"I'm taking it to Sunday School and giving it to God." the little girl replied. "He'll be just as surprised as I was at not getting a dollar like usual."



VEGETABLE BEEF

6 Servings Ingredients

- 3 medium potatoes, sliced
- 3 carrots, sliced
- 3 celery ribs, sliced
- 2 cups cut fresh or frozen cut green beans
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 pound lean ground beef (90% lean)
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme •
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 4 medium tomatoes, peeled, seeded and chopped
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese

Directions

1. In a 3-qt. casserole, layer half the potatoes, carrots, celery, green beans and onion. Crumble half the uncooked beef over vegetables. Sprinkle with 1/2 teaspoon each thyme, salt and pepper. Repeat layers.

2. Top with tomatoes. Cover and bake at 400° for 15 minutes. Reduce heat to 350°; bake about 1 hour longer or until vegetables are tender and meat is no longer pink. Sprinkle with cheese; cover and let stand until cheese is melted.

SPINACH BEEF MACARONI

2 CASSEROLES 12 SERVINGS EACH. CAN BE HALVED.

Ingredients

- 5-1/4 cups uncooked elbow macaroni
- 2-1/2 pounds ground beef
- 2 large onions, chopped
- 3 large carrots, shredded
- 3 celery ribs, chopped
- 2 cans (28 ounces each) Italian diced tomatoes, undrained
- 4 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano



Ground Beef Casseroles

- 2 packages (10 ounces each) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and squeezed dry
- 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese

Directions

1. Cook macaroni according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a large Dutch oven, cook the beef, onions, carrots and celery over medium heat until meat is no longer pink; drain. Add the tomatoes, salt, garlic powder, pepper and oregano. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 30 minutes or until vegetables are tender.

2. Drain macaroni; add macaroni and spinach to beef mixture. Pour into two greased 3-qt. baking dishes. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 25-30 minutes or until heated through.

CHURCH SUPPER

8 Servings

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 2 cups sliced peeled potatoes
- 2 cups finely chopped celery
- 3/4 cup finely chopped carrots
- 1/4 cup finely chopped green
- 1/4 cup finely chopped onion
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 cup water
- 2 cans (10-3/4 ounces each) condensed cream of mushroom soup, undiluted
- 1 can (5 ounces) chow mein noodles, divided
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink; drain and set aside.
- 2. In same skillet, saute potatoes, celery, carrots, green pepper and onion in butter 5 minutes. Add water; cover and simmer 10 minutes or until vegetables are tender. Stir in soup and cooked ground beef until blended.
- 3. Sprinkle half the chow mein noodles into a greased shallow 2-qt. baking dish. Spoon meat mixture over noodles. Cover and bake 20 minutes. Top with cheese and remaining noodles. Bake, uncovered, 10 minutes longer or until heated through.



GROUND BEEF AND PASTA

6 servings **Ingredients:**

- 12 ounces uncooked medium shells or mini penne pasta
- 1 pound lean ground chuck ground round
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 can (14.5 ounces) diced tomatoes with juice
- 1 can (15 ounces) tomato sauce
- 2 teaspoons granulated sugar
- 1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 350 F.
- 2. Lightly spray or grease an 11-by-7-inch baking dish
- 3. Cook pasta according to package directions until just tender: drain well.
- 4. In a large skillet over medium heat, saute beef with onion and celery, breaking up with a spoon. Cook, stirring, until almost cooked through.
- 5. Add garlic and salt and cook for 2 to 3 minutes longer.
- 6. Stir in the tomatoes, tomato sauce, granulated sugar, and the cooked drained pasta.
- 7. Spoon into the prepared baking dish and cover dish tightly with foil.
- 8. Bake for 30 to 40 minutes, or until hot and bubbly. Remove foil.
- 9. Sprinkle with the cheese and bake uncovered for about minutes longer, or until cheese is melted

MOZZARELLA SPAGHETTI

8 Servings **Ingredients**

- 8 ounces uncooked spaghetti, broken into thirds
- 1 large egg
- 1/2 cup whole milk
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 pound ground beef
- 1/2 pound bulk Italian sausage
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
- 1 jar (14 ounces) meatless spaghetti sauce
- 1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce
- 1 to 2 cups shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Cook spaghetti according to package directions.
- 2. Meanwhile, in a large bowl, beat egg, milk and salt. Drain spaghetti; add to egg mixture and toss to coat. Transfer to a greased 13x9-in. baking dish.
- 3. In a large skillet, cook beef, sausage, onion and green pepper over medium heat until meat is no longer pink; drain. Stir in spaghetti sauce and tomato sauce. Spoon over the spaghetti mixture.
- 4. Bake, uncovered, 20 minutes. Sprinkle with the cheese. Bake 10 minutes longer or until cheese is melted. Let stand 10 minutes before cutting.

Freeze option: Cool spaghetti completely before tossing with egg mixture. Transfer to baking dish; cover and refrigerate. Meanwhile, prepare meat sauce and cool completely before spooning over spaghetti mixture. Cover and freeze unbaked casserole. To use, partially thaw in refrigerator overnight. Remove from refrigerator 30 minutes before baking. Preheat oven to 350°. Bake as directed, increasing time as necessary to heat through and for a thermometer inserted in center to read 165°.





Claybank Master Gardeners

Greetings Gardeners!

While Hurricane Sally certainly blessed us with full rain barrels, it also over watered nearly everything else. Our local farmers were close to harvesting a record peanut crop, but too much rain at a time when dry weather was needed will severely diminish their harvest.

Too much rain can leach out essential nutrients from the soil, but by



adding compost to your plants or a balanced granular fertilizer (such as 0-10-10 which has less nitrogen to pollute water basins) a few days after the run-off of water may help them regain much needed nutrition. If you don't yet have a mature compost source, good quality mushroom compost or composted manure from a garden center will help. Another organic source, fish emulsion (also called "fish fertilizer"), is very effective and healthy for veggies and ornamental plants. Mix a tablespoon in a gallon of water and apply.

Here's what you can plant now: But first, If you get a soil test done before you plant you will find out what to add to your soil to make your veggies thrive. Beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, Chinese cabbage, collards, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce, mustard, onions, radishes, snap beans, spinach, summer squash, turnips, white potatoes, winter squash. This list is from the Alabama Cooperative Extension System's SOW app which is easy to access from your cell phone. Let it know that you live in Zone 8a or 8b (Houston, Coffee & Dale Counties). Tap on any of the suggested veggies and more information appears about how deep and far apart to plant seeds, suggested varieties, and much more.

The Claybank Master Gardeners are again meeting every third Thursday of the month, with masks and socially distanced, at 11AM at Hoppergrass Restaurant in Ozark, 129 S. East Ave. (But please call the Dale County Extension Office at (334) 774-2329 to be sure in case of changes). This month, on October 22nd we are planning to meet. Interesting speakers, on different topics related to gardening, are usually with us.






Dear James,

Well, it makes sense your wife would be onboard with the whole thing. It's her dad making the offer, so of course she would be a lot more comfortable with the idea than you are.

This is a big deal, and it's something you two should have a very serious conversation about. Get on the same page in every regard. Also, I'd recommend making sure you get everything in writing. See to it, as well, that it can be forgiven at the maximum allowable annual gift rate. addition, in the event of death make sure it's included in the estate, it's forgiven, and there will be zero call on the note. In effect, that would make it an advance on your inheritance instead of debt. Under no circumstances should they, or any other heirs, have grounds to call the note.
