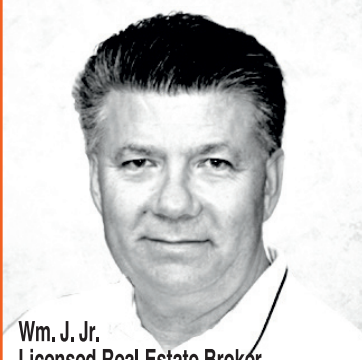

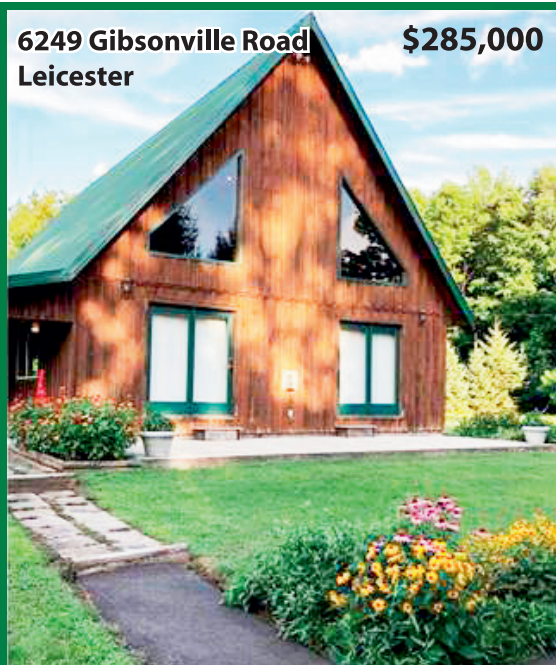

2020 Census Drive at Upcoming Food Distribution Events

The Census Bureau, in partnership with Livingston County, will be onsite at two upcoming Foodlink food distribution events – August 19 at the Mount Morris Central School and August 26 at the Livonia Central School – to answer questions and to assist County residents with completing the 2020 Census forms. Both events will be held from 2-4 PM.

Livingston County's goal remains to surpass its 2010 household self-response rate of 67%. As of August 11, the County's household self-response rate is just over 61%. Self-response will be available until September 30.

Need Help Paying for Medicare?

If your gross monthly income is less than \$1,615 for an individual or \$2,175 for a couple, you may be eligible for one or both of these programs. These figures are based on the 2020 federal poverty limits and are subject to change.

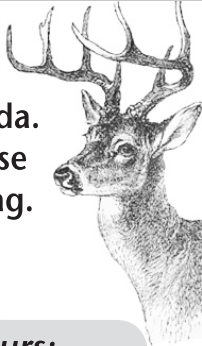

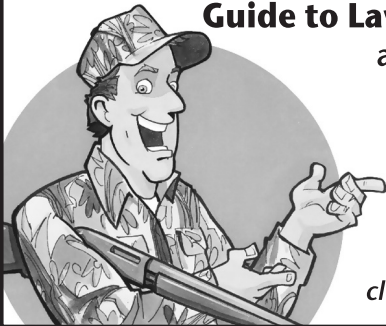

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speakout,"

I want to congratulate all women on the 100th anniversary of your right to vote. August 2020 is "Women's Suffrage Centennial" and "National Women's History" month.

The 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution was ratified on Wednesday, August 18, 1920, and prohibited the states and federal governments from prohibiting the right to vote to any citizen of the United States of America on the basis of sex.

I will attempt to include all the women who were prominent in Livingston County in alphabetical order.

Jessie E. McTarnaghan (1883-1948) She was the first woman to serve as Town Supervisor in Livingston County. She was appointed on December 9, 1947, in Hunt. She served on the Livingston County Board of Supervisors from December 22, 1947, until January 14, 1948, and passed away five days later.

Norine A. Meagher (1916-1999) She was a native of Livonia and served in World War II with a Women's Army Corps medical unit stationed in Japan. She later served in the United States until her unit was recalled during the Korean Conflict. Sergeant Meagher was then stationed in San Francisco. She was a charter member of the Livonia V. F. W. Post 9028 and was also active with the Harrison-Lee American Legion Post 283.

Elizabeth Smith Miller (1822-1911) She was born at the Hampton homestead and was a well-known designer of the women's Bloomer costume. She and her daughter, Ann Fitzhugh Miller, were suffragists and carried on the family tradition of philanthropy and social reform.

Helen Pratt (1906-2000) She was graduated from Albany Law School and was admitted to the New York State Bar in 1928. She then joined her father's law firm in Dansville and formed Pratt & Pratt where she continued the firm for the next 64 years before retiring in 1992. She served as the youngest alternate to the Democratic National Convention in 1932 when Franklin D. Roosevelt was nominated for U. S. President. Her youth and vitality attracted news journalists who were struck not only by her interest in politics but also by her ability to fly an airplane.

Jessie Belle Rittenhouse (1869-1948) She was a literary critic, compiler of anthologies and poet. She was born north-east of Tuscarora to John Edward and Mary MacArthur Rittenhouse. She was graduated in 1890 from Genesee Wesleyan Seminary in Lima. Her literary career began with book reviews in Buffalo and Rochester and led to a position as a reporter for the Rochester Democrat and Chronicle in 1894. In October 2019 she was honored with a sign at Dutch Street Cemetery north of Tuscarora and also a sign for MacArthur Road where she lived.

Rose M. Shave (1848-1925) She was a critically acclaimed artist in Nunda and was considered third in the United States for her watercolor painting of flowers in 1895. She began her career in 1876 as a student at Ingham University in Leroy which was the first women's college in the United States. She returned to Nunda to join her sister, Belle, also an artist, at a new home and studio at 49 East Street.

PLEASE REGISTER AND VOTE!!! Only 60% of women who were eligible to vote in the 2016 national election actually voted. So many of these women of the past labored for decades for the right to vote - so please vote.

Lord willing we will conclude our study of these wonderful women of our past next week. May God richly bless you.

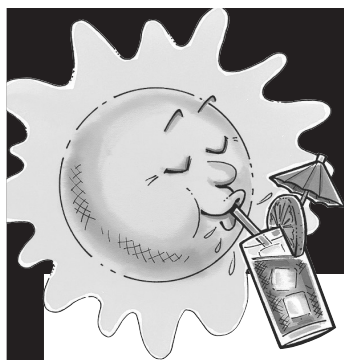
The Mount Morris Police Department reports the arraignment of Justin Gledhill age 22 from Mount Morris.

Livingston County Calls for Washington to Compromise on Stimulus Bill Without Federal Aid, Counties Face Financial Cliff in Lost Sales Tax Revenue and Reductions in State Reimbursements

Following the recent introduction of the HEALS Act in the U.S. Senate, Livingston County is calling on Congressional leaders and President Trump to reach a compromise coronavirus relief bill that provides direct, unrestricted aid to states and counties. This much-needed aid will help prevent devastating cuts and support Livingston County as it funds and administers a wide array of vital services, including Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), and substance abuse prevention services.

“With sales tax returns plummeting and New York State cutting state aid by 20%, county governments are teetering on the edge of a fiscal cliff as demands for services rise and economic activity is at a standstill. With COVID-19 cases rising around the nation and the New York state economy struggling to get back on track, now is not the time to be cutting services, jobs or limiting the capacity of our frontline workers to keep the virus in check. It’s time for our leaders in Washington to come together and compromise on a plan that provides direct federal aid to support our communities during this crisis and keep us moving forward,” stated Ian M. Coyle, Livingston County Administrator.

An updated economic impact report recently released by the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) shows counties and New York City facing a catastrophic \$13.5 billion loss in revenue over two fiscal years that could lead to significant cuts to services and permanent layoffs, slowing the economic recovery and threatening gains made against the virus. Without direct federal aid to backfill this loss of revenue, counties will not be able to fully fund the testing, tracing, and emergency response activities needed to get the pandemic under control and get our communities back on their feet.

The report also notes that State and local governments are major employers and provide nearly 12 percent of all U.S. jobs. Economists have noted that in the last downturn, during the Great Recession, the federal government’s austerity approach and decision to prematurely end financial assistance to states and local governments contributed significantly to the slow recovery, both in employment terms and contributions to gross domestic product.

“County governments are facing a perfect fiscal storm, as severe revenue loss and a forecasted high demand for social service programs threaten to grind county government to a halt and stall our progress in combatting COVID-19,” said Coyle. “Without help from our federal partners in the form of direct aid to local governments, counties will be hard-pressed to provide the essential services that are crucial to stopping the virus and reopening our communities.”

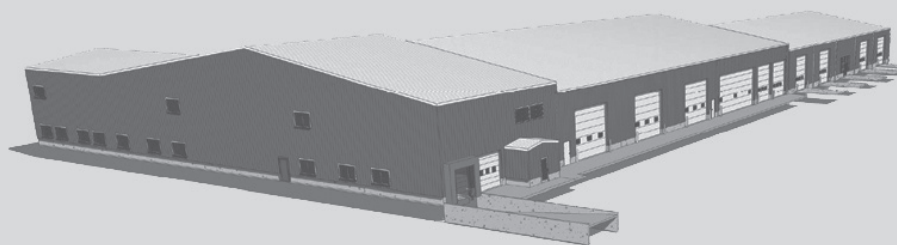
