## **Planned** for **POW/MIA's**

When someone is missing or being held against their will, there are loved ones and friends in their

hometown who have to deal with this tragedy, searching diligently for them, hoping to learn of their fate, and to reunite soon.

Such tragedies can strike especially during wartime, and too often going unresolved despite our best efforts. Since 1998 National POW/MIA Recognition Day is observed on the third Friday in September to remember and honor those US service members who were prisoners of war and those who are still missing in action.

The statistics are sobering: Over 83,000 remain missing from WWII through the Gulf



## Recounting **Earlier 'Tears'**

SHOALS- The "Trail of Tears Commemorative Motorcycle Ride" begins in Bridgeport, Alabama near Chattanooga on September 19 and ends in Waterloo where a festival will take place. Waterloo is where some of the Cherokee were loaded on boats in 1838 for transporting to Indian country in Oklahoma. Others walked trails to Oklahoma through freezing temperatures and slept on the ground. Thousands died.

The story of the Cherokee Trail of Tears is well-known, but the three other Indian tribes who lived in Alabama, the Chickasaw, Choctaw and Creek also had their trail

of tears story before the Cherokee. Their's are not well known.

Author Harry Shannon Phillips, Sr. tells more about the story in his book, Before The Trail Of Tears-The Rest of *Their Story,* that some history books omitted for whatever reason. Contrary to conventional wisdom, they are not "Indians" but are native Americans who were nomads in Siberia thousands of years before they migrated to America. The "Rest of the Story"

brings to light Andrew Jackson's



shameful 1830 Removal Act that finally doomed the Chickasaw, Choctaw, Creek Nations, and the

Cherokee, the last to be removed.

## Medicare Minute "Physician Charges"

There are three ways your doctor can be paid if you are on Medicare. The three ways are through Medicare assignment, Medicare excess charges or by not taking Medicare at all. Today we will discuss these three methods.

The most common way a physician gets paid is by Medicare assignment. These physicians are called "participating doctors". After the Part B deductible of \$198 is met, participating doctors will accept the Medicare approved amount for their services. These doctors charge Medicare 80% and the beneficiary 20% of the cost of the benefit. For example, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, and you would be responsible for the other 20%, or \$20.

A "non-participating doctor" can choose to accept or not accept Medicare assignment. If the doctor does not accept Medicare assignment you may have to pay an additional 15% of the cost of the service the doctor provided. This is call a Medicare excess charge. It means you would be responsible for 35% of the Medicare reduced amount instead of 20%. If we follow the example in the previous paragraph, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, but you would be responsible for 35%, or \$35.

Doctors who opt out of Medicare can charge whatever they want for their services and you are responsible of 100% of the cost. The majority of doctors in north Alabama accept Medicare, so you won't be faced with this situation very often.

Most people who have Medicare also have a supplemental policy that helps cover the 20% Medicare doesn't cover. If you are just entering Medicare and would like to know which policies cover what Medicare doesn't pay, you can contact our office for more information.



in 2018 when it was raining because he did not believe it important to honor American war dead, referring to them as 'suckers' and 'losers.' And besides, he feared his hair would become disheveled in the rain.

Not even a single source for the story was willing to go on record. It's a desperate smear by those aligned with an increasingly desperate Biden campaign that sees momentum changing.

As of my press time over 20 officials who were part of the trip have said the claims in the story simply aren't true.

They dismissed the anonymous accounts as 'simplyfalse', 'despicable,' 'untrue', and 'BS,' the latter coming in a tweet from a normally collected former press secretary, Sarah Huckabee Sanders. Sanders later held a full press conference on the issue to elaborate on the fake story.

Matz was in France and coordinated the events where the comments were allegedly made. He called The Atlantic story, "false and despicable."



experience then complained that it didn't improve anything. I could have told him it wouldn't help, but he never asked me. Here is why that didn't work.

Local internet service providers advertise "blazing" speeds that promise to make everything faster. I have news for you: They lie. Before continuing with this article, please go get your latest invoice

from your internet service

and paying extra for anything over 25Mbps, you're probably slow speed. For example, a typical website sends data to

provider and let's go over a couple of things. Got it? OK, now look for a heading that tells you how many megabits per second you are paying for (Mbps -- million bits per second). Common speeds around here are 16, 25, 50, or over 100Mbps.

If you're a family of 3 or 4 throwing money out the window and here is why: Most websites deliver content to you at a pretty you at only 1 or 2 Mbps. Thus,

if all you do is visit Facebook or check your email the slowest plan you can buy will be more than you can possibly use. High definition Netflix delivers movies at 3 Mbps but they recommend 5 Mbps as a buffer. Speeds faster than 10Mbps won't make that high def video any more high def. A few of you may have the new-ish "ultra high def" 4K TVs. Those require a minimum of 15Mbps (25Mbps as a buffer) -- but only if you're actually watching 4k videos.

Households with more than one person need to consider

how many users or devices are playing on the internet at the same time. If your household has 4 people who all surf the 'net at the same time, each of you may use up to 3-5 Mbps each so you'll need to opt for a 20 Mbps plan to keep everyone happy.

In my home, I have my gaming system, 6 TVs, smart doorbells, security cameras, thermostats, phones, tablets, washer/dryer (yes, I have "smart" washer and dryers and I have no idea why), and my whole-house music system all playing at the same time and I only pay for the minimal 25Mbps plan from Comcast for \$30/mo.

Business users are in a whole different category, of course. Many use internet phone systems as well as all the business stuff that goes on that requires a bit of analysis to come Courier Journal / September 16, 2020

up with a minimum speed. I can only tell you that, at my office with 10 computers downloading updates, employees wasting time on YouTube, my phone system, and our smartphones and I get by just fine with a 60Mbps plan from Comcast. If you already have a decently fast internet and stuff is still slow, it's probably your wireless network that is crimping your style. That will be the subject for my next exciting installment.


