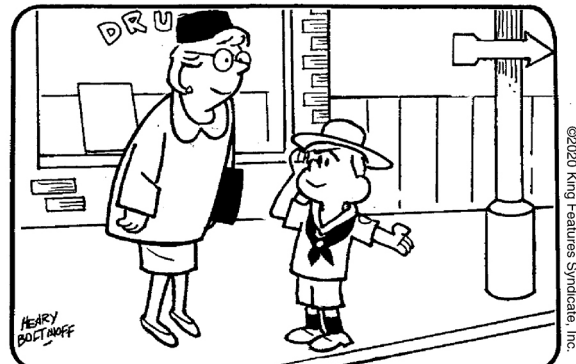

In early October 2011, a police officer saw a little puppy in the middle of South Main Street in Danville, about to be hit by a car. He picked him up and brought him to the shelter.

April, the shelter manager, put the required cage card on his cage door. She looked at him and said, "Oh, Paulette has to meet you." She knew I loved long, low dog bodies with scruffy hair. He was part wirehaired dachshund and part poodle.

When April brought him in to my office, she said we needed to find a name for him. I said, "No, his name is Wally."

I had not had a dog since my beloved Katy went to heaven and I thought I would not be able to have another one. Wally, though, had a kind, gentle heart and soft eyes that looked at me with a lot of love. I took him home one night to meet my two shelter-adopted cats and they absolutely terrorized him. I thought then that another home should be sought, so Wally went to a couple of adoption fairs. He did not interact with anyone, choosing instead to be held in my lap with his head on my shoulder. He spent the days in the shelter office.

We were building a new wing on to the shelter at the time and Wally and April's dogs loved to run up and down the long hallway after the construction people left. When we left, Wally snuggled into a cat cage with lots of blankets and toys. The then-board president, Lynn, came by after work every evening to let Wally have one last potty break. We had him neutered, so he was ready to go into a new home when the perfect one was found. I still have the picture of him sitting on the examination table and my heart melts whenever I see it.

One day, though, I decided Wally absolutely had to come home with me. He came to terms with Billy and Becky, my shelter-adopted cats. The terms were that he agreed to completely capitulate to them, never walk by them, and let them do whatever they wanted to do to him. In return, they let him on the couch and eat his food.

Wally and I settled in to a routine and Wally became a full-time shelter staff member. He loved to sit by the front door and supervise the Public Works employees across the street.

Wally loved the simple things in life - a soft bed under my desk, play time on the weekend with April's dogs in her fenced-in yard, barking at all the big dogs coming into the shelter, and running up and down the shelter hallways when we were closed.

About two weeks ago, he had a look in his eye that told me he was not feeling well. The horrible news came that he had a mass on his spleen and within 24 hours, his spleen was removed. The pathology report was not good. My little Wally boy had lymphoma and had 1-3 years left to live.

His decline, though, was a rapid one. His lymph nodes were quite obviously swollen and he felt awful. Wally's eyes were truly a mirror to his soul. I recognized the kindness in them, and now I recognized the pain and weakness.

On Monday, October 26th, Wally went to heaven with assistance from a veterinarian. He leaves behind broken hearts and a legacy of gentleness (well, except in his desire to bark at large dogs).

I was with him as his spirit left his body and I know I will see him again. The space under my desk seems so empty without my little Wa-Wa man.

Tavern Table

Although antique dealers tell us early 1900s oak furniture doesn't sell — average Chippendale pieces are not wanted and fancy French designs of the past are out of style — some average examples and even good copies can be useful and a good investment.

In 1899, Wallace Nutting started photographing, hand-coloring and selling scenes that had a "Colonial" look. He bought and borrowed the furniture and accessories, and sold thousands of the pictures. There were some historic flaws in the pictures, like hooked rugs in front of the fireplace in an early 1700s scene. Eventually, he started to make and sell accurate copies of his furniture. Today, there are collectors of Wallace Nutting furniture as well as the photographs.

In the 1920s, Peter Hunt decided to paint early wooden furniture with the colorful peasant designs he developed. It became popular as a style, and today, Peter Hunt furniture sells for more than the type of furniture he repainted. Costume jewelry also was made to look like expensive gold and gem-set originals. Nowadays, the best of signed costume jewelry can sell for thousands of dollars. A Wallace Nutting tavern table made in the early 20th century as a copy of an 18th-century table sold at a Garth's auction for \$469.

"Meet the Beatles" sold for \$275.

* The human body gives off enough heat in 30 minutes to bring a gallon of water to a boil.

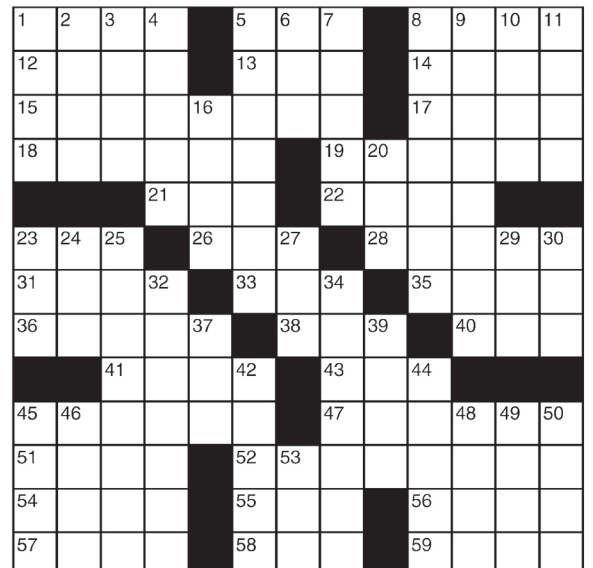

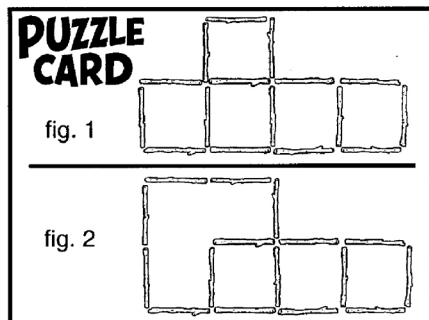

The Weight-Loss Battle Continues

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am looking for advice on diet pills. I have tried everything. I eat well, go to the gym and walk, but my meniscus problem limits my walking speed. Since menopause, I have gained 30 pounds. I am sure there is something out there that will kick-start my metabolism. I am so depressed, and my doctor has no sympathy. -- A.R.

ANSWER: Difficulty losing excess weight is one of the greatest public health problems in industrial countries, and I'm not going to solve it here, but I'll try to discuss principles of drug treatment for weight.

One critical issue is to look at any medications you are taking: Many can cause weight gain, and some, like beta blockers, often used for high blood pressure, are unrecognized by many doctors. Stopping medicines that predispose to weight gain is critical.

Depression itself is a predisposing factor to weight gain. Some people lose weight with depression, but my experience is that weight gain is much more common. Many anti-depression medicines cause weight gain. One, bupropion, commonly causes weight loss.

Among medicines specifically for weight loss, most work either by decreasing fat absorption or by reducing appetite. They don't really increase metabolism, with the exception of phentermine, which does increase resting energy expenditure somewhat and may be useful in preventing weight regain in people who have lost weight, for whom metabolism does often slow down.

Orlistat (called Xenical by prescription, Alli over-the-counter) prevents the body from absorbing some of the fat in the diet. The fat is then excreted through stool. This may cause many people to have gastrointestinal side effects, which are diminished when on a low-fat diet. Orlistat caused people to lose about 7 pounds more than placebo.

There are several drugs that work on appetite. Liraglutide is a diabetes medicine that has been found to be helpful in overweight people even without diabetes. Metformin is another diabetes medicine that is sometimes used for weight loss, although it does not have a Food and Drug Administration indication for this. Both of these diabetes drugs often have gastrointestinal side effects. Lorcaserin (Belviq) is about as effective as orlistat, but with fewer side effects (headache was the most common).

Some weight loss experts use combination drugs, including phentermine/topiramate (Qsymia) and bupropion/naltrexone (Contrave). These have more significant risks. I don't prescribe these drugs, but I do refer my patients who are interested in medication treatment to a weight loss expert. Look for a doctor who is board certified in obesity management.

It's important to remember that medications are not a cure for being overweight. Once the medicines stop, weight is expected to rise, unless a person makes significant changes in diet and exercise.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Does cooking affect fiber content in foods? I find that I have an easier time eating cooked vegetables, but I have read a recommendation to eat raw vegetables for fiber. I cook them by steaming. -- A.N.

ANSWER: Cooking does not significantly decrease the amount of fiber in foods. You can get the benefits of fiber from raw or cooked vegetables. Overcooking vegetables does reduce their vitamin content, but brief steaming doesn't much affect the vitamins in food. Peeling vegetables reduces both fiber and vitamin content, so whenever possible, leave on the skin after a thorough scrubbing.

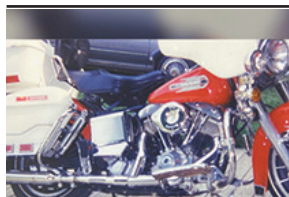

To make walnut crisp topping: In food processor, pulse 1 cup walnuts until finely ground.

In small bowl, combine ground walnuts, flour, brown sugar, oats and cinnamon. Cut butter into mixture until coarse crumb forms. Coarsely chop remaining walnuts and stir into crumb mixture until incorporated. Set aside.

To make apple pear filling: Preheat oven to 350 F. In bowl, toss apples, pears, sugar, cornstarch, cinnamon, salt and lemon juice.

Pumpkin Walnut Sage Risotto

Total time: 30 minutes

Risotto:

- 6 cups vegetable stock
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1/2 large yellow onion, finely diced
- 1 1/2 cups Arborio rice
- 1 cup pumpkin puree
- 1/4 cup grated pecorino cheese

Walnut Sage Pesto:

- 2 cloves fresh garlic
- 1 cup California walnuts
- 1/2 cup fresh sage leaves, plus additional for garnish, if desired
- 1/2 cup grated pecorino cheese, plus additional for garnish, if desired
- 2 tablespoons olive oil

kosher salt, to taste black pepper, to taste

To make risotto: In medium pot over medium-low heat, heat vegetable stock.

In large, heavy pot over medium heat, heat olive oil. Add onion and cook, stirring often, 5 minutes, or until soft.

Add rice and cook, stirring often, 2-3 minutes until rice is translucent except for white center.

Add hot stock 1 cup at a time, stirring frequently. As stock is absorbed, add another cup. Continue until all stock has been incorporated and rice is cooked al dente, about 20 minutes. Stir in pumpkin and cheese.

To make walnut sage pesto: In bowl of food processor, combine garlic and walnuts; pulse until minced. Add 1/2 cup sage leaves, 1/2 cup cheese and olive oil; pulse until coarse pesto forms. Season with salt, to taste.

In final few minutes, add 1/2 cup walnut sage pesto to risotto, stirring until well incorporated. Season with kosher salt and black pepper, to taste. Garnish with remaining pesto, cheese and fresh sage, if desired.

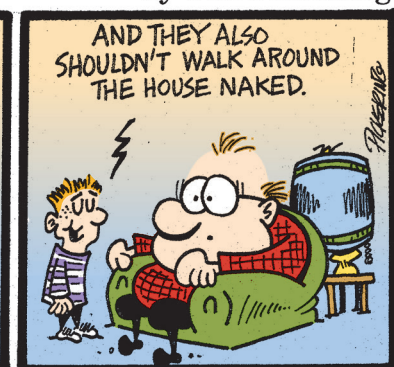
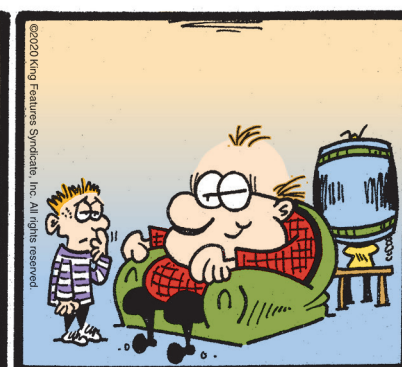

RECIPES

Chicken Spaghetti



Ingredients

- ¼ cup unsalted butter
- 1 yellow bell pepper, diced small
- 1 red bell pepper, diced small
- 1 small onion, diced small
- 3 clove garlic, minced
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup half and half
- ¾ cups parmesan cheese, grated
- 1 tablespoon fresh chopped parsley
- 1 rotisserie chicken (about 3 cups), shredded and cut into small pieces
- ½ a (16-ounce) package spaghetti
- 1 cup sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- extra parsley for garnish, optional
- salt and pepper to taste

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Cook spaghetti according to directions on the package. Drain and add a little oil or butter to prevent it sticking together, set aside.

In a 12-inch cast iron skillet over medium heat melt the butter. Add the peppers, onion, and the garlic. Cook for 3 to 5 minutes or until vegetables are tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in the flour and cook for about 1 minute. Stir in the chicken broth and allow it to come to a boil while continuing to stir. Whisk in the half and half stirring continuously to prevent sticking. Allow it to come to a boil then stir in the grated parmesan cheese and the parsley, remove from the heat.

Stir in the chicken and the pasta. Bake in the preheated oven for 18 to 20 minutes. Top with the sharp cheddar cheese. Bake 3 to 5 minutes, or until cheese is melted. Optionally, garnish with fresh parsley.

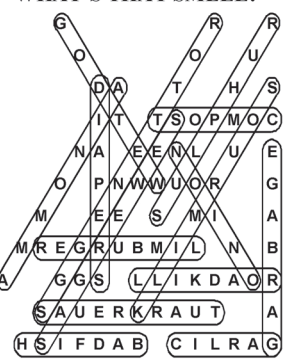
