

Mr. Beckwith said Keding has unquestionable honesty, and would spring into action for his customers.

"He provided very good service over the years," said Mrs. Beckwith. "I had a lot of emergencies. He had guite a team here. We're going to miss them."

Keding said he is selling the building at 309 East Ave. to his daughter Christine and son-in-law Michael Buorgiorne. It will be the base for Buorgiorne's construction business.



When Keding started as a mechanic when he was a teen-ager, he installed turning lights and fixed lawn mowers. He learned the auto mechanic trade at the General Motors Institute in Flint, Mich., beginning the two-year program in 1953. He worked for General Motors for three years before a two-year stint in Army at Fort Dix from 1958 to 1960.

He returned to Albion in 1960 and worked as a mechanic for a car dealership for 13 years before a brief stint as an electrician.

He opened his own business at the East Avenue location in January 1974. Keding said the work has become more high-tech with problems in cars more difficult to diagnose due to computers and electronics in vehicles.

"I've really enjoyed it," he said about his career. "It's something I always wanted to do." Shawn Deibel, 25, has worked with Keding the past eight years, starting in high school.

"John has been a good teacher," Deibel said. "He has always been accepting and if I needed help he would lend a hand. He has been a wealth of knowledge."

Karne Dibley has worked as the office manager for the past 14 years. She will be taking a job at the high school as a teacher's aide.

"He has a love for the job," Dibley said about Keding. "If it came in broken, he could fix it. He has really enjoyed being out in the community."







#### Let's go on an adventure together....to the Wonderful Land of Oz!

Did you know you can visit the Wonderful Land of Oz without leaving New York State? You don't have to ride a house in a tornado. You don't have to wear magical ruby slippers. You only need to take about a two and a half hour drive – give or take, depending on the route you take – to Chittenango, NY. And... you just might encounter a wicked witch, a cowardly lion, a scarecrow looking for a brain, a rusty tin man, and a sweet girl named Dorothy while you're there.

Chittenango is the birthplace of L. Frank Baum – author of the Wizard of Oz books. The small village of Chittenango embraces their connection to the famous author with 0z-themes everywhere you look – including yellow brick sidewalks, a lovely 0z-themed public library, and the All-Things-0z Museum. Just outside the village, they have an Oz-themed casino with an active tornado in the lobby and the Wicked Good Pizza place next door. There are several other Oz-themed shops in and around the village making sure that you can experience Oz anytime you want in Chittenango.



**Downtown Chittenango, NY** Their big claim to fame is the Oz-Stravaganza festival held the first weekend in June every year. Of course, this year's event was canceled, but when it happens, it's pretty darned cool. They have all kinds of costume contests and activities for young and old, alike. One end of town is dedicated to vendors, food trucks, music, and carnival-type rides and games. All the Oz characters come to life and wander around the village for photo opportunities and to

The weekend is capped with a big parade. I attended in 2017 and the Grand Marshall that year was Jane Lahr daughter of Bert Lahr, who played The Cowardly Lion in the movie. I got to meet her and have a nice conversation with her. Come as you are or dress like your favorite Oz character – you won't be out of place at the Oz-Stravaganza. The closing ceremony usually includes a balloon lift-off to take Dorothy back to Kansas. Unfortunately, the year I was there the threat of severe afternoon storms caused them to cancel the balloon lift-off. I will have to go, again, sometime to see that part!

But, Oz isn't all that Chittenango has to offer. Back in the early days of the Erie Canal, Chittenango Landing was known for building and repairing canal boats. They have a wonderful Canal Boat Museum that is open to the public and they give school children tours to teach them all about building canal boats. Volunteers have worked to reconstruct the dry docks and other buildings that were once an important canal resource from remains that were

discovered and unearthed. I really enjoyed the museum and recommend it if you're in the area.

Just four miles down the road is Chittenango Falls - I mentioned this beautiful park with a waterfall and walking trails in my Cooperstown article. Then, another five miles or so is the lovely village of Cazenovia with wonderful shops, restaurants, and a stunning lake.

One of my favorite things about the entire weekend was visiting The Wild Animal Park just north of Chittenango. It is an awesome park with lots of opportunities to get up close and personal with various animals that you can feed and pet. There are also some animals in enclosures for your protection or theirs. They also have snack huts and a bounce house for the kids, as well as a nice picnic area overlooking a lake. It is one of the better animal parks I've ever been to and is well worth the two hour or so drive.

And ... it isn't that far to make a day trip to the Wild Animal Park and a walk down the yellow brick sidewalks in Chittenango.



The average person can help his or her immune system do its job more effectively by making the immune system as strong as it can be.

Harvard Medical School says that diet, exercise, age, and psychological stress may affect immune system response. Certain lifestyle choices can promote a strong immune system.

· Get adequate sleep. Doctors believe sleep and immunity are closely tied. A study of 164 healthy adults published by the National Institutes of Health found those who slept fewer than six hours each night were more likely to catch a cold than people who slept for more than six hours. Aim for adequate rest each night to keep your body in top form.

· Increase your intake of fruits and vegetables. Fruits and vegetables supply the powerhouse antioxidants that are essential for protecting a body against free radicals. Free radicals may play a role in heart disease, cancer and other diseases. Serve fruits and/or vegetables with every meal to ensure you're getting enough antioxidant-rich foods.

· Consume fiber and fermented foods. Fiber can help feed the gut microbiome, which is linked to a robust immune system. The microbiome also may prevent harmful pathogens from entering the body through the digestive tract. Data also suggests that eating more fermented foods can further strengthen and populate healthy bacteria in the gut.

· Exercise regularly. Aim for 30 minutes of moderate exercise per day, advises the American Heart Association. Thirty minutes of exercise each day can go a long way toward keeping the body healthy. The U.S. National Library of Medicine says physical activity may help flush bacteria out of the lungs and airways. Exercise causes changes in antibodies and white blood cells. These antibodies and white blood cells circulate rapidly, so they may detect illnesses earlier than they would if you do not exercise. Body temperature also rises during exercise, which could naturally prevent bacteria from growing.

• Try to minimize stress. According to Simply Psychology, when people are stressed, the immune system's ability to fight off antigens is reduced, making people more susceptible to infections. The stress hormone corticosteroid can suppress the effectiveness of the immune system. Limiting stress through meditation and breathing exercises, or trying to remove stressors from one's life, may help.

A healthy immune system is vital to fending off or recovering from illness.


