

Lilyana is an incredible 8 year old girl that has inspired so many people and has touched so many hearts in her 8 years of being on this earth. She lights up a room with her big beautiful smile and always puts everyone else's feeling before hers even though she's the one with the disability. she loves playing with her friends, going on advenutures, most of all she loves being independently mobile.

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week I conclude our study of many of the wonderful women who have shaped Livingston County history. As was mentioned in my past three articles, August 2020 is "Women's Suffrage Centennial" and "National Women's History" month. All the women of Livingston County are to be honored.

The 19th Amendment to the United States Constitution was ratified on Wednesday, August 18, 1920, and prohibited the states and federal governments from prohibiting the right to vote to any citizen of the United States of America on the basis of sex. Therefore this past Tuesday marked the 100th Anniversary of this amendment. Congratulation to all you fine ladies!!!

Below are the last of those famous Livingston County women:

Ann Carroll Fitzhugh Smith (1805-1875) She worked with her husband Gerrit for the abolition of slavery, partnered with her daughter Elizabeth Smith Miller and granddaughter Anne Fitzhugh Miller for women's rights, and supported her son Greene in environmental conservation efforts. The Smith home was an active Underground Railroad site and haven for social reformers. She was the sister of Elizabeth Potts Fitzhugh Birney.

Laura Page Smith (1817-1886) In 1866, she resided on Murray Hill in Mount Morris and became the owner and president of Smith's Bank of Perry upon the death of her husband Anson D. Smith. Although Laura did not act in this capacity for very long, she nonetheless stepped into a realm that women of her era did not enter. She was a pioneer of women in the business world.

Elizabeth Cady Stanton (1815-1902) She was perhaps one of the women who was most beneficial to women in the United States as a whole. She was a famous abolitionist, suffragist and women's rights advocate who spoke at many locations in Livingston County in the late 19th and early 20th century. She died eighteen years before women gained the right to vote in 1920 and therefore she did not see all the fruits of her efforts.

Sojourner Truth (1797-1883) She was a former black slave, abolitionist and women's rights advocate and spoke several times in Livingston County – once in Avon and once in Livonia in August 1878 and once in Mount Morris in 1879.

Alice Hay Wadsworth (1880-1960) She was a national anti-suffragist leader. She lived with her husband, United States Senator James W. Wadsworth, Jr., in their palatial estate at the north entrance to the Village of Geneseo which is still there today. She became the second president of the New York State National Association Opposed to Women's Suffrage.

Frances Willard (1839-1898) She was one of the most prominent women of her time. Her vision encompassed raising the age of consent, labor reforms such as the eight-hour workday, prison reform and scientific temperance instruction.

I encourage anyone who knows any other prominent women to send their article to "Speakout" so we can all be blest by them. I look forward to any of the historians in Livingston County to share their vast knowledge to our edification. We look to each of you to keep us informed. Without you much of our past will be lost to future generations. You are very important to all of us. May God richly bless all the women of Livingston County.






