In late summer of 2005, Annette Nolen-Ferguson found a litter of orphaned, unweaned kittens in this area. She took them into her home and lovingly bottle fed them and provided them 24 hours a day care. When they were about seven weeks old, she found all of them homes. People who knew Annette were not surprised by this, because she had loved animals her whole life.

Annette and her family had no way of knowing that shortly after that, on October 25, 2005, Annette would pass away suddenly, leaving a grief-stricken family.

In 2018, her parents, George and Judy Nolen, decided that they wanted their daughter's life to be remembered and memorialized, and they chose to do that by establishing the Annette Nolen Ferguson Foster Fund with the Danville Area Humane Society.

Although we have had a foster program for special-needs cases, we have a desire to expand that program. As many orphaned, unweaned kittens and puppies come into our open-admission shelter every year (sometimes in the hundreds), the need is great for people to be willing to provide the care in their homes. As a natural consequence of this, they become adoption ambassadors for their foster animals and help find homes with friends and family members, using our regular adoption process. That is a winning situation for the animals, the foster homes, and us!

Sometimes, an animal that requires special care outside of a shelter environment is in need of a foster home

for a short period of time. The reasons for needing a foster home vary.

Until now, foster homes were responsible for the cost of the food and veterinary care. This fund allows us to provide the food and to pay for the veterinary treatment.

The process for being approved to be a foster home is the same for being approved for an adoption. It is not a long process and it helps us ensure the future safety and well-being of shelter animals. Just stop by the shelter during our regular business hours (12-5:30 Monday-Friday and 12-3:30 on Saturday) and fill out a questionnaire to begin the process.

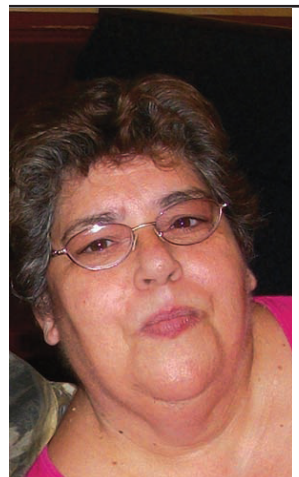

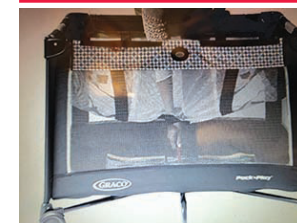

The customer is asked to provide a debit card or credit card number in order to make payment.

Danville Utilities does not make phone calls to customers about disconnects. Any notice of disconnection is done by mail.

Businesses often are targets of utility bill payment scams, but households appear to be the target of this scam.

Utility bill payment scams are not new. Guard against fraud. Never provide a Social Security number, credit card number or banking information to anyone requesting it unless you initiated the contact and know the identity of the person with whom you are speaking.

If you receive a call from someone you do not know and who is urging you to make a payment to Danville Utilities, capture the phone number and then hang up and contact the Division of Customer Accounts at 434-799-5125 or visit the Charles H. Fall breakfast doesn't get much better than these Baked Pumpkin Donut Holes!

Ingredients

For the donuts:

- 1 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 3/4 cup pumpkin puree (not pumpkin pie filling)
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup milk

For the cinnamon sugar coating:

- 1 stick of unsalted butter, melted
- 2/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Generously grease a 24-cup mini muffin pan with nonstick spray.

Sift flour into medium mixing bowl, add in baking powder, salt, nutmeg and pumpkin pie spice.

In a separate large bowl, scoop in the pumpkin puree and mix in brown sugar.

Mix in the vegetable oil, vanilla extract, and add an egg. Pour in milk, and mix until smooth.

Add the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients and stir until just combined. Be careful not to overmix the batter.

Scoop the batter into a 24-cup mini muffin pan, about 3/4 full each cup, and bake at 350 degrees for 10-12 minutes, or until a toothpick comes out clean.

Remove the donuts from the oven and allow to cool just enough to handle.

Place melted butter in one bowl and the sugar and cinnamon in another.

Dip the donuts into the melted butter, and coat, coat, coat in cinnamon sugar.

Serve warm, and enjoy
