

My husband was in a automobile accident and I have had to take off work to take care of him. I had to hire someone to help me with the household chores and yard work and I am really stressed out having to take care of him and everything else that I have to do. I want to sue the person that caused the accident, but a friend of my said I couldn't. Is there anything I can do?

Norma, Athens, AL

Yes you can. Alabama, like most states, recognizes a claim that a spouse has against a person who injures them. I like these claims and think that jurors are receptive to the legal claim that is technically called a claim for "consortium".

Historically, the law began as a claim a husband had against

someone who had compensated him for the loss of his wife's consortium and services. That is the right of a husband to his wife's company, fellowship, usual services in taking care of the home, rearing the children, as well as his loss of her society and comfort.

When I first started practicing law in the late 80s with cases involving consortium claims, you would see the occasional defense lawyer who would be crude enough to inquire about the sexual habits of a married couple. I think these lawyers did this to embarrass people in an attempt to discourage their claim. Sometimes that tactic worked and sometimes it was offensive for no good reason.

The law recognizes a wife's claim for the loss of consortium and services in her husband and includes a loss of the companionship, affection, society, support and sexual relations. It is kind of odd that in the newest jury instructions, a wife has a specific claim for the loss of "sexual relations" with her husband but the jury charge for the husband does not include that specific claim, although it is probably implied.

I like these claims for two reasons, the first is that these claims force everyone including the defendant and the jury to look at the very natural consequences to a family of a serious personal injury and secondly, these claims often provide additional insurance coverage and a greater

monetary recovery.

Mom is 80 and has just been diagnosed with lung cancer which has spread to her bones. She is losing weight and has started using a cane. Her doctors told her no one knows how long she has but could live a year or more. We've read that few older people live so long. How can we determine how long she does have?

You are asking about her 'prognosis': a word from the Greek "gnosis"—"knowledge of spiritual truth" [M.Webster's]. Dorland's Medical Dictionary defines it as "a forecast of the probable course and outcome of a disorder and the prospects of recovery".

There is also a biblical reference: Psalm 39:4 "Lord, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days; that I may know how frail I am."

Certainly no one knows absolutely, but there are still good guidelines to help patients/families so that they can make plans, and, in the final few weeks of life, avoid the regret of not having said things that need to be said, or not doing things that need to be done.

These are two key indicators of a 'poor' prognosis [meaning less than 6-12 months survival]:

- 1. Progressive loss of appetite and weight; especially if also sleeping more during the day.
- 2. Increasing assistance with ADL's [Activities of Daily Living - bathing, toileting, walking, eating, dressing] over previous several months.

A person with a stage 4 metastatic cancer [cancer that has spread], who cannot get out of bed to the toilet by themselves, usually lives—on average—only another 3

Patients with progressive non-cancer chronic diseases, like congestive heart failure, have a less easily predicted course and must be assessed individually—although the same guidelines regarding weight loss and ADL's often still apply.

The Courier Journal covered Gary's reunion with his fondly-remembered hospital nurse forty years after his Birmingham heart surgery in the March 25, 2015 issue. This isn't about that remarkable story. It's about another one from which we all can learn.

He and Gwen recently shared a lunch organized by Shoals CASA with a few TOM MAGAZZU local teenagers who are in the foster care system. After the meal Gary pulled his chair up,

completing a large circle that placed him almost within arm's reach of each person.

He proceeded to talk with the group, giving them a little background so they would be relaxed and realize how easily they could relate to his early life.

Gary was raised in Florence with his family that included a father who was a non-functioning alcoholic. Dad tried to stay a step ahead of the law. Sometimes he didn't. The family had nothing. If his dad ever made some money, he would drink it away. The rats had more to eat than the family. Gary knew he wanted better.

"We were dirt poor. When I was in first, second, third grade trying to learn was not a

BOTH MY READERS MAY

recall from a previous article that I sold my old house and am in the process of building a new one. In the meantime, Tammy and I are in an apartment. During the construction process, I wanted

to cut costs on everything I could so as to leave enough money for beans and rice.

One of the first things I did was to "cut the cord" on my cable TV service.

Cutting the cord is the act of using internet-based services to provide streaming TV rather than traditional services such as cable, satellite and over-the-air broadcast. The goal is to pay low monthly fee for internet service (typically about \$35

a month) and watch "free" TV over the internet. Well, I can definitively tell you that cord cutting is not yet ready for primetime. Not for me,

I'd heard much about a device called Roku. It's a small \$70.00 box with a cute remote control that connects to your TV and serves as a portal to the world of streaming video. Well, I didn't do enough research on this little box. Turns out it's great for corralling all your streaming services into one convenient box, but if you're used to your local network channels, sports, and 24/7

news channels, this is not the box for you. In order to catch all the episodes of The Good Wife, for example, you have to pay a \$10 monthly subscription to CBS. Another \$10 gets you ESPN. Another gets you NBC shows and so on. There is no access to 24/7 news channels at all. All the normal TV shows are available somewhere but only via subscription services or by purchasing individual shows. So, after I "cut the cord," then paid ala-carte for the shows I want to watch, I still came out ahead but not nearly the monthly savings I had hoped for.

There is also an inconvenience factor. I don't mind operating two or three remotes, using arrows to navigate to the shows and services to which I subscribe in order to get what I want, but SOME PEOPLE (who's name I will not mention but her initials are TAMMY FISHER), want to push one button and have stuff work. So, after cutting all my cords and receiving a tongue lashing from my wife, I ended up subscribing to AT&T Uverse for one year.

On the other hand, more and more services are making their stuff freely or cheaply available online. A device called Sling TV has been making some noise in the market. For \$20 per month, you get a fair amount of basic TV and a few extras. Cord cutters will eventually win this war. Cable and satellite services will slowly evolve into (across from Hobby Lobby) 256-767-3337

some hybrid of streaming and traditional programming. But for now, if you're willing to complicate your life a bit, sacrifice a few channels, and tick off your wife, cutting the cord can save you some





A Bulldog Legend

For those of you who Cities teams. He also remember all the great football Quad-Cities teams in the decade of the 40's and 50's, you can recall the great rivalries between Coffee, Deshler and Sheffield during that era. Those were the games you pointed to on your schedule each year.

The games were hard fought battles to claim bragging rights as the Quad-Cities champions. Jam-packed stadiums were the norm during those classic rivalries and every single player who wore the Coffee, Deshler and Sheffield uniforms wore

them with great pride.
One of the all-time great Sheffield Bulldog players in the 1940s was Howard Stanford. He played tackle on legendary Hall of Fame coach Walton Wright's teams from 1941-1944. During his playing days, Stanford had great success on the gridiron. During his career, the Bulldogs compiled an overall record of 27-6-2.

But it was aforementioned rivalry games that Stanford was most proud of. His playing record against Coffee was 3-0-1 and against Deshler 3-1—a remarkable mark of 6 wins, 1 loss and 1 tie. The 1944 team was the best. The Bulldogs went undefeated, posting a 9-0 mark. They started the season with five consecutive shutouts and gave up only 4 touchdowns all season long.

That senior season, Stanford was named to the All-State and All-Triwas named Co-Captain of the '44 squad. Coach Wright once said about Stanford: "He was one of the best players he ever had." After graduation, Stanford enlisted in the United States Army and served in the Army of occupation in Japan.

After his discharge, he attended Florence State Teachers College for a short time and then received a football scholarship to the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. For his athletic achievements, Stanford was post-humously inducted into the 2015 Colbert County Sports Hall of Fame. Howard Stanford—truly a Bulldog Legend.

TAKE A HIKE

Your dog's company can enhance your experience of the great outdoors

iking is a great way to enjoy the outdoors, spend time with your dog and wear him out, especially if he's the super-active type. It's quite possibly the most accessible activity you can do with your dog. Wherever you live, you probably have access to dog-friendly hiking trails within 30 minutes of home. We've gathered eight tips to help you both have the best hike possible.

1. Puppies can go hiking as long as you condition them gradually. Start with short hikes of a half-mile to a mile, and slowly work up to longer distances.

2. Watch the weather. It's not just flatfaced dogs who are sensitive to heat and humidity. Plenty of dogs wilt quickly, even in moderate temperatures of 65 degrees Fahrenheit. Any time the temperature exceeds 80 degrees Fahrenheit, it's too hot for most dogs to exert themselves. If you're going on a short hike near home, consider hosing down your dog before you leave to help him stay cool, or stop during the hike at a place where he can go swimming or get wet.

3. Bring plenty of water and a snack. For a day hike in optimum temperatures over moderate terrain, a quart of water and some cut-up boiled chicken or hot dogs (frozen the night before) should be enough

to keep your dog hydrated and full of pep.

4. Because of the uneven terrain and changes in elevation, hiking is harder on the body than just going for a walk. Pay attention to your dog's condition, especially if he's a puppy or an old dog. You never want to see him panting heavily or unable to go on. Remember that dogs are lower to the ground and may not have the benefit of a breeze.

5. Keep your dog on leash so he doesn't disturb wildlife or other hikers. Accidents happen, though, so he should be trained to come to a whistle. The sound will carry over a longer distance than your voice if you get separated. He should also know and respond to the commands "sit," "stay" or "wait," "down," "heel" and "quiet."

6. Know how to treat injuries. You can find a pet first-aid course in your area through the Red Cross. Carry a first-aid kit that contains items such as bandages, antiseptic wipes and Benadryl (check with your veterinarian ahead of time so you'll know the appropriate amount to give if your dog suffers an insect bite or sting).

7. Tote that load. Your dog can carry his water, snacks, first-aid kit, a folding water dish and poop bags in a canine backpack. Before buying, check the fit to make sure it stays on securely without



being too tight or too loose or restricting his movement. You should be able to comfortably fit two to four fingers between the straps and your dog's body. Features that can add to his comfort include a mesh back panel for ventilation and padding beneath the straps. Other conveniences you may appreciate are D-rings for attaching items to the pack, weather-sealed zippers, attachment points for the leash and a handle on top that allows you to hold onto or lift your dog if necessary.

8. Bug out. Protect your dog from fleas and ticks with an oral or spot-on preventive. If the local insect population is especially intense, you can try applying an all-natural citronella spray to his coat. Be aware that the effect probably won't last more than an hour, so you'll need to reapply it regularly.

How to pat the cat? Stick to the head




