On Fri., Oct. 2, 2020, a single-engine, high performance aircraft crashed in Genesee County killing both people on board. The crash occurred in a remote wooded area off Route 33 in the Town of Corfu. Multiple agencies were called to assist in the initial fire suppression and rescue efforts. Upon arriving on scene, it was quickly determined that there were no survivors and this would be a recovery operation needing the involvement of high-level government agencies and a team of experienced individuals with the proper training and expertise with such crashes.

Jeff McIntire, Coroner for Genesee County reached out to me for assistance with the recovery mission due to my experience with several mass fatality incidents and my affiliation with the National Disaster Medical System of the U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services and DMORT. I promptly accepted the invitation and solicited the services of Wyoming County Coroner Dr. Jennifer Prutsman-Pfeiffer who is also a Forensic Anthropologist. Together with Cynthia Reynolds, Genesee County Deputy Coroner, Randy McIntire, (a former DMORT member and retired funeral director), and a tremendous compliment of volunteers, the team was able to recover the remains of the individuals who perished in the crash.

On a personal and professional level, I extend my heartfelt gratitude to ALL the volunteers who worked tirelessly for days to recover the remains and to Jeff for having the knowledge, strength and character to ask for help when he needed it. Jeff, it was my humble privilege to assist with the mission and an honor to serve with you and everyone involved... as a TEAM, working a scene which we thought "COULD NEVER HAPPEN HERE."

Travel Thoughts By Kim

Let's go on an adventure together...to Bermuda!

Whenever the weather starts to get cold, I start thinking of warm places to take the chill out of my old bones and joints. One of my favorite warm places is Bermuda. I took a Royal Caribbean cruise to Bermuda in October 2018 and it was the most perfect trip – I cannot wait to go back again and again. We sailed out of Boston, spent two and a half days at sea, then stayed docked at Bermuda for three full days, and spent another day and a half at sea returning to Boston. It was so relaxing to stay docked at one port and to have the freedom to come and go from the ship all hours of the day and night with no deadlines be on-board, except for the final day. A great mix of cruising fun and an extended stay at an amazing port.

In my never to be humble opinion, a cruise is the best way to go when traveling to Bermuda. Resorts and other lodging in Bermuda is extremely expensive and then you have to also factor in airfare to get there and your food and entertainment while you are there. When taking a cruise, especially one that includes an extended stay docked exclusively in Bermuda, your lodging, meals, entertainment, etc. are all included in one price and most likely far less expensive in the long run than staying at a resort. There are other options – different cruises and different accommodations – and a travel agent can help you find the most economical way that works best for you. But, if you ask me, a cruise is the way to go!

Bermuda is a fascinating place. It is a small island – just 21 miles long and 1.5 miles wide – that is under British rule and sits on a dead volcano. Contrary to some belief, it is not part of the Caribbean. It is actually located in the Atlantic Ocean off of the eastern coast of the US. The island was discovered in the 1600s and the original population, after it started to develop, was mostly slaves who jumped ships to freedom when they sailed past the island because it looked like a safe haven for them. Although they are British rule, they are fairly self-sufficient and even have their own currency that is equal to ours and is used interchangeably with US currency. So, you don't have to worry about exchange rates or getting Bermuda currency to use while you're there. But, be careful about bringing back any Bermuda currency, except what you may want as a souvenir – it is worthless outside of Bermuda. The cost of living in Bermuda is one of the highest in the world. They have no industry and very little agriculture, so pretty much everything has to be imported at an extremely high cost. So, expect to pay a lot at restaurants and businesses – another good reason to go the cruise option and have most, if not all, your meals on ship...not to mention the amazing free evening entertainment on-board.

You may have heard that all the buildings in Bermuda have white roofs. Well, that is correct! They are colorfully painted in beautiful pastel colors, but are all topped with white roofs. The reason for that is because there is NO fresh water on the island at all. The roofs are made of limestone and the white paint also contains limestone. The roofs are carefully designed to allow rain water to cascade across the limestone to purify it, then it is captured by a lip along the edge that directs the purified water to elaborate gutter systems sending the water into the "water cellar" – every building has one. Everyone on the island is very conservative with their water because they may need it to last through a drought! In recent years, the island now has three plants that process salt water into fresh water, but everyone is still required to generate their own water and only use the water from the conversion plants when absolutely necessary. Also, some of the more affluent homes and businesses now have their own water systems to turn salt water into fresh.

The capital of Bermuda is currently Hamilton, whereas, the original capital was St. George – the capital was moved when the population of the island started to grow. Hamilton is a larger city and more centrally located. But, St. George is absolutely incredible and loaded with history – including an awesome old church and cemetery, which is the oldest church in the Western Hemisphere still operating as a church – established in 1612. St George is a "must see" to put on your "things to do in Bermuda" list.

I took a bus tour of the island and learned so much about the history and economy of the island – our guide was amazing. Guided tours are a great way to learn so much more than brochures will offer you when touring on your own – most of the time, they are well worth the price. I like to do a bus tour first to get the low down, then do a bit of exploring on my own to see what's beyond the tours.



I went on two glass bottom boat tours – they were literally the same tour with different themes, but one was during the day and one was at night. Both were really fun and I'm glad I did both, but I especially liked the one at night – how cool is it to be on a pirate themed boat at night drinking rum in the Bermuda Triangle!!!!? I took a lot of ribbing when I was planning my trip – lots of jokes about never seeing me, again. But, that whole Bermuda Triangle legend is really just a myth. Yes, strange things have happened there and the magnetic and gravitational pulls can be an issue. But, a lot of what has happened can be explained by understanding that ships and planes didn't use to have as advanced technology as they do now and they didn't know how to navigate through the extensive barrier reefs, so the magnetic and gravitational anomalies made it difficult for them to pass through the area safely. So, don't worry --- go to Bermuda and enjoy without fear of getting "lost"!

There is so much to see and do on this tiny little island. But, one of the best things is to just go spend some time on Horseshoe Bay Beach – consistently ranked among the Top 5 Most Beautiful Beaches in the WORLD! The pink sand (colored with pink flecks caused by the coral reefs) and crystal blue water is simply stunning and unlike any sand and water you'll find anywhere else in the world! The water is even more blue and beautiful than the waters in the Caribbean...totally indescribable.

But, with all of the amazing things I did and saw while in Bermuda, the most memorable thing was getting to swim with dolphins. Just off the ship, there is a lagoon that I was able to swim and play with dolphins and even got to kiss one! It was the best time and best money I spent on the entire trip...I LOVED IT!!!


If you like history, snorkeling, rum, boating adventures, dolphins...did I mention rum...or just sitting on any one of several stunning beaches soaking up the sun, you'll absolutely love Bermuda! And, October is a great time to go – it was still in the 80s every day, but it was just about the end of the season, so there were less tourists to deal with than in higher peak times of the year.

OPEN OR CLOSED ADOPTION?



Albion merchants want to do more murals in community

ALBION – Members of the Albion Merchants Association and other key contributors are pleased with a new mural about Albion being home to the original Santa School. They watched a stucco wall be transformed into a winter scene, with a prominent reindeer, snowy owl, and a Santa's outstretched hand in a white glove. The wall acts as a welcome sign, proclaiming Albion as "Home of the original Santa School."

Justin Suarez is putting the finishing touches on the mural today on the north side of the Lake Country Pennysaver at 170 North Main St.

Courtney Henderson, president of the Merchants Association, and Natasha Wasuck, an AMA member, created a GoFundMe for the project and solicited other donations. They challenged the community to support the project back in June, when so many of the local festivals and events were being canceled for the summer.

"Help us beautify the town in dark times," they wrote. "Together we can help paint a view for a brighter future, lift moods in our neighborhood and for those traveling to or just passing through. Join us to make our city shine with a one-of-a-kind art piece."

The AMA received \$1,290 through GoFundMe, plus \$1,000 each from the AMA and Albion Betterment Committee. Other donors also stepped forward outside of GoFund Me. "It certainly adds a lot as you come into the village from this direction," said Gary Derwick, an ABC director. "It's great we have new business people pushing it."

County Legislator Ken DeRoller gave \$500 towards the project. He said it will help brand Albion and adds another spot for people to see in town.

3 ways to eat healthy on game day

Game day gatherings are a great way to make sports more fun. But they also can compromise people's efforts to eat right, as traditional tailgate fare is not always so healthy. Thankfully, there are ways to eat healthy on gameday without forgoing fun.

1. Learn your calorie counts. Education might be your greatest ally if you want to stay the dietary course on game day. According to the United States Department of Agriculture, popular game day fare like beer and chicken wings are high in calories. Beers vary depending on which type you're drinking, but 12-ounce light beers typically contain around 100 calories apiece. The USDA also notes that a half dozen chicken wings typically come in at just under 700 calories, though that number will increase when dipping the wings into blue cheese or ranch dressing or slathering them in barbecue sauce. Understanding how high in calories these staples can be may compel you to opt for healthier, lighter fare, such as vegetables and water.

2. Pay attention to how much you're eating. A 2014 study published in the Journal of the American Medical Association: Internal Medicine found that the amount of food people eat while watching something is influenced by what they're watching. Conducted by researchers at Cornell University, the study found that people ate considerably more while watching action-packed entertainment than they did while watching more sedate programs like talk shows. Researchers concluded that the action-packed programs distracted people from how much they were eating. If you want to limit how much you eat while watching the big game, make a conscious effort to track your consumption, even making a small snack bag before the game begins and eating only that once it starts.

3. Make your own foods. When you make your own food for game day, you control what you're putting into your body. Homemade snacks that are low in calories and don't contain much sugar can help you stay the dietary course more effectively than brownies, chips and nachos.

Game day can quickly derail diets if fans aren't mindful of what they eat. But staying the dietary course on game day is easier than sports fans may think. ■

3

Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.

4

Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

OTHER STROKE WARNING SIGNS

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking, dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

Signs of a HEART ATTACK
