysis of U.S. Census data from the 2012 Survey of Business Owners shows significant growth since 2007. As of 2012 there are 9.9 million women-owned businesses a 27.5% rise. The analysis also showed that Women-owned businesses generated 1.6 trillion in total receipts which is up from 1.2 trillion in 2007. That is an increase of 35%! For comparison, maleowned businesses saw an increase of 33%. While sole proprietorships account for 89.4% of businesses owned by women, employee hiring has also increased by 19.5%.

African-American women own more than 1.5 million businesses across the U.S., a 67.5% jump from 2007. There are 1.48 million Hispanic womenowned businesses in the U.S, an increase of 87.31% since 2007. Now 754,874 Asian American women own businesses, up 44.3% from 2007. Another area of tremendous growth was in veteran women-owned businesses which increased by 206% from 2007 to a total of 384,548 businesses nationwide.

Over 100 Women's Business Centers across the country offer counseling, training business and other services to women in business in all 50 states. The Center for Rural Affairs' REAP Women's Business Center has been proudly serving the women of Nebraška as part of the association since 2001.
