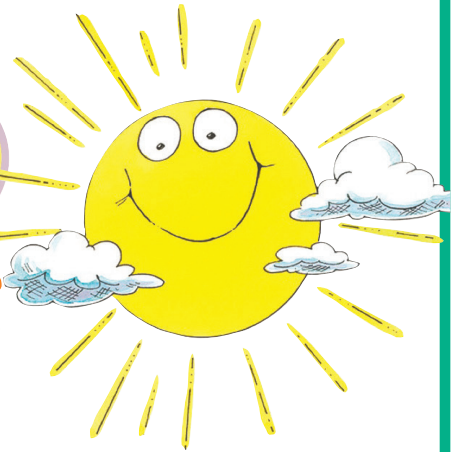

# SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speakout,"

Congratulations to all women on the 100th Anniversary of your right to vote. August 2020 is "**Women's Suffrage Centennial**" and "**National Women's History**" month.

The 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution was ratified on Wednesday, August 18, 1920, and prohibited the states and federal governments from prohibiting the right to vote to any citizen of the United States of America on the basis of sex.

I will attempt to include all the women who were prominent in Livingston County in alphabetical order.

**Dr. Harriet N. Austin, M. D.** (1826-1892). She opened her house called "Our Home" in Dansville in 1858 which would become the Jackson Sanatorium. She became one-third partner in the new venture as an active practitioner and partner, treating both male and female patients, including Clara Barton and Elizabeth Cady Stanton. The institution soon became nationally and internationally known as the largest water cure in the world.

**Donna Avery** (1932-2011) She was the first woman elected Town Supervisor in Livingston County. She worked part time at the Conesus Post Office. In her retirement, she volunteered at the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation as an advocate for the residents.

**Clarissa Harlowe Barton** (1821-1912) She is one of the most esteemed women in American history. When the Civil War broke out, she secured permission to go wherever her services were needed. She was named the "Angel of the Battlefield". She came to Dansville seeking respite at the Jackson Sanatorium and remained in Dansville for many years while continuing to lobby for the creation of the American Red Cross which she led as its President for twenty-three years.

**Elizabeth Potts Fitzhugh Birney** (1802-1869) She rose in national prominence and was most known for her anti-slavery activities and philanthropic contributions to the advancement of African Americans. She was the sister of Ann Carroll Fitzhugh Smith.

**Daisy Schirmer Everman** (1905-1998) She owned and operated the Everman Dairy Farm on Route 63 in Sparta for nearly fifty years. She left her teaching position at a nearby district school in 1932 to assume the management of the dairy portion of the Clement Everman farm.

**Nicholas Shaw Fraser** She lived at 22 Main Street in Geneseo in the first half of the 20th century. She was the sister of Eleanor Shaw Smith Fraser who also lived in the same house. She and her sister were involved in the highest levels of the state, national and international suffrage and temperance organizations. They were inspired by their aunt, the Reverend Dr. Anna Howard Shaw, who took her two nieces under wing after their mother died.

**Please register and vote!!!** Only 60% of women who were eligible to vote in the 2016 national election actually voted. So many of these wonderful women of the past labored for decades to obtain the right to vote. Please don't neglect your right to vote as your vote could be the decisive vote that determines our next President. Lord willing we will study many more wonderful women next week.

## Office Marine Patrol Unit

The Livingston County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol Unit is an intricate and valued part of the Sheriff's Office team. Marine Patrol members include 6 deputies and one sergeant who are all specially trained in Marine Law Enforcement and boater safety. The Marine Patrol Unit operates two up-fitted patrol boats and has two pontoon-boats available for special operations. There are two sub-stations on Conesus Lake available for Marine Patrol use. One is located at Sand Point and the other at Long Point. The Marine Patrol Unit supports other Sheriff's Office special teams by working in concert with the Underwater Search and Recovery Team as well as the SONAR Unit.

The primary goal of the Marine Patrol Unit is the safety of the citizens who use Conesus Lake for recreational boating and fishing. This is accomplished primarily by having a notable and visible presence daily with a goal to have all boaters following the rules of the water safely. This is handled through boater inspections, verbal and written warnings, and when necessary, enforcement.

A review of vessel stops revealed that most are for minor violations, such as improperly lighted boats or not having the correct equipment on board. Many families this year are first time boaters and may not be aware of some of the regulations. The deputies assist with many questions, work diligently to educate and have the "NYS Safe Boater Pamphlet" available for anyone.

The Livingston County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol Unit has been active during this summer. The 2020 boating season started out with uncertainty and quite a lot of apprehension on what the summer season would be like. The unit was forced to cancel two safe boaters courses early in the year due to the COVID-19 shut down. As an alternative, the boating course was offered online.

Memorial Day celebrations were cancelled throughout the region, and as a result, Conesus Lake saw an uptick in the early part of the boating season. The first boating mishap resulted when a man fell overboard, and was rescued by Livonia Fire department personnel. Sergeant Smith and Deputy Young responded and determined that the gentleman had on the correct coast guard approved PFD, which kept him safely afloat until help could arrive.

Through the second week of July 2020, the Marine Unit has handled 340 calls for service. The Marine Unit handled 295 calls for the entire 2019 boating season. There has been an increase in the number of vessel stops and inspections in 2020. This increase is believed to be in direct response to an increase in boaters and families taking advantage of the natural safe distancing that boating activities encourage. While speaking with the marinas on Conesus Lake, it was learned that there was also an increase in boat sales this year. It would appear that families are spending their vacation time and money closer to home.

The Marine Patrol Unit works closely with the Conesus Lake Association (CLA). They are instrumental through their website in helping to return lost and found property to the respective owners.

The CLA did cancel the annual Lake of Fire Celebration on July 3rd this year. While gatherings that did occur were subdued and respective of the social distancing guidelines, many residents lit their own flares and the Lake was lit up in celebration.

The Marine Patrol Unit looks forward to everyone having a safe and enjoyable experience the rest of the summer on Conesus Lake, and as always, is available for any questions or concerns.
