Zurinsky Has Exciting Ideas for Florence and District 2

I am River Zurinsky and I'm asking for your vote for Florence City Council District 2 in the upcoming August 25th municipal elections. I was born in District 2 at ECM Hospital and I have lived in District 2 all of my life. Deciding to run for Florence City Council at 21 years old was not an easy decision for me to make, but when I saw our current city council deny local charity Room at the Table the right to serve meals to those in need out of their building, I knew it was the right decision for me to run. Room at the Table is currently suing the City of Florence just to try to gain the right to

If I am elected to the Florence City Council, I want to meet with Room at the Table

and negotiate a deal which

will allow them to feed the hungry without costing the taxpayers of Florence court costs and legal fees. The same city council that denied Room at the Table a permit, allowed a carnival to keep their permit and set up in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. If I get elected to the Florence City Council, I promise to never put profits over people. I will look out for the health and well-being of the people of Florence. I will also make sure the city is spending its money wisely. Recently the current city council unanimously chose to pay internet hackers a \$290,000 ransom after refusing to buy cyber insurance for the city's computer systems. I will immediately introduce legislation to buy cyber insurance for the city. Not long ago, the Times Daily reported that Muscle Shoals provides their police officers with better pay than Florence does. I want to raise the salaries of Florence firefighters and police officers to make sure they are getting paid a fair amount. I have included a dog park in my plans for the old golf course because there is still great demand for one today. A city-owned dog park would provide a place for dogs to get exercise and play with other dogs. A



skate park in McFarland Park would provide teenagers in District 2 and their friends a place to have fun outdoors. A splash pad in McFarland Park would provide residents of District 2 and tourists a place to cool off from the heat during the summer. TVA recently awarded the City of Florence a grant to build a canoe/ kayak ramp at the north end of Cypress Creek near Cox Creek

Parkway. Building a canoe/ kayak storage facility in McFarland Park would provide a place to store canoes and kayaks after floating down Cypress Creek. People on the Tennessee River could dock and store their canoes and kayaks there as well. Improving McFarland Park will attract new business along Hwy 20/ Savannah Hwy in District 2 and will also bring more people to Downtown Florence.

I will immediately introduce legislation to fix the broken pedestrian signals on Court St. The intersections of Alabama St and Court St, and Court St, and Dr. Hicks Boulevard have pedestrian signals that are completely burned out. The intersection at College St and Court St has half of its pedestrian signals burned out. The intersections at Court St and Mobile St, Court St and Tombigbee St, and Court St and Tuscaloosa St have pedestrian signals with no buttons to push to activate them. It is only a matter of time until someone gets hurt or killed unless something is done to fix these broken pedestrian signals! I don't want anyone to get hurt because of a problem the current city council ignored or didn't care enough to do anything about. I also propose adding pedestrian signals on Pine St at the intersections of Mobile St and Pine St, Pine St and Tombigbee St, and Pine St and Tuscaloosa St. Adding pedestrian signals at the intersections of Mobile St and Pine St, and Pine St and Tombigbee St will give residents of Courtview Towers peace of mind when crossing Pine St to get to restaurants and other local businesses on Court Street. Adding pedestrian signals to the intersection of Pine St and Tuscaloosa St will enable UNA students to walk down Pine St to Downtown without having to worry if it is safe to cross or not.



My husband and I are about to start Baby Step 5. We want to save money for college to help our children, but we're a little worried about starting a 529 Plan and being penalized if we pull the money out for trade school or they don't finish their studies. What do you think we should do?

Dear Dani,

You'd only be taxed on the growth, not what you put into the plan. And you'd be taxed on the growth anyway if you put it into something else, so there's no reason not to go with a 529 Plan.

The truth is a 529 will work for a lot of trade schools. It may not be accepted if they do a straight-up apprenticeship, but it's fine for a course of study at a votech school.

Now, if you don't use all of what's in your 529 for education, the portion that goes unused will be taxed. You'll want a chunk of cash sitting in your 529, enough to make a difference in their educational goals, but you don't want to overfund it.

Avoid These Big Mistakes on Auto Insurance Applications

Skipping a question when filling out a car insurance application may not seem like a big deal, but what you omit or enter incorrectly can create issues down the road. Errors on the application can result in a denied claim or even a policy revocation.

Mistakes happen, but some applicants intentionally try to hide or alter information to get lower premiums. The cost of this insurance fraud is spread among



all the other policyholders, typically causing their rates to go up.

Be sure to avoid these mistakes when you're applying for auto insurance:

- Not reporting all the drivers for the vehicle: Most often, the people who aren't listed on the application are teenage drivers or adults with traffic infractions on their records. If a driver who's not rated for a vehicle is involved in an accident, your premiums may go up and your policy may be canceled.
- Not listing the actual parking location for the vehicle: Vehicles housed in garages are typically safer and less prone to accidents than those parked on the street. If you do park on the street, make sure that's what goes on your application, or a drive-by fender bender may not be covered.
- Guessing about the miles driven: Report your mileage accurately. If you're in an accident and file a claim, the repair estimate reveals the mileage discrepancy. Standard checks performed during smog emission testing or vehicle servicing also reveal the true number.
- Forgetting to mention business travel: If you omitted that your vehicle is used for business, then later have an accident while performing business activities, your policy could be canceled.






high school diploma was 15.3% compared with just 7.4% for college graduates. The unemployment rate for Hispanics was 40% higher than for whites. That gap was 30% for blacks.

Those disparities are likely to remain in the coming months. Recovery from the COVID-19 shutdown could take years. The percentage of working-age people in the labor force -- those working or looking for work -- is still well below what it was before the Great Recession.

To reduce pressure on jobseekers, the Trump administration stopped green issuing cards, which give lifetime work privileges to permanent immigrants, to individuals not already in the United States in April. But until June 22, the president hadn't stopped his administration from processing up to 1 million temporary guest-worker visas that corporations use to hire foreign laborers for at least 7% less pay than Americans.

By suspending these guest-worker programs, President Trump rejected the demands of Big Business and stood up for the forgotten men and women that politicians in both parties have ignored for decades.

The United States hands out 1 million green cards a year. On top of that, every year we admit about 750,000



displace and drive down wages for all workers in those occupations.

In 2019, 188,000 foreign workers came to the United States on H-1B visas -- and mostly took entry-level tech jobs. That same year 98,000 came on H-2B visas to take construction, landscaping, and other manual-labor jobs. An unlimited number can come on H-2A farmworker visas. Almost 150,000 found employment through the OPT program, which allows foreigners who graduate from U.S. colleges stay and work for up to three years.

The influx of foreign labor depresses Americans' wages, according to more than a dozen studies reviewed by the National Academy of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine. And lessadvantaged Americans, particularly minorities, suffer the biggest losses

in earnings because they compete most directly with foreigners.

Even prior to the pandemic, minority communities struggled with higher rates of unemployment. The black jobless rate last year was twice as high as the white unemployment rate in 14 states, according to the Economic Policy Institute.

This chronic joblessness causes poverty, which in turn affects everything from social mobility to the quality of public schools. President Trump stood

up for Black and Ĥispanic Americans by suspending guest-worker visas.

At a time of record unemployment, there's simply no reason to import guest workers for jobs that Americans are able and willing to do.

I was turning left when a car hit me. The car was absolutely speeding and the officer said fault was undetermined. I had a yellow light that had been a green arrow. I talked to a lawyer and they wouldn't take my case, will you?

Most states are comparative negligence states and under that type of law, the negligence of the parties is compared and adjustments are made depending on a percentage of fault assigned by a jury.

Alabama is a contributory

negligence state. What that

Your case is an example of contributory negligence. One person is speeding and another person pulls out in front of them and fails to yield the right of way. In Alabama, neither party will be able to successfully bring a claim against the other because both parties are at least 1% at fault for the accident.

In a comparative negligence state, if the party who was speeding was 10% at fault and their case is worth \$100,000.00, the jury would merely deduct 10% from the \$100,000.00 to account for their share of the accident.

Contributory negligence must be proven but it is a complete bar to recovery if you were even 1% at fault in Alabama.






Credit Scores

Over the past few years, I've spent a considerable amount of time researching credit scores and factors that have the largest impact on them.

Thanks to websites like myfico.com and creditkarma.com, as well as multiple blogs on the subject, there is a lot of information out there. First, it is important to understand how your

score is calculated:



As you can see from the chart I found on mvfico.com, the amount you owe and your payment history impact your score by 65%. Of the amount you owe, revolving credit (such as credit cards) can have a huge impact on your score. For example, if you carry high balances on your credit cards and the amount you owe is close to the credit available to you, it can have a negative impact.

You can improve your score very quickly by paying down the amount of credit card balances that you owe. While you might think that paying them completely off would have the biggest impact and make your score the highest, that may not always be the case.

There are multiple opinions out there that your credit score may actually be the highest if your balance to available credit ratio is in the 8-10% range. This may indicate that you are not living above your means and that you use your credit responsibly. Your credit score could vastly improve if you paid your balances down below 50% of your available credit, and even more so if you paid your credit card balances down below 33% of your available credit. Several of the "experts" agree that the 8-10% balance to available credit ratio might be the sweet spot in regards to revolving credit for a maximum credit rating.

Why is this important? The better your credit, the better interest rate you will qualify for on a mortgage. For example, you could take a look at Courier Journal. your credit now to see if there are ways you could improve your score to above 740 or 780, which might save you .125 or better on a mortgage interest rate, which would save you thousands of dollars in interest over time. Many of these websites have what they call score simulators, where you can actually see what your score would be if you took certain actions such as paying down credit card balances as we discussed above. she'd say. There's no reason to be. God gave you what you have. Don't put yourself first. Then she showed us – she got up first. She cooked. She cleaned. She ate the wings. We were more important than she was. She was always looking to see what she could do for us and for others to make our way better.

God is in every 3) day. On those bad childhood nights, we would hear her

say, "Tomorrow is another day." She expected God to help us through the nights and the next day. And He did. On one of those tomorrows, our lives did changed. During her decline, my mom prayed, "Give us this day." I now understand that mom gave her days to God so that she could make it through the nights. (Oh, if the world would do this.)

What has your mama taught you? Have you honored, as in obeyed, that teaching? Have you thanked her lately? Ever? Doesn't she deserve a thank you? Some of you will say that you will thank her as soon as she does something for you. I am sorry about your situation. But also, there's today – this moment. Don't waste it.



Medicare Minute "4 Parts of Medicare"

Did you know there were four parts to Medicare not two? Did you know that two of the parts you can get through the federal government but the other two parts, if you choose to take them, must be purchased through private insurance

to take them, must be purchased through private insurance companies? Finally, did you know most people have an option as to whether to sign up for three of the four parts of Medicare? Editor:

According to a Family Research Council article, in early May, Lt. Colonel David McGraw, a chaplain at the Army Garrison in Stuttgart, Germany, was ordered to halt his open-air Sunday services. The Christian chaplain's offense? Preaching Sunday sermons on his apartment balcony during the virus lockdown. He later learned his commander had a 53-minute phone call with the head of Military Religious Foundation Freedom (MRFF).

In late April, Colonel Moon Kim, stationed at Camp Humphreys in South Korea, learned he would be subject to a review that could harm his career and reputation. The Christian chaplain's offense? He sent an email to a few of his U.S. Army chaplain colleagues, telling them that a Christian e-book he found online might be helpful as they counsel.

Even the Army's 10th Mountain Division -renowned for achieving victories in extreme settings -- waved the white flag of surrender over religious freedom. Their chaplain's offense? When Major Scott Ingram said in a Facebook video: "God encourages us not to be dismayed by what we see around us," his superiors removed it at MRFF's bidding.

I want to believe that the leadership in our military services are the best. However, the ability of the MRFF to influence commanders to deny religious freedoms to their chaplains makes me question their understanding of the constitution they are sworn to defend.
