





Loving Cup

In past centuries before the invention of the camera, heroes and celebrities were remembered with figurines, prints and plates, and mugs of glass or ceramics. Coronations, royal weddings, major exhibitions and historic events were commemorated by souvenirs with depictions of the people or the event. The Royal Doulton Co. made many figurines of attractive imaginary people and animals. The company started making several sizes of small character jugs honoring fictional as well as real people in 1930, and it still makes a few new ones each year. Most sell today for under \$100.

Thirty limited edition loving cups and jugs (pitchers) about 10 inches high were made from 1930 to 1938, and two that honor Queen Elizabeth, one at her coronation in 1953, the other at her Silver Jubilee in 1977. The pieces designed by Charles Noke, molded with raised figures and decorated in bright colors, are rare. Each has a special mark on the bottom explaining the history of the hero and events pictured. The standard Royal Doulton Co. mark, a lion and crown, also is used. These limited editions were selling for more than \$1,000 each until about 10 years ago, when all Doulton prices fell.

A commemorative Admiral Lord Nelson loving cup auctioned at Skinner Auctions in Boston in 2015 for \$800. Lord Nelson was a naval hero who fought in many naval battles and seemed unstoppable. He lost an arm in one battle, an eye in another, and he was finally killed at the Battle of Trafalgar Bay in 1805. On one side of the loving cup is a picture of the one-armed admiral in his ship; a sinking ship and lifeboat with sailors is on the other side.

Q. I have a silver spoon marked with a small hallmark: the letter "S" in the middle of wings. I'd like to know the maker and when it was made.

A. This mark was used by George W. Shiebler, who started his company in Baltimore in 1876. He moved to Brooklyn and the company

name became George W. Shiebler & Co. in 1891. It went out of business in 1910. The company made flatware, hollowware, souvenir spoons and specialty items. A sterling teaspoon is worth about \$25 to \$50. A plated teaspoon sells for only \$10 to \$15.

DANVILLE, Va. Local historian and artist Robert Daniel "Danny" Ricketts, 79, of Danville died on Tuesday, June 30, 2020, at Centra Lynchburg General Hospital after a sudden illness.

Born January 13, 1941, in a

log cabin in Blairs, Virginia, Danny was the son of the late Ruben Edward and Annie Marie Jones Ricketts. Danny was also predeceased by one brother Ray E. (Mary) Ricketts of Richmond; three sisters, Idella (James, living) Lynch of Danville, Marion (Willie) Lewis (Herman) Cook, and Elaine (Edward) Gibson; and a grandson, Cody Austin Hill.

Danny's family moved to Washington Street when he was five years old. On March 29, 1968, Danny married his first (and only) wife, Nancye Barbour Ricketts, after wooing her with a series of ancient arrowhead hunting dates. Together, they raised three children: one daughter, Jo Ricketts (Kevin) Hawke of Danville; and two sons, Robert Allen "Bobby" (Kimberly) Ricketts of Forest, VA, and Paul Daniel (Rebecca) Ricketts of Broken Arrow, OK. He is survived by six grandsons: Joseph Robert (Erica) Ricketts of Lynchburg, VA; Ryan Andrew Hill of Danville; Caleb Daniel Ricketts and Samuel James Ricketts, both of Broken Arrow, OK; and Lucas Sebastian Dalton and Atticus Sage Hawke, both of Danville. Also surviving are several generations of nieces and nephews and a multitude of cousins.

Danny graduated from George Washington High School in 1960. He joined the U. S. Air Force in January 1961 and served in Intelligence as a Radio Intercept Analyst Specialist in Karamursel, Turkey, where he became fascinated by ancient and early cultures of western civilization. After serving his country, Danny studied at Danville Community College and became a letter carrier for the U.S. Postal Service, delivering mail, enjoying conversation, and running from dogs until he retired in 1992.

Danny was an avid historian and collector of ancient artifacts and local memorabilia alike. He and son Bobby unearthed the oldest surviving wooden water wheel in America, the Beavers Mill water wheel (circa 1792) in Pittsylvania County in 2003. It was excavated, preserved, and donated to the Virginia Historical Society for display in the Virginia Museum of History and Culture in 2006. Danny started painting as a child. His art teachers—Mrs. Vass in fourth grade at Stonewall Jackson Elementary and later Miss Lucille Walton at George Washington High School—encouraged his talent. Danny won two Scholastic Gold Key awards for his artwork. For the next 50 years, his art was primarily focused on his historical work, producing dozens of posters on local history and more. Then, in 2011, he once again immersed himself fully in his art. Danny's artistic hero was Pablo Picasso, but over the course of his lifetime, he produced more than 1,300 pieces spanning multiple styles and modes, including abstracts, landscapes, collage, and sculpture.

In 1996, Danny and Nancye moved to Tulsa, OK, where they attended Rhema Bible Training College, graduating in 1998. They traveled with mission teams to India twice and pastored Victory Family Church in Danville for several years. Danny's favorite Bible verse was, "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." He said that this verse was posted over the door of his Sunday School class at Third Avenue Congregational Church, where he and his family were members for many years. Striving to live this message out every day of his life, Danny Ricketts' testimony will continue to live on in his historical work, his art, and his family and friends for countless years to come.

A funeral will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 4, 2020, at Norris Funeral Services' Mt. Hermon Chapel with Rev. Oscar Rivera officiating. 



5 Steps for Sizzling Steak

A sizzling steak is a surefire sound of summer, and the flavors achieved from one that's perfectly grilled are hard to match.

Before you fire up your grill, consider these five basics for cooking a chefworthy steak:

Prepare Your Cut

Taste preferences (and prices) may differ among sirloins, ribeyes, T-bones and more, but the way you prepare steaks likely won't change much from cut to cut. You'll want to trim the thickness down to 1/2-1 inch for proper cooking, and setting the meat out ahead of time allows it to warm to room temperature before hitting the grill.

Add Some Salt

Feel free to add any spices you prefer, but remember a good steak typically doesn't require fancy seasoning -a pinch of salt works just fine. Add your salt anywhere between 30 minutes to a few hours before grilling time to help retain moisture and improve flavor.

Aim for High Heat

A two-zone fire is usually the way to go – one side of the grill should be hot (using direct heat) with the other side not quite as warm (indirect heat). This allows you to create a sear over direct heat before finishing cooking through without burning – over indirect heat.

Sear and Slide

Cooking your steak over direct heat 1-2 minutes on each side is normally about right for creating a proper sear. At this point, depending on the thickness of your steak, you'll want to check for doneness. If it's not quite to the temperature you're looking to achieve, simply slide it over to the indirect heat for a finishing touch. Keep in mind these general guidelines for doneness: 120-125 F is rare, 130-135 F is medium-rare, 140-145 F is medium, 150-155 F is medium-well and 160-175 F is well done.

Let Rest

Finally, as hungry as you may be at this point, resting steaks is an important last step before diving in. Giving your steaks 5-10 minutes (foil or no foil) allows flavors to redistribute and moisture to be retained in the meat.

Mississippi Pot Roast with Gravy



INGREDIENTS

3-4 lb Boneless Beef Roast (your choice cut)

l stick unsalted butter (if your roast looks fatty, use less butter)

l package au jus gravy mix

1 package Hidden Valley Ranch dressing mix (dry)

Pepperoncini peppers (I used 7, depends on your taste more or less is fine)

Fresh ground pepper to taste

For the Gravy:

3 tablespoons cornstarch

INSTRUCTIONS

Put the roast in a slow cooker. Sprinkle au jus gravy mix and ranch dressing mix over the roast add the butter, and pepperoncini peppers and a little of the pepper juice if you like. Add fresh cracked pepper and cook on low until tender, about 8 hours. (For Instant Pot Cook at high pressure on manual for 90 minutes. Do not allow warming cycle to kick on. Then use natural release for 15 minutes and switch to quick release.)

For the Gravy:

To make the gravy, pour the liquid from the crock pot into a measuring cup. Skim off the fat. Measure two cups of the liquid, adding water if needed. Transfer to a sauce pan reserving 1/2 cup of the liquid.

Stir the cornstarch into the reserved liquid, then stir


