Ingredients

• 2 tbs Canola oil • 4 - 6 Chicken bone-in, skin on thighs (about 6 oz) • 1/2 tsp Paprika Salt & Pepper 4 Carrots sliced 1/4-inch rounds • 3 stalks Celery (9 oz) sliced 1/4-inch thick 2 large Shallots (4 oz) finely diced 2 cloves Garlic minced • 1 tbs Thyme leaves chopped • 1 tbs oregano leaves chopped • 2 tsp Lemon zest 1 tbs lemon juice • 1 cup long-grain Rice • 4 cups Chicken stock

• 1 tbs fresh chive chopped

Directions

Preheat the broiler. Heat 1 tablespoon of the oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Toss the chicken with the paprika, 1 teaspoon salt and a few grinds of pepper in a large bowl. Place the chicken skin-side down in the skillet and cook undisturbed until the skin is golden but not too dark, 4 to 5 minutes. Remove the chicken to a plate using a metal spatula and add the remaining 1 tablespoon oil to the skillet.

Add the carrots, celery and shallots to the skillet and cook, stirring occasionally, until softened but not yet turning golden, 4 to 5 minutes. Stir in the garlic, thyme, oregano, lemon zest, lemon juice, 1/2 teaspoon salt and a few grinds of pepper and cook just until you begin to smell the garlic, about 1 minute. Stir in the rice and cook undisturbed until lightly toasted, about 2 minutes. Pour in the broth, add 1/2 teaspoon salt and stir to combine, then add the chicken thighs back to the pan, skin-side up. Bring the liquid to a boil then cover, reduce the heat to a simmer and cook until the rice is tender and the chicken is cooked through, 15 to 20 minutes.

Remove the lid from the pan and broil until the chicken skin is crispy and golden, 2 to 3 minutes. Sprinkle with the chives.

DISTRICT NEEDS FISCAL YEAR '22 Each year the City of New York requires each Community Board to submit a list of capital and expense requests in its respective district for review. For example, Bronx Community Board #10 can suggest to the city to increase garbage pick-up, increase hiring for parks maintenance and cleaning and to increase resources road repair. If there is a city program that is successful and you wish for it to have its funding increased, please let me know. It is crucial now more than ever to demand the City continue funding popular and successful municipal services. As you know, the City budget was cut drastically and we are already seeing an increase in complaints as agencies are doing more with less resources. Our annual District Needs Statement Public Hearing occurs on October 17 **NEW YORK STATE UNCLAIMED FUNDS**

<u>New York State Unclaimed Funds</u> According to New York State Comptroller Thomas DiNapoli's office, the state of New York returned over \$100 million to its rightful owners. The New York State Abandoned Property Law requires certain entities to return abandoned monies or securities to the New York State Comptroller's Office of Unclaimed Funds. The process is simple! All you have to do is search your name on www.osc.state.ny.us/ouf/index.htm and you will find out if you have any unclaimed funds. As always, I and my staff are available to check for you, but I encourage you to stop by so that we can assist. My office is open Monday through Friday from 9 A.M. to 5 P.M. Good luck on your search!

SPEED CAMERAS

School zones are back in effect as of this week. Speed cameras in our communities will operate from 6 A.M. to 10 P.M. Monday through Friday all throughout the year. This expansion is part of the City of New York's Vision Zero initiative to reduce vehicular, pedestrian and bicycling incidents. As you all know, our speed limit is 25 miles per hour.
