

# Holt Led the Chamber by Example

FLORENCE -- Shoals Chamber of Commerce President Steve Holt announced his resignation last week during the Chamber's monthly Board

of Directors meeting.
Holt, 67, arrived in 1994 from
Asheville, North Carolina, moving with his wife, Susie, and their two

youngest children, Jon and Allison. He knew quickly the Shoals was going to be a place to call home.
"When we

arrived at our new Holt home, everything we had was still on the truck. So I stopped at a grocery store to pick up some bread and basics," Holt recalled. "I wrote a \$40 check on a Carolina bank. The cashier never asked for an ID

and invited us to church." Holt oversaw the Chamber's role in numerous high-profile projects such as the Singing River (Patton Island) Bridge, the Shoal Creek Bridge, and the Robert Trent Jones development. Quality of life projects, ranging from Education Workforce
Development to Keep Shoals Beautiful were created, along with Outreach programs such as Youth Leadership Shoals and the Shoals Area Law Enforcement Coalition.

Holt's served at chambers of commerce in Morristown and in Kingsport, Tennessee, before serving as executive-vice

training, to effectively respond to structure fires. The inspection included but not limited to reviewing the number of training hours each fireman has accumulated, the equipment and hardware that each truck contains and fire prevention plans for each business served by the fire department. Many hours were spent ensuring that all protocols and records were up to date and that all required equipment was present on all of the fire trucks. The hard work paid off as the department rating for the five mile radius around the station dropped from six to four. This should equate to a savings for all Central residents who pay for homeowners insurance living inside that

Hall's book, *The Man From* Muscle Shoals: My Journey From Shame to Fame, was released shortly after the movie. Hall has also been invited to be an honorary member of the Guild.

Florence City Historian, Warren, will be inducted as a member of the Shoals Writers Guild at the group's meeting on February 20. Warren is the President Heritage Preservation which is dedicated to the preservation of local historic structures, sites, and documents. He is chairman of both the design committee for Florence Main Street and the Alabama Renaissance Faire which celebrates its 30th anniversary this year. Warren also writes a monthly column on local history for Kidsville News! He co-authored a book with Dr. Tom Ott and Jimmy Hill about the history of the homes on Walnut Street entitled, A Walk Down Walnut.

#### Questions from the Heart



My mother's doctor told her she is at risk for congestive heart failure. What is congestive heart failure, and what are the causes and symptoms that we should look out for? What can we do to prevent it? --Todd from Lexington

Congestive heart failure is a medical condition that occurs when your heart does not effectively pump blood as it should. This condition occurs when the function of the heart's left ventricle is reduced.

Ejection fraction is the percentage of blood that the left ventricle pumps to the body with each beat. Cardiologists determine this by a number of tests - such as Echocardiography, Nuclear Stress Ejection Fraction, and Cardiac Catheterization. When this percentage is significantly reduced, you are at a risk of congestive heart

So what are some of the *causes* of congestive heart failure? One cause is a Myocardial infarction, or rather, a heart attack. If you experience a heart attack, your heart loses some of its ability to pump. The muscle that is damaged by the infarction is permanently scarred and does not contract as it would normally, which can lead to congestive heart failure

Cardiomyopathy, or cardiac muscle weakness, is one type of viral condition which weakens heart muscle and reduces the heart's ability to clear an amount of blood that it usually does with each heartbeat. This reduced clearance function can again lead to congestive heart failure.

Another condition that reduces the efficiency of your heart is **high blood pressure**. High blood pressure leads to a thickening of the muscular wall of the heart, and eventual decreased muscle function can also be a cause for congestive heart failure.

Another cause of congestive heart failure is rheumatic **fever.** As a result of rheumatic fever, one of the four valves of the heart may be affected by an infection or scarring of

So what are the *symptoms* of congestive heart failure?

Someone with congestive heart failure is easily short of breath, and as the failure worsens, the shortness of breath worsens as well. People with this symptom have difficulty completing tasks that used to be ordinary. Someone experiencing congestive heart failure may even feel short of breath while lying down. Some people even forgo the bed and sleep only in a chair at night, or sleep with many pillows underneath their heads.

Swelling, also known as edema, is also a common symptom of congestive heart failure. Usually, the first noticeable swelling occurs in the legs (known as peripheral edema), and it may progress to swelling of the stomach as fluid builds in the body.

The mainstay of treatment for congestive heart failure primarily involves medicine such as beta blockers (which control your heart rate), ACE inhibitors (which control blood pressure), or diuretics (which eliminate extra fluid by encouraging urination). In addition to these options, there is a new medication called Entresto, which has shown significant clinical improvement in many patients. Treatment such as coronary artery revascularization and certain types of pacemaker placement may offer relief. Along with pharmacological treatment, it is also mandatory to restrict salt in your diet and avoid all prepared foods with high sodium amounts. If a single food has over 400mg of sodium, you should avoid it and make the food with fresh or frozen vegetables. Usually canned vegetables, canned soups, canned meats, packaged lunch meats, or snack foods do not contain less than 400mg of sodium per serving. Your total daily sodium intake should be less than 2g of sodium.

To treat congestive heart failure, we need to first identify the cause. If you are experiencing any swelling in the feet, ankles, and legs, along with a sudden shortness of breath, you should visit a doctor immediately. Before the next day, you should have your symptoms evaluated as this could be a serious and dangerous problem. There are many therapeutic interventions that can improve your symptoms and extend

I lost my change purse that had my license, social security card and insurance card in it. I am very concerned that someone will "steal my identity" and ruin my credit. If someone opens accounts in my name do I have to pay those bills? What do I do?

### McCutcheon

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama.

First, get your credit report. You can get one free credit report a year through AnnualCreditReport.com and make sure that no one has established any accounts that do not belong to you.

Remember that banks are required to recognize your signature and not pay a check that has been forged. BUT, you are required to go over your monthly statement and notify the bank

quickly for them to be required to put the money back in your account. You also have to promise to prosecute the person who stole the money and you really only get to invoke this protection one time. If someone you allow in your house on a regular basis has stolen a check, the law is that the bank is only liable the first time. After you know that someone who comes in your house that has stolen a check, it is your responsibility to make sure they do not steal checks and it is also your responsibility to pay for the checks if they do steal them.

Look over your credit card statements carefully to make sure no unauthorized charges have been made.

I like the idea of a company like Lifelock that monitors your credit. They have different programs at different costs that monitor your credit and notify you if someone opens a new account in your name. I recently looked into this for a client and the top level of service was \$349.00 a year and it was payable monthly if you so

My advice would be to hire a company such as Lifelock to monitor your credit and help you if you had a problem. That may be expensive but it sure would help you get a good night's sleep.

Obviously, if a credit card was stolen you would notify the credit card company immediately to freeze the credit card and hopefully help in tracking down anyone who had been using it.

Buckle up and drive safely.



No, I don't insure inexpensive things like smartphones. And if a smartphone is an expensive item to you, you probably thên shouldn't have that phone. I mean, there's nothing wrong with having a cell phone if you can afford it. But if you tear up a phone or it breaks down and you can't afford to replace it out of your own pocket, then you've got too much phone!







technology is already a challenge that the defense establishment grapples with. Doesn't this create more problems than it solves?

This is corroborated by the Daily Caller's report which excerpts the report by saying "The way in which DoD acquires its weapons platforms and supplies will also see significant changes. According to the document, the assistant secretary of defense for acquisition will overhaul "policies to integrate climate change considerations into mission area analyses and acquisition strategies across the life cycle of weapons systems, platforms, and equipment."

That's pretty bad, but it gets worse. It also creates <sup>'</sup>climate boards" that will integrate the new standards into all layers of the services.

Worse still, the military's tactical aims are being According complicated. to Americans for Limited Government President Rick Manning, "Sergeants leading a platoon should not be worried about the environmental sensitivity of a rice paddy that needs to be traversed to achieve their mission, while providing the maximum security for the personnel under their command. Tank commanders should be afforded all the training they need no matter how much fuel is expended in the process. Naval Captains should run their ships at the speeds that are necessitated by the immediate needs of the situation. Instead, President Obama would install bureaucratic boards and other second guessers tactical climate change assessments that would be held over officers' heads should they choose what was deemed to be a climate change insensitive course of action."

A three year moratorium on the Obama climate order should be instituted by Congress to assure that the full impacts can be realized before doing great damage to the technical capabilities of our armed forces, as well as damaging our capability to project force. If we want to return to the original mission of our military which is readiness, Congress itself must be ready to flex its Article I muscles. Our safety may very well depend on it.





# Come on, Spring!

If you know me at all, you know how much I love a beautiful green lawn (my wife likes to joke about it). It's true, though! A rich, green, well-manicured lawn sets off a home like nothing else. There's a secret to having one: If you want a beautiful lawn in August, the time to start doing something about it is now. Yes, I know, it may snow next week. That's ok, because this is the planning stage. We actually have a great, free resource for information about lawns and gardens—the local Agricultural Extension Office. It's a state-funded program, and every county in Alabama has one. The Lauderdale County office happens to be the home base of Extension Agent Taylor Vandiver, whose field is Home, Grounds, Gardens, and Home Pests. Taylor shared some advice on what to do this time of year in order to have the lawn you want come summer.

• Go by your local Extension Office and purchase a soil sample kit. This \$7 kit instructs you on how to obtain a sample of your lawn soil and mail it to the lab at Auburn University. Scientists there will prepare a report for you detailing fertilizer recommendations especially for your lawn. This report comes back within about 7 days.

• Don't fertilize yet! Fertilizing too soon encourages grass to begin growing, but a freeze will kill it. Wait until after the threat of frost to apply fortilizor.

• Now IS the time for pre-emergent application to treat spring and summer emergent weeds. Get to know your weeds, and apply pre-emergent herbicides accordingly. These herbicides don't actually kill the weed seeds. Instead, they create a film on the soil, which the sprouting weeds encounter after germination. Most seeds germinate when the soil becomes 60-70 degrees consistently. There are also some fall or winter weeds, so those need to be addressed at a later date. Don't know what some of your weeds are? Take a sample by the Extension Office and they will be happy to identify them for you.

• Moles can wreak havoc on a lawn. The best way to treat them is to trap them or apply a castor oil emulsion to repel them. You don't want to try to kill their food sources, because what you apply to kill grubs will also kill beneficial earthworms. Earthworms are good for your lawn.






