

So.....I took my own advice and I planned a nice little get-away to the Adirondack Mountains with hopes of catching the leaves turning at just the right time. Some of what I put on my list of things to check out were either still closed or not fully operational, so I didn't do everything I considered doing. But, that was OK — the main intent of this trip was to get away and relax. I did a lot of driving around looking at the scenery and spent time along Main Street in Lake Placid at the shops and restaurants. I have never spent time specifically in Lake Placid, before, so it was all

My Mom used to take us to the Adirondacks on vacations when we were kids. We'd go to all those wonderful attractions that used to be there, but, sadly, are now long gone — Land of Make Believe, Frontier Town, Santa's Workshop, 1000 Animals, and others. I discovered that Santa's Workshop is still there, so I did take time to go there for "old time's sake". The workshop and park were not open due to COVID, but I got to see it, take some photos, and go in the gift shop. It was a bit of nostalgia that warmed my heart.

I'm not a hiker, so didn't get out in the woods, much. But I did go

on a lovely boat cruise on Lake Placid that made for a wonderful afternoon of fresh air on the water. I also took the Essex Ferry across Lake Champlain to Vermont for a day. I didn't have anything specific in mind to do in Vermont, except I did want to find the Ben & Jerry's factory in Waterbury. I mostly drove around checking out Burlington and Shelbourne. Shelbourne was a quaint town that had scarecrows all over town dressed like women and men all spiffed up for Sunday church complete with gloves, hats, and jewelry – I took a lot of time driving around looking at them all. I made two specific stops in Vermont - the Vermont Teddy Bear Company in Shelbourne and to have a dish of Cherry Garcia ice cream at the Ben & Jerry's factory (they weren't doing tours, so I'll have to make another trip once the restrictions are lifted to do that). Then, I headed back across Lake Champlain on the ferry to get back to Lake Placid by dinner time.

My trip wasn't meant to be a "go, go, go" week, so I spent it doing laid back, relaxing things — a lot of enjoying the lake and fall colors and reading while enjoying the lake and fall colors — hahaha — and I capped the week off with a relaxing massage in the spa at my hotel the night before I left to come home. Security and Law Enforcement Class Learn Role of Medical Examiner

Security and Law Enforcement teachers, Dudley Gilbert and Gene Newman, invited retired medical examiner Neal Hodgson to speak to their juniors at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center.

Mr. Hodgson talked to the students about his former career and showed the students an autopsy video and some photos from cases that he worked on. He talked to them about cases that made an impact on him and what they may encounter as law enforcement when attending accidents or crime scenes.

Many of the students found the autopsies interesting as well as Mr. Hodgson's observations and reactions. The images were no doubt disturbing, but left an impact on the students as far as

making poor choices and being in the wrong place at the wrong time.

Mr. Hodgson has been lecturing to students from high schools to college from over 50 years. He currently lives in Florida, but says he likes to travel around the country to talk to students and to share his expertise. "I am probably one of the few medical examiners in the country who do this and it is a very important mission to me. I will keep doing this until I am physically unable to do so. It always amazes me when I run into people who heard me talk years ago and still remember it and now I am talking to some of their children. I love what I do!'

Both Mr. Gilbert and Mr. Newman were grateful for Mr. Hodgson's time and his insights to this side of law enforcement.

IS MY COMPANY WEBSITE COPYRIGHT PROTECTED?

Your company website is a vital part of your business; it is often the first impression a potential customer has of your business. Therefore, it is just as important to protect the content of your site as it is to protect your physical business. This is done through copyright. Original website copy is considered intellectual property including blogs, videos, and webinars. The website is owned by the company, who therefore owns the copyright, but if independent contractors are used for content or design, they own what they add and you will need to include permission to use it in their contract. Registering your copyright is simple and can be done online. It is automatically protected when it goes live.

For paper applications, the Copyright Office does not send out an acknowledgement of receipt, so it's best to use a mail service that provides confirmation of delivery. If the copyright registration application is submitted electronically, the applicant will receive email confirmations of each completed step of the application process. If you have any questions about registering copyright, please call the Law Office of MACK & PACE at (585)798-1000.




Five Great Reasons to Take Engagement Photos



The Oak Orchard Light ħouse Museum

We have been unable to host our annual major fund raiser this year due the COVID-19 restrictions and we are running far short of funds required to maintain and operate both the museum and lighthouse.

Located at Point Breeze on Lake Ontario, the Oak Orchard Light House Museum is an exact replica of the original light house first erected in 1871 and destroyed in a storm. The present lighthouse was constructed in 2010 using \$200,000 raised by Orleans County citizens.

Each year, the lighthouse serves to welcome boaters, from all directions, as they enter the Point Breeze harbor. Families walk along the shore and visit the museum.

This lighthouse museum draws visitors who also spend tourism dollars in the county, and supports tourist visits drawn by other attractions.

It is a place where citizens, including school groups, learn about our commercial and recreational boating past. They learn the importance and navigational use of lighthouses. They learn local history and the place of this port in history.

The museum is generally open Friday nights from 5:00-7:00 p.m., Saturdays from 10:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m., and Sundays from noon to 4:00 p.m. It is located where Route 98 meets Lake Ontario, next to the Black North Inn, north of Albion. Or you can arrive by boat to Point Breeze and dock at the first dock on your port side as you enter the harbor.
