Iowa Lakeside Lab, Imagine Iowa Great Lakes Launch New Artist in Residence Program

Iowa Lakeside Laboratory and Imagine Iowa Great Lakes today launched a new Public Art & Ecology Artist in Residence (AIR) program. The program will result in the creation of interactive, artistic experiences that allow residents and visitors to learn about the ecology and natural systems that comprise the Iowa Great Lakes region.

Each year, an artist will be selected for an extended residency where they will develop and execute a temporary public art project. Projects will be informed by the ecology, science, and natural history of the area. To accomplish this, the Public Art & Ecology AIR will run parallel to Lakeside Lab's courses, research, and other artist residencies that occur during the summer months.



"We are grateful for the opportunity to broaden our programming and to facilitate the new AIR program. Given its longer duration, the program will afford the selected artist the ability to explore their chosen topic in greater depth," said Iowa Lakeside Lab Artists-in-Residence program director, Alex Braidwood. "This research phase will ensure the artist delivers a project that speaks to our local region and enhances the natural environment."

The new artist in residence program is expected to begin in the spring, with completion

of the project anticipated in early August to coincide with the area's peak tourism season.

"This partnership embodies the collaborative spirit we seek in all our work. The public art and ecology AIR will augment Lakeside Lab's programming while furthering Imagine's public art efforts," said Michele Goode-now, Imagine Iowa Great Lakes executive director. "We are eager to launch this program and to select our first artist in residence."

Artists interested in applying may do so at <http://lakesidelabair.org/public-art-res/>. The initial application period will be open through Monday, November 9.

Hydrate & Refresh Dry Skin

Dehydrated skin is among the many causes of facial wrinkling, which also can be caused by smoking, environmental factors and UV exposure. Aging skin doesn't produce as much collagen and elastin, which allows skin to spring back into place, as it once did. Conditions like dry, dehydrated skin may make wrinkles appear worse. Treating dehydration and dryness may reduce wrinkles and refresh dry skin, giving it a more youthful appearance.

Those who want to treat dry, dehydrated skin must hydrate skin by increasing its water content by increasing the amount of water contained in skin cells. This can result in a healthy, plump complexion. Skin that is properly hydrated will keep fine lines and wrinkles from being overly apparent.


Moisturizing skin involves applying a lubricant that mimics naturally produced lipids and oils in the skin that will protect and soothe.

Hydration and moisturizing often work hand-in-hand. In addition to drinking plenty of water to hydrate the skin from the inside out. Once water is bound to the skin, a moisturizer will prevent the water from leaving it. Look for moisturizers with natural oils and butters to help retain moisture, like cocoa butter.

The following are some additional methods to maximize hydration and moisturize skin.

- Take warm showers, as hot water can strip the natural lipids from skin and cause dryness.
- Avoid too many alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic drinks are diuretics that can cause the body to lose water.
- Use a humidifier indoors to amp up the moisture level in the air.
- Enjoy water-rich foods, like watermelon, cucumber, grapes, and other succulent fruits and vegetables.
- Drink the recommended amount of water per day, and limit your consumption of caffeinated and sugary beverages.
- Work out to improve blood flow and oxygenation in the skin.

Thursday night's opening performance will feature *Mogen's Heroes*, one of the most popular groups of the summer. *Galaxy* is scheduled for October 22nd; with *Surfin' Safari* on October 29th. *The Interstate Cruisers* are slated for November 5th, and *Storm Rising* will be the only other November performance, on the 19th. December's lone show will close the season with the *Mr.V. Trio*, along with the *Iowa Rock 'n' Roll All Stars...*

This week will have *Elliot Keane Jazz* on the stage in the barn at the Little Swan Lake Winery, on Thursday night, starting at 6:00; with *The Itty Bitty Boji Band* (Ms. Mel, Jackie, and Bill) on the same stage Saturday night, also from 6-8:00; and *Storm Rising*, too, on Sunday afternoon, from 4-6:00...

While Boji Bill has sad news, he also has some good news. The monthly Saturday night dances at the Elks Lodge in Estherville, and the monthly dances at the Spirit Lake Senior Center have been erased from the calendars until at least March of next year... His good news is the *IBBB's* appearance at the Little Swan Lake Winery, Sunday afternoon (above). His email came with an admonishment: "Stay safe!"

With all the memory enhancement drugs advertised on television these days, research director RD has found that today is the day the pill pushers have all been waiting for — Train Your Brain Day. While there are pills for that, RD, of course, has come up with a very fitting song, *A Satisfied Mind*, written by Jack Rhodes and Red Hayes in 1954. One of the most popular versions was released by Ella Fitzgerald on her 1958 album, *The First Lady of Song*, for Decca. The lyrics say, "The wealthiest person is a pauper at times compared to the man with a satisfied mind." Let's be fair here and update the lyrics to "a man or woman" with a satisfied mind. In recent years the song has been covered by country singers Marty Stuart (2003), Johnny Cash (2004) and M-m-mel Tillis (2005). (You do remember that Mr. Tellis embraced his stuttering on television!?)

Today is also **Skeptics Day**, for which RD has suggested a 1926 Jimmy McHugh song with lyrics by Clarence Gaskill, *I Can't Believe That You're in Love With Me*. In the century that has followed, the song has been recorded by Anita O'Day, (1945), Tony Bennett (1955), and Frank Sinatra on his 1961 Capitol LP, *Sinatra's Swingin' Session!*

And, **Saturday is Sweetest Day**, with just one most appropriate song, *Love Is The Sweetest Thing*, which is a Ray Noble song dating back to 1932. As with all other great songs, it, too, has been copied by a variety of artists, including Mel Torme (1946), Dinah Washington (1962), and, most recently, English singer and broadcaster Clare Teal, on her 2011 CD, *Hey Ho...*


RD also found two birthdays to celebrate over the weekend. Songwriter, pianist and sometimes vocalist and television producer, Robert William 'Bobby' Troup, Jr. was born on October 18, 1918, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. His highly acclaimed 1955 Liberty album, *Bobby Troup and His Trio*, features jazz standards written by familiar names in the business, including, *Yes, Sir, That's My Baby* (Gus Kahn/Walter Donaldson), and *Let's Get Away From It All*, (Matt Dennis/Tom Adair), as well as, *I Get a Kick Out of You*, and *I've Got You Under My Skin* (both Cole Porter).

Proving to have most of her mental faculties working even without pills, RD also discovered that the aforementioned Anita O'Day was born on October 18, 1919...

Cyclones Get Nice, Boring Victory

Saturday’s 31-15 win over Texas Tech was just what Iowa State needed after two thrilling wins to open Big 12 play over TCU and Oklahoma. Iowa State dominated this game from start to finish, with the only drama coming when ISU once again gave up a special teams’ touchdown, this time coming off a blocked 20-yard field goal that turned into a Red Raiders’ 90-yard return for a TD and an early 7-0 lead. The Cyclones, however, would not hang their heads and turned that deficit into a 21-7 halftime lead by scoring on their next three drives to take control of the game. When Connor Assalley kicked a 26-yard field goal to give ISU a 31-7 lead early in the fourth quarter, the stats were so one-sided that had you looked at them you would have thought the Cyclones would be up by even more as they had 25 first downs to Tech’s 4 and also had over 500 total yards compared to the Red Raider’s 94. Tech did put together some nice drives late in the game and scored with 4:54 left to make the final score closer than the game actually was.

It was great to see ISU dominate another Big 12 team not named Kansas, and while Tech is not an upper-division team, they easily could have been 2-0 heading into Saturday as they blew a 15-point lead with 3:30 left to Texas and had a chance to beat Kansas State in the fourth quarter last week. Brock Purdy looked like his 2018 self, running enough to keep the defense honest and being on target with his passes, ending the day 32/43 with 302 yards and two touchdowns. Breece Hall continues to prove that he’s not only one of the best running backs in the Big 12, but also in the nation, running over, around and above Tech defenders on his way to 135 yards and two touchdowns while sitting out most of the fourth quarter. ISU also showed they have one of the best tight end groups in the Big 12, with all three TEs catching at least three passes, including touchdowns by Chase Allen and Charlie Kolar. Xavier Hutchison is turning into a go to guy on the outside, as he had nine receptions for 77 yards on a day that Purdy spread out his passes to 11 different Cyclones. Jon Heacock’s defense was simply dominant, limiting a Tech offense that was averaging over 5 yards per rush to just 2.45 yards per rush, while also shutting down their passing game until late in the fourth quarter when the outcome was already determined.

#20 Iowa State now has a bye week before they will head to Stillwater, Oklahoma, for a first-place showdown with #7 Oklahoma State on October 24th. While the Cyclones have been impressive during their 3-0 Big 12 start, they do still have some things to clean up if they want to compete for a championship. On Saturday they had a touchdown called back due to an illegal formation, and that lead to the blocked field goal return, which ended up being a 14-point swing, which is something ISU will not be able to overcome against upper-level Big 12 teams. ISU also had several of these same penalties against Oklahoma that called back two big plays the week before. ISU’s special teams have now given up three touchdowns on returns, and if you throw in TCU’s fumble return of Brock Purdy’s brain cramp play, that’s four touchdowns that ISU has given up with their defense on the sideline. ISU once again lost the turnover battle on Saturday, fortunately just 1-0, as they had several plays, they could have had interceptions or fumble returns that they just didn’t capitalize on. It’s great to be able to nit-pick some of these things and still be 3-0 and tied for first in the Big 12. Let’s hope the Cyclones can get some key guys back off the injury list during this bye week and continue to build on the momentum they have created. ISU’s schedule sets up nicely with having three games on, a bye week, three more games, another bye week and then their final three games. The only drawback is that one of these byes is in Brocktober, a month when ISU is now an amazing 12-1 in during the last three+ seasons. If the Cyclones can play some October football in November, they will have a great shot at winning their first ever Big 12 championship!

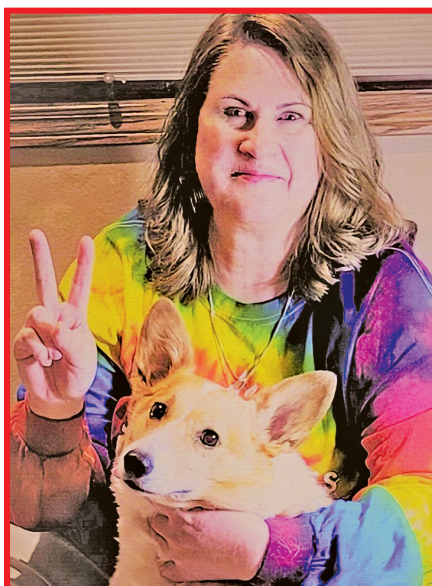

Turkey Pumpkin Chili
~ Serves 4 at 475 calories/person

1 tablespoon olive oil
1 yellow onion, chopped
2 whole carrots, peeled and chopped
1 medium zucchini
4 ounces sliced fresh mushrooms
1 pound ground turkey
1 cup pumpkin puree
15 oz. diced tomatoes with green chilies
15 ounces black beans, undrained
1/2 cup chicken broth
2 teaspoons cumin
1 1/2 teaspoons chili powder
1 teaspoon garlic powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper

Heat olive oil in a large soup pot over medium heat. Add onion and carrots and sauté for 5 minutes. Meanwhile, chop zucchini and slice mushrooms. Stir zucchini and mushrooms into the pot and cook for 2 minutes more. Grumble in ground turkey and cook, stirring and breaking apart with a spoon, until turkey is cooked through, about 5 minutes. Stir in pumpkin puree, tomatoes, undrained beans, broth, cumin, chili powder, garlic powder, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and simmer for 15 minutes, until hot and thick.

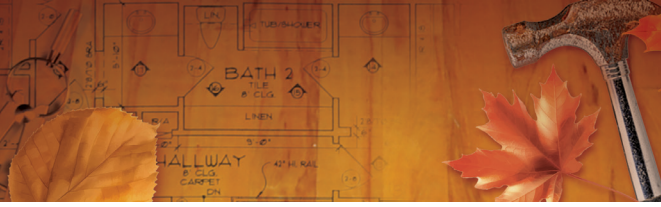

LRH Experiencing Surge Of COVID Inpatients

Dickinson County experienced their peak of COVID-19 cases in mid-June, but Lakes Regional Healthcare is just now experiencing their peak of COVID-19 inpatients. Between March 1 and August 31, LRH had a cumulative number of 18 COVID-positive patients hospitalized. During September 1 and the October 8, an additional 16 COVID-positive patients have been hospitalized at LRH.

Of the coronavirus inpatients at LRH, all but three of them have been from Dickinson County, all but one have been age 60 and older, and all but one of them have at least two comorbidities such as COPD, CHF, diabetes, or high blood pressure.

The reason for the increase in hospitalizations despite the relatively low and stable number of COVID-positive Dickinson County residents is not known, although speculations abound. LRH President and CEO Jason Harrington said, “We do know that we have kept more patients in the hospital because the admission criteria for nursing homes to accept their residents back are very stringent. Also, many of our referral centers such as Avera McKennan are near capacity and are not accepting many patients. Furthermore, we had sent some patients there, and those patients have since become stable enough to return here for us to treat. Other than that, we suspect the increase in hospitalizations may be related to schools opening and children potentially infecting grandparents and other high risk populations with coronavirus.”

In recent years the average number of patients spending the night at the hospital averaged around 10-12 patients. Over the past few weeks that number has increased to an average of 15-20 patients per night. “We’ve had to make some difficult decisions to ensure we have adequate staffing

to care for our inpatients,” said Harrington. “This week we postponed some elective inpatient surgeries and are now in the practice of evaluating our capacity each day and making determinations accordingly. It’s not something we like to do, but something that is necessary.”

LRH has had much success treating COVID-positive patients. Dickinson County Board of Health Chair and Lakes Regional Family Medicine physician Zach Borus, MD, MPH said medical staff are following best practice treatment protocols from Avera and various hospitals and medical societies. Some of the ways LRH cares for COVID-positive patients include:

- **Various levels of supplemental oxygen**
LRH has five heated high-flow oxygen machines and four ventilators/Cpap/Bi-pap machines that improve oxygen flow. There are also four negative pressure rooms in the hospital that are used for COVID-positive patients because they increase the air exchanges in the room to make the air in the room cleaner. The hospital also has in-house Respiratory Therapists to assist nursing staff and monitor the patients’ oxygen levels.
- **eServices for Additional Care**
LRH patients receive extra care remotely from Avera professionals via eServices such as eICU, ePharmacy, eRespiratory Therapy, eER, and eHospitalists.
- **Specialty Medications**
Symptoms of COVID-19 have been shown to improve when patients take medications such as Remdesivir, an anti-viral medication. In addition, steroids such as Dexamethasone help to decrease inflammation in the lungs. LRH administers these and other specialty medications known to help COVID patients.

Although currently supply levels of these medications seem stable, this remains an ongoing concern.

- **Convalescent Plasma**
LRH patients who have coronavirus have also received convalescent plasma, which contains COVID-19 antibodies from people who have previously recovered from COVID-19.
- **Positioning**
Many patients have benefited from prone positioning, which is a term that refers to the patient laying on their stomach. Dr. Borus said, “This is especially beneficial for larger patients because it relieves the pressure on the lungs, allowing the lungs to expand and allow more oxygen flow.”

According to Dr. Borus, COVID-19 transmission could be prevented by wearing masks and socially distancing. He said, “We also encourage people to stay on top of their health screenings and provider check-ups because getting other health conditions may not only compromise your health and immune system and make you more vulnerable to COVID-19, but also make it more difficult to recover from COVID-19 if you do get it.”

Those who have symptoms of coronavirus, including cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, or fever are encouraged to call LRH’s Respiratory Clinic at 712-336-6696. Those who have been exposed to someone with coronavirus can visit www.TestIowa.com, complete the questionnaire, and then attend LRH’s Test Iowa drive-through site, located in the parking lot north of the hospital off 23rd Street in Spirit Lake. The Test Iowa site is open Monday from 8:00am until 4:00pm, Tuesday through Thursday from 7:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 5:00pm, and on Friday from 7:00am until 9:00am.
