

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speakout,"

We continue the study of our wonderful "Declaration of Independence" with the hope of learning more of our history, becoming more patriotic Americans and protecting our liberties. We, as Americans, are entitled to trial by jury for any charges brought against us, but the king deprived the colonists of this fundamental freedom which we enjoy today: "For depriving us in many cases, of the benefits of trial by jury:..."

How would you like to be transported to another country to be tried for offenses which you did not perpetrate? The king did exactly this in violation of the colonists' rights. We have the right to trial by our peers near where we live: "For transporting us beyond seas to be tried for pretended offenses:..."

The rights to which citizens in England were entitled were denied to the colonists and the laws were interpreted as they seemed fit for the king: "For abolishing the free system of English laws in a neighboring province, establishing therein an arbitrary government, and enlarging its boundaries so as to render it at once an example and fit instrument for introducing the same absolute rule in these colonies:..."

The colonists had been given charters to benefit and protect them. But the king abolished these charters as he willed: "For taking away our charters, abolishing our most valuable laws, and altering fundamentally the forms of our governments:..."

The colonists elected legislatures to enable them to live as free citizens but the king would abolish these legislatures: "For suspending our own legislatures, and declaring themselves invested with power to legislate for us in all cases whatsoever."

The king wanted control over the colonies and did not wish to protect them but instead instituted a warlike atmosphere against them in the destructive manners in which he mistreated them: "He has abdicated government here, by declaring us out of his protection and waging war against us."

Our founding fathers now began to list the many military acts which the English military had perpetrated against the colonists during the early 1770s: "He has plundered our seas, ravaged our coasts, burned our towns, and destroyed the lives of our people."

The Prussian government was paid to send their armies to America to assist the English in the control of the colonists. These armies were brutal in their treatment of the colonists: "He is at this time transporting large armies of foreign mercenaries to complete the works of death, desolation and tyranny, already begun with circumstances of cruelty and perfidy scarcely paralleled in the most barbarous ages, and totally unworthy the head of a civilized nation."

The king would force colonists who were taken prisoners on the high seas to fight against their own friends and to even execute them or die as a punishment for refusal: "He has constrained our fellow citizens taken captive on the high seas to bear arms against their country, to become the executioners of their friends and brethren, or to fall themselves by their hands:..."

I pray that we are learning about the tyrannical government under which our ancestors lived and the reasons they rebelled so that we will be more appreciative of the freedoms and duties which we now enjoy as citizens of the United States of America.

Please hold onto your freedoms and protect them because we will lose them if we do not diligently fight to protect them. Lord willing, we will continue the study of our wonderful "Declaration of Independence" next week. May God bless you.

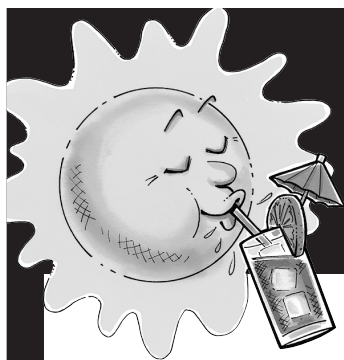
You need to respect your seniors and disabled seniors, who have to survive on a fixed income. We try to keep up with as much as we can.

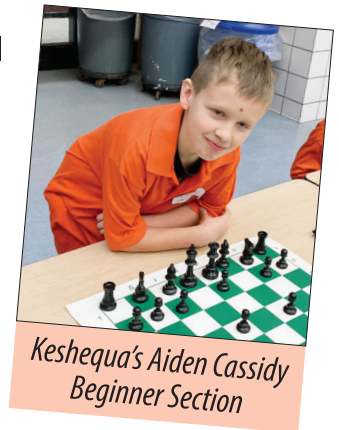
As Dansville had won the previous two elementary matches, awarding them the Championship was an easy choice.
