The Veterans Voice – Service Connected PTSD (Part 2)

spread-word), approximately 22 military service members and veterans take their lives every day. Last week we discussed combat related PTSD. Today we will discuss service connected PTSD as a result of personal injury/trauma. The most frequently filed claims with Veterans Services involving personal injury/trauma have to do with Military Sexual Trauma (MST). The Department of Veterans Affairs have many excellent resources for victims of MST at www.mentalhealth.va.gov/ mentalhealth/msthome/index.asp. There are, of course, other situations besides MST a veteran You can visit www.vba.va.gov/ experienced pubs/forms/VBA-21-0781a-ARE.pdf and view page 3 for MST and other personal injury/trauma symptoms. We also have counselors from the South Bend Vet Center who come to Berrien County on Wednesday's and Thursday's for individual and family counseling to deal with all forms of PTSD. You can contact them at (574) 231-8480 for more information. To qualify for the free counseling services you need to be a combat veteran, combat drone operator, medical professional who treated injured combatants, loaded/unloaded causalities, MST or immediate family member who lost a loved one on active duty. There are also many fine local private organizations who offer coping therapies ranging from pet/dog and horseback riding therapies to float tank and fishing therapies. You can Google many other excellent resources and please also take time to visit the Lone Survivor Foundation website at https://lonesurvivorfoundation.org/

is weren't documented in service, we have other ways of service connecting the PTSD. One method we use are statements from the veteran, family members and fellow service members. We also look carefully at the service members personal performance evaluations. If they, for example, were performing at a certain level consistently and then there was a noticeable decline in their regular level of performance or personal appearance following the personal injury or traumatic event (e.g. they started using drugs and/or alcohol at a higher level than normal to self-medicate from the pain or shame of the event, etc.) we can make those arguments with the VA and in many instances prevail. According to VA law, lay testimony/statements are supposed to have the same weight of evidence as medical, especially when medical record entries are minimal or lacking entirely. We frequently cite 38 CFR § 3.159(2), "Evidence not requiring that the proponent have specialized education, training, or experience. Lay evidence is competent if it is provided by a person who has knowledge of facts or circumstances and conveys matters that can be observed and described by a lay person." Several significant precedent setting Veterans Law Federal Circuit cases we use include Buchanan v. Nicholson and Jandreau v. Nicholson (2006) and Davidson v. Shinseki (2009), which reminds VA raters of the significance of lay testimony when adjudicating a veterans claim. If you were in combat operations or suffered from a personal injury/traumatic event(s) in service and believe you have PTSD, please contact our office for additional information.

Gyms officially reopened in our region Wednesday morning, after being closed for nearly six months due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

As with other re-openings, the public can expect things to look differently than normal. The executive order places various stipulations on fitness-related facilities including a 25% cap on capacity; requiring an increase in circulation of outdoor air through use of windows, doors, and fans; regularly sanitizing fitness equipment and ensuring social distancing requirements are met; encouraging outdoor classes vs. indoor; and mandating gym-goers to wear a mask at all times, including when working out.

I must say, my reaction to these restrictions are mixed. While I'm ecstatic gyms are finally open and completely understand the need for restrictions, I'm frustrated there was nothing new or innovative about the precautions ultimately placed. Fitness facilities have been told they've remained closed due to the nature of their industry, yet now they are re-opening with restrictions nearly identical to the ones restaurants had for dine-in back in June.

That begs the question, what precluded these restrictions from being placed on every gym in Michigan three months ago? Gym owners and their patrons would have welcomed these concessions if it meant they could open and exercise. After all, people who frequent the gym care about their health in the first place.

Instead, those "invested" in our fitness industry had to wait 5 months and 24 days –a whopping 48% of the year – before fully re-opening. In the 177 day stretch, there have been 171 executive orders – nearly one a day – and it was not until executive order 2020-176 that this industry received even a word of when they would be able to re-open. In these columns, I have frequently written about business owners needing customers, cashflow, and certainty in

order to survive. That struggle for gyms may finally be over, but the plight for many other Michigan businesses continues on.

Movie theaters, arcades, amusement parks, bowling alleys, ice rinks, climbing facilities, trampoline parks, performance venues, and more still remain closed to the public in Michigan. (Bowling alleys, roller rinks, and ice rinks may open for the sole purpose of serving as a venue for organized sports, not the public.) With property taxes due in mid-September and still no revenue coming in, many are at their breaking point.

Again, I must ask why? The overwhelming majority of other states have now figured out how to re-open these industries safely and most of them have less potential for contact and transmission of the virus than industries that have already been given the green light. Movie theaters for example can easily accommodate 25 to 30 masked and physically distanced patrons, all of whom will face the same direction for the duration of their visit, with no contact at all. Not only that, the seats within theaters can be sanitized and the air circulated after every single show

In fact, the cinema industry is so beleaguered a historic alliance of more than 380 cinema companies representing over 3,000 locations and 33,000 screens nationwide have together to recommend and implement expert-backed, industry-specific health and safety protocols to help states working through their re-opening process. They've even launched a website where the general public can view their efforts called www.cinemasafe.org. I encourage you to visit and see their thoughtful approach for yourself.

Despite all this, Michigan remains one of just seven states that have still not re-opened movie theaters. Yet another alarming example of the lack of industry input in our state's decision-making process.

I've said it before and I'll say it again, these businesses are desperate and fighting for survival. Their only true path to solvency and long-term stability is re-opening and it is well past time we let them

You'll like the good vibes at New Era, especially if you hearken back to that "old school" type of atmosphere, but with a touch of modern swag. Mario's stated purpose at New Era Cuts is straight forward: To not only provide you with a euphoric feel, but to bring sensation and confidence to your life. He adds. "No matter what ethnicity or background you come from, at New Era, we stand by change, which inspires us to inspire you!"

The Bridgman City Planning Commission has voted unanimously to proceed with a recommendation to the full City Commission for a zoning ordinance amendment which would pave the way for creation of an Interstate Gateway District covering some 29 parcels of land encompassing Red Arrow Highway at I-94 in the community. The intent of the district as stated, is "To provide commercial uses to serve the larger community and the traveling public in the vicinity of I-94, and to promote the economic development of the city, while establishing standards for curb cut locations, parking, loading & unloading areas, landscaping and building material, to enhance the connectivity, safety and appearance of the city's primary southern entrance." It would change the designation from a

Commercial Corridor District to an Interstate Gateway District in order to support new development. The planners conducted a virtual Zoom meeting on the measure and heard only one objection from a Kalamazoo Attorney, Michael Bingen, who represents property owner Gurwinder Gill and his BP Gas Station at that interchange. Gill through his attorney earlier this week and again in the meeting argues that the zoning amendment "will turn Red Arrow Highway into a commercial wasteland of unregulated fast food restaurants, automobile dealerships, service stations, and asphalt." They contend that while the city's stated intent for the Interstate Gateway District is to promote economic development by establishing standards for parking, landscaping, and building material, reality is that "this 'District' will eliminate the provisions in the current zoning ordinance which regulate these industries by requiring special use permits." Bingen argued that the district "violates the intent and spirit of the City of Bridgman Master Plan that was just adopted in 2019, which envisions a high quality and attractive commercial strip for Red Arrow Highway." He then pointed out that one of the city's Master Plan goals (Goal 10) states: The preservation and enhancement of natural features of the community will be a central consideration in all civic decisions in Bridgman. Buildings and infrastructure will be planned, constructed, and maintained to protect and improve the quality of the natural environment while serving the needs of the population and giving residents and visitors appropriate access to enjoy natural features. Instead, the service station owner and his attorney contend that, "The Planning Commission wants to reduce thoughtful regulation so that an automobile dealership and a Casey's General Store can locate on Red Arrow Highway without complying with the requirements of special land use permits and the current Zoning Ordinance." Bingen told the Planning Commission that they should not be allowed to abandon the intent of the Master Plan just to satisfy businesses that do not want to enhance Red Arrow Highway and the community. Weko Dunes resident Peter Loveland was unable to participate in the meeting, however he dispatched a letter to City Manager Juan Ganum saying, "I attended one of these meetings and expressed the need to make major improvements on our Red Arrow gateway entrance to Bridgman. Red Arrow sees far more traffic than Lake Street does. With the exception of the Monogram Building renovation and the new McDonald's, little or nothing has been done to improve our major thoroughfare, Red Arrow Highway, in the past 15 years." He went on to write, "I can understand Mr. Gill's desire to maintain a monopoly with the only gas station at Exit 16. If I owned it, I'd fight to keep the same monopoly. However, by growing our visitor base through new



If your efforts to renew your driver's license or your license plate tabs have been thwarted by the pandemic, and you've been able to take advantage of the state's renewal extension plan, you are being warned that you will need to act before the end of the month. The Michigan Department of State is reminding drivers that the current driver's license, state ID and vehicle renewal extension plan will expire on September 30th. Under Public Acts 127-129, those with driver's license, state ID or vehicle registration expiration dates between March 1st and September 30th have until September 30th to complete their renewals. With that deadline now just two weeks away, drivers who haven't completed their renewals are encouraged to make a plan to do so immediately. Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson reminds everyone, "As part of our ongoing efforts to address customer needs during the pandemic, we have expanded our branch hours and added a number of appointments to ensure everyone who needs to is able to renew their driver's license or ID ahead of the September 30th deadline," and adds, "There are still many available appointments, and anyone

who has not handled their renewals is encouraged to do so immediately." Her department announced recently the expansion of Secretary of State branch office hours to accommodate renewals for driver's licenses and state IDs that expire between January 1st, 2020, and September 30th, 2020, and must be renewed in person. Appointments reserved for that specific circumstance are available from 4 pm to 7 pm Monday through Friday from now until September 30th. To make an appointment, visit www.Michigan.gov/SOS or call 888-SOS-MICH (767-6424). Many driver's license and ID renewals also can be completed online at wwwExpressSOS.com. Vehicle registration and tab renewals should be completed online, by mail or at one of the 121 self-service stations located across the state. To renew at a self-service kiosk, drivers only need their license plate number and the last four digits of their Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or the renewal noticed mailed to them by the Michigan Department of State.


