She misses spontaneity, the freedom to just on the spur of the moment decide to have a change of scenery. Of course we have done some of those things but with trepidation. We mask up and sometimes glove up and are careful not to get close to anybody. We haven't been inside a business establishment in months. The only public building we've been in is the post office. Our groceries are delivered to our trunk. We may be bordering on paranoia but at least we feel a little safer. We have taken short car trips around the county. I'm doing interviews by phone these days. It's a lot safer.

Susan and I have taken early morning walks in our city park. It's a lot less crowded than our state park, which is full of hikers and bikers. I've also been doing some recording around the town and did a radio piece on our acoustic summer. It includes the sounds of lawn equipment, cicadas, geese and ducks at the city park, a fisherman casting a line in the city lake, footsteps pounding the pavement, a yoga lesson, the sound of the 3 waterfalls at the spring, the sound of firing up the bbq grill, wind, wind chimes, the fantastic repertoire of a humming bird and the roar of a night time thunderstorm.
