I sold a car and over the weekend the engine failed. I never had any problems with the car and I don't believe the person that bought it did anything to the engine that made it fail. Now the person wants their money back. I sold the car "as is". What can I do?

Owen, Moulton, AL

Between an ordinary buyer and ordinary seller as opposed to people in the business of buying and selling cars, I would advise people to be very specific about what representations are made during the sale of a car. As I have said before, if it is not in writing it is not worth the paper it is not written on.

If a "try out" period is given by the seller it should be specific as to time and miles. If a warranty is given it should be specific as to what is warranted and what is not.

In normal business usage the phrase included in the sale of a used car "as is, where is" means and is intended to mean that there is no warranty at all. The courts of this state have consistently held that absent special circumstances a car purchased "as is, where is" has no warranty and the seller has no duty to repair any problem once the transaction has been made.

A specific exception is made for the sale of a car with a salvage title. There is a statutory duty to provide the buyer with the following information in no smaller than 10 point type: "This vehicle's title contains the designation "salvage" or "rebuilt"." Other exceptions could include specific misrepresentations as to the arra condition that were known to the collect and the car's condition that were known to the seller and made fraudulently or willfully suppressed. Misrepresentations as to the odometer are covered under federal law and each title contains an odometer statement. Those misrepresentations have a minimum and maximum monetary penalty as compensatory damages and a jury could award punitive damages as well.

Including the phrase "as is, where is" in any bill of sale is good business unless otherwise agreed upon and in this case the result is that you do not have to give the money back.

Mark and Sonya Zaremba of Killen have hiked on trails throughout the United States and in other coun-However, tries. said Cane they Creek Canyon Nature Preserve is as spectacular as any state or national

park they have visited. "It's a real gem," Sonya said.

More than 15 miles of hiking trails crisscross the preserve, which is owned by Jim and Faye Lacefield. The preserve is open sunrise to sunset daily. Admission is free.

With more than 100 species of native trees, the preserve has one of the most diverse forests in Alabama. Numerous wildflowers, including rare species, also grow at the preserve.

Jacqueline Gray Miller, Alabama marketing manager for the Nature Conservancy, said it is unusual to find so much forest diversity in one area.

During the fall, the pre-serve is one of the best places in north Alabama to see

colorful foliage. The canyon is about 350 feet deep in places and was carved by Cane Creek flowing over sandstone.

Waterfalls and stone overhangs are located along the canyon walls. The streams and creeks at the preserve are crystal clear.

Wildlife, including deer, bobcats and otters, can be found at the preserve.

The Lacefields enjoy sharing their land with others to provide a place for exploring nature, and they enjoy meeting the many visitors.

Miller said it is the only privately owned nature preserve with free admission in Alabama.

Susann Hamlin, presi-dent and CEO of Colbert County Tourism and Convention Bureau, considers Cane Creek Canyon Nature Preserve to be the perfect place for a leisurely walk or an all-day hike.


"It's a great place for families to spend time in the outdoors, discovering nature," Hamlin said.

The preserve is pet friendly. Many hikers take their dogs and let them run free along the trails.

Directions to Cane Creek Canyon Nature Preserve from Tuscumbia: Turn onto the service road at Colbert County Farmers Coopera-tive, 1417 U.S. Highway 72. At the end of the service road, turn left onto Frankfort Road. Travel south on Frankfort Road for 8 1/4 miles to Loop Road. Turn right onto Loop Road and travel about 150 feet. Loop Road will curve right, but go straight onto the gravel road and continue to ¹/₂-mile to the Lacefield's home.






Dear Editor:

Rivater collection is a way to conserve water that can be adopted by both private homeowners and businesses. Harvesting water during peak times of precipitation ensures water will be on hand during drought or when water restrictions are implemented. Making use of rainwater reduces reliance on underground wells or municipal water systems. Harvesting rainwater also can help prevent flooding and soil erosion.

The average homeowner can collect thousands of gallons of rainwater each year. To learn just how much water can be harvested, as well as how many natural resources can be produced from that rain, visit www.save-the-rain.com, where men and women can calculate their rain collection potential by geographic location and average rainfall. Afterward, homeowners may be inclined to establish their own rainwater harvesting systems. Here is how to get started.

• Determine your roofing material. Potable water can be harvested from homes with sheet

metal or slate roofing. Clay or adobe tiles also may be acceptable. Asphalt, wood shingles and tar roofs may leach toxic chemicals into the water, making it unsafe for drinking. This rainwater may only be collected to use for irrigation methods or washing cars and outdoor items.

• Check gutter materials. Some gutters are made with lead soldering components. A commercial lead swab test can help you determine if there is lead present in your gutters. At a later time you can choose to replace the gutters if you desire a potable supply of water.

• Invest in a collection tank or barrel. A number of manu-facturers offer prefabricated rain collection systems complete with collection barrels. Otherwise, you can use your own barrel or tank to house the collected water. Ensure it is large enough to handle the volume of water collected.

• Purchase and install leaf guards. If your home is surrounded by many trees, you probably accumulate leaf and tree debris in your home gutters and downspouts. Leaf guards will help keep the gutters clear and increase water flow through the water collection system.



• Create a water collection area. A portion of the gutter system should be removed so that it connects to the collection barrel or tank. As the rain falls, it will run down the roof and into the gutters before it streams into the downspouts. The downspout connected to the tank will deposit the water directly inside. Filters can be installed to help block the flow of debris.

• Outfit the tank for overflow and water usage. A spigot and hose connection makes it easy to use the collected water for outdoor purposes. Many rainwater collection systems are designed with an overflow safeguard that will prevent the water from backing up through the system. It will divert the rainwater back out of the downspout when the barrel or tank is full.

A rainwater collection system harnesses a natural source of water to be used for gardens and other outdoor purposes. This water doesn't contain chlorine or other additives, making it relatively clean and safe to use. Homeowners should check to see if a permit is necessary to install a rainwater collection system and then begin gathering water for various uses.





Ou granddaughter is namec after my Mom, Ruby Rivers After mom died I never imagined that I would be calling anyone else ir my life "Ruby". But Lora had a different idea. Hei grandmother died wher she was thirteen and she had saved the name for last year's birth. I must admit it has been an adjustment saying that name all the time. I had put it away. But the small, smiling face with the full little afro that now wears that name brings joy back to that name. Ruby heals and rejuvenates a spirit of hope. I once wrote "I can say [this] about Ruby Rivers, my mom. She didn't try to be positive and encouraging. She just was positive and encouraging She was always young in her enthusiasm and in the center of her hear was hope and cheer. She was wonderful." Little Ruby's innocence and joy honors her name. She too is wonderful. She reminds me that there is hope. She encourages my heart. My mom would be crazy about her!

Happy birthday, Ruby! 1 am simply glad that you are with us on this day - that is a miraculous blessing like every first birthday or earth. Stay sweet. Stay ful of hope and cheer and, ir your lifetime, give - like your namesake.



Rent To Own

Several weeks ago I promised you a column about Contract for Deed vs. Lease with Option to Buy (sometimes referred to as "rent to own"). Before I get started, let me just say that I am not an attorney. I am going to share with you some of my own opinions and what I have learned from my years in the real estate business, but ultimately you must consult your attorney about

matters like this. I only have room this week to look at one side of this equation, so we're going to go with the Seller side first. If you have a property that isn't selling, sometimes one of these options may be a great way to open up avenues to otherwise unavailable buyers. Let's look at both.

The way that a standard Contract for Deed is usually of no advantage to the Seller. This contract gives the Buyer an equitable interest in the property. It can also be an extremely costly and lengthy process to remove the Buyer from the property, should they breach the contract. On the other hand, the standard process for a Lease with Option to Buy is much more to the Seller's advantage. With a Lease with Option, the Seller retains ownership of the property without losing equitable interest. In the event of a breach of contract, the Seller can usually pursue the case without the aid of an attorney, and can pursue it in district rather than circuit court. In cases of breach of contract, it is also less costly and far less time consuming to remove the tenant from the property.

A wise attorney once told me that any contract is only as good as the parties executing it. Whichever option you choose to go with, know that if both parties adhere to the terms of the contract, neither should have any problems. A common misconception is that a Contract for Deed involves a much smaller down payment, when that is actually not always the case. The down payment, along with all of the other terms, is negotiable. If you're a Buyer and all of this seems to be negative information, take heart! We will discuss things from a Buyer's point of view next time. Whether you're a Buyer or a Seller, remember that it is important to consult

an attorney before entering into a contract. - mr Please feel free to send your questions.


