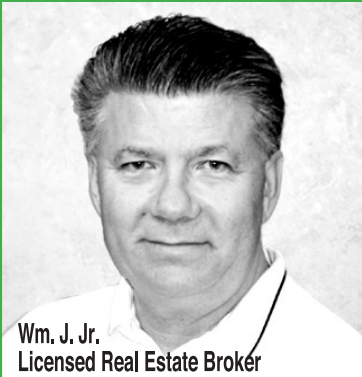

## Wheelchair Van for Lilyana Faith Chicken BBQ Benefit • August 30<sup>th</sup>



Lilyana is an incredible 8 year old girl that has inspired so many people and has touched so many hearts in her 8 years of being on this earth. She lights up a room with her big beautiful smile and always puts everyone else's feeling before hers even though she's the one with the disability. she loves playing with her friends, going on adventures, most of all she loves being independently mobile.

Lilyana was diagnosed with Quadriplegic Spastic Cerebral Palsy when she was a year old and hip dysplasia when she was 3. She has undergone 5 surgeries from 2015-2019 to correct hip dislocations and a deformed femur. Due to Lilyana's disability she is wheelchair bound and has very limited use of her legs she does use a walker but not very well and for only short periods of time. She has had a hard life in just a short time of living but she continues to do it all with a smile on her face and so much drive and determination.

Why am I telling you all this well Lilyana loves being in her electric wheelchair it gives her a feeling of independence she can go for walks, play with her sister outside in the yard driving around but when we take outings, go to doctor appointments, etc. due to transportation reasons we are unable to take her electric wheelchair and the one thing that gives her independence is taken away. we currently found a handicap wheelchair van that will allow Lilyana to drive her wheelchair up into it and she will be able to sit right in the van securely strapped in. We are asking for your help in purchasing this vehicle so she can have independence everywhere she goes. Making this purchase for her would give her so much more she would be able to go to friends house and play outside with them, go to doctor appointments, go to a store, go to a park, go anywhere she would like without having me pushing her in her manual chair.

Unpaid school taxes will be relieved with the town and county taxes in January, 2021 with an increased rate of interest.

# SPEAK OUT!!!

The Mount Morris Shopper feels that everyone has a right to be heard (or read, in this case) so we are offering this page each week (space permitting) for our readers to share their ideas, views, feelings or whatever. Realizing that everyone cannot AFFORD to pay for this privilege, the Mount Morris Shopper is offering this page as a FREE Public Service for articles or letters sent in for publication. All letters submitted must be signed with the name, address and phone number of the author. Please make letters as brief as possible.

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week I conclude our study of many of the wonderful women who have shaped Livingston County history. As was mentioned in my past three articles, August 2020 is "**Women's Suffrage Centennial**" and "**National Women's History**" month. All the women of Livingston County are to be honored.

The 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution was ratified on Wednesday, August 18, 1920, and prohibited the states and federal governments from prohibiting the right to vote to any citizen of the United States of America on the basis of sex. Therefore this past Tuesday marked the 100th Anniversary of this amendment. Congratulation to all you fine ladies!!!

Below are the last of those famous Livingston County women:

**Ann Carroll Fitzhugh Smith (1805-1875)** She worked with her husband Gerrit for the abolition of slavery, partnered with her daughter Elizabeth Smith Miller and granddaughter Anne Fitzhugh Miller for women's rights, and supported her son Greene in environmental conservation efforts. The Smith home was an active Underground Railroad site and haven for social reformers. She was the sister of Elizabeth Potts Fitzhugh Birney.

**Laura Page Smith (1817-1886)** In 1866, she resided on Murray Hill in Mount Morris and became the owner and president of Smith's Bank of Perry upon the death of her husband Anson D. Smith. Although Laura did not act in this capacity for very long, she nonetheless stepped into a realm that women of her era did not enter. She was a pioneer of women in the business world.

**Elizabeth Cady Stanton (1815-1902)** She was perhaps one of the women who was most beneficial to women in the United States as a whole. She was a famous abolitionist, suffragist and women's rights advocate who spoke at many locations in Livingston County in the late 19th and early 20th century. She died eighteen years before women gained the right to vote in 1920 and therefore she did not see all the fruits of her efforts.

**Sojourner Truth (1797-1883)** She was a former black slave, abolitionist and women's rights advocate and spoke several times in Livingston County – once in Avon and once in Livonia in August 1878 and once in Mount Morris in 1879.

**Alice Hay Wadsworth (1880-1960)** She was a national anti-suffragist leader. She lived with her husband, United States Senator James W. Wadsworth, Jr., in their palatial estate at the north entrance to the Village of Geneseo which is still there today. She became the second president of the New York State National Association Opposed to Women's Suffrage.

**Frances Willard (1839-1898)** She was one of the most prominent women of her time. Her vision encompassed raising the age of consent, labor reforms such as the eight-hour workday, prison reform and scientific temperance instruction.

I look forward to any of the historians in Livingston County to share their vast knowledge to our edification. We look to each of you to keep us informed. Without you much of our past will be lost to future generations. You are very important to all of us. May God richly bless all the women of Livingston County.
