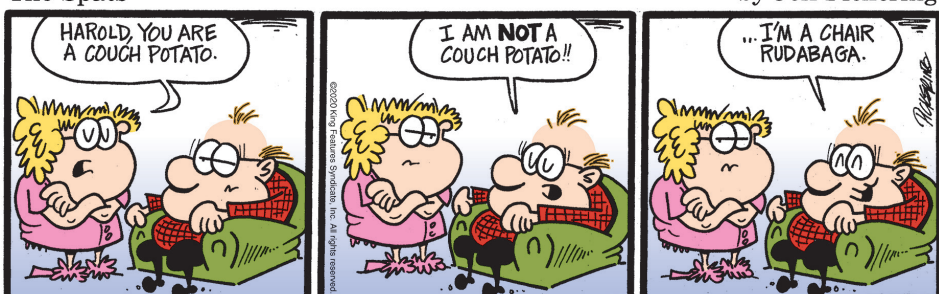

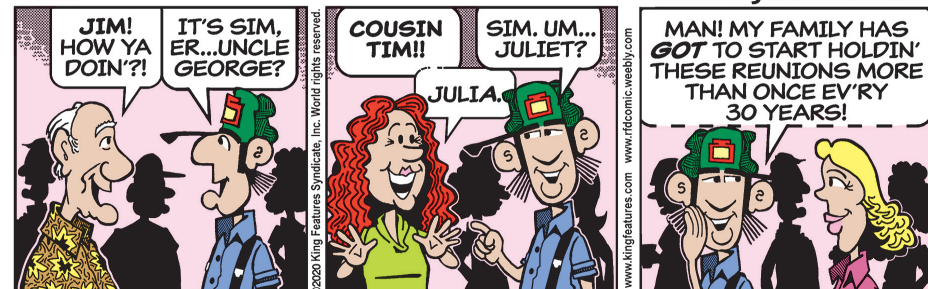

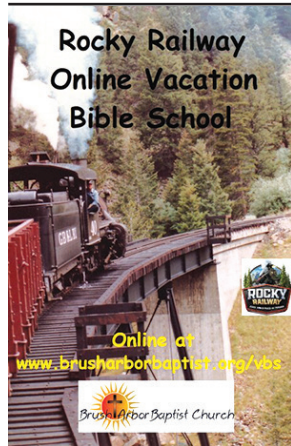

The article explains what happens then:

When a hermit crab spots a new shell, it'll size up the shell for a good fit. If the shell is too big, the prospecting hermit crab will sit back and wait to steal the castoff shell of a larger crab that decides to upgrade. In the meantime, while the first crab waits, other crabs gather around the shell and do the same.

The hermit crabs form a sort of conga line ordered from largest to smallest crab. As the largest crab enters its new home, the next crab in line takes the vacated shell, leaving an open shell for the crab behind him. The shell swapping continues down the line until everyone has upgraded. 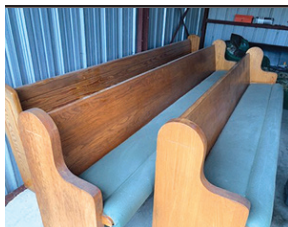

HOLLYWOOD by Tony Rizzo

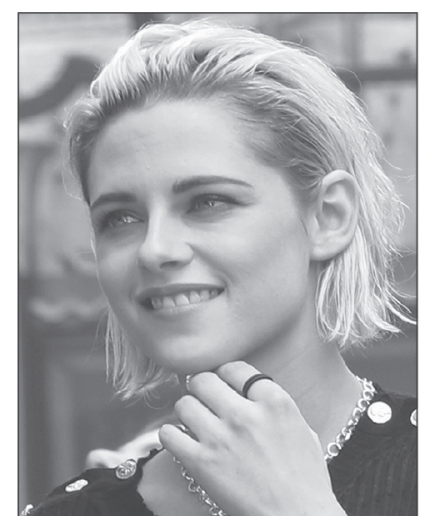

A Health Care Power of Attorney: A First Step

Most adults know that they need to appoint a person that could step in and make needed medical decisions should they become incapacitated. In legal terms, that person is your Agent appointed in your Health Care Power of Attorney or Advance Medical Directive. As with most cases, this is not simply the act of filling out a form that you may receive at the hospital or at a health care fair. The act of appointing a Health Care Agent is a process, a process that requires thought and conversations.

The first conversation is asking a loved one or trusted friend to be your Health Care Agent. You may be surprised but some folks do not wish to be put in that position. We have seen instances where a spouse, sibling or child is simply too emotional to have to make some decisions for a loved one. So do not just assume that your spouse, siblings and/or children will be the perfect people to appoint. Most of the time they are, but you need to know that if the time comes, they can and will make those certain hard decisions about your care. You will need a primary agent and a successor agent to step in if that primary agent is unavailable.

Once you determine who your agents will be, it's time to visit a Certified Elder Law Attorney. It's at this time your attorney will begin to ask questions as to what your wishes might be if you are ever in a persistent vegetative state (coma) or if you are at the final stage described as "end-of-life." This is the information that will be used in fashioning your Living Will. It is a statement of your wishes if you ever find yourself in either situation. Yet, there is much more to the process than simply stating whether or not you would want artificial nutrition or hydration (a feeding tube). This is your opportunity to structure how you would wish to be cared for.

For example, imagine if you have a chronic illness that you have faced for years. You probably know a lot about the types of treatments that are available or that you have had in the past. Would you want your Agent to explore new treatments or continue prior treatments? Imagine a cancer survivor: they may have had chemotherapy or radiation in the past. Would they want it again? That answer might be different coming from a 50 year old than an 80 year old. Thus, you need to think about what you would want to happen if the cancer came back. You can also see why we urge our clients to revisit, review and update this document as needed regularly.

One of the resources we make available to our clients is the Consumer's Tool Kit for Health Care Advance Planning, published by the American Bar Association's Commission on Law and Aging. Just having a written Health Care Power Of Attorney, Advance Medical Directive or Living Will by itself does not ensure that your wishes will be understood and respected. Studies have shown that these standard forms do little to influence end-of-life decisions without the client engaging in informed, thoughtful reflection about your wishes and values, and initiating a personal communication between you and your likely decision-makers before a crisis occurs.

Good advance planning for health care decisions is, in reality, a continuing conversation, about your values, priorities, the meaning of one's life, and quality of life. To help you in this process, this tool kit contains a variety of self-help worksheets, suggestions, and resources. There are 10 tools in all, each clearly labeled and user-friendly. This tool kit does not create a formal advance directive for you. Instead, it helps you do the much harder job of discovering, clarifying, and communicating what is important to you in the face of serious illness.

Once you have given these issues some thought, we will then know exactly how to tailor your documents to your unique situation. Even more important, a completed tool-kit is an excellent conversation starter for you to use when discussing your wishes with your chosen health care agent. Remember, you do not want to make your Agent the decision maker, you want your Agent to simply voice and carry out the decisions you have already made but are now unable to voice.

Without the benefit of essential documents in place such as Health Care Powers Of Attorney, Advance Medical Directives or Living Wills, your family might be forced to petition the circuit court to become your Guardian! In addition to the expensive and time-consuming legal process of obtaining Guardianship, your family will have to wrestle with medical care and end-of-life decisions without ever having had the important conversations with you that need to occur now, while you have the capacity to give these decisions careful thought and reflection!

Financial Help for Retirees Affected by COVID-19

Dear Savvy Senior,

Are there any financial assistance programs you can refer me to? The coronavirus pandemic has cost me my part-time retirement job and has shrunk my measly IRA account.

Needy Retiree

Dear Needy,

Absolutely! In addition to the \$1,200 federal coronavirus stimulus check that was distributed in April and May, there are many other financial-assistance programs (both public and private) that can help struggling retirees, as well as give relief to family members who help provide financial support for their loved ones.

To find out what types of assistance you may be eligible for, just go to BenefitsCheckUp.org, a free, confidential Web tool designed for adults 55 and older and their families. It will help you locate federal, state and private benefits programs that can assist with paying for food, medications, utilities, health care, housing and other needs. This site – created by the National Council on Aging – contains more than 2,500 programs across the country.

To identify benefits, you'll first need to fill out an online questionnaire that asks a series of questions like your date of birth, ZIP code, expenses, income, assets, veteran status, the medications you take and a few other factors. It takes about 15 minutes.

Once completed, you'll get a report detailing all the programs and services you may qualify for, along with detailed information on how to apply.

Some programs can be applied for online; some have downloadable application forms that you can print and mail in; and some require that you contact the program's administrative office directly (they provide the necessary contact information).

If you don't have Internet access, you can also get help in-person at any of the 84 Benefit Enrollment Centers located throughout the U.S. Call 888-268-6706 or visit NCOA.org/centerforbenefits/beans to locate a center in your area. Some centers also offer assistance over the phone.

Types of Benefits

Depending on your income level and where you live, here are some benefits you may be eligible for:

Food assistance: Programs like the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) can help pay for groceries. The average SNAP benefit for 60-and-older households is around \$125 per month. Other programs that may be available include the Emergency Food Assistance Program, Commodity Supplemental Food Program, and the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program.

Healthcare: Medicaid and Medicare Savings Programs can help or completely pay for out-of-pocket health care costs. And, there are special Medicaid waiver programs that provide in-home care and assistance too.

Prescription drugs: There are hundreds of programs offered through pharmaceutical companies, government agencies and charitable organizations that help lower or eliminate prescription drug costs, including the federal Low-Income Subsidy known as "Extra Help" that pays premiums, deductibles and prescription copayments for Medicare Part D beneficiaries.

Utility assistance: There's the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), as well as local utility companies and charitable organizations that provide assistance in lowering home heating and cooling costs.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI): Administered by the Social Security Administration, SSI provides monthly payments to very low-income seniors, age 65 and older, as well as to those who are blind and disabled. In 2020, SSI pays up to \$783 per month for a single person and up to \$1,175 for couples.


In addition to these programs, there are numerous other benefits they can help you locate such as HUD housing, home weatherization assistance, tax relief, veteran's benefits, senior transportation, respite care, free legal assistance, job training and employment and debt counseling.

Getting Up Off the Floor

With aging, we lose muscle. With all the staying home we're doing now, we're losing more muscle. We have to fight against that.

One serious result of losing muscle at our age is the simple task of getting up off the floor. It can happen to anybody our age: You look for something at the back of the bottom shelf of the refrigerator, and suddenly there you are, sitting on the kitchen floor, unable to get up.

Even if you can reach the phone to call for help, think about what happens next. The EMT crew will show up, but they won't come rushing in. Not nowadays. Now they want to determine whether or not you're likely to have the COVID virus. If there's any risk at all, they're likely to suit up with all their biohazard gear before they even come in the house. The best way to avoid all that drama is to not lose those muscles and to know a few techniques for getting up again.

Ordinarily I'd say to ask your senior center to hold a few classes on muscle building and how to get up off the floor. But it's likely they're closed. YouTube, however, never closes.

Put these search words into YouTube or even your browser: "seniors get off floor muscles." Some specific YouTube channels you can search through for helpful exercises and techniques are "Eldergym Fitness for Seniors," "Ernie Schramayr" and "Bob & Brad." (These last two guys are physical therapists with a great sense of humor. In fact, click Videos and look through all their offerings.)

When you find something you like, bookmark it. Then, when you have the muscles and the technique, test it once a week. Get down on the floor, get up. Even if you're certain you'd have no problems, test it anyway. With aging you never know.


